Philistines against Saul 13 1CH 12 19 # And there fell [some] of Manasseh to David, when he came with the Philistines against Saul to battle: but they helped them not: for the lords of the Philistines upon advisement sent him away, saying, He will fall to his master Saul to [the jeopardy of] our heads.

Philistines all the <u>09\_1SA\_07\_13</u> # So the Philistines were subdued, and they came no more into the coast of Israel: and the hand of the LORD was against the Philistines all the days of Samuel.

Philistines all the <u>09\_1SA\_14\_52</u># And there was sore war against the Philistines all the days of Saul: and when Saul saw any strong man, or any valiant man, he took him unto him.

Philistines also came <u>10\_2SA\_05\_18</u> # The Philistines also came and spread themselves in the valley of Rephaim.

Philistines also had <u>14\_2CH\_28\_18</u># The Philistines also had invaded the cities of the low country, and of the south of Judah, and had taken Bethshemesh, and Ajalon, and Gederoth, and Shocho with the villages thereof, and Timnah with the villages thereof, Gimzo also and the villages thereof: and they dwelt there.

Philistines although that <u>02\_EXO\_13\_17</u># And it came to pass, when Pharaoh had let the people go, that God led them not [through] the way of the land of the Philistines, although that [was] near; for God said, Lest peradventure the people repent when they see war, and they return to Egypt:

Philistines and against 14\_2CH\_26\_07 # And God helped him against the Philistines, and against the Arabians that dwelt in Gurbaal, and the Mehunims.

Philistines and all <u>06\_JOS\_13\_02</u> # This [is] the land that yet remaineth: all the borders of the Philistines, and all Geshuri,

Philistines and all <u>07\_JUD\_03\_03</u># [Namely], five lords of the Philistines, and all the Canaanites, and the Sidonians, and the Hivites that dwelt in mount Lebanon, from mount Baalhermon unto the entering in of Hamath.

Philistines and Ashkelon <u>24\_JER\_25\_20</u> # And all the mingled people, and all the kings of the land of Uz, and all the kings of the land of the Philistines, and Ashkelon, and Azzah, and Ekron, and the remnant of Ashdod,

Philistines and brake 14\_2CH\_26\_06# And he went forth and warred against the Philistines, and brake down the wall of Gath, and the wall of Jabneh, and the wall of Ashdod, and built cities about Ashdod, and among the Philistines.

Philistines and brought <u>09\_1SA\_23\_05</u># So David and his men went to Keilah, and fought with the Philistines, and brought away their cattle, and smote them with a great slaughter. So David saved the inhabitants of Keilah.

Philistines and burnt <u>07\_JUD\_15\_05</u># And when he had set the brands on fire, he let [them] go into the standing corn of the Philistines, and burnt up both the shocks, and also the standing corn, with the vineyards [and] olives.

Philistines and Caphthorim 13\_1CH\_01\_12 # And Pathrusim, and Casluhim, [of whom came the

Philistines,] and Caphthorim.

Philistines and David <u>10\_2SA\_21\_15</u> # Moreover the Philistines had yet war again with Israel; and David went down, and his servants with him, and fought against the Philistines: and David waxed faint.

Philistines and discomfited <u>09\_1SA\_07\_10</u># And as Samuel was offering up the burnt offering, the Philistines drew near to battle against Israel: but the LORD thundered with a great thunder on that day upon the Philistines, and discomfited them; and they were smitten before Israel.

Philistines and drew 13\_1CH\_11\_18# And the three brake through the host of the Philistines, and drew water out of the well of Bethlehem, that [was] by the gate, and took [it], and brought [it] to David: but David would not drink [of] it, but poured it out to the LORD,

Philistines and drew 10\_2SA\_23\_16 # And the three mighty men brake through the host of the Philistines, and drew water out of the well of Bethlehem, that [was] by the gate, and took [it], and brought [it] to David: nevertheless he would not drink thereof, but poured it out unto the LORD.

Philistines and Elhanan <u>13\_1CH\_20\_05</u> # And there was war again with the Philistines; and Elhanan the son of Jair slew Lahmi the brother of Goliath the Gittite, whose spear staff [was] like a weaver's beam.

Philistines and fell <u>13\_1CH\_10\_01</u> # Now the Philistines fought against Israel; and the men of Israel fled from before the Philistines, and fell down slain in mount Gilboa.

Philistines and fell <u>09\_1SA\_31\_01</u> # Now the Philistines fought against Israel: and the men of Israel fled from before the Philistines, and fell down slain in mount Gilboa.

Philistines and forsook <u>07\_JUD\_10\_06</u># And the children of Israel did evil again in the sight of the LORD, and served Baalim, and Ashtaroth, and the gods of Syria, and the gods of Zidon, and the gods of Moab, and the gods of the children of Ammon, and the gods of the Philistines, and forsook the LORD, and served not him.

Philistines and from <u>13\_1CH\_18\_11</u># Them also king David dedicated unto the LORD, with the silver and the gold that he brought from all [these] nations; from Edom, and from Moab, and from the children of Ammon, and from the Philistines, and from Amalek.

