boiled and rested [18 JOB 30 27](#) # My bowels boiled, and rested not: the days of affliction prevented me.

boiled my son [12 2KI 06 29](#) # So we boiled my son, and did eat him: and I said unto her on the next day, Give thy son, that we may eat him: and she hath hid her son.

boiled their flesh [11 1KI 19 21](#) # And he returned back from him, and took a yoke of oxen, and slew them, and boiled their flesh with the instruments of the oxen, and gave unto the people, and they did eat. Then he arose, and went after Elijah, and ministered unto him.

broiled fish and [42 LUK 24 42](#) # And they gave him a piece of a broiled fish, and of an honeycomb.

oiled bread and [02 EXO 29 23](#) # And one loaf of bread, and one cake of oiled bread, and one wafer out of the basket of the unleavened bread that [is] before the LORD:

oiled bread and [03 LEV 08 26](#) # And out of the basket of unleavened bread, that [was] before the LORD, he took one unleavened cake, and a cake of oiled bread, and one wafer, and put [them] on the fat, and upon the right shoulder:

spoiled and when [23 ISA 33 01](#) # Woe to thee that spoilest, and thou [wast] not spoiled; and dealest treacherously, and they dealt not treacherously with thee! when thou shalt cease to spoil, thou shalt be spoiled; [and] when thou shalt make an end to deal treacherously, they shall deal treacherously with thee.

spoiled as Shalman [28 HOS 10 14](#) # Therefore shall a tumult arise among thy people, and all thy fortresses shall be spoiled, as Shalman spoiled Betharbel in the day of battle: the mother was dashed in pieces upon [her] children.

spoiled Babylon and [24 JER 51 55](#) # Because the LORD hath spoiled Babylon, and destroyed out of her the great voice; when her waves do roar like great waters, a noise of their voice is uttered:

spoiled Betharbel in [28 HOS 10 14](#) # Therefore shall a tumult arise among thy people, and all thy fortresses shall be spoiled, as Shalman spoiled Betharbel in the day of battle: the mother was dashed in pieces upon [her] children.

spoiled by violence [26 EZE 18 12](#) # Hath oppressed the poor and needy, hath spoiled by violence, hath not restored the pledge, and hath lifted up his eyes to the idols, hath committed abomination,

spoiled by violence [26 EZE 18 16](#) # Neither hath oppressed any, hath not withholden the pledge, neither hath spoiled by violence, [but] hath given his bread to the hungry, and hath covered the naked with a garment,

spoiled cry ye [24 JER 49 03](#) # Howl, O Heshbon, for Ai is spoiled: cry, ye daughters of Rabbah, gird you with sackcloth; lament, and run to and fro by the hedges; for their king shall go into captivity, [and] his priests and his princes together.

spoiled even all [01 GEN 34 29](#) # And all their wealth, and all their little ones, and their wives took they captive, and spoiled even all that [was] in the house.

spoiled evermore and [05 DEU 28 29](#) # And thou shalt grope at noonday, as the blind gropeth in darkness, and thou shalt not prosper in thy ways: and thou shalt be only oppressed and spoiled evermore, and no man shall save [thee].

spoiled for the [23 ISA 24 03](#) # The land shall be utterly emptied, and utterly spoiled: for the LORD hath spoken this word.

spoiled he hath [33 MIC 02 04](#) # In that day shall [one] take up a parable against you, and lament with a doleful lamentation, [and] say, We be utterly spoiled: he hath changed the portion of my people: how hath he removed [it] from me! turning away he hath divided our fields.

spoiled his brother [26 EZE 18 18](#) # [As for] his father, because he cruelly oppressed, spoiled his brother by violence, and did [that] which [is] not good among his people, lo, even he shall die in his iniquity.

spoiled howl O [38 ZEC 11 02](#) # Howl, fir tree; for the cedar is fallen; because the mighty are spoiled: howl, O ye oaks of Bashan; for the forest of the vintage is come down.

spoiled Kiriathaim is [24 JER 48 01](#) # Against Moab thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Woe unto Nebo! for it is spoiled: Kiriathaim is confounded [and] taken: Misgab is confounded and dismayed.

