

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Nebuchadnezzar also carried <u>14\_2CH\_36\_07</u> # Nebuchadnezzar also carried of the vessels of the house of the LORD to Babylon, and put them in his temple at Babylon.

Nebuchadnezzar and he <u>27\_DAN\_04\_33</u> # The same hour was the thing fulfilled upon Nebuchadnezzar: and he was driven from men, and did eat grass as oxen, and his body was wet with the dew of heaven, till his hairs were grown like eagles' [feathers], and his nails like birds' [claws].

Nebuchadnezzar came near 27\_DAN\_03\_26 # Then Nebuchadnezzar came near to the mouth of the burning fiery furnace, [and] spake, and said, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, ye servants of the most high God, come forth, and come [hither]. Then Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, came forth of the midst of the fire.

Nebuchadnezzar dreamed dreams <u>27\_DAN\_02\_01</u> # And in the second year of the reign of Nebuchadnezzar Nebuchadnezzar dreamed dreams, wherewith his spirit was troubled, and his sleep brake from him.

Nebuchadnezzar fell upon <u>27\_DAN\_02\_46</u># Then the king Nebuchadnezzar fell upon his face, and worshipped Daniel, and commanded that they should offer an oblation and sweet odours unto him.

Nebuchadnezzar full of <u>27\_DAN\_03\_19</u> # Then was Nebuchadnezzar full of fury, and the form of his visage was changed against Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego: [therefore] he spake, and commanded that they should heat the furnace one seven times more than it was wont to be heated.

Nebuchadnezzar had brought <u>15\_EZR\_01\_07</u> # Also Cyrus the king brought forth the vessels of the house of the LORD, which Nebuchadnezzar had brought forth out of Jerusalem, and had put them in the house of his gods;

Nebuchadnezzar had carried <u>24\_JER\_29\_01</u> # Now these [are] the words of the letter that Jeremiah the prophet sent from Jerusalem unto the residue of the elders which were carried away captives, and to the priests, and to the prophets, and to all the people whom Nebuchadnezzar had carried away captive from Jerusalem to Babylon;

Nebuchadnezzar had set <u>27\_DAN\_03\_03</u> # Then the princes, the governors, and captains, the judges, the treasurers, the counsellors, the sheriffs, and all the rulers of the provinces, were gathered together unto the dedication of the image that Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up; and they stood before the image that Nebuchadnezzar had set up.

Nebuchadnezzar had taken 27\_DAN\_05\_02 # Belshazzar, whiles he tasted the wine, commanded to bring the golden and silver vessels which his father Nebuchadnezzar had taken out of the temple which [was] in Jerusalem; that the king, and his princes, his wives, and his concubines, might drink therein.

Nebuchadnezzar have seen 27\_DAN\_04\_18 # This dream I king Nebuchadnezzar have seen. Now thou, O Belteshazzar, declare the interpretation thereof, forasmuch as all the wise [men] of my kingdom are not able to make known unto me the interpretation: but thou [art] able; for the spirit of the holy gods [is] in thee.

Nebuchadnezzar in his <u>27\_DAN\_03\_13</u># Then Nebuchadnezzar in [his] rage and fury commanded to bring Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. Then they brought these men before the king.

Nebuchadnezzar king of <u>14\_2CH\_36\_06</u> # Against him came up Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, and bound him in fetters, to carry him to Babylon.

Nebuchadnezzar king of <u>12\_2KI\_24\_01</u> # In his days Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came up, and Jehoiakim became his servant three years: then he turned and rebelled against him.

Nebuchadnezzar king of <u>12\_2KI\_24\_10</u> # At that time the servants of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came up against Jerusalem, and the city was besieged.

Nebuchadnezzar king of <u>12\_2KI\_24\_11</u># And Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came against the city, and his servants did besiege it.

Nebuchadnezzar king of <u>12\_2KI\_25\_01</u> # And it came to pass in the ninth year of his reign, in the tenth month, in the tenth [day] of the month, [that] Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came, he, and all his host, against Jerusalem, and pitched against it: and they built forts against it round about.

Nebuchadnezzar king of <u>12\_2KI\_25\_08</u> # And in the fifth month, on the seventh [day] of the month, which [is] the nineteenth year of king Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, came Nebuzaradan, captain of the guard, a servant of the king of Babylon, unto Jerusalem:

Nebuchadnezzar king of <u>12\_2KI\_25\_22</u> # And [as for] the people that remained in the land of Judah, whom Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon had left, even over them he made Gedaliah the son of Ahikam, the son of Shaphan, ruler.

Nebuchadnezzar king of <u>27\_DAN\_01\_01</u># In the third year of the reign of Jehoiakim king of Judah came Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon unto Jerusalem, and besieged it.

