Ahohite and of 13\_1CH\_27\_04 # And over the course of the second month [was] Dodai an Ahohite, and of his course [was] Mikloth also the ruler: in his course likewise [were] twenty and four thousand.

Ahohite Maharai the 10\_2SA\_23\_28 # Zalmon the Ahohite, Maharai the Netophathite,

Ahohite one of 10\_2SA\_23\_09 # And after him [was] Eleazar the son of Dodo the Ahohite, [one] of the three mighty men with David, when they defied the Philistines [that] were there gathered together to battle, and the men of Israel were gone away:

Ahohite who was 13\_1CH\_11\_12# And after him [was] Eleazar the son of Dodo, the Ahohite, who [was one] of the three mighties.

Ahohite 13\_1CH\_11\_29 # Sibbecai the Hushathite, Ilai the Ahohite,

Benzoheth <u>13\_1CH\_04\_20</u> # And the sons of Shimon [were], Amnon, and Rinnah, Benhanan, and Tilon. And the sons of Ishi [were], Zoheth, and Benzoheth.

Bohan the son <u>06\_JOS\_15\_06</u># And the border went up to Bethhogla, and passed along by the north of Betharabah; and the border went up to the stone of Bohan the son of Reuben:

Bohan the son <u>06\_JOS\_18\_17</u># And was drawn from the north, and went forth to Enshemesh, and went forth toward Geliloth, which [is] over against the going up of Adummim, and descended to the stone of Bohan the son of Reuben,

Elelohe - Israel 01\_GEN\_33\_20 # And he erected there an altar, and called it Elelohe-Israel.

Elkohshite 34\_NAH\_01\_01 # The burden of Nineveh. The book of the vision of Nahum the Elkohshite.

Eshtemoh and Anim 06\_JOS\_15\_50 # And Anab, and Eshtemoh, and Anim,

Giloh eleven cities 06\_JOS\_15\_51 # And Goshen, and Holon, and Giloh; eleven cities with their villages:

Giloh while he <u>10\_2SA\_15\_12</u> # And Absalom sent for Ahithophel the Gilonite, David's counsellor, from his city, [even] from Giloh, while he offered sacrifices. And the conspiracy was strong; for the people increased continually with Absalom.

Hallohesh Pileha Shobek 16\_NEH\_10\_24 # Hallohesh, Pileha, Shobek,

Halohesh the ruler <u>16\_NEH\_03\_12</u> # And next unto him repaired Shallum the son of Halohesh, the ruler of the half part of Jerusalem, he and his daughters.

Hoham king of <u>06\_JOS\_10\_03</u># Wherefore Adonizedek king of Jerusalem sent unto Hoham king of Hebron, and unto Piram king of Jarmuth, and unto Japhia king of Lachish, and unto Debir king of Eglon, saying,

Janohah to Ataroth <u>06\_JOS\_16\_07</u> # And it went down from Janohah to Ataroth, and to Naarath, and came to Jericho, and went out at Jordan.

Janohah <u>06\_JOS\_16\_06</u># And the border went out toward the sea to Michmethah on the north side; and the border went about eastward unto Taanathshiloh, and passed by it on the east to Janohah;

Jehohanan and Azariah <u>14 2CH\_23\_01</u> # And in the seventh year Jehoiada strengthened himself, and took the captains of hundreds, Azariah the son of Jeroham, and Ishmael the son of Jehohanan, and Azariah the son of Obed, and Maaseiah the son of Adaiah, and Elishaphat the son of Zichri, into covenant with him.

Jehohanan and Malchijah <u>16 NEH 12 42 #</u> And Maaseiah, and Shemaiah, and Eleazar, and Uzzi, and Jehohanan, and Malchijah, and Elam, and Ezer. And the singers sang loud, with Jezrahiah [their] overseer.

Jehohanan Hananiah Zabbai <u>15\_EZR\_10\_28</u># Of the sons also of Bebai; Jehohanan, Hananiah, Zabbai, [and] Athlai.

Jehohanan the captain 14\_2CH\_17\_15 # And next to him [was] Jehohanan the captain, and with him two hundred and fourscore thousand.

Jehohanan the sixth 13\_1CH\_26\_03 # Elam the fifth, Jehohanan the sixth, Elioenai the seventh.

Jehohanan 16\_NEH\_12\_13 # Of Ezra, Meshullam; of Amariah, Jehohanan;

Jeroham and Elah <u>13\_1CH\_09\_08</u># And Ibneiah the son of Jeroham, and Elah the son of Uzzi, the son of Michri, and Meshullam the son of Shephatiah, the son of Reuel, the son of Ibnijah;

Jeroham and Ishmael <u>14\_2CH\_23\_01</u># And in the seventh year Jehoiada strengthened himself, and took the captains of hundreds, Azariah the son of Jeroham, and Ishmael the son of Jehohanan, and Azariah the son of Obed, and Maaseiah the son of Adaiah, and Elishaphat the son of Zichri, into covenant with him.

Jeroham his son 13\_1CH\_06\_27 # Eliab his son, Jeroham his son, Elkanah his son.

Jeroham of Gedor 13\_1CH\_12\_07 # And Joelah, and Zebadiah, the sons of Jeroham of Gedor.

Jeroham the son 13\_1CH\_06\_34 # The son of Elkanah, the son of Jeroham, the son of Eliel, the son of Toah,

Jeroham the son <u>13\_1CH\_09\_12</u> # And Adaiah the son of Jeroham, the son of Pashur, the son of Malchijah, and Maasiai the son of Adiel, the son of Jahzerah, the son of Meshullam, the son of Meshillemith, the son of Immer;

Jeroham the son <u>09\_1SA\_01\_01</u> # Now there was a certain man of Ramathaimzophim, of mount Ephraim, and his name [was] Elkanah, the son of Jeroham, the son of Elihu, the son of Tohu, the son of Zuph, an Ephrathite:

Jeroham the son <u>16\_NEH\_11\_12</u># And their brethren that did the work of the house [were] eight hundred twenty and two: and Adaiah the son of Jeroham, the son of Pelaliah, the son of Amzi, the son of Zechariah, the son of Pashur, the son of Malchiah,

Jeroham These were 13\_1CH\_27\_22 # Of Dan, Azareel the son of Jeroham. These [were] the princes of the tribes of Israel.

