

# KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Cononiah and Shimei <u>14\_2CH\_31\_13</u> # And Jehiel, and Azaziah, and Nahath, and Asahel, and Jerimoth, and Jozabad, and Eliel, and Ismachiah, and Mahath, and Benaiah, [were] overseers under the hand of Cononiah and Shimei his brother, at the commandment of Hezekiah the king, and Azariah the ruler of the house of God.

Cononiah the Levite <u>14\_2CH\_31\_12</u> # And brought in the offerings and the tithes and the dedicated [things] faithfully: over which Cononiah the Levite [was] ruler, and Shimei his brother [was] the next.

dishonour by evil <u>47\_2CO\_06\_08</u> # By honour and dishonour, by evil report and good report: as deceivers, and [yet] true;

dishonour it is <u>46\_1CO\_15\_43</u># It is sown in dishonour; it is raised in glory: it is sown in weakness; it is raised in power:

dishonour me <u>43\_JOH\_08\_49</u> # Jesus answered, I have not a devil; but I honour my Father, and ye do dishonour me.

dishonour mine adversaries <u>19\_PSA\_69\_19</u># Thou hast known my reproach, and my shame, and my dishonour: mine adversaries [are] all before thee.

dishonour shall he <u>20\_PRO\_06\_33</u># A wound and dishonour shall he get; and his reproach shall not be wiped away.

dishonour that magnify <u>19\_PSA\_35\_26</u># Let them be ashamed and brought to confusion together that rejoice at mine hurt: let them be clothed with shame and dishonour that magnify [themselves] against me.

dishonour that seek <u>19\_PSA\_71\_13</u># Let them be confounded [and] consumed that are adversaries to my soul; let them be covered [with] reproach and dishonour that seek my hurt.

dishonour their own <u>45\_ROM\_01\_24</u> # Wherefore God also gave them up to uncleanness through the lusts of their own hearts, to dishonour their own bodies between themselves:

dishonour therefore have <u>15\_EZR\_04\_14</u> # Now because we have maintenance from [the king's] palace, and it was not meet for us to see the king's dishonour, therefore have we sent and certified the king;

dishonour <u>55\_2TI\_02\_20</u> # But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and of silver, but also of wood and of earth; and some to honour, and some to dishonour.

dishonour <u>45\_ROM\_09\_21</u> # Hath not the potter power over the clay, of the same lump to make one vessel unto honour, and another unto dishonour?

dishonourest thou God <u>45\_ROM\_02\_23</u> # Thou that makest thy boast of the law, through breaking the law dishonourest thou God?

dishonoureth her head <u>46\_1CO\_11\_05</u># But every woman that prayeth or prophesieth with [her] head uncovered dishonoureth her head: for that is even all one as if she were shaven.

dishonoureth his head <u>46\_1CO\_11\_04</u># Every man praying or prophesying, having [his] head covered,

dishonoureth his head.

dishonoureth the father <u>33\_MIC\_07\_06</u># For the son dishonoureth the father, the daughter riseth up against her mother, the daughter in law against her mother in law; a man's enemies [are] the men of his own house.

gluttonous and a <u>40\_MAT\_11\_19</u># The Son of man came eating and drinking, and they say, Behold a man gluttonous, and a winebibber, a friend of publicans and sinners. But wisdom is justified of her children.

gluttonous man and <u>42\_LUK\_07\_34</u> # The Son of man is come eating and drinking; and ye say, Behold a gluttonous man, and a winebibber, a friend of publicans and sinners!

honour abideth not <u>19\_PSA\_49\_12</u> # Nevertheless man [being] in honour abideth not: he is like the beasts [that] perish.

