myself a little <u>47\_2CO\_11\_16</u># I say again, Let no man think me a fool; if otherwise, yet as a fool receive me, that I may boast myself a little.

myself a transgressor <u>48\_GAL\_02\_18</u> # For if I build again the things which I destroyed, I make myself a transgressor.

myself against sorrow <u>24\_JER\_08\_18</u> # [When] I would comfort myself against sorrow, my heart [is] faint in me.

myself alone and <u>18\_JOB\_31\_17</u># Or have eaten my morsel myself alone, and the fatherless hath not eaten thereof;

myself alone bear <u>05\_DEU\_01\_12</u># How can I myself alone bear your cumbrance, and your burden, and your strife?

myself alone <u>05\_DEU\_01\_09</u> # And I spake unto you at that time, saying, I am not able to bear you myself alone:

myself also am <u>44\_ACT\_10\_26</u># But Peter took him up, saying, Stand up; I myself also am a man.

myself also am <u>45\_ROM\_15\_14</u> # And I myself also am persuaded of you, my brethren, that ye also are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge, able also to admonish one another.

myself also <u>10\_2SA\_18\_02</u> # And David sent forth a third part of the people under the hand of Joab, and a third part under the hand of Abishai the son of Zeruiah, Joab's brother, and a third part under the hand of Ittai the Gittite. And the king said unto the people, I will surely go forth with you myself also.

myself also <u>45\_ROM\_16\_02</u> # That ye receive her in the Lord, as becometh saints, and that ye assist her in whatsoever business she hath need of you: for she hath been a succourer of many, and of myself also.

myself and came <u>05\_DEU\_10\_05</u># And I turned myself and came down from the mount, and put the tables in the ark which I had made; and there they be, as the LORD commanded me.

myself and enter <u>11\_1KI\_22\_30</u># And the king of Israel said unto Jehoshaphat, I will disguise myself, and enter into the battle; but put thou on thy robes. And the king of Israel disguised himself, and went into the battle.

myself and mine <u>18\_JOB\_19\_27</u> # Whom I shall see for myself, and mine eyes shall behold, and not

myself and repent <u>18\_JOB\_42\_06</u># Wherefore I abhor [myself], and repent in dust and ashes.

myself and sanctify <u>26\_EZE\_38\_23</u> # Thus will I magnify myself, and sanctify myself; and I will be known in the eyes of many nations, and they shall know that I [am] the LORD.

myself and the <u>43\_JOH\_08\_18</u># I am one that bear witness of myself, and the Father that sent me beareth witness of me.

myself and to <u>46\_1CO\_04\_06</u> # And these things, brethren, I have in a figure transferred to myself and [to] Apollos for your sakes; that ye might learn in us not to think [of men] above that which is written, that no one of you be puffed up for one against another.

myself and to <u>17\_EST\_05\_12</u># Haman said moreover, Yea, Esther the queen did let no man come in with the king unto the banquet that she had prepared but myself; and to morrow am I invited unto her also with the king.

myself and will <u>14\_2CH\_18\_29</u># And the king of Israel said unto Jehoshaphat, I will disguise myself, and will go to the battle; but put thou on thy robes. So the king of Israel disguised himself; and they went to the battle.

myself as a <u>19\_PSA\_131\_02</u> # Surely I have behaved and quieted myself, as a child that is weaned of his mother: my soul [is] even as a weaned child.

myself as I <u>38\_ZEC\_07\_03</u> # [And] to speak unto the priests which [were] in the house of the LORD of hosts, and to the prophets, saying, Should I weep in the fifth month, separating myself, as I have done these so many years?

myself as though <u>19\_PSA\_35\_14</u># I behaved myself as though [he had been] my friend [or] brother: I bowed down heavily, as one that mourneth [for his] mother.

myself at all <u>27\_DAN\_10\_03</u># I ate no pleasant bread, neither came flesh nor wine in my mouth, neither did I anoint myself at all, till three whole weeks were fulfilled.