Jeroham 13\_1CH\_08\_27 # And Jaresiah, and Eliah, and Zichri, the sons of Jeroham.

Jeshohaiah and Asaiah <u>13\_1CH\_04\_36</u># And Elioenai, and Jaakobah, and Jeshohaiah, and Asaiah, and Adiel, and Jesimiel, and Benaiah,

Joha his brother 13\_1CH\_11\_45 # Jediael the son of Shimri, and Joha his brother, the Tizite,

Joha the sons 13\_1CH\_08\_16 # And Michael, and Ispah, and Joha, the sons of Beriah;

Johanan and Dalaiah <u>13\_1CH\_03\_24</u># And the sons of Elioenai [were], Hodaiah, and Eliashib, and Pelaiah, and Akkub, and Johanan, and Dalaiah, and Anani, seven.

Johanan and Jaddua <u>16 NEH\_12\_22</u># The Levites in the days of Eliashib, Joiada, and Johanan, and Jaddua, [were] recorded chief of the fathers: also the priests, to the reign of Darius the Persian.

Johanan and Jonathan 24 JER 40 08 # Then they came to Gedaliah to Mizpah, even Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, and Johanan and Jonathan the sons of Kareah, and Seraiah the son of Tanhumeth, and the sons of Ephai the Netophathite, and Jezaniah the son of a Maachathite, they and their men.

Johanan and Josabad 13 1CH 12 04 # And Ismaiah the Gibeonite, a mighty man among the thirty, and over the thirty; and Jeremiah, and Jahaziel, and Johanan, and Josabad the Gederathite,

Johanan begat Azariah <u>13\_1CH\_06\_10</u> # And Johanan begat Azariah, [he [it is] that executed the priest's office in the temple that Solomon built in Jerusalem:]

Johanan Berechiah the <u>14\_2CH\_28\_12</u># Then certain of the heads of the children of Ephraim, Azariah the son of Johanan, Berechiah the son of Meshillemoth, and Jehizkiah the son of Shallum, and Amasa the son of Hadlai, stood up against them that came from the war,

Johanan had taken <u>16\_NEH\_06\_18</u># For [there were] many in Judah sworn unto him, because he [was] the son in law of Shechaniah the son of Arah; and his son Johanan had taken the daughter of Meshullam the son of Berechiah.

Johanan the eighth 13\_1CH\_12\_12 # Johanan the eighth, Elzabad the ninth,

Johanan the second <u>13\_1CH\_03\_15</u># And the sons of Josiah [were], the firstborn Johanan, the second Jehoiakim, the third Zedekiah, the fourth Shallum.

Johanan the son 12\_2KI\_25\_23 # And when all the captains of the armies, they and their men, heard that the king of Babylon had made Gedaliah governor, there came to Gedaliah to Mizpah, even Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, and Johanan the son of Careah, and Seraiah the son of Tanhumeth the Netophathite, and Jaazaniah the son of a Maachathite, they and their men.

Johanan the son <u>15\_EZR\_08\_12</u> # And of the sons of Azgad; Johanan the son of Hakkatan, and with him an hundred and ten males.

Johanan the son <u>15\_EZR\_10\_06</u># Then Ezra rose up from before the house of God, and went into the chamber of Johanan the son of Eliashib: and [when] he came thither, he did eat no bread, nor drink water: for he mourned because of the transgression of them that had been carried away.

Johanan the son 24\_JER\_40\_13 # Moreover Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the captains of the forces that [were] in the fields, came to Gedaliah to Mizpah,

Johanan the son 24\_JER\_40\_15 # Then Johanan the son of Kareah spake to Gedaliah in Mizpah secretly, saying, Let me go, I pray thee, and I will slay Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, and no man shall know [it]: wherefore should he slay thee, that all the Jews which are gathered unto thee should be scattered, and the remnant in Judah perish?

Johanan the son <u>24\_JER\_40\_16</u> # But Gedaliah the son of Ahikam said unto Johanan the son of Kareah, Thou shalt not do this thing: for thou speakest falsely of Ishmael.

Johanan the son 24\_JER\_41\_11 # But when Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the captains of the forces

that [were] with him, heard of all the evil that Ishmael the son of Nethaniah had done,

Johanan the son 24\_JER\_41\_13 # Now it came to pass, [that] when all the people which [were] with Ishmael saw Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the captains of the forces that [were] with him, then they were glad.

Johanan the son 24\_JER\_41\_14 # So all the people that Ishmael had carried away captive from Mizpah cast about and returned, and went unto Johanan the son of Kareah.

Johanan the son 24\_JER\_41\_16 # Then took Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the captains of the forces that [were] with him, all the remnant of the people whom he had recovered from Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, from Mizpah, after [that] he had slain Gedaliah the son of Ahikam, [even] mighty men of war, and the women, and the children, and the eunuchs, whom he had brought again from Gibeon:

Johanan the son 24\_JER\_42\_01 # Then all the captains of the forces, and Johanan the son of Kareah, and Jezaniah the son of Hoshaiah, and all the people from the least even unto the greatest, came near,

Johanan the son <u>24\_JER\_42\_08</u># Then called he Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the captains of the forces which [were] with him, and all the people from the least even to the greatest,

Johanan the son 24\_JER\_43\_02 # Then spake Azariah the son of Hoshaiah, and Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the proud men, saying unto Jeremiah, Thou speakest falsely: the LORD our God hath not sent thee to say, Go not into Egypt to sojourn there:

Johanan the son <u>24\_JER\_43\_04</u> # So Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the captains of the forces, and all the people, obeyed not the voice of the LORD, to dwell in the land of Judah.

Johanan the son <u>24\_JER\_43\_05</u># But Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the captains of the forces, took all the remnant of Judah, that were returned from all nations, whither they had been driven, to dwell in the land of Judah;

Johanan the son 16\_NEH\_12\_23 # The sons of Levi, the chief of the fathers, [were] written in the book of the chronicles, even until the days of Johanan the son of Eliashib.

Johanan with eight <u>24\_JER\_41\_15</u># But Ishmael the son of Nethaniah escaped from Johanan with eight men, and went to the Ammonites.