Honour all men <u>60\_1PE\_02\_17</u># Honour all [men]. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honour the king.

honour all the <u>19\_PSA\_71\_08</u># Let my mouth be filled [with] thy praise [and with] thy honour all the day.

honour and another <u>45\_ROM\_09\_21</u> # Hath not the potter power over the clay, of the same lump to make one vessel unto honour, and another unto dishonour?

honour and brightness 27\_DAN\_04\_36 # At the same time my reason returned unto me; and for the glory of my kingdom, mine honour and brightness returned unto me; and my counsellors and my lords sought unto me; and I was established in my kingdom, and excellent majesty was added unto me.

honour and bring <u>17\_EST\_06\_09</u> # And let this apparel and horse be delivered to the hand of one of the king's most noble princes, that they may array the man [withal] whom the king delighteth to honour, and bring him on horseback through the street of the city, and proclaim before him, Thus shall it be done to the man whom the king delighteth to honour.

honour and didst <u>58\_HEB\_02\_07</u># Thou madest him a little lower than the angels; thou crownedst him with glory and honour, and didst set him over the works of thy hands:

honour and glory <u>60\_1PE\_01\_07</u> # That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ:

honour and glory <u>54\_1TI\_01\_17</u># Now unto the King eternal, immortal, invisible, the only wise God, [be] honour and glory for ever and ever. Amen.

honour and glory <u>61\_2PE\_01\_17</u># For he received from God the Father honour and glory, when there came such a voice to him from the excellent glory, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

honour and glory <u>66\_REV\_05\_12</u># Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing.

honour and glory <u>66\_REV\_05\_13</u># And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessing, and honour, and glory,

and power, [be] unto him that sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever.

honour and he <u>14\_2CH\_32\_27</u> # And Hezekiah had exceeding much riches and honour: and he made himself treasuries for silver, and for gold, and for precious stones, and for spices, and for shields, and for all manner of pleasant jewels;

honour and he <u>18\_JOB\_14\_21</u> # His sons come to honour, and he knoweth [it] not; and they are brought low, but he perceiveth [it] not of them.

honour and I <u>04\_NUM\_22\_17</u># For I will promote thee unto very great honour, and I will do whatsoever thou sayest unto me: come therefore, I pray thee, curse me this people.

honour and if <u>39\_MAL\_01\_06</u># A son honoureth [his] father, and a servant his master: if then I [be] a father, where [is] mine honour? and if I [be] a master, where [is] my fear? saith the LORD of hosts unto you, O priests, that despise my name. And ye say, Wherein have we despised thy name?

honour and immortality <u>45\_ROM\_02\_07</u># To them who by patient continuance in well doing seek for glory and honour and immortality, eternal life:

honour and life 20\_PRO\_22\_04 # By humility [and] the fear of the LORD [are] riches, and honour, and life.

honour and majesty <u>19\_PSA\_104\_01</u> # Bless the LORD, O my soul. O LORD my God, thou art very great; thou art clothed with honour and majesty.

honour and majesty <u>19\_PSA\_21\_05</u># His glory [is] great in thy salvation: honour and majesty hast thou laid upon him.

Honour and majesty <u>19\_PSA\_96\_06</u># Honour and majesty [are] before him: strength and beauty [are] in his sanctuary.

honour and our <u>46\_1CO\_12\_23</u> # And those [members] of the body, which we think to be less honourable, upon these we bestow more abundant honour; and our uncomely [parts] have more abundant comeliness.

honour and peace <u>45\_ROM\_02\_10</u> # But glory, honour, and peace, to every man that worketh good, to the Jew first, and also to the Gentile:

honour and power <u>54\_1TI\_06\_16</u># Who only hath immortality, dwelling in the light which no man can approach unto; whom no man hath seen, nor can see: to whom [be] honour and power everlasting. Amen.

honour and power <u>66\_REV\_04\_11</u># Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.

honour and power <u>66\_REV\_07\_12</u> # Saying, Amen: Blessing, and glory, and wisdom, and thanksgiving, and honour, and power, and might, [be] unto our God for ever and ever. Amen.

honour and power <u>66\_REV\_19\_01</u> # And after these things I heard a great voice of much people in heaven, saying, Alleluia; Salvation, and glory, and honour, and power, unto the Lord our God:

honour and Solomon <u>13\_1CH\_29\_28</u> # And he died in a good old age, full of days, riches, and honour: and Solomon his son reigned in his stead.

honour and understandeth <u>19\_PSA\_49\_20</u># Man [that is] in honour, and understandeth not, is like the beasts [that] perish.

honour are her <u>20\_PRO\_31\_25</u># Strength and honour [are] her clothing; and she shall rejoice in time to come.

honour are in <u>13\_1CH\_16\_27</u> # Glory and honour [are] in his presence; strength and gladness [are] in his place.

honour are with <u>20\_PRO\_08\_18</u># Riches and honour [are] with me; [yea], durable riches and righteousness.

honour at his <u>14\_2CH\_32\_33</u># And Hezekiah slept with his fathers, and they buried him in the chiefest of the sepulchres of the sons of David: and all Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem did him honour at his death. And Manasseh his son reigned in his stead.

honour be not <u>01\_GEN\_49\_06</u> # O my soul, come not thou into their secret; unto their assembly, mine honour, be not thou united: for in their anger they slew a man, and in their selfwill they digged down a wall.

honour before all 24\_JER\_33\_09 # And it shall be to me a name of joy, a praise and an honour before all the nations of the earth, which shall hear all the good that I do unto them: and they shall fear and tremble for all the goodness and for all the prosperity that I procure unto it.

honour both to <u>17\_EST\_01\_20</u> # And when the king's decree which he shall make shall be published throughout all his empire, [for it is great,] all the wives shall give to their husbands honour, both to great and small.

honour but in <u>41\_MAR\_06\_04</u> # But Jesus said unto them, A prophet is not without honour, but in his own country, and among his own kin, and in his own house.

honour but in <u>20\_PRO\_14\_28</u># In the multitude of people [is] the king's honour: but in the want of people [is] the destruction of the prince.

honour but lo <u>04\_NUM\_24\_11</u># Therefore now flee thou to thy place: I thought to promote thee unto great honour; but, lo, the LORD hath kept thee back from honour.

honour come of <u>13\_1CH\_29\_12</u> # Both riches and honour [come] of thee, and thou reignest over all; and in thine hand [is] power and might; and in thine hand [it is] to make great, and to give strength unto all.

honour dwelleth <u>19\_PSA\_26\_08</u># LORD, I have loved the habitation of thy house, and the place where thine honour dwelleth.

honour especially they <u>54\_1TI\_05\_17</u> # Let the elders that rule well be counted worthy of double honour, especially they who labour in the word and doctrine.

honour for a <u>20\_PRO\_20\_03</u> # [It is] an honour for a man to cease from strife: but every fool will be meddling.

honour for the <u>07\_JUD\_04\_09</u> # And she said, I will surely go with thee: notwithstanding the journey that thou takest shall not be for thine honour; for the LORD shall sell Sisera into the hand of a woman. And Deborah arose, and went with Barak to Kedesh.

honour from men <u>43\_JOH\_05\_41</u> # I receive not honour from men.

honour from the <u>14\_2CH\_26\_18</u> # And they withstood Uzziah the king, and said unto him, [It appertaineth] not unto thee, Uzziah, to burn incense unto the LORD, but to the priests the sons of Aaron, that are consecrated to burn incense: go out of the sanctuary; for thou hast trespassed; neither [shall it be] for thine honour from the LORD God.

honour God and <u>07\_JUD\_09\_09</u># But the olive tree said unto them, Should I leave my fatness, wherewith by me they honour God and man, and go to be promoted over the trees?

honour have all <u>19\_PSA\_149\_09</u> # To execute upon them the judgment written: this honour have all his saints. Praise ye the LORD.

honour him not 23\_ISA\_58\_13 # If thou turn away thy foot from the sabbath, [from] doing thy pleasure on my holy day; and call the sabbath a delight, the holy of the LORD, honourable; and shalt honour him, not doing thine own ways, nor finding thine own pleasure, nor speaking [thine own] words:

honour him <u>19\_PSA\_91\_15</u># He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I [will be] with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him.

honour in abundance <u>14\_2CH\_17\_05</u> # Therefore the LORD stablished the kingdom in his hand; and all Judah brought to Jehoshaphat presents; and he had riches and honour in abundance.

honour in abundance <u>14\_2CH\_18\_01</u> # Now Jehoshaphat had riches and honour in abundance, and joined affinity with Ahab.

honour in his <u>43\_JOH\_04\_44</u> # For Jesus himself testified, that a prophet hath no honour in his own country.

honour in the <u>19\_PSA\_07\_05</u> # Let the enemy persecute my soul, and take [it]; yea, let him tread down my life upon the earth, and lay mine honour in the dust. Selah.

honour into it <u>66\_REV\_21\_24</u> # And the nations of them which are saved shall walk in the light of it: and the kings of the earth do bring their glory and honour into it.

honour is humility <u>20\_PRO\_15\_33</u># The fear of the LORD [is] the instruction of wisdom; and before honour [is] humility.

honour is not <u>20\_PRO\_26\_01</u> # As snow in summer, and as rain in harvest, so honour is not seemly for a fool.

honour is nothing <u>43\_JOH\_08\_54</u> # Jesus answered, If I honour myself, my honour is nothing: it is my

Father that honoureth me; of whom ye say, that he is your God:

honour me but <u>23\_ISA\_29\_13</u># Wherefore the Lord said, Forasmuch as this people draw near [me] with their mouth, and with their lips do honour me, but have removed their heart far from me, and their fear toward me is taught by the precept of men:

honour of his <u>19\_PSA\_66\_02</u># Sing forth the honour of his name: make his praise glorious.

honour of kings <u>20\_PRO\_25\_02</u> # [It is] the glory of God to conceal a thing: but the honour of kings [is] to search out a matter.

honour of my <u>27\_DAN\_04\_30</u># The king spake, and said, Is not this great Babylon, that I have built for the house of the kingdom by the might of my power, and for the honour of my majesty?

honour of the <u>27\_DAN\_11\_21</u># And in his estate shall stand up a vile person, to whom they shall not give the honour of the kingdom: but he shall come in peaceably, and obtain the kingdom by flatteries.

honour of the 66\_REV\_21\_26 # And they shall bring the glory and honour of the nations into it.

honour of thy <u>13\_1CH\_17\_18</u> # What can David [speak] more to thee for the honour of thy servant? for

thou knowest thy servant.

honour one of 43\_JOH\_05\_44 # How can ye believe, which receive honour one of another, and seek not the honour that [cometh] from God only?

honour preferring one <u>45\_ROM\_12\_10</u> # [Be] kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour preferring one another;

honour sanctified and 55\_2TI\_02\_21 # If a man therefore purge himself from these, he shall be a vessel unto honour, sanctified, and meet for the master's use, [and] prepared unto every good work.

honour save in 40\_MAT\_13\_57 # And they were offended in him. But Jesus said unto them, A prophet is not without honour, save in his own country, and in his own house.

honour shall uphold 20\_PRO\_29\_23 # A man's pride shall bring him low: but honour shall uphold the humble in spirit.

honour so that 11\_1KI\_03\_13 # And I have also given thee that which thou hast not asked, both riches, and honour: so that there shall not be any among the kings like unto thee all thy days.

honour so that 21\_ECC\_06\_02 # A man to whom God hath given riches, wealth, and honour, so that he wanteth nothing for his soul of all that he desireth, yet God giveth him not power to eat thereof, but a stranger eateth it: this [is] vanity, and it [is] an evil disease.

honour such as 14\_2CH\_01\_12 # Wisdom and knowledge [is] granted unto thee; and I will give thee riches, and wealth, and honour, such as none of the kings have had that [have been] before thee, neither shall there any after thee have the like.

honour than the 58\_HEB\_03\_03 # For this [man] was counted worthy of more glory than Moses, inasmuch as he who hath builded the house hath more honour than the house.

honour that cometh 43\_JOH\_05\_44 # How can ye believe, which receive honour one of another, and seek not the honour that [cometh] from God only?

honour that he 58\_HEB\_02\_09 # But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour; that he by the grace of God should taste death for every man.

honour that the 54\_1TI\_06\_01 # Let as many servants as are under the yoke count their own masters worthy of all honour, that the name of God and [his] doctrine be not blasphemed.

honour the face 03\_LEV\_19\_32 # Thou shalt rise up before the hoary head, and honour the face of the old man, and fear thy God: I [am] the LORD.

honour the Father 43\_JOH\_05\_23 # That all [men] should honour the Son, even as they honour the Father. He that honoureth not the Son honoureth not the Father which hath sent him.

honour the God 27\_DAN\_11\_38 # But in his estate shall he honour the God of forces: and a god whom his fathers knew not shall he honour with gold, and silver, and with precious stones, and pleasant things.

