offend against the <u>19\_PSA\_73\_15</u># If I say, I will speak thus; behold, I should offend [against] the generation of thy children.

offend all If <u>59\_JAM\_03\_02</u># For in many things we offend all. If any man offend not in word, the same [is] a perfect man, [and] able also to bridle the whole body.

offend and come <u>28\_HOS\_04\_15</u># Though thou, Israel, play the harlot, [yet] let not Judah offend; and come not ye unto Gilgal, neither go ye up to Bethaven, nor swear, The LORD liveth.

offend and them <u>40\_MAT\_13\_41</u># The Son of man shall send forth his angels, and they shall gather out of his kingdom all things that offend, and them which do iniquity;

offend any more <u>18\_JOB\_34\_31</u># Surely it is meet to be said unto God, I have borne [chastisement], I will not offend [any more]:

offend evil shall <u>24\_JER\_02\_03</u> # Israel [was] holiness unto the LORD, [and] the firstfruits of his increase: all that devour him shall offend; evil shall come upon them, saith the LORD.

offend I will <u>46\_1CO\_08\_13</u> # Wherefore, if meat make my brother to offend, I will eat no flesh while the world standeth, lest I make my brother to offend.

offend imputing this <u>35\_HAB\_01\_11</u># Then shall [his] mind change, and he shall pass over, and offend, [imputing] this his power unto his god.

offend in one <u>59\_JAM\_02\_10</u> # For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one [point], he is guilty of all.

offend not because <u>24\_JER\_50\_07</u> # All that found them have devoured them: and their adversaries said, We offend not, because they have sinned against the LORD, the habitation of justice, even the LORD, the hope of their fathers.

offend not in <u>59\_JAM\_03\_02</u># For in many things we offend all. If any man offend not in word, the same [is] a perfect man, [and] able also to bridle the whole body.

offend one of <u>42\_LUK\_17\_02</u> # It were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and he cast into the sea, than that he should offend one of these little ones.

offend one of 41\_MAR\_09\_42 # And whosoever shall offend one of [these] little ones that believe in me, it is better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and he were cast into the sea.

offend one of <u>40\_MAT\_18\_06</u># But whoso shall offend one of these little ones which believe in me, it were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and [that] he were drowned in the depth of the sea.

offend thee cut <u>41\_MAR\_09\_43</u> # And if thy hand offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter into life maimed, than having two hands to go into hell, into the fire that never shall be quenched:

offend thee cut 41\_MAR\_09\_45 # And if thy foot offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter halt into

life, than having two feet to be cast into hell, into the fire that never shall be quenched:

offend thee cut <u>40\_MAT\_05\_30</u># And if thy right hand offend thee, cut it off, and cast [it] from thee: for it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should perish, and not [that] thy whole body should be cast into hell.

offend thee cut <u>40\_MAT\_18\_08</u># Wherefore if thy hand or thy foot offend thee, cut them off, and cast [them] from thee: it is better for thee to enter into life halt or maimed, rather than having two hands or two feet to be cast into everlasting fire.

offend thee pluck <u>41\_MAR\_09\_47</u> # And if thine eye offend thee, pluck it out: it is better for thee to enter into the kingdom of God with one eye, than having two eyes to be cast into hell fire:

offend thee pluck 40 MAT 05 29 # And if thy right eye offend thee, pluck it out, and cast [it] from thee: for it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should perish, and not [that] thy whole body should be cast into hell.

offend thee pluck 40\_MAT\_18\_09# And if thine eye offend thee, pluck it out, and cast [it] from thee: it is better for thee to enter into life with one eye, rather than having two eyes to be cast into hell fire.

offend them go 40\_MAT\_17\_27# Notwithstanding, lest we should offend them, go thou to the sea, and cast an hook, and take up the fish that first cometh up; and when thou hast opened his mouth, thou shalt find a piece of money: that take, and give unto them for me and thee.

offend them 19\_PSA\_119\_165 # Great peace have they which love thy law: and nothing shall offend them.

offend you <u>43\_JOH\_06\_61</u> # When Jesus knew in himself that his disciples murmured at it, he said unto them, Doth this offend you?

offend <u>46\_1CO\_08\_13</u> # Wherefore, if meat make my brother to offend, I will eat no flesh while the world standeth, lest I make my brother to offend.

offended after they <u>40\_MAT\_15\_12</u># Then came his disciples, and said unto him, Knowest thou that the Pharisees were offended, after they heard this saying?

offended against the <u>14\_2CH\_28\_13</u> # And said unto them, Ye shall not bring in the captives hither: for whereas we have offended against the LORD [already], ye intend to add [more] to our sins and to our trespass: for our trespass is great, and [there is] fierce wrath against Israel.

offended against thee <u>24\_JER\_37\_18</u> # Moreover Jeremiah said unto king Zedekiah, What have I offended against thee, or against thy servants, or against this people, that ye have put me in prison?

offended and I 47\_2CO\_11\_29 # Who is weak, and I am not weak? who is offended, and I burn not?

offended and revenged <u>26\_EZE\_25\_12</u># Thus saith the Lord GOD; Because that Edom hath dealt against the house of Judah by taking vengeance, and hath greatly offended, and revenged himself upon them;

offended and shall <u>40\_MAT\_24\_10</u># And then shall many be offended, and shall betray one another, and shall hate one another.

offended any thing 44\_ACT\_25\_08 # While he answered for himself, Neither against the law of the Jews, neither against the temple, nor yet against Caesar, have I offended any thing at all.

offended at him <u>41\_MAR\_06\_03</u> # Is not this the carpenter, the son of Mary, the brother of James, and Joses, and of Juda, and Simon? and are not his sisters here with us? And they were offended at him.

offended because of 41\_MAR\_14\_27 # And Jesus saith unto them, All ye shall be offended because of me this night: for it is written, I will smite the shepherd, and the sheep shall be scattered.

offended because of 40\_MAT\_26\_31# Then saith Jesus unto them, All ye shall be offended because of me this night: for it is written, I will smite the shepherd, and the sheep of the flock shall be scattered abroad.

offended because of 40\_MAT\_26\_33 # Peter answered and said unto him, Though all [men] shall be offended because of thee, [yet] will I never be offended.

offended in Baal <u>28\_HOS\_13\_01</u> # When Ephraim spake trembling, he exalted himself in Israel; but when he offended in Baal, he died.

offended in him 40\_MAT\_13\_57# And they were offended in him. But Jesus said unto them, A prophet is not without honour, save in his own country, and in his own house.

offended in me 42\_LUK\_07\_23 # And blessed is [he], whosoever shall not be offended in me.

offended in me 40\_MAT\_11\_06# And blessed is [he], whosoever shall not be offended in me.

offended is harder <u>20\_PRO\_18\_19</u> # A brother offended [is harder to be won] than a strong city: and [their] contentions [are] like the bars of a castle.

offended or is <u>45\_ROM\_14\_21</u> # [It is] good neither to eat flesh, nor to drink wine, nor [any thing] whereby thy brother stumbleth, or is offended, or is made weak.

offended return from 12\_2KI\_18\_14 # And Hezekiah king of Judah sent to the king of Assyria to Lachish, saying, I have offended; return from me: that which thou puttest on me will I bear. And the king of Assyria appointed unto Hezekiah king of Judah three hundred talents of silver and thirty talents of gold.

offended thee that <u>01 GEN 20 09</u> # Then Abimelech called Abraham, and said unto him, What hast thou done unto us? and what have I offended thee, that thou hast brought on me and on my kingdom a great sin? thou hast done deeds unto me that ought not to be done.

offended their lord <u>01\_GEN\_40\_01</u> # And it came to pass after these things, [that] the butler of the king of Egypt and [his] baker had offended their lord the king of Egypt.

offended yet will 41\_MAR\_14\_29 # But Peter said unto him, Although all shall be offended, yet [will] not I.

offended 43\_JOH\_16\_01 # These things have I spoken unto you, that ye should not be offended.

offended <u>41\_MAR\_04\_17</u># And have no root in themselves, and so endure but for a time: afterward, when affliction or persecution ariseth for the word's sake, immediately they are offended.

offended <u>40\_MAT\_13\_21</u># Yet hath he not root in himself, but dureth for a while: for when tribulation or persecution ariseth because of the word, by and by he is offended.

offended <u>40\_MAT\_26\_33</u># Peter answered and said unto him, Though all [men] shall be offended because of thee, [yet] will I never be offended.

offender for a 23\_ISA\_29\_21 # That make a man an offender for a word, and lay a snare for him that reproveth in the gate, and turn aside the just for a thing of nought.

offender or have 44\_ACT\_25\_11 # For if I be an offender, or have committed any thing worthy of death, I refuse not to die: but if there be none of these things whereof these accuse me, no man may deliver me unto

them. I appeal unto Caesar.

offenders  $\underline{11\_1KI\_01\_21}$ # Otherwise it shall come to pass, when my lord the king shall sleep with his fathers, that I and my son Solomon shall be counted offenders.