myself before the <u>33\_MIC\_06\_06</u> # Wherewith shall I come before the LORD, [and] bow myself before the high God? shall I come before him with burnt offerings, with calves of a year old?

myself beseech you <u>47\_2CO\_10\_01</u> # Now I Paul myself beseech you by the meekness and gentleness of Christ, who in presence [am] base among you, but being absent am bold toward you:

myself but as <u>43\_JOH\_08\_28</u> # Then said Jesus unto them, When ye have lifted up the Son of man, then shall ye know that I am [he], and [that] I do nothing of myself; but as my Father hath taught me, I speak these things.

myself But every <u>46\_1CO\_07\_07</u> # For I would that all men were even as I myself. But every man hath his proper gift of God, one after this manner, and another after that.

myself but he <u>43\_JOH\_07\_28</u> # Then cried Jesus in the temple as he taught, saying, Ye both know me, and ye know whence I am: and I am not come of myself, but he that sent me is true, whom ye know not.

myself but he <u>43\_JOH\_08\_42</u> # Jesus said unto them, If God were your Father, ye would love me: for I proceeded forth and came from God; neither came I of myself, but he sent me.

myself but the <u>43\_JOH\_12\_49</u> # For I have not spoken of myself; but the Father which sent me, he gave me

a commandment, what I should say, and what I should speak.

myself but the <u>43\_JOH\_14\_10</u># Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works.

myself for an <u>14\_2CH\_07\_12</u> # And the LORD appeared to Solomon by night, and said unto him, I have heard thy prayer, and have chosen this place to myself for an house of sacrifice.

myself from being <u>47\_2CO\_11\_09</u># And when I was present with you, and wanted, I was chargeable to no man: for that which was lacking to me the brethren which came from Macedonia supplied: and in all [things] I have kept myself from being burdensome unto you, and [so] will I keep [myself].

myself from him <u>19\_PSA\_55\_12</u># For [it was] not an enemy [that] reproached me; then I could have borne [it]: neither [was it] he that hated me [that] did magnify [himself] against me; then I would have hid myself from him:

myself from mine <u>10\_2SA\_22\_24</u># I was also upright before him, and have kept myself from mine iniquity.

myself from mine <u>19\_PSA\_18\_23</u># I was also upright before him, and I kept myself from mine iniquity.

myself from thee <a><u>18\_JOB\_13\_20</u></a> # Only do not two [things] unto me: then will I not hide myself from thee.

myself handle me <u>42\_LUK\_24\_39</u> # Behold my hands and my feet, that it is I myself: handle me, and see; for a spirit hath not flesh and bones, as ye see me have.

myself happy king <u>44\_ACT\_26\_02</u> # I think myself happy, king Agrippa, because I shall answer for myself this day before thee touching all the things whereof I am accused of the Jews:

myself have I <u>01\_GEN\_22\_16</u># And said, By myself have I sworn, saith the LORD, for because thou hast done this thing, and hast not withheld thy son, thine only [son]:

myself I have <u>43\_JOH\_10\_18</u> # No man taketh it from me, but I lay it down of myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This commandment have I received of my Father.

myself I will <u>47\_2CO\_12\_05</u># Of such an one will I glory: yet of myself I will not glory, but in mine infirmities.

myself I will <u>18\_JOB\_10\_01</u> # My soul is weary of my life; I will leave my complaint upon myself; I will speak in the bitterness of my soul.

myself in great <u>19\_PSA\_131\_01</u> # A Song of degrees of David. LORD, my heart is not haughty, nor mine eyes lofty: neither do I exercise myself in great matters, or in things too high for me.

myself in sorrow <u>18\_JOB\_06\_10</u> # Then should I yet have comfort; yea, I would harden myself in sorrow: let him not spare; for I have not concealed the words of the Holy One.