Philistines and from <u>02\_EXO\_23\_31</u> # And I will set thy bounds from the Red sea even unto the sea of the Philistines, and from the desert unto the river: for I will deliver the inhabitants of the land into your hand; and thou shalt drive them out before thee.

Philistines And he <u>07\_JUD\_16\_30</u> # And Samson said, Let me die with the Philistines. Philistines and of <u>14\_2CH\_21\_16</u> # Moreover the LORD stirred up against Jehoram the spirit of the Philistines, and of the Arabians, that [were] near the Ethiopians:

Philistines and out <u>09\_1SA\_30\_16</u># And when he had brought him down, behold, [they were] spread abroad upon all the earth, eating and drinking, and dancing, because of all the great spoil that they had taken out of the land of the Philistines, and out of the land of Judah.

Philistines and out <u>10\_2SA\_03\_18</u> # Now then do [it]: for the LORD hath spoken of David, saying, By the hand of my servant David I will save my people Israel out of the hand of the Philistines, and out of the hand of all their enemies.

Philistines and said <u>09\_1SA\_05\_11</u># So they sent and gathered together all the lords of the Philistines, and said, Send away the ark of the God of Israel, and let it go again to his own place, that it slay us not, and our people: for there was a deadly destruction throughout all the city; the hand of God was very heavy there.

Philistines And Samson <u>07\_JUD\_14\_03</u># Then his father and his mother said unto him, [Is there] never a woman among the daughters of thy brethren, or among all my people, that thou goest to take a wife of the uncircumcised Philistines? Philistines and Saul <u>09\_1SA\_27\_01</u># And David said in his heart, I shall now perish one day by the hand of Saul: [there is] nothing better for me than that I should speedily escape into the land of the Philistines; and Saul shall despair of me, to seek me any more in any coast of Israel: so shall I escape out of his hand.

Philistines and save <u>09\_1SA\_23\_02</u> # Therefore David inquired of the LORD, saying, Shall I go and smite these Philistines? And the LORD said unto David, Go, and smite the Philistines, and save Keilah.

Philistines and she <u>12\_2KI\_08\_03</u> # And it came to pass at the seven years' end, that the woman returned out of the land of the Philistines: and she went forth to cry unto the king for her house and for her land.

Philistines and slew <u>09\_1SA\_19\_08</u># And there was war again: and David went out, and fought with the Philistines, and slew them with a great slaughter; and they fled from him.

Philistines and smote <u>09\_1SA\_07\_11</u># And the men of Israel went out of Mizpeh, and pursued the Philistines, and smote them, until [they came] under Bethcar.

Philistines and spake <u>09\_1SA\_17\_23</u># And as he talked with them, behold, there came up the champion, the Philistine of Gath, Goliath by name, out of the armies of the Philistines, and spake according to the same words: and David heard [them].

Philistines and subdued 13\_1CH\_18\_01 # Now after this it came to pass, that David smote the Philistines, and subdued them, and took Gath and her towns out of the hand of the Philistines.

Philistines and subdued 10\_2SA\_08\_01 # And after this it came to pass, that David smote the Philistines, and subdued them: and David took Methegammah out of the hand of the Philistines.

Philistines and that <u>09\_1SA\_13\_04</u># And all Israel heard say [that] Saul had smitten a garrison of the Philistines, and [that] Israel also was had in abomination with the Philistines. And the people were called together after Saul to Gilgal.

Philistines and the <u>13\_1CH\_11\_14</u># And they set themselves in the midst of [that] parcel, and delivered it, and slew the Philistines; and the LORD saved [them] by a great deliverance.

Philistines And the <u>09\_1SA\_13\_04</u># And all Israel heard say [that] Saul had smitten a garrison of the Philistines, and [that] Israel also was had in abomination with the Philistines. And the people were called together after Saul to Gilgal.

Philistines and they <u>23\_ISA\_02\_06</u># Therefore thou hast forsaken thy people the house of Jacob, because they be replenished from the east, and [are] soothsayers like the Philistines, and they please themselves in the children of strangers.

Philistines and they <u>31\_OBA\_01\_19</u> # And [they of] the south shall possess the mount of Esau; and [they of] the plain the Philistines: and they shall possess the fields of Ephraim, and the fields of Samaria: and Benjamin [shall possess] Gilead.

Philistines and to 09\_1SA\_28\_19 # Moreover the LORD will also deliver Israel with thee into the hand of

the Philistines: and to morrow [shalt] thou and thy sons [be] with me: the LORD also shall deliver the host of Israel into the hand of the Philistines.

Philistines and to 14\_2CH\_09\_26 # And he reigned over all the kings from the river even unto the land of the Philistines, and to the border of Egypt.

Philistines and to 24\_JER\_47\_04 # Because of the day that cometh to spoil all the Philistines, [and] to cut off from Tyrus and Zidon every helper that remaineth: for the LORD will spoil the Philistines, the remnant of the country of Caphtor.