Nebuchadnezzar king of <u>24\_JER\_27\_20</u> # Which Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon took not, when he carried away captive Jeconiah the son of Jehoiakim king of Judah from Jerusalem to Babylon, and all the nobles of Judah and Jerusalem;

Nebuchadnezzar king of <u>24\_JER\_28\_03</u># Within two full years will I bring again into this place all the vessels of the LORD'S house, that Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon took away from this place, and carried them to Babylon:

Nebuchadnezzar king of 24\_JER\_28\_11 # And Hananiah spake in the presence of all the people, saying, Thus saith the LORD; Even so will I break the yoke of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon from the neck of all nations within the space of two full years. And the prophet Jeremiah went his way.

Nebuchadnezzar king of 24\_JER\_28\_14 # For thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; I have put a yoke of iron upon the neck of all these nations, that they may serve Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon; and they shall serve him: and I have given him the beasts of the field also.

Nebuchadnezzar king of 24\_JER\_29\_03 # By the hand of Elasah the son of Shaphan, and Gemariah the son of Hilkiah, [whom Zedekiah king of Judah sent unto Babylon to Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon] saying,

Nebuchadnezzar king of 24\_JER\_34\_01 # The word which came unto Jeremiah from the LORD, when Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, and all his army, and all the kingdoms of the earth of his dominion, and all the people, fought against Jerusalem, and against all the cities thereof, saying,

Nebuchadnezzar king of 24\_JER\_39\_05 # But the Chaldeans' army pursued after them, and overtook Zedekiah in the plains of Jericho: and when they had taken him, they brought him up to Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon to Riblah in the land of Hamath, where he gave judgment upon him.

Nebuchadnezzar lifted up 27\_DAN\_04\_34 # And at the end of the days I Nebuchadnezzar lifted up mine

eyes unto heaven, and mine understanding returned unto me, and I blessed the most High, and I praised and honoured him that liveth for ever, whose dominion [is] an everlasting dominion, and his kingdom [is] from generation to generation:

Nebuchadnezzar Nebuchadnezzar dreamed <u>27\_DAN\_02\_01</u> # And in the second year of the reign of Nebuchadnezzar Nebuchadnezzar dreamed dreams, wherewith his spirit was troubled, and his sleep brake from him.

Nebuchadnezzar O king <u>27\_DAN\_03\_09</u># They spake and said to the king Nebuchadnezzar, O king, live for ever.

Nebuchadnezzar praise and <u>27\_DAN\_04\_37</u> # Now I Nebuchadnezzar praise and extol and honour the King of heaven, all whose works [are] truth, and his ways judgment: and those that walk in pride he is able to abase.

Nebuchadnezzar sent and <u>14\_2CH\_36\_10</u> # And when the year was expired, king Nebuchadnezzar sent, and brought him to Babylon, with the goodly vessels of the house of the LORD, and made Zedekiah his brother king over Judah and Jerusalem.

Nebuchadnezzar spake and <u>27\_DAN\_03\_14</u># Nebuchadnezzar spake and said unto them, [Is it] true, O Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, do not ye serve my gods, nor worship the golden image which I have set up?

Nebuchadnezzar spake and <u>27\_DAN\_03\_28</u> # [Then] Nebuchadnezzar spake, and said, Blessed [be] the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, who hath sent his angel, and delivered his servants that trusted in him, and have changed the king's word, and yielded their bodies, that they might not serve nor worship any god, except their own God.

Nebuchadnezzar the king <u>27\_DAN\_03\_01</u> # Nebuchadnezzar the king made an image of gold, whose height [was] threescore cubits, [and] the breadth thereof six cubits: he set it up in the plain of Dura, in the province of Babylon.

Nebuchadnezzar the king <u>27\_DAN\_03\_02</u> # Then Nebuchadnezzar the king sent to gather together the princes, the governors, and the captains, the judges, the treasurers, the counsellors, the sheriffs, and all the rulers of the provinces, to come to the dedication of the image which Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up.

Nebuchadnezzar the king <u>27\_DAN\_03\_02</u> # Then Nebuchadnezzar the king sent to gather together the princes, the governors, and the captains, the judges, the treasurers, the counsellors, the sheriffs, and all the rulers of the provinces, to come to the dedication of the image which Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up.

Nebuchadnezzar the king <u>27\_DAN\_03\_03</u> # Then the princes, the governors, and captains, the judges, the treasurers, the counsellors, the sheriffs, and all the rulers of the provinces, were gathered together unto the dedication of the image that Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up; and they stood before the image that Nebuchadnezzar had set up.

Nebuchadnezzar the king <u>27\_DAN\_03\_05</u> # [That] at what time ye hear the sound of the cornet, flute, harp, sackbut, psaltery, dulcimer, and all kinds of music, ye fall down and worship the golden image that Nebuchadnezzar the king hath set up:

Nebuchadnezzar the king <u>27\_DAN\_03\_07</u> # Therefore at that time, when all the people heard the sound of the cornet, flute, harp, sackbut, psaltery, and all kinds of music, all the people, the nations, and the languages, fell down [and] worshipped the golden image that Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up.