Honour the king 60\_1PE\_02\_17 # Honour all [men]. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honour the king.

honour the King <u>27\_DAN\_04\_37</u> # Now I Nebuchadnezzar praise and extol and honour the King of heaven, all whose works [are] truth, and his ways judgment: and those that walk in pride he is able to abase.

Honour the LORD <u>20\_PRO\_03\_09</u> # Honour the LORD with thy substance, and with the firstfruits of all thine increase:

honour the person <u>03\_LEV\_19\_15</u># Ye shall do no unrighteousness in judgment: thou shalt not respect the person of the poor, nor honour the person of the mighty: [but] in righteousness shalt thou judge thy neighbour.

honour the Son <u>43\_JOH\_05\_23</u> # That all [men] should honour the Son, even as they honour the Father. He that honoureth not the Son honoureth not the Father which hath sent him.

honour therefore show <u>27\_DAN\_02\_06</u> # But if ye show the dream, and the interpretation thereof, ye shall receive of me gifts and rewards and great honour: therefore show me the dream, and the interpretation thereof.

honour thy father <u>13\_1CH\_19\_03</u> # But the princes of the children of Ammon said to Hanun, Thinkest thou that David doth honour thy father, that he hath sent comforters unto thee? are not his servants come unto thee for to search, and to overthrow, and to spy out the land?

honour thy father <u>10\_2SA\_10\_03</u> # And the princes of the children of Ammon said unto Hanun their lord, Thinkest thou that David doth honour thy father, that he hath sent comforters unto thee? hath not David [rather] sent his servants unto thee, to search the city, and to spy it out, and to overthrow it?

Honour thy father <u>05\_DEU\_05\_16</u># Honour thy father and thy mother, as the LORD thy God hath commanded thee; that thy days may be prolonged, and that it may go well with thee, in the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

Honour thy father <u>49\_EPH\_06\_02</u># Honour thy father and mother; which is the first commandment with promise;

Honour thy father <u>02\_EXO\_20\_12</u> # Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

Honour thy father <u>42\_LUK\_18\_20</u> # Thou knowest the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Honour thy father and thy mother.

Honour thy father <u>41\_MAR\_07\_10</u> # For Moses said, Honour thy father and thy mother; and, Whoso curseth father or mother, let him die the death:

Honour thy father <u>41\_MAR\_10\_19</u># Thou knowest the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Defraud not, Honour thy father and mother.

Honour thy father <u>40\_MAT\_15\_04</u># For God commanded, saying, Honour thy father and mother: and, He that curseth father or mother, let him die the death.

Honour thy father <u>40\_MAT\_19\_19</u># Honour thy father and [thy] mother: and, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

honour to a 20\_PRO\_26\_08 # As he that bindeth a stone in a sling, so [is] he that giveth honour to a fool.

honour to him <u>66\_REV\_19\_07</u> # Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife hath made herself ready.

honour to that <u>46\_1CO\_12\_24</u> # For our comely [parts] have no need: but God hath tempered the body together, having given more abundant honour to that [part] which lacked:

honour to the <u>51\_COL\_02\_23</u> # Which things have indeed a show of wisdom in will worship, and humility, and neglecting of the body; not in any honour to the satisfying of the flesh.

honour to whom <u>45\_ROM\_13\_07</u> # Render therefore to all their dues: tribute to whom tribute [is due]; custom to whom custom; fear to whom fear; honour to whom honour.

honour unto himself <u>58\_HEB\_05\_04</u> # And no man taketh this honour unto himself, but he that is called of God, as [was] Aaron.

honour unto others 20\_PRO\_05\_09 # Lest thou give thine honour unto others, and thy years unto the cruel:

honour unto the <u>60\_1PE\_03\_07</u> # Likewise, ye husbands, dwell with [them] according to knowledge, giving honour unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life; that your prayers be not hindered.

honour upon him <u>04\_NUM\_27\_20</u> # And thou shalt put [some] of thine honour upon him, that all the congregation of the children of Israel may be obedient.
