afternoon and they [07 JUD 19 08](#) # And he arose early in the morning on the fifth day to depart: and the damsel's father said, Comfort thine heart, I pray thee. And they tarried until afternoon, and they did eat both of them.

noon and I [30 AMO 08 09](#) # And it shall come to pass in that day, saith the Lord GOD, that I will cause the sun to go down at noon, and I will darken the earth in the clear day:

noon and then [12 2KI 04 20](#) # And when he had taken him, and brought him to his mother, he sat on her knees till noon, and [then] died.

noon But Benhadad [11 1KI 20 16](#) # And they went out at noon. But Benhadad [was] drinking himself drunk in the pavilions, he and the kings, the thirty and two kings that helped him.

noon day and [36 ZEP 02 04](#) # For Gaza shall be forsaken, and Ashkelon a desolation: they shall drive out Ashdod at the noon day, and Ekron shall be rooted up.

noon day as [23 ISA 59 10](#) # We grope for the wall like the blind, and we grope as if [we had] no eyes: we stumble at noon day as in the night; [we are] in desolate places as dead [men].

noon day [23 ISA 58 10](#) # And [if] thou draw out thy soul to the hungry, and satisfy the afflicted soul; then shall thy light rise in obscurity, and thy darkness [be] as the noon day:

noon for they [01 GEN 43 25](#) # And they made ready the present against Joseph came at noon: for they heard that they should eat bread there.

noon for why [22 SON 01 07](#) # Tell me, O thou whom my soul loveth, where thou feedest, where thou makest [thy flock] to rest at noon: for why should I be as one that turneth aside by the flocks of thy companions?

noon saying O [11 1KI 18 26](#) # And they took the bullock which was given them, and they dressed [it], and called on the name of Baal from morning even until noon, saying, O Baal, hear us. But [there was] no voice, nor any that answered. And they leaped upon the altar which was made.

noon suddenly there [44 ACT 22 06](#) # And it came to pass, that, as I made my journey, and was come nigh unto Damascus about noon, suddenly there shone from heaven a great light round about me.

noon that Elijah [11 1KI 18 27](#) # And it came to pass at noon, that Elijah mocked them, and said, Cry aloud: for he [is] a god; either he is talking, or he is pursuing, or he is in a journey, [or] peradventure he sleepeth, and must be awaked.

noon will I [19 PSA 55 17](#) # Evening, and morning, and at noon, will I pray, and cry aloud: and he shall hear my voice.

noon Woe unto [24 JER 06 04](#) # Prepare ye war against her; arise, and let us go up at noon. Woe unto us! for the day goeth away, for the shadows of the evening are stretched out.

noon [10 2SA 04 05](#) # And the sons of Rimmon the Beerothite, Rechab and Baanah, went, and came about the heat of the day to the house of Ishbosheth, who lay on a bed at noon.

noon [01 GEN 43 16](#) # And when Joseph saw Benjamin with them, he said to the ruler of his house, Bring [these] men home, and slay, and make ready; for [these] men shall dine with me at noon.

noonday as in [18 JOB 05 14](#) # They meet with darkness in the daytime, and grope in the noonday as in the night.

noonday as the [05 DEU 28 29](#) # And thou shalt grope at noonday, as the blind gropeth in darkness, and thou shalt not prosper in thy ways: and thou shalt be only oppressed and spoiled evermore, and no man shall save [thee].

noonday hide the [23 ISA 16 03](#) # Take counsel, execute judgment; make thy shadow as the night in the midst of the noonday; hide the outcasts; bewray not him that wandereth.

noonday I have [24 JER 15 08](#) # Their widows are increased to me above the sand of the seas: I have brought upon them against the mother of the young men a spoiler at noonday: I have caused [him] to fall upon it suddenly, and terrors upon the city.

noonday thou shalt [18 JOB 11 17](#) # And [thine] age shall be clearer than the noonday; thou shalt shine forth, thou shalt be as the morning.