myself in the <u>09\_1SA\_20\_05</u> # And David said unto Jonathan, Behold, to morrow [is] the new moon, and I should not fail to sit with the king at meat: but let me go, that I may hide myself in the field unto the third [day] at even.

myself in the <u>12\_2KI\_05\_18</u># In this thing the LORD pardon thy servant, [that] when my master goeth into the house of Rimmon to worship there, and he leaneth on my hand, and I bow myself in the house of Rimmon: when I bow down myself in the house of Rimmon, the LORD pardon thy servant in this thing.

myself in the <u>12\_2KI\_05\_18</u># In this thing the LORD pardon thy servant, [that] when my master goeth

myself in thy <u>19\_PSA\_119\_16</u># I will delight myself in thy statutes: I will not forget thy word.

myself in thy 19\_PSA\_119\_47 # And I will delight myself in thy commandments, which I have loved.

myself known among <u>26\_EZE\_35\_11</u># Therefore, [as] I live, saith the Lord GOD, I will even do according to thine anger, and according to thine envy which thou hast used out of thy hatred against them; and I will make myself known among them, when I have judged thee.

myself known unto <u>26\_EZE\_20\_05</u># And say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD; In the day when I chose Israel, and lifted up mine hand unto the seed of the house of Jacob, and made myself known unto them in the land of Egypt, when I lifted up mine hand unto them, saying, I [am] the LORD your God;

myself known unto <u>26\_EZE\_20\_09</u># But I wrought for my name's sake, that it should not be polluted before the heathen, among whom they [were], in whose sight I made myself known unto them, in bringing them forth out of the land of Egypt.

myself known unto <u>04\_NUM\_12\_06</u># And he said, Hear now my words: If there be a prophet among you, [I] the LORD will make myself known unto him in a vision, [and] will speak unto him in a dream.

myself lest I <u>08\_RUT\_04\_06</u># And the kinsman said, I cannot redeem [it] for myself, lest I mar mine own inheritance: redeem thou my right to thyself; for I cannot redeem [it].

myself mine own <u>18\_JOB\_09\_20</u> # If I justify myself, mine own mouth shall condemn me: [if I say], I [am] perfect, it shall also prove me perverse.

myself my honour <u>43\_JOH\_08\_54</u> # Jesus answered, If I honour myself, my honour is nothing: it is my Father that honoureth me; of whom ye say, that he is your God:

myself my witness <u>43\_JOH\_05\_31</u> # If I bear witness of myself, my witness is not true.

myself now will <u>23\_ISA\_42\_14</u> # I have long time holden my peace; I have been still, [and] refrained myself: [now] will I cry like a travailing woman; I will destroy and devour at once.

myself perceived also <u>21\_ECC\_02\_14</u> # The wise man's eyes [are] in his head; but the fool walketh in darkness: and I myself perceived also that one event happeneth to them all.

myself saith the <u>24\_JER\_22\_05</u> # But if ye will not hear these words, I swear by myself, saith the LORD, that this house shall become a desolation.

myself saith the <u>24\_JER\_49\_13</u> # For I have sworn by myself, saith the LORD, that Bozrah shall become a desolation, a reproach, a waste, and a curse; and all the cities thereof shall be perpetual wastes.

myself servant unto <u>46\_1CO\_09\_19</u> # For though I be free from all [men], yet have I made myself servant unto all, that I might gain the more.

myself serve the <u>45\_ROM\_07\_25</u> # I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the law of God; but with the flesh the law of sin.

myself seven thousand <u>45\_ROM\_11\_04</u> # But what saith the answer of God unto him? I have reserved to myself seven thousand men, who have not bowed the knee to [the image of] Baal.

myself shall come <u>50\_PHP\_02\_24</u> # But I trust in the Lord that I also myself shall come shortly.

myself should be <u>46\_1CO\_09\_27</u> # But I keep under my body, and bring [it] into subjection: lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a castaway.

