Persian <u>27_DAN_06_28</u># So this Daniel prospered in the reign of Darius, and in the reign of Cyrus the Persian.

Persian <u>16_NEH_12_22</u># The Levites in the days of Eliashib, Joiada, and Johanan, and Jaddua, [were] recorded chief of the fathers: also the priests, to the reign of Darius the Persian.

Persians and the <u>17_EST_01_19</u># If it please the king, let there go a royal commandment from him, and let it be written among the laws of the Persians and the Medes, that it be not altered, That Vashti come no more before king Ahasuerus; and let the king give her royal estate unto another that is better than she.

Persians is That <u>27_DAN_06_15</u> # Then these men assembled unto the king, and said unto the king, Know, O king, that the law of the Medes and Persians [is], That no decree nor statute which the king establisheth may be changed.

Persians which altereth <u>27_DAN_06_08</u> # Now, O king, establish the decree, and sign the writing, that it be not changed, according to the law of the Medes and Persians, which altereth not.

Persians which altereth <u>27_DAN_06_12</u> # Then they came near, and spake before the king concerning the king's decree; Hast thou not signed a decree, that every man that shall ask [a petition] of any God or man within thirty days, save of thee, O king, shall be cast into the den of lions? The king answered and said, The thing [is] true, according to the law of the Medes and Persians, which altereth not.

Persians <u>27_DAN_05_28</u> # PERES; Thy kingdom is divided, and given to the Medes and Persians.