Johanan 13\_1CH\_06\_09 # And Ahimaaz begat Azariah, and Azariah begat Johanan,

John about to 44\_ACT\_03\_03 # Who seeing Peter and John about to go into the temple asked an alms.

John again those <u>40\_MAT\_11\_04</u># Jesus answered and said unto them, Go and show John again those things which ye do hear and see:

John all the <u>44\_ACT\_03\_11</u># And as the lame man which was healed held Peter and John, all the people ran together unto them in the porch that is called Solomon's, greatly wondering.

John also taught <u>42\_LUK\_11\_01</u> # And it came to pass, that, as he was praying in a certain place, when he ceased, one of his disciples said unto him, Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples.

John and Andrew 44 ACT 01 13 # And when they were come in, they went up into an upper room, where abode both Peter, and James, and John, and Andrew, Philip, and Thomas, Bartholomew, and Matthew, James [the son] of Alphaeus, and Simon Zelotes, and Judas [the brother] of James.

John and Andrew 41\_MAR\_13\_03 # And as he sat upon the mount of Olives over against the temple, Peter and James and John and Andrew asked him privately,

John and began 41 MAR 14 33 # And he taketh with him Peter and James and John, and began to be sore amazed, and to be very heavy;

John and bound <u>41\_MAR\_06\_17</u> # For Herod himself had sent forth and laid hold upon John, and bound him in prison for Herodias' sake, his brother Philip's wife: for he had married her.

John and bound 40\_MAT\_14\_03# For Herod had laid hold on John, and bound him, and put [him] in prison for Herodias' sake, his brother Philip's wife.

John and he 43\_JOH\_05\_33 # Ye sent unto John, and he bare witness unto the truth.

John and James <u>42 LUK 09 28 #</u> And it came to pass about an eight days after these sayings, he took Peter and John and James, and went up into a mountain to pray.

John and leadeth 41\_MAR\_09\_02 # And after six days Jesus taketh [with him] Peter, and James, and John, and leadeth them up into an high mountain apart by themselves: and he was transfigured before them.

John and of 41 MAR 02 18 # And the disciples of John and of the Pharisees used to fast: and they come and say unto him, Why do the disciples of John and of the Pharisees fast, but thy disciples fast not?

John answered and <u>43\_JOH\_03\_27</u># John answered and said, A man can receive nothing, except it be given him from heaven.

John answered and 42\_LUK\_09\_49 # And John answered and said, Master, we saw one casting out devils in thy name; and we forbad him, because he followeth not with us.

John answered him <u>41\_MAR\_09\_38</u> # And John answered him, saying, Master, we saw one casting out devils in thy name, and he followeth not us: and we forbad him, because he followeth not us.

John answered saying <u>42 LUK 03 16 #</u> John answered, saying unto [them] all, I indeed baptize you with water; but one mightier than I cometh, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to unloose: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost and with fire:

John answered them <u>43\_JOH\_01\_26</u> # John answered them, saying, I baptize with water: but there standeth one among you, whom ye know not;

John as a 40\_MAT\_21\_26# But if we shall say, Of men; we fear the people; for all hold John as a prophet.

John at first 43\_JOH\_10\_40 # And went away again beyond Jordan into the place where John at first baptized; and there he abode.

John Baptist hath <u>42\_LUK\_07\_20</u> # When the men were come unto him, they said, John Baptist hath sent us unto thee, saying, Art thou he that should come? or look we for another?

John Baptist's head 40\_MAT\_14\_08 # And she, being before instructed of her mother, said, Give me here John Baptist's head in a charger.

John bare record <u>43\_JOH\_01\_32</u># And John bare record, saying, I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it abode upon him.

John bare witness 43\_JOH\_01\_15 # John bare witness of him, and cried, saying, This was he of whom I spake, He that cometh after me is preferred before me: for he was before me.

John calling unto 42\_LUK\_07\_19 # And John calling [unto him] two of his disciples sent [them] to Jesus, saying, Art thou he that should come? or look we for another?

John came neither 40\_MAT\_11\_18# For John came neither eating nor drinking, and they say, He hath a devil.

John came unto 40 MAT\_21\_32 # For John came unto you in the way of righteousness, and ye believed him not: but the publicans and the harlots believed him: and ye, when ye had seen [it], repented not afterward, that ye might believe him.

John departing from 44\_ACT\_13\_13 # Now when Paul and his company loosed from Paphos, they came to Perga in Pamphylia: and John departing from them returned to Jerusalem.

John did baptize <u>41\_MAR\_01\_04</u> # John did baptize in the wilderness, and preach the baptism of repentance for the remission of sins.

John did no 43 JOH 10 41 # And many resorted unto him, and said, John did no miracle: but all things that John spake of this man were true.

John fast often <u>42\_LUK\_05\_33</u> # And they said unto him, Why do the disciples of John fast often, and make prayers, and likewise [the disciples] of the Pharisees; but thine eat and drink?

John for the <u>43\_JOH\_05\_36</u> # But I have greater witness than [that] of John: for the works which the Father hath given me to finish, the same works that I do, bear witness of me, that the Father hath sent me.

John forbad him <u>40\_MAT\_03\_14</u># But John forbad him, saying, I have need to be baptized of thee, and comest thou to me?

John fulfilled his 44\_ACT\_13\_25 # And as John fulfilled his course, he said, Whom think ye that I am? I am not [he]. But, behold, there cometh one after me, whose shoes of [his] feet I am not worthy to loose.

John had first <u>44\_ACT\_13\_24</u># When John had first preached before his coming the baptism of repentance to all the people of Israel.

John had heard <u>40\_MAT\_11\_02</u># Now when John had heard in the prison the works of Christ, he sent two of his disciples,

John had his 40\_MAT\_03\_04# And the same John had his raiment of camel's hair, and a leathern girdle about his loins; and his meat was locusts and wild honey.

John had said <u>41\_MAR\_06\_18</u># For John had said unto Herod, It is not lawful for thee to have thy brother's wife.

John have I <u>42\_LUK\_09\_09</u> # And Herod said, John have I beheaded: but who is this, of whom I hear such things? And he desired to see him.

John his brother 41\_MAR\_01\_19 # And when he had gone a little farther thence, he saw James the [son] of Zebedee, and John his brother, who also were in the ship mending their nets.