myself so that <u>44\_ACT\_20\_24</u># But none of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to testify the gospel of the grace of God.

myself that I <u>47\_2CO\_02\_01</u> # But I determined this with myself, that I would not come again to you in heaviness.

myself that I <u>44\_ACT\_26\_09</u> # I verily thought with myself, that I ought to do many things contrary to the name of Jesus of Nazareth.

myself that I <u>35\_HAB\_03\_16</u># When I heard, my belly trembled; my lips quivered at the voice: rottenness entered into my bones, and I trembled in myself, that I might rest in the day of trouble: when he cometh up unto the people, he will invade them with his troops.

myself that they <u>43\_JOH\_17\_19</u># And for their sakes I sanctify myself, that they also might be sanctified through the truth.

myself that where <u>43\_JOH\_14\_03</u># And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, [there] ye may be also.

myself that ye <u>47\_2CO\_11\_07</u> # Have I committed an offence in abasing myself that ye might be exalted, because I have preached to you the gospel of God freely?

myself the word <u>23\_ISA\_45\_23</u> # I have sworn by myself, the word is gone out of my mouth [in] righteousness, and shall not return, That unto me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall swear.

myself therefore and <u>09\_1SA\_13\_12</u> # Therefore said I, The Philistines will come down now upon me to Gilgal, and I have not made supplication unto the LORD: I forced myself therefore, and offered a burnt offering.

myself they shall 23\_ISA\_43\_21 # This people have I formed for myself; they shall show forth my praise.

myself this day <u>44\_ACT\_26\_02</u> # I think myself happy, king Agrippa, because I shall answer for myself this day before thee touching all the things whereof I am accused of the Jews:

myself to behold <u>21\_ECC\_02\_12</u> # And I turned myself to behold wisdom, and madness, and folly: for what [can] the man [do] that cometh after the king? [even] that which hath been already done.

myself to have <u>44\_ACT\_24\_16</u> # And herein do I exercise myself, to have always a conscience void of offence toward God, and [toward] men.

myself to have <u>50\_PHP\_03\_13</u># Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but [this] one thing [I do], forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before,

myself to him <u>43\_JOH\_14\_21</u> # He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.

myself To morrow <u>44\_ACT\_25\_22</u> # Then Agrippa said unto Festus, I would also hear the man myself. To morrow, said he, thou shalt hear him.

myself unto him <u>11\_1KI\_18\_15</u># And Elijah said, [As] the LORD of hosts liveth, before whom I stand, I

will surely show myself unto him to day.

myself unto wine <u>21\_ECC\_02\_03</u># I sought in mine heart to give myself unto wine, yet acquainting mine heart with wisdom; and to lay hold on folly, till I might see what [was] that good for the sons of men, which they should do under the heaven all the days of their life.

myself was not <u>47\_2CO\_12\_13</u> # For what is it wherein ye were inferior to other churches, except [it be] that I myself was not burdensome to you? forgive me this wrong.

myself were accursed <u>45\_ROM\_09\_03</u># For I could wish that myself were accursed from Christ for my brethren, my kinsmen according to the flesh:

myself when evil <u>18\_JOB\_31\_29</u># If I rejoiced at the destruction of him that hated me, or lifted up myself when evil found him:

myself will awake <u>19\_PSA\_108\_02</u> # Awake, psaltery and harp: I [myself] will awake early.

myself will awake <u>19\_PSA\_57\_08</u> # Awake up, my glory; awake, psaltery and harp: I [myself] will awake early.

myself will fight <u>24\_JER\_21\_05</u># And I myself will fight against you with an outstretched hand and with a strong arm, even in anger, and in fury, and in great wrath.

myself wise under 21\_ECC\_02\_19 # And who knoweth whether he shall be a wise [man] or a fool? yet shall he have rule over all my labour wherein I have laboured, and wherein I have showed myself wise under the sun. This [is] also vanity.

