Omri and Jerimoth [13 1CH 07 08](#) # And the sons of Becher; Zemira, and Joash, and Eliezer, and Elioenai, and Omri, and Jerimoth, and Abiah, and Anathoth, and Alameth. All these [are] the sons of Becher.

Omri are kept [33 MIC 06 16](#) # For the statutes of Omri are kept, and all the works of the house of Ahab, and ye walk in their counsels; that I should make thee a desolation, and the inhabitants thereof an hissing: therefore ye shall bear the reproach of my people.

Omri did evil [11 1KI 16 30](#) # And Ahab the son of Omri did evil in the sight of the LORD above all that [were] before him.

Omri king of [12 2KI 08 26](#) # Two and twenty years old [was] Ahaziah when he began to reign; and he reigned one year in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Athaliah, the daughter of Omri king of Israel.

Omri prevailed against [11 1KI 16 22](#) # But the people that followed Omri prevailed against the people that followed Tibni the son of Ginath: so Tibni died, and Omri reigned.

Omri reigned over [11 1KI 16 29](#) # And in the thirty and eighth year of Asa king of Judah began Ahab the son of Omri to reign over Israel: and Ahab the son of Omri reigned over Israel in Samaria twenty and two years.

Omri reigned [11 1KI 16 22](#) # But the people that followed Omri prevailed against the people that followed Tibni the son of Ginath: so Tibni died, and Omri reigned.

Omri slept with [11 1KI 16 28](#) # So Omri slept with his fathers, and was buried in Samaria: and Ahab his son reigned in his stead.

Omri the captain [11 1KI 16 16](#) # And the people [that were] encamped heard say, Zimri hath conspired, and hath also slain the king: wherefore all Israel made Omri, the captain of the host, king over Israel that day in the camp.

Omri the son [13 1CH 09 04](#) # Uthai the son of Ammihud, the son of Omri, the son of Imri, the son of Bani, of the children of Pharez the son of Judah.

Omri the son [13 1CH 27 18](#) # Of Judah, Elihu, [one] of the brethren of David: of Issachar, Omri the son of Michael:

Omri to reign [11 1KI 16 23](#) # In the thirty and first year of Asa king of Judah began Omri to reign over Israel, twelve years: six years reigned he in Tirzah.

Omri to reign [11 1KI 16 29](#) # And in the thirty and eighth year of Asa king of Judah began Ahab the son of Omri to reign over Israel: and Ahab the son of Omri reigned over Israel in Samaria twenty and two years.

Omri went up [11 1KI 16 17](#) # And Omri went up from Gibbethon, and all Israel with him, and they besieged Tirzah.

Omri which he [11 1KI 16 27](#) # Now the rest of the acts of Omri which he did, and his might that he showed, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Israel?

Omri wrought evil [11 1KI 16 25](#) # But Omri wrought evil in the eyes of the LORD, and did worse than all that [were] before him.

Omri [11 1KI 16 21](#) # Then were the people of Israel divided into two parts: half of the people followed Tibni the son of Ginath, to make him king; and half followed Omri.

Omri [14 2CH 22 02](#) # Forty and two years old [was] Ahaziah when he began to reign, and he reigned one year in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] Athaliah the daughter of Omri.