spoiled many nations [35 HAB 02 08](#) # Because thou hast spoiled many nations, all the remnant of the people shall spoil thee; because of men's blood, and [for] the violence of the land, of the city, and of all that dwell therein.

spoiled none by [26 EZE 18 07](#) # And hath not oppressed any, [but] hath restored to the debtor his pledge, hath spoiled none by violence, hath given his bread to the hungry, and hath covered the naked with a garment;

spoiled out of [24 JER 21 12](#) # O house of David, thus saith the LORD; Execute judgment in the morning, and deliver [him that is] spoiled out of the hand of the oppressor, lest my fury go out like fire, and burn that none can quench [it], because of the evil of your doings.

spoiled out of [24 JER 22 03](#) # Thus saith the LORD; Execute ye judgment and righteousness, and deliver the spoiled out of the hand of the oppressor: and do no wrong, do no violence to the stranger, the fatherless, nor the widow, neither shed innocent blood in this place.

spoiled the Egyptians [02 EXO 12 36](#) # And the LORD gave the people favour in the sight of the Egyptians, so that they lent unto them [such things as they required]. And they spoiled the Egyptians.

spoiled the tents [12 2KI 07 16](#) # And the people went out, and spoiled the tents of the Syrians. So a measure of fine flour was [sold] for a shekel, and two measures of barley for a shekel, according to the word of the LORD.

spoiled their pasture [24 JER 25 36](#) # A voice of the cry of the shepherds, and an howling of the principal of the flock, [shall be heard]: for the LORD hath spoiled their pasture.

spoiled their tents [09 ISA 17 53](#) # And the children of Israel returned from chasing after the Philistines, and they spoiled their tents.

spoiled them and [26 EZE 39 10](#) # So that they shall take no wood out of the field, neither cut down [any] out of the forests; for they shall burn the weapons with fire: and they shall spoil those that spoiled them, and rob those that robbed them, saith the Lord GOD.

spoiled they have [19 PSA 76 05](#) # The stouthearted are spoiled, they have slept their sleep: and none of the men of might have found their hands.

spoiled to the [23 ISA 18 07](#) # In that time shall the present be brought unto the LORD of hosts of a people scattered and peeled, and from a people terrible from their beginning hitherto; a nation meted out and trodden under foot, whose land the rivers have spoiled, to the place of the name of the LORD of hosts, the mount Zion.

spoiled we are [24 JER 09 19](#) # For a voice of wailing is heard out of Zion, How are we spoiled! we are greatly confounded, because we have forsaken the land, because our dwellings have cast [us] out.

spoiled what wilt [24 JER 04 30](#) # And [when] thou [art] spoiled, what wilt thou do? Though thou clothest thyself with crimson, though thou deckest thee with ornaments of gold, though thou rentest thy face with painting, in vain shalt thou make thyself fair; [thy] lovers will despise thee, they will seek thy life.

spoiled you for [38 ZEC 02 08](#) # For thus saith the LORD of hosts; After the glory hath he sent me unto the nations which spoiled you: for he that toucheth you toucheth the apple of his eye.

spoiled [30 AMO 03 11](#) # Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; An adversary [there shall be] even round about the land; and he shall bring down thy strength from thee, and thy palaces shall be spoiled.

spoiled [26 EZE 23 46](#) # For thus saith the Lord GOD; I will bring up a company upon them, and will give them to be removed and spoiled.

spoiled [24 JER 04 13](#) # Behold, he shall come up as clouds, and his chariots [shall be] as a whirlwind: his horses are swifter than eagles. Woe unto us! for we are spoiled.

spoiled [24 JER 48 20](#) # Moab is confounded; for it is broken down: howl and cry; tell ye it in Arnon, that Moab is spoiled,

spoiled [38 ZEC 11 03](#) # [There is] a voice of the howling of the shepherds; for their glory is spoiled: a voice of the roaring of young lions; for the pride of Jordan is spoiled.

toiled all the [42 LUK 05 05](#) # And Simon answering said unto him, Master, we have toiled all the night, and have taken nothing: nevertheless at thy word I will let down the net.