John his brother 40\_MAT\_04\_21# And going on from thence, he saw other two brethren, James [the son] of Zebedee, and John his brother, in a ship with Zebedee their father, mending their nets; and he called them.

John his brother 40\_MAT\_10\_02# Now the names of the twelve apostles are these; The first, Simon, who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother; James [the son] of Zebedee, and John his brother;

John his brother 40\_MAT\_17\_01# And after six days Jesus taketh Peter, James, and John his brother, and bringeth them up into an high mountain apart,

John in Jordan 41\_MAR\_01\_09 # And it came to pass in those days, that Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee, and was baptized of John in Jordan.

John in prison 42\_LUK\_03\_20 # Added yet this above all, that he shut up John in prison.

John in the 40\_MAT\_14\_10 # And he sent, and beheaded John in the prison.

John indeed baptized <u>44\_ACT\_11\_16</u># Then remembered I the word of the Lord, how that he said, John indeed baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost.

John knowing that <u>41\_MAR\_06\_20</u> # For Herod feared John, knowing that he was a just man and an holy, and observed him; and when he heard him, he did many things, and heard him gladly.

John Philip and 42\_LUK\_06\_14 # Simon, [whom he also named Peter,] and Andrew his brother, James and John, Philip and Bartholomew,

John preached <u>44\_ACT\_10\_37</u> # That word, [I say], ye know, which was published throughout all Judaea, and began from Galilee, after the baptism which John preached;

John said Look 44\_ACT\_03\_04 # And Peter, fastening his eyes upon him with John, said, Look on us.

John said unto 40\_MAT\_14\_04 # For John said unto him, It is not lawful for thee to have her.

John saw the <u>66\_REV\_21\_02</u># And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

John saw these 66\_REV\_22\_08 # And I John saw these things, and heard [them]. And when I had heard

and seen, I fell down to worship before the feet of the angel which showed me these things.

John saw this <u>42\_LUK\_09\_54</u># And when his disciples James and John saw [this], they said, Lord, wilt thou that we command fire to come down from heaven, and consume them, even as Elias did?

John saying Go 42\_LUK\_22\_08 # And he sent Peter and John, saying, Go and prepare us the passover, that we may eat.

John saying Why 40\_MAT\_09\_14# Then came to him the disciples of John, saying, Why do we and the Pharisees fast oft, but thy disciples fast not?

John seeth Jesus 43\_JOH\_01\_29 # The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.

John showed him 42\_LUK\_07\_18 # And the disciples of John showed him of all these things.

John since that <u>42\_LUK\_16\_16</u># The law and the prophets [were] until John: since that time the kingdom of God is preached, and every man presseth into it.

John spake of 43\_JOH\_10\_41 # And many resorted unto him, and said, John did no miracle: but all things that John spake of this man were true.

John speak and 43\_JOH\_01\_40 # One of the two which heard John [speak], and followed him, was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother.

John stood and 43\_JOH\_01\_35 # Again the next day after John stood, and two of his disciples;

John that he <u>41\_MAR\_11\_32</u># But if we shall say, Of men; they feared the people: for all [men] counted John, that he was a prophet indeed.

John the Baptist <u>42\_LUK\_07\_28</u> # For I say unto you, Among those that are born of women there is not a greater prophet than John the Baptist: but he that is least in the kingdom of God is greater than he.

John the Baptist <u>42\_LUK\_07\_33</u> # For John the Baptist came neither eating bread nor drinking wine; and ye say, He hath a devil.

John the Baptist <u>42\_LUK\_09\_19</u> # They answering said, John the Baptist; but some [say], Elias; and others [say], that one of the old prophets is risen again.

John the Baptist 41\_MAR\_06\_14 # And king Herod heard [of him]; [for his name was spread abroad:] and he said, That John the Baptist was risen from the dead, and therefore mighty works do show forth themselves in him.

John the Baptist 41\_MAR\_06\_24 # And she went forth, and said unto her mother, What shall I ask? And she said, The head of John the Baptist.

John the Baptist 41\_MAR\_06\_25 # And she came in straightway with haste unto the king, and asked, saying, I will that thou give me by and by in a charger the head of John the Baptist.

John the Baptist 41\_MAR\_08\_28 # And they answered, John the Baptist: but some [say], Elias; and others, One of the prophets.

John the Baptist 40\_MAT\_03\_01# In those days came John the Baptist, preaching in the wilderness of Judaea,

John was it 41\_MAR\_11\_30 # The baptism of John, was [it] from heaven, or of men? answer me.

John was not 43\_JOH\_03\_24 # For John was not yet cast into prison.

John was put 41 MAR 01 14 # Now after that John was put in prison, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God,

John was risen <u>42\_LUK\_09\_07</u># Now Herod the tetrarch heard of all that was done by him: and he was perplexed, because that it was said of some, that John was risen from the dead;

John went up <u>44\_ACT\_03\_01</u> # Now Peter and John went up together into the temple at the hour of prayer, [being] the ninth [hour].

John whether he <u>42\_LUK\_03\_15</u># And as the people were in expectation, and all men mused in their hearts of John, whether he were the Christ, or not;

John who also <u>66\_REV\_01\_09</u># I John, who also am your brother, and companion in tribulation, and in the kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ, was in the isle that is called Patmos, for the word of God, and for the testimony of Jesus Christ.

John who seemed <u>48\_GAL\_02\_09</u># And when James, Cephas, and John, who seemed to be pillars, perceived the grace that was given unto me, they gave to me and Barnabas the right hands of fellowship; that we [should go] unto the heathen, and they unto the circumcision.

John whom I <u>41\_MAR\_06\_16</u># But when Herod heard [thereof], he said, It is John, whom I beheaded: he is risen from the dead.

John whose surname 44\_ACT\_12\_12# And when he had considered [the thing], he came to the house of Mary the mother of John, whose surname was Mark; where many were gathered together praying.

John with the 44\_ACT\_12\_02 # And he killed James the brother of John with the sword.

John <u>44\_ACT\_08\_14</u># Now when the apostles which were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God, they sent unto them Peter and John:

Pharaoh awoke and <u>01\_GEN\_41\_07</u> # And the seven thin ears devoured the seven rank and full ears. And Pharaoh awoke, and, behold, [it was] a dream.