myself wisely in <u>19\_PSA\_101\_02</u> # I will behave myself wisely in a perfect way. O when wilt thou come unto me? I will walk within my house with a perfect heart.

myself with mine <u>09\_1SA\_25\_33</u> # And blessed [be] thy advice, and blessed [be] thou, which hast kept me this day from coming to [shed] blood, and from avenging myself with mine own hand.

myself with snow <u>18\_JOB\_09\_30</u># If I wash myself with snow water, and make my hands never so clean;

myself worthy to <u>42\_LUK\_07\_07</u># Wherefore neither thought I myself worthy to come unto thee: but say in a word, and my servant shall be healed.

myself yet am <u>46\_1CO\_04\_04</u> # For I know nothing by myself; yet am I not hereby justified: but he that judgeth me is the Lord.

myself yet my <u>43\_JOH\_08\_14</u> # Jesus answered and said unto them, Though I bear record of myself, [yet] my record is true: for I know whence I came, and whither I go; but ye cannot tell whence I come, and whither I go.

myself <u>47\_2CO\_11\_09</u> # And when I was present with you, and wanted, I was chargeable to no man: for that which was lacking to me the brethren which came from Macedonia supplied: and in all [things] I have kept myself from being burdensome unto you, and [so] will I keep [myself].

myself <u>44\_ACT\_24\_10</u> # Then Paul, after that the governor had beckoned unto him to speak, answered, Forasmuch as I know that thou hast been of many years a judge unto this nation, I do the more cheerfully answer for myself: myself <u>17\_EST\_06\_06</u> # So Haman came in. And the king said unto him, What shall be done unto the man whom the king delighteth to honour? Now Haman thought in his heart, To whom would the king delight to do honour more than to myself?

myself <u>02\_EXO\_19\_04</u> # Ye have seen what I did unto the Egyptians, and [how] I bare you on eagles' wings, and brought you unto myself.

myself <u>26\_EZE\_14\_07</u> # For every one of the house of Israel, or of the stranger that sojourneth in Israel, which separateth himself from me, and setteth up his idols in his heart, and putteth the stumblingblock of his iniquity before his face, and cometh to a prophet to inquire of him concerning me; I the LORD will answer him by myself:

myself <u>26\_EZE\_29\_03</u> # Speak, and say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I [am] against thee, Pharaoh king of Egypt, the great dragon that lieth in the midst of his rivers, which hath said, My river [is] mine own, and I have made [it] for myself.

myself <u>01\_GEN\_03\_10</u># And he said, I heard thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I [was] naked; and I hid myself.

myself 23\_ISA\_33\_10 # Now will I rise, saith the LORD; now will I be exalted; now will I lift up myself.

myself 23\_ISA\_44\_24 # Thus saith the LORD, thy redeemer, and he that formed thee from the womb, I [am] the LORD that maketh all [things]; that stretcheth forth the heavens alone; that spreadeth abroad the earth by myself;

myself <u>18\_JOB\_07\_20</u> # I have sinned; what shall I do unto thee, O thou preserver of men? why hast thou set me as a mark against thee, so that I am a burden to myself?

myself <u>18\_JOB\_09\_27</u> # If I say, I will forget my complaint, I will leave off my heaviness, and comfort [myself]:

myself <u>18\_JOB\_19\_04</u> # And be it indeed [that] I have erred, mine error remaineth with myself.

myself <u>43\_JOH\_07\_17</u># If any man will do his will, he shall know of the doctrine, whether it be of God, or [whether] I speak of myself.

myself <u>04\_NUM\_08\_17</u> # For all the firstborn of the children of Israel [are] mine, [both] man and beast: on the day that I smote every firstborn in the land of Egypt I sanctified them for myself.

myself <u>57\_PHM\_01\_17</u> # If thou count me therefore a partner, receive him as myself.

myself <u>19\_PSA\_119\_52</u># I remembered thy judgments of old, O LORD; and have comforted myself.
