nay And the <u>11_1KI_02_20</u># Then she said, I desire one small petition of thee; [I pray thee], say me not nay. And the king said unto her, Ask on, my mother: for I will not say thee nay.

Nay but a <u>09_1SA_12_12</u># And when ye saw that Nahash the king of the children of Ammon came against you, ye said unto me, Nay; but a king shall reign over us: when the LORD your God [was] your king.

Nay but as <u>06_JOS_05_14</u> # And he said, Nay; but [as] captain of the host of the LORD am I now come. And Joshua fell on his face to the earth, and did worship, and said unto him, What saith my lord unto his servant?

Nay but by 45_ROM_03_27 # Where [is] boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? of works? Nay: but by the law of faith.

Nay but I <u>13_1CH_21_24</u> # And king David said to Ornan, Nay; but I will verily buy it for the full price: for I will not take [that] which [is] thine for the LORD, nor offer burnt offerings without cost.

Nay but rather <u>42_LUK_12_51</u># Suppose ye that I am come to give peace on earth? I tell you, Nay; but rather division:
