loft and was <u>44_ACT_20_09</u> # And there sat in a window a certain young man named Eutychus, being fallen into a deep sleep: and as Paul was long preaching, he sunk down with sleep, and fell down from the third loft, and was taken up dead.

loft where he <u>11_1KI_17_19</u># And he said unto her, Give me thy son. And he took him out of her bosom, and carried him up into a loft, where he abode, and laid him upon his own bed.

loftily <u>19_PSA_73_08</u># They are corrupt, and speak wickedly [concerning] oppression: they speak loftily.

loftiness and his <u>24_JER_48_29</u># We have heard the pride of Moab, [he is exceeding proud] his loftiness, and his arrogancy, and his pride, and the haughtiness of his heart.

loftiness of man <u>23_ISA_02_17</u> # And the loftiness of man shall be bowed down, and the haughtiness of men shall be made low: and the LORD alone shall be exalted in that day.

lofty and high <u>23_ISA_57_07</u># Upon a lofty and high mountain hast thou set thy bed: even thither wentest thou up to offer sacrifice.

lofty and upon 23_ISA_02_12 # For the day of the LORD of hosts [shall be] upon every [one that is] proud and lofty, and upon every [one that is] lifted up; and he shall be brought low:

lofty are their <u>20_PRO_30_13</u> # [There is] a generation, O how lofty are their eyes! and their eyelids are lifted up.

lofty city he <u>23_ISA_26_05</u> # For he bringeth down them that dwell on high; the lofty city, he layeth it low; he layeth it low, [even] to the ground; he bringeth it [even] to the dust.

lofty looks of 23_ISA_02_11# The lofty looks of man shall be humbled, and the haughtiness of men shall be bowed down, and the LORD alone shall be exalted in that day.

lofty neither do <u>19_PSA_131_01</u># A Song of degrees of David. LORD, my heart is not haughty, nor mine eyes lofty: neither do I exercise myself in great matters, or in things too high for me.

lofty One that <u>23_ISA_57_15</u># For thus saith the high and lofty One that inhabiteth eternity, whose name [is] Holy; I dwell in the high and holy [place], with him also [that is] of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones.

lofty shall be <u>23_ISA_05_15</u># And the mean man shall be brought down, and the mighty man shall be humbled, and the eyes of the lofty shall be humbled:

oft as he <u>12_2KI_04_08</u> # And it fell on a day, that Elisha passed to Shunem, where [was] a great woman; and she constrained him to eat bread. And [so] it was, [that] as oft as he passed by, he turned in thither to eat bread.

oft as ye <u>46_1CO_11_25</u># After the same manner also [he took] the cup, when he had supped, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink [it], in remembrance of me.

oft but thy <u>40_MAT_09_14</u># Then came to him the disciples of John, saying, Why do we and the Pharisees

oft did they <u>19_PSA_78_40</u># How oft did they provoke him in the wilderness, [and] grieve him in the desert!

oft eat not <u>41_MAR_07_03</u> # For the Pharisees, and all the Jews, except they wash [their] hands oft, eat not, holding the tradition of the elders.

oft in every <u>44_ACT_26_11</u># And I punished them oft in every synagogue, and compelled [them] to blaspheme; and being exceedingly mad against them, I persecuted [them] even unto strange cities.

oft into the <u>40_MAT_17_15</u># Lord, have mercy on my son: for he is a lunatic, and sore vexed: for ofttimes he falleth into the fire, and oft into the water.

oft is the <u>18_JOB_21_17</u> # How oft is the candle of the wicked put out! and [how oft] cometh their destruction upon them! [God] distributeth sorrows in his anger.

oft refreshed me <u>55_2TI_01_16</u> # The Lord give mercy unto the house of Onesiphorus; for he oft refreshed me, and was not ashamed of my chain:

oft shall my <u>40_MAT_18_21</u># Then came Peter to him, and said, Lord, how oft shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? till seven times?

oft upon it <u>58_HEB_06_07</u># For the earth which drinketh in the rain that cometh oft upon it, and bringeth forth herbs meet for them by whom it is dressed, receiveth blessing from God:

oft <u>47_2CO_11_23</u># Are they ministers of Christ? [I speak as a fool] I [am] more; in labours more abundant, in stripes above measure, in prisons more frequent, in deaths oft.

often and make <u>42_LUK_05_33</u> # And they said unto him, Why do the disciples of John fast often, and make prayers, and likewise [the disciples] of the Pharisees; but thine eat and drink?

often and now <u>50_PHP_03_18</u># [For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, [that they are] the enemies of the cross of Christ:

often as the <u>58_HEB_09_25</u> # Nor yet that he should offer himself often, as the high priest entereth into the holy place every year with blood of others;

often as they <u>66_REV_11_06</u># These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.

often as ye <u>46_1CO_11_26</u># For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this cup, ye do show the Lord's death till he come.

often bound with <u>41_MAR_05_04</u># Because that he had been often bound with fetters and chains, and the chains had been plucked asunder by him, and the fetters broken in pieces: neither could any [man] tame him.

often have suffered <u>58_HEB_09_26</u> # For then must he often have suffered since the foundation of the world: but now once in the end of the world hath he appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself.

often in cold <u>47_2CO_11_27</u># In weariness and painfulness, in watchings often, in hunger and thirst, in fastings often, in cold and nakedness.

often in hunger <u>47_2CO_11_27</u># In weariness and painfulness, in watchings often, in hunger and thirst, in fastings often, in cold and nakedness.

often in perils <u>47_2CO_11_26</u> # [In] journeyings often, [in] perils of waters, [in] perils of robbers, [in] perils by [mine own] countrymen, [in] perils by the heathen, [in] perils in the city, [in] perils in the wilderness, [in] perils in the sea, [in] perils among false brethren;

often infirmities <u>54_1TI_05_23</u> # Drink no longer water, but use a little wine for thy stomach's sake and thine often infirmities.

often one to <u>39_MAL_03_16</u># Then they that feared the LORD spake often one to another: and the LORD hearkened, and heard [it], and a book of remembrance was written before him for them that feared the LORD, and that thought upon his name.

often reproved hardeneth <u>20_PRO_29_01</u># He, that being often reproved hardeneth [his] neck, shall suddenly be destroyed, and that without remedy.

often would I <u>42_LUK_13_34</u> # O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, which killest the prophets, and stonest them that are sent unto thee; how often would I have gathered thy children together, as a hen [doth gather] her brood under [her] wings, and ye would not!

often would I <u>40_MAT_23_37</u># O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, [thou] that killest the prophets, and stonest them which are sent unto thee, how often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathereth her chickens under [her] wings, and ye would not!

oftener and communed <u>44_ACT_24_26</u> # He hoped also that money should have been given him of Paul, that he might loose him: wherefore he sent for him the oftener, and communed with him.

oftentimes also thine <u>21_ECC_07_22</u> # For oftentimes also thine own heart knoweth that thou thyself likewise hast cursed others.

oftentimes I purposed <u>45_ROM_01_13</u> # Now I would not have you ignorant, brethren, that oftentimes I purposed to come unto you, [but was let hitherto,] that I might have some fruit among you also, even as among other Gentiles.

oftentimes it had <u>42_LUK_08_29</u> # [For he had commanded the unclean spirit to come out of the man. For oftentimes it had caught him: and he was kept bound with chains and in fetters; and he brake the bands, and was driven of the devil into the wilderness.]

oftentimes proved diligent <u>47_2CO_08_22</u> # And we have sent with them our brother, whom we have oftentimes proved diligent in many things, but now much more diligent, upon the great confidence which [I have] in you.

oftentimes the same <u>58_HEB_10_11</u># And every priest standeth daily ministering and offering oftentimes the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins:

oftentimes with man <u>18_JOB_33_29</u> # Lo, all these [things] worketh God oftentimes with man,

ofttimes he falleth <u>40_MAT_17_15</u># Lord, have mercy on my son: for he is a lunatic, and sore vexed: for ofttimes he falleth into the fire, and oft into the water.

ofttimes it hath <u>41_MAR_09_22</u># And ofttimes it hath cast him into the fire, and into the waters, to destroy

him: but if thou canst do any thing, have compassion on us, and help us.

ofttimes resorted thither <u>43_JOH_18_02</u> # And Judas also, which betrayed him, knew the place: for Jesus ofttimes resorted thither with his disciples.

soft and the <u>18_JOB_23_16</u> # For God maketh my heart soft, and the Almighty troubleth me:

soft answer turneth <u>20_PRO_15_01</u> # A soft answer turneth away wrath: but grievous words stir up anger.

soft clothing are <u>40_MAT_11_08</u># But what went ye out for to see? A man clothed in soft raiment? behold, they that wear soft [clothing] are in kings' houses.

soft raiment Behold <u>42_LUK_07_25</u> # But what went ye out for to see? A man clothed in soft raiment? Behold, they which are gorgeously apparelled, and live delicately, are in kings' courts.

soft raiment behold <u>40_MAT_11_08</u># But what went ye out for to see? A man clothed in soft raiment? behold, they that wear soft [clothing] are in kings' houses.

soft tongue breaketh <u>20_PRO_25_15</u># By long forbearing is a prince persuaded, and a soft tongue breaketh the bone.

soft with showers <u>19_PSA_65_10</u> # Thou waterest the ridges thereof abundantly: thou settlest the furrows thereof: thou makest it soft with showers: thou blessest the springing thereof.

soft words unto <u>18_JOB_41_03</u> # Will he make many supplications unto thee? will he speak soft [words] unto thee?

softer than oil <u>19_PSA_55_21</u> # [The words] of his mouth were smoother than butter, but war [was] in his heart: his words were softer than oil, yet [were] they drawn swords.

softly according as <u>01_GEN_33_14</u># Let my lord, I pray thee, pass over before his servant: and I will lead on softly, according as the cattle that goeth before me and the children be able to endure, until I come unto my lord unto Seir.

softly all my <u>23_ISA_38_15</u> # What shall I say? he hath both spoken unto me, and himself hath done [it]: I shall go softly all my years in the bitterness of my soul.

softly and rejoice <u>23_ISA_08_06</u> # Forasmuch as this people refuseth the waters of Shiloah that go softly, and rejoice in Rezin and Remaliah's son;

softly and uncovered <u>08_RUT_03_07</u> # And when Boaz had eaten and drunk, and his heart was merry, he went to lie down at the end of the heap of corn: and she came softly, and uncovered his feet, and laid her down.

softly supposing that <u>44_ACT_27_13</u># And when the south wind blew softly, supposing that they had obtained [their] purpose, loosing [thence], they sailed close by Crete.

softly unto him <u>07_JUD_04_21</u> # Then Jael Heber's wife took a nail of the tent, and took an hammer in her hand, and went softly unto him, and smote the nail into his temples, and fastened it into the ground: for he was fast asleep and weary. So he died.

softly <u>11_1KI_21_27</u># And it came to pass, when Ahab heard those words, that he rent his clothes, and put sackcloth upon his flesh, and fasted, and lay in sackcloth, and went softly.