Nebuchadnezzar the king <u>27\_DAN\_03\_24</u> # Then Nebuchadnezzar the king was astonied, and rose up in haste, [and] spake, and said unto his counsellors, Did not we cast three men bound into the midst of the

fire? They answered and said unto the king, True, O king.

Nebuchadnezzar the king <u>27\_DAN\_04\_01</u># Nebuchadnezzar the king, unto all people, nations, and languages, that dwell in all the earth; Peace be multiplied unto you.

Nebuchadnezzar the king <u>17\_EST\_02\_06</u># Who had been carried away from Jerusalem with the captivity which had been carried away with Jeconiah king of Judah, whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon had carried away.

Nebuchadnezzar the king <u>15\_EZR\_02\_01</u> # Now these [are] the children of the province that went up out of the captivity, of those which had been carried away, whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon had carried away unto Babylon, and came again unto Jerusalem and Judah, every one unto his city;

Nebuchadnezzar the king <u>15\_EZR\_05\_12</u># But after that our fathers had provoked the God of heaven unto wrath, he gave them into the hand of Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, the Chaldean, who destroyed this house, and carried the people away into Babylon.

Nebuchadnezzar the king <u>24\_JER\_27\_06</u># And now have I given all these lands into the hand of Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, my servant; and the beasts of the field have I given him also to serve him.

Nebuchadnezzar the king 24\_JER\_27\_08 # And it shall come to pass, [that] the nation and kingdom which will not serve the same Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, and that will not put their neck under the yoke of the king of Babylon, that nation will I punish, saith the LORD, with the sword, and with the famine, and with the pestilence, until I have consumed them by his hand.

Nebuchadnezzar the king <u>16\_NEH\_07\_06</u> # These [are] the children of the province, that went up out of the captivity, of those that had been carried away, whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon had carried away, and came again to Jerusalem and to Judah, every one unto his city;

Nebuchadnezzar thy father <u>27\_DAN\_05\_11</u># There is a man in thy kingdom, in whom [is] the spirit of the holy gods; and in the days of thy father light and understanding and wisdom, like the wisdom of the gods, was found in him; whom the king Nebuchadnezzar thy father, the king, [I say], thy father, made master of the magicians, astrologers, Chaldeans, [and] soothsayers;

Nebuchadnezzar thy father <u>27\_DAN\_05\_18</u># O thou king, the most high God gave Nebuchadnezzar thy father a kingdom, and majesty, and glory, and honour:

Nebuchadnezzar to thee <u>27\_DAN\_04\_31</u># While the word [was] in the king's mouth, there fell a voice from heaven, [saying], O king Nebuchadnezzar, to thee it is spoken; The kingdom is departed from thee.

Nebuchadnezzar took forth <u>15\_EZR\_06\_05</u> # And also let the golden and silver vessels of the house of God, which Nebuchadnezzar took forth out of the temple which [is] at Jerusalem, and brought unto Babylon, be restored, and brought again unto the temple which [is] at Jerusalem, [every one] to his place, and place [them] in the house of God.

Nebuchadnezzar took out <u>15\_EZR\_05\_14</u> # And the vessels also of gold and silver of the house of God, which Nebuchadnezzar took out of the temple that [was] in Jerusalem, and brought them into the temple of Babylon, those did Cyrus the king take out of the temple of Babylon, and they were delivered unto [one], whose name [was] Sheshbazzar, whom he had made governor;

Nebuchadnezzar was at <u>27\_DAN\_04\_04</u> # I Nebuchadnezzar was at rest in mine house, and flourishing in my palace:

Nebuchadnezzar we are 27\_DAN\_03\_16 # Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, answered and said to the

king, O Nebuchadnezzar, we [are] not careful to answer thee in this matter.

Nebuchadnezzar what shall <u>27\_DAN\_02\_28</u> # But there is a God in heaven that revealeth secrets, and maketh known to the king Nebuchadnezzar what shall be in the latter days. Thy dream, and the visions of thy head upon thy bed, are these;

Nebuchadnezzar who had <u>14\_2CH\_36\_13</u># And he also rebelled against king Nebuchadnezzar, who had made him swear by God: but he stiffened his neck, and hardened his heart from turning unto the LORD God of Israel.

Nebuchadnezzar <u>13\_1CH\_06\_15</u># And Jehozadak went [into captivity], when the LORD carried away Judah and Jerusalem by the hand of Nebuchadnezzar.

Nebuchadnezzar <u>27\_DAN\_01\_18</u> # Now at the end of the days that the king had said he should bring them in, then the prince of the eunuchs brought them in before Nebuchadnezzar.

Nebuchadnezzar 27\_DAN\_04\_28 # All this came upon the king Nebuchadnezzar.