Pharaoh king of 12 2KI 17 07 # For [so] it was, that the children of Israel had sinned against the LORD their God, which had brought them up out of the land of Egypt, from under the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt, and had feared other gods,

Pharaoh king of <u>26\_EZE\_31\_02</u># Son of man, speak unto Pharaoh king of Egypt, and to his multitude; Whom art thou like in thy greatness?

Pharaoh king of <u>26\_EZE\_32\_02</u> # Son of man, take up a lamentation for Pharaoh king of Egypt, and say unto him, Thou art like a young lion of the nations, and thou [art] as a whale in the seas: and thou camest forth with thy rivers, and troubledst the waters with thy feet, and fouledst their rivers.

Pharaoh king of <u>01\_GEN\_41\_46</u> # And Joseph [was] thirty years old when he stood before Pharaoh king of Egypt. And Joseph went out from the presence of Pharaoh, and went throughout all the land of Egypt.

Pharaoh king of 23\_ISA\_36\_06 # Lo, thou trustest in the staff of this broken reed, on Egypt; whereon if a man lean, it will go into his hand, and pierce it: so [is] Pharaoh king of Egypt to all that trust in him.

Pharaoh king of <u>24\_JER\_25\_19</u> # Pharaoh king of Egypt, and his servants, and his princes, and all his people;

Pharaoh king of 24\_JER\_46\_17 # They did cry there, Pharaoh king of Egypt [is but] a noise; he hath passed the time appointed.

Pharaoh Let me 11\_1KI\_11\_21# And when Hadad heard in Egypt that David slept with his fathers, and that Joab the captain of the host was dead, Hadad said to Pharaoh, Let me depart, that I may go to mine own country.

Pharaoh lift up <u>01\_GEN\_40\_13</u># Yet within three days shall Pharaoh lift up thine head, and restore thee unto thy place: and thou shalt deliver Pharaoh's cup into his hand, after the former manner when thou wast his butler.

Pharaoh lift up <u>01\_GEN\_40\_19</u> # Yet within three days shall Pharaoh lift up thy head from off thee, and shall hang thee on a tree; and the birds shall eat thy flesh from off thee.

Pharaoh lo he <u>02\_EXO\_08\_20</u> # And the LORD said unto Moses, Rise up early in the morning, and stand before Pharaoh; lo, he cometh forth to the water; and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let my people go, that they may serve me.

Pharaoh rose up <u>02\_EXO\_12\_30</u> # And Pharaoh rose up in the night, he, and all his servants, and all the Egyptians; and there was a great cry in Egypt; for [there was] not a house where [there was] not one dead.

Pharaoh said Behold <u>02\_EXO\_05\_05</u># And Pharaoh said, Behold, the people of the land now [are] many, and ye make them rest from their burdens.

Pharaoh said Go <u>01\_GEN\_50\_06</u># And Pharaoh said, Go up, and bury thy father, according as he made thee swear.

Pharaoh said I <u>02\_EXO\_08\_28</u> # And Pharaoh said, I will let you go, that ye may sacrifice to the LORD your God in the wilderness; only ye shall not go very far away: entreat for me.

Pharaoh said unto 11\_1KI\_11\_22# Then Pharaoh said unto him, But what hast thou lacked with me, that, behold, thou seekest to go to thine own country? And he answered, Nothing: howbeit let me go in any wise.

Pharaoh said unto <u>02\_EXO\_10\_28</u># And Pharaoh said unto him, Get thee from me, take heed to thyself, see my face no more; for in [that] day thou seest my face thou shalt die.

Pharaoh said unto <u>01\_GEN\_41\_15</u># And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, I have dreamed a dream, and [there is] none that can interpret it: and I have heard say of thee, [that] thou canst understand a dream to interpret it.

Pharaoh said unto <u>01\_GEN\_41\_17</u># And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, In my dream, behold, I stood upon the bank of the river:

Pharaoh said unto <u>01\_GEN\_41\_38</u># And Pharaoh said unto his servants, Can we find [such a one] as this [is], a man in whom the Spirit of God [is]?

Pharaoh said unto <u>01\_GEN\_41\_39</u> # And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, Forasmuch as God hath showed thee all this, [there is] none so discreet and wise as thou [art]:

Pharaoh said unto <u>01\_GEN\_41\_41</u> # And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, See, I have set thee over all the land of Egypt.

Pharaoh said unto <u>01\_GEN\_41\_44</u> # And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, I [am] Pharaoh, and without thee shall no man lift up his hand or foot in all the land of Egypt.

Pharaoh said unto <u>01\_GEN\_41\_55</u># And when all the land of Egypt was famished, the people cried to Pharaoh for bread: and Pharaoh said unto all the Egyptians, Go unto Joseph; what he saith to you, do.

lade your beasts, and go, get you unto the land of Canaan;

Pharaoh said unto <u>01\_GEN\_47\_03</u># And Pharaoh said unto his brethren, What [is] your occupation? And they said unto Pharaoh, Thy servants [are] shepherds, both we, [and] also our fathers.

Pharaoh said unto 01\_GEN\_47\_08 # And Pharaoh said unto Jacob, How old [art] thou?

Pharaoh said Who <u>02\_EXO\_05\_02</u> # And Pharaoh said, Who [is] the LORD, that I should obey his voice to let Israel go? I know not the LORD, neither will I let Israel go.

Pharaoh saw her <u>01\_GEN\_12\_15</u># The princes also of Pharaoh saw her, and commended her before Pharaoh: and the woman was taken into Pharaoh's house.

Pharaoh saying If <u>01\_GEN\_50\_04</u># And when the days of his mourning were past, Joseph spake unto the house of Pharaoh, saying, If now I have found grace in your eyes, speak, I pray you, in the ears of Pharaoh, saying,

Pharaoh saying It <u>01\_GEN\_41\_16</u># And Joseph answered Pharaoh, saying, [It is] not in me: God shall give Pharaoh an answer of peace.

Pharaoh saying Wherefore <u>02\_EXO\_05\_15</u># Then the officers of the children of Israel came and cried unto Pharaoh, saying, Wherefore dealest thou thus with thy servants?

Pharaoh saying <u>01\_GEN\_50\_04</u> # And when the days of his mourning were past, Joseph spake unto the house of Pharaoh, saying, If now I have found grace in your eyes, speak, I pray you, in the ears of Pharaoh, saying,

Pharaoh sent and <u>02\_EXO\_09\_07</u># And Pharaoh sent, and, behold, there was not one of the cattle of the Israelites dead. And the heart of Pharaoh was hardened, and he did not let the people go.

Pharaoh sent and <u>02\_EXO\_09\_27</u> # And Pharaoh sent, and called for Moses and Aaron, and said unto them, I have sinned this time: the LORD [is] righteous, and I and my people [are] wicked.

Pharaoh so that 11\_1KI\_11\_19# And Hadad found great favour in the sight of Pharaoh, so that he gave him to wife the sister of his own wife, the sister of Tahpenes the queen.

Pharaoh spake unto <u>01\_GEN\_47\_05</u># And Pharaoh spake unto Joseph, saying, Thy father and thy brethren are come unto thee:

Pharaoh surely ye <u>01\_GEN\_42\_16</u> # Send one of you, and let him fetch your brother, and ye shall be kept in prison, that your words may be proved, whether [there be any] truth in you: or else by the life of Pharaoh surely ye [are] spies.

Pharaoh that came <u>02\_EXO\_14\_28</u># And the waters returned, and covered the chariots, and the horsemen, [and] all the host of Pharaoh that came into the sea after them; there remained not so much as one of them.

Pharaoh that he <u>02\_EXO\_07\_02</u># Thou shalt speak all that I command thee: and Aaron thy brother shall speak unto Pharaoh, that he send the children of Israel out of his land.

Pharaoh that sat <u>02\_EXO\_12\_29</u> # And it came to pass, that at midnight the LORD smote all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, from the firstborn of Pharaoh that sat on his throne unto the firstborn of the captive that [was] in the dungeon; and all the firstborn of cattle.

Pharaoh Thus saith <u>02\_EXO\_04\_22</u># And thou shalt say unto Pharaoh, Thus saith the LORD, Israel [is] my son, [even] my firstborn:

Pharaoh Thus saith <u>02\_EXO\_05\_01</u># And afterward Moses and Aaron went in, and told Pharaoh, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Let my people go, that they may hold a feast unto me in the wilderness.

Pharaoh which Mered <u>13\_1CH\_04\_18</u># And his wife Jehudijah bare Jered the father of Gedor, and Heber the father of Socho, and Jekuthiel the father of Zanoah. And these [are] the sons of Bithiah the daughter of Pharaoh, which Mered took.

Pharaoh who hath <u>02\_EXO\_18\_10</u> # And Jethro said, Blessed [be] the LORD, who hath delivered you out of the hand of the Egyptians, and out of the hand of Pharaoh, who hath delivered the people from under the hand of the Egyptians.

Pharaoh will say <u>02\_EXO\_14\_03</u> # For Pharaoh will say of the children of Israel, They [are] entangled in the land, the wilderness hath shut them in.

Pharaoh with his <u>26\_EZE\_17\_17</u> # Neither shall Pharaoh with [his] mighty army and great company make for him in the war, by casting up mounts, and building forts, to cut off many persons:

Pharaoh women of <u>11\_1KI\_11\_01</u># But king Solomon loved many strange women, together with the daughter of Pharaoh, women of the Moabites, Ammonites, Edomites, Zidonians, [and] Hittites;

Pharaoh's cup into <u>01 GEN 40 13</u> # Yet within three days shall Pharaoh lift up thine head, and restore thee unto thy place: and thou shalt deliver Pharaoh's cup into his hand, after the former manner when thou wast his butler.

Pharaoh's cup was <u>01\_GEN\_40\_11</u># And Pharaoh's cup [was] in my hand: and I took the grapes, and pressed them into Pharaoh's cup, and I gave the cup into Pharaoh's hand.

Pharaoh's daughter and <u>11 1KI 03 01</u> # And Solomon made affinity with Pharaoh king of Egypt, and took Pharaoh's daughter, and brought her into the city of David, until he had made an end of building his own house, and the house of the LORD, and the wall of Jerusalem round about.

Pharaoh's daughter took 44\_ACT\_07\_21# And when he was cast out, Pharaoh's daughter took him up, and nourished him for her own son.

Pharaoh's daughter whom <u>11\_1KI\_07\_08</u># And his house where he dwelt [had] another court within the porch, [which] was of the like work. Solomon made also an house for Pharaoh's daughter, whom he had taken [to wife], like unto this porch.

Pharaoh's daughter <u>58\_HEB\_11\_24</u># By faith Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter;

Pharaoh's hand <u>01\_GEN\_40\_11</u># And Pharaoh's cup [was] in my hand: and I took the grapes, and pressed them into Pharaoh's cup, and I gave the cup into Pharaoh's hand.

Pharaoh's hand <u>01\_GEN\_40\_21</u># And he restored the chief butler unto his butlership again; and he gave the cup into Pharaoh's hand:

Pharaoh's heart and <u>02\_EXO\_07\_03</u># And I will harden Pharaoh's heart, and multiply my signs and my wonders in the land of Egypt.

Pharaoh's heart and <u>02\_EXO\_10\_27</u># But the LORD hardened Pharaoh's heart, and he would not let them go.

Pharaoh's heart is 02\_EXO\_07\_14 # And the LORD said unto Moses, Pharaoh's heart [is] hardened, he

refuseth to let the people go.

Pharaoh's heart so <u>02\_EXO\_10\_20</u># But the LORD hardened Pharaoh's heart, so that he would not let the children of Israel go.

Pharaoh's heart so <u>02\_EXO\_11\_10</u># And Moses and Aaron did all these wonders before Pharaoh: and the LORD hardened Pharaoh's heart, so that he would not let the children of Israel go out of his land.

Pharaoh's heart that <u>02\_EXO\_07\_13</u># And he hardened Pharaoh's heart, that he hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said.

Pharaoh's heart that <u>02\_EXO\_14\_04</u># And I will harden Pharaoh's heart, that he shall follow after them; and I will be honoured upon Pharaoh, and upon all his host; that the Egyptians may know that I [am] the LORD. And they did so.

Pharaoh's heart was <u>02\_EXO\_07\_22</u> # And the magicians of Egypt did so with their enchantments: and Pharaoh's heart was hardened, neither did he hearken unto them; as the LORD had said.

Pharaoh's heart was <u>02\_EXO\_08\_19</u> # Then the magicians said unto Pharaoh, This [is] the finger of God: and Pharaoh's heart was hardened, and he hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said.

Pharaoh's horses his <u>02\_EXO\_14\_23</u># And the Egyptians pursued, and went in after them to the midst of the sea, [even] all Pharaoh's horses, his chariots, and his horsemen.

Pharaoh's house and <u>11\_1KI\_11\_20</u># And the sister of Tahpenes bare him Genubath his son, whom Tahpenes weaned in Pharaoh's house: and Genubath was in Pharaoh's household among the sons of Pharaoh.

Pharaoh's house in 24\_JER\_43\_09 # Take great stones in thine hand, and hide them in the clay in the brickkiln, which [is] at the entry of Pharaoh's house in Tahpanhes, in the sight of the men of Judah;

Pharaoh's house saying <u>01\_GEN\_45\_16</u># And the fame thereof was heard in Pharaoh's house, saying, Joseph's brethren are come: and it pleased Pharaoh well, and his servants.

Pharaoh's house <u>09\_1SA\_02\_27</u> # And there came a man of God unto Eli, and said unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Did I plainly appear unto the house of thy father, when they were in Egypt in Pharaoh's house?

Pharaoh's house <u>01\_GEN\_12\_15</u> # The princes also of Pharaoh saw her, and commended her before Pharaoh: and the woman was taken into Pharaoh's house.

Pharaoh's house <u>01\_GEN\_47\_14</u># And Joseph gathered up all the money that was found in the land of Egypt, and in the land of Canaan, for the corn which they bought: and Joseph brought the money into Pharaoh's house.

Pharaoh's household among <u>11\_1KI\_11\_20</u># And the sister of Tahpenes bare him Genubath his son, whom Tahpenes weaned in Pharaoh's house: and Genubath was in Pharaoh's household among the sons of Pharaoh.

Pharaoh's officers that <u>01\_GEN\_40\_07</u> # And he asked Pharaoh's officers that [were] with him in the ward of his lord's house, saying, Wherefore look ye [so] sadly to day?

Pharaoh's presence <u>02\_EXO\_10\_11</u># Not so: go now ye [that are] men, and serve the LORD; for that ye did desire. And they were driven out from Pharaoh's presence.

Pharaoh's servants and 02\_EXO\_11\_03 # And the LORD gave the people favour in the sight of the

Egyptians. Moreover the man Moses [was] very great in the land of Egypt, in the sight of Pharaoh's servants, and in the sight of the people.

Pharaoh's servants said <u>02\_EXO\_10\_07</u># And Pharaoh's servants said unto him, How long shall this man be a snare unto us? let the men go, that they may serve the LORD their God: knowest thou not yet that Egypt is destroyed?

Pharaoh's servants <u>01\_GEN\_47\_25</u># And they said, Thou hast saved our lives: let us find grace in the sight of my lord, and we will be Pharaoh's servants.

Pharaoh's taskmasters had <u>02\_EXO\_05\_14</u># And the officers of the children of Israel, which Pharaoh's taskmasters had set over them, were beaten, [and] demanded, Wherefore have ye not fulfilled your task in making brick both yesterday and to day, as heretofore?

Pharaoh's <u>01\_GEN\_47\_20</u># And Joseph bought all the land of Egypt for Pharaoh; for the Egyptians sold every man his field, because the famine prevailed over them: so the land became Pharaoh's.

Pharaoh's <u>01\_GEN\_47\_26</u># And Joseph made it a law over the land of Egypt unto this day, [that] Pharaoh should have the fifth [part]; except the land of the priests only, [which] became not Pharaoh's.

Pharaohhophra king of <u>24\_JER\_44\_30</u> # Thus saith the LORD; Behold, I will give Pharaohhophra king of Egypt into the hand of his enemies, and into the hand of them that seek his life; as I gave Zedekiah king of Judah into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon, his enemy, and that sought his life.

Pharaohnecho king of <u>24 JER\_46\_02</u># Against Egypt, against the army of Pharaohnecho king of Egypt, which was by the river Euphrates in Carchemish, which Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon smote in the fourth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah.

Pharaohnechoh king of 12 2KI 23 29 # In his days Pharaohnechoh king of Egypt went up against the king of Assyria to the river Euphrates: and king Josiah went against him; and he slew him at Megiddo, when he had seen him.

Pharaohnechoh made Eliakim <u>12\_2KI\_23\_34</u> # And Pharaohnechoh made Eliakim the son of Josiah king in the room of Josiah his father, and turned his name to Jehoiakim, and took Jehoahaz away: and he came to Egypt, and died there.

Pharaohnechoh put him 12\_2KI\_23\_33 # And Pharaohnechoh put him in bands at Riblah in the land of Hamath, that he might not reign in Jerusalem; and put the land to a tribute of an hundred talents of silver, and a talent of gold.

Pharaohnechoh 12 2KI 23 35 # And Jehoiakim gave the silver and the gold to Pharaoh; but he taxed the land to give the money according to the commandment of Pharaoh: he exacted the silver and the gold of the people of the land, of every one according to his taxation, to give [it] unto Pharaohnechoh.

Rohgah Jehubbah and 13\_1CH\_07\_34 # And the sons of Shamer; Ahi, and Rohgah, Jehubbah, and Aram.

Shiloh and after <u>09\_1SA\_01\_09</u> # So Hannah rose up after they had eaten in Shiloh, and after they had drunk. Now Eli the priest sat upon a seat by a post of the temple of the LORD.

Shiloh and came <u>11\_1KI\_14\_04</u># And Jeroboam's wife did so, and arose, and went to Shiloh, and came to the house of Ahijah. But Ahijah could not see; for his eyes were set by reason of his age.

Shiloh and from 24\_JER\_41\_05 # That there came certain from Shechem, from Shiloh, and from Samaria, [even] fourscore men, having their beards shaven, and their clothes rent, and having cut themselves, with offerings and incense in their hand, to bring [them] to the house of the LORD.

