adorneth herself with 23\_ISA\_61\_10 # I will greatly rejoice in the LORD, my soul shall be joyful in my God; for he hath clothed me with the garments of salvation, he hath covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decketh [himself] with ornaments, and as a bride adorneth [herself] with her jewels.

Anethothite Mebunnai the 10\_2SA\_23\_27 # Abiezer the Anethothite, Mebunnai the Hushathite,

Anetothite of the 13 1CH 27 12 # The ninth [captain] for the ninth month [was] Abiezer the Anetothite, of the Benjamites: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.

appertaineth in the <u>03\_LEV\_06\_05</u># Or all that about which he hath sworn falsely; he shall even restore it in the principal, and shall add the fifth part more thereto, [and] give it unto him to whom it appertaineth, in the day of his trespass offering.

contemneth the rod <u>26\_EZE\_21\_10</u> # It is sharpened to make a sore slaughter; it is furbished that it may glitter: should we then make mirth? it contemneth the rod of my son, [as] every tree.

Netophathites Ataroth the <u>13\_1CH\_02\_54</u># The sons of Salma; Bethlehem, and the Netophathites, Ataroth, the house of Joab, and half of the Manahethites, the Zorites.

Netophathites 13 1CH 09 16 # And Obadiah the son of Shemaiah, the son of Galal, the son of Jeduthun, and Berechiah the son of Asa, the son of Elkanah, that dwelt in the villages of the Netophathites.