Shiloh and go <u>07\_JUD\_21\_21</u># And see, and, behold, if the daughters of Shiloh come out to dance in dances, then come ye out of the vineyards, and catch you every man his wife of the daughters of Shiloh, and go to the land of Benjamin.

Shiloh and set <u>06\_JOS\_18\_01</u> # And the whole congregation of the children of Israel assembled together at Shiloh, and set up the tabernacle of the congregation there. And the land was subdued before them.

Shiloh And the <u>09\_1SA\_01\_03</u># And this man went up out of his city yearly to worship and to sacrifice unto the LORD of hosts in Shiloh. And the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, the priests of the LORD, [were] there.

Shiloh and the <u>09\_1SA\_01\_24</u># And when she had weaned him, she took him up with her, with three bullocks, and one ephah of flour, and a bottle of wine, and brought him unto the house of the LORD in Shiloh: and the child [was] young.

Shiloh and this 24\_JER\_26\_09 # Why hast thou prophesied in the name of the LORD, saying, This house shall be like Shiloh, and this city shall be desolate without an inhabitant? And all the people were gathered against Jeremiah in the house of the LORD.

Shiloh and will 24\_JER\_26\_06 # Then will I make this house like Shiloh, and will make this city a curse to all the nations of the earth.

Shiloh before the <u>06\_JOS\_18\_10</u># And Joshua cast lots for them in Shiloh before the LORD: and there Joshua divided the land unto the children of Israel according to their divisions.

Shiloh before the <u>06\_JOS\_19\_51</u># These [are] the inheritances, which Eleazar the priest, and Joshua the son of Nun, and the heads of the fathers of the tribes of the children of Israel, divided for an inheritance by lot in Shiloh before the LORD, at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation. So they made an end of dividing the country.

Shiloh behold there <u>11\_1KI\_14\_02</u># And Jeroboam said to his wife, Arise, I pray thee, and disguise thyself, that thou be not known to be the wife of Jeroboam; and get thee to Shiloh: behold, there [is] Ahijah the prophet, which told me that [I should be] king over this people.

Shiloh by the <u>09\_1SA\_03\_21</u># And the LORD appeared again in Shiloh: for the LORD revealed himself to Samuel in Shiloh by the word of the LORD.

Shiloh come and <u>01\_GEN\_49\_10</u># The sceptre shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh come; and unto him [shall] the gathering of the people [be].

Shiloh come out <u>07\_JUD\_21\_21</u># And see, and, behold, if the daughters of Shiloh come out to dance in dances, then come ye out of the vineyards, and catch you every man his wife of the daughters of Shiloh, and go to the land of Benjamin.

Shiloh for the <u>09\_1SA\_03\_21</u> # And the LORD appeared again in Shiloh: for the LORD revealed himself to Samuel in Shiloh by the word of the LORD.

Shiloh that they <u>09\_1SA\_04\_04</u># So the people sent to Shiloh, that they might bring from thence the ark of the covenant of the LORD of hosts, which dwelleth [between] the cherubims: and the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, [were] there with the ark of the covenant of God.

Shiloh the same <u>09\_1SA\_04\_12</u> # And there ran a man of Benjamin out of the army, and came to Shiloh the same day with his clothes rent, and with earth upon his head.

Shiloh the tent 19\_PSA\_78\_60 # So that he forsook the tabernacle of Shiloh, the tent [which] he placed among men;

Shiloh to go <u>06\_JOS\_22\_12</u> # And when the children of Israel heard [of it], the whole congregation of the children of Israel gathered themselves together at Shiloh, to go up to war against them.

Shiloh unto all <u>09\_1SA\_02\_14</u># And he struck [it] into the pan, or kettle, or caldron, or pot; all that the fleshhook brought up the priest took for himself. So they did in Shiloh, unto all the Israelites that came thither.

Shiloh unto us <u>09\_1SA\_04\_03</u># And when the people were come into the camp, the elders of Israel said, Wherefore hath the LORD smitten us to day before the Philistines? Let us fetch the ark of the covenant of the LORD out of Shiloh unto us, that, when it cometh among us, it may save us out of the hand of our enemies.

Shiloh wearing an <u>09\_1SA\_14\_03</u># And Ahiah, the son of Ahitub, Ichabod's brother, the son of Phinehas, the son of Eli, the LORD'S priest in Shiloh, wearing an ephod. And the people knew not that Jonathan was gone.

Shiloh where I <u>24\_JER\_07\_12</u> # But go ye now unto my place which [was] in Shiloh, where I set my name at the first, and see what I did to it for the wickedness of my people Israel.

Shiloh which is <u>06\_JOS\_22\_09</u># And the children of Reuben and the children of Gad and the half tribe of Manasseh returned, and departed from the children of Israel out of Shiloh, which [is] in the land of Canaan, to go unto the country of Gilead, to the land of their possession, whereof they were possessed, according to the word of the LORD by the hand of Moses.

Shiloh which is <u>07 JUD\_21 12</u> # And they found among the inhabitants of Jabeshgilead four hundred young virgins, that had known no man by lying with any male: and they brought them unto the camp to Shiloh, which [is] in the land of Canaan.

Socoh and Azekah 06\_JOS\_15\_35 # Jarmuth, and Adullam, Socoh, and Azekah,

Socoh 06\_JOS\_15\_48 # And in the mountains, Shamir, and Jattir, and Socoh,

Taanathshiloh and passed <u>06\_JOS\_16\_06</u># And the border went out toward the sea to Michmethah on the north side; and the border went about eastward unto Taanathshiloh, and passed by it on the east to Janohah;

Tohu the son <u>09\_1SA\_01\_01</u> # Now there was a certain man of Ramathaimzophim, of mount Ephraim, and his name [was] Elkanah, the son of Jeroham, the son of Elihu, the son of Tohu, the son of Zuph, an Ephrathite:

Zohar and Shaul <u>02\_EXO\_06\_15</u># And the sons of Simeon; Jemuel, and Jamin, and Ohad, and Jachin, and Zohar, and Shaul the son of a Canaanitish woman: these [are] the families of Simeon.