Philistines and unto 11\_1KI\_04\_21# And Solomon reigned over all kingdoms from the river unto the land of the Philistines, and unto the border of Egypt: they brought presents, and served Solomon all the days of his life.

Philistines and whithersoever <u>09\_1SA\_14\_47</u># So Saul took the kingdom over Israel, and fought against all his enemies on every side, against Moab, and against the children of Ammon, and against Edom, and against the kings of Zobah, and against the Philistines: and whithersoever he turned himself, he vexed [them].

Philistines and wilt 13 1CH 14 10 # And David inquired of God, saying, Shall I go up against the Philistines? and wilt thou deliver them into mine hand? And the LORD said unto him, Go up; for I will deliver them into thine hand.

Philistines are rulers <u>07\_JUD\_15\_11</u># Then three thousand men of Judah went to the top of the rock Etam, and said to Samson, Knowest thou not that the Philistines [are] rulers over us? what [is] this [that] thou hast done unto us? And he said unto them, As they did unto me, so have I done unto them.

Philistines at Gob <u>10\_2SA\_21\_18</u> # And it came to pass after this, that there was again a battle with the Philistines at Gob: then Sibbechai the Hushathite slew Saph, which [was] of the sons of the giant.

Philistines at which <u>13\_1CH\_20\_04</u># And it came to pass after this, that there arose war at Gezer with the Philistines; at which time Sibbechai the Hushathite slew Sippai, [that was] of the children of the giant: and they were subdued.

Philistines be they <u>30\_AMO\_06\_02</u> # Pass ye unto Calneh, and see; and from thence go ye to Hamath the great: then go down to Gath of the Philistines: [be they] better than these kingdoms? or their border greater than your border?

Philistines be upon <u>09\_1SA\_18\_17</u> # And Saul said to David, Behold my elder daughter Merab, her will I give thee to wife: only be thou valiant for me, and fight the LORD'S battles. For Saul said, Let not mine hand be upon him, but let the hand of the Philistines be upon him.

Philistines be upon <u>07\_JUD\_16\_09</u> # Now [there were] men lying in wait, abiding with her in the chamber. And she said unto him, The Philistines [be] upon thee, Samson. And he brake the withs, as a thread of tow is broken when it toucheth the fire. So his strength was not known.

Philistines be upon <u>07\_JUD\_16\_12</u># Delilah therefore took new ropes, and bound him therewith, and said unto him, The Philistines [be] upon thee, Samson. And [there were] liers in wait abiding in the chamber. And he brake them from off his arms like a thread.

Philistines be upon <u>07\_JUD\_16\_14</u># And she fastened [it] with the pin, and said unto him, The Philistines [be] upon thee, Samson. And he awaked out of his sleep, and went away with the pin of the beam, and with the web.

Philistines be upon 07\_JUD\_16\_20 # And she said, The Philistines [be] upon thee, Samson. And he awoke

out of his sleep, and said, I will go out as at other times before, and shake myself. And he wist not that the LORD was departed from him.

Philistines before that <u>09 1SA 14 21</u> # Moreover the Hebrews [that] were with the Philistines before that time, which went up with them into the camp [from the country] round about, even they also [turned] to be with the Israelites that [were] with Saul and Jonathan.

Philistines before that <u>24\_JER\_47\_01</u># The word of the LORD that came to Jeremiah the prophet against the Philistines, before that Pharaoh smote Gaza.

Philistines behind and <u>23 ISA 09 12 #</u> The Syrians before, and the Philistines behind; and they shall devour Israel with open mouth. For all this his anger is not turned away, but his hand [is] stretched out still.

Philistines belonging to <u>09\_1SA\_06\_18</u># And the golden mice, [according to] the number of all the cities of the Philistines [belonging] to the five lords, [both] of fenced cities, and of country villages, even unto the great [stone of] Abel, whereon they set down the ark of the LORD: [which stone remaineth] unto this day in the field of Joshua, the Bethshemite.

Philistines brought Jehoshaphat 14\_2CH\_17\_11# Also [some] of the Philistines brought Jehoshaphat presents, and tribute silver; and the Arabians brought him flocks, seven thousand and seven hundred rams, and seven thousand and seven hundred he goats.

Philistines brought up <u>07\_JUD\_16\_08</u> # Then the lords of the Philistines brought up to her seven green withs which had not been dried, and she bound him with them.

Philistines by night <u>09\_1SA\_14\_36</u># And Saul said, Let us go down after the Philistines by night, and spoil them until the morning light, and let us not leave a man of them. And they said, Do whatsoever seemeth good unto thee. Then said the priest, Let us draw near hither unto God.

Philistines called for <u>09\_1SA\_06\_02</u> # And the Philistines called for the priests and the diviners, saying, What shall we do to the ark of the LORD? tell us wherewith we shall send it to his place.

Philistines came and 13\_1CH\_10\_07 # And when all the men of Israel that [were] in the valley saw that they fled, and that Saul and his sons were dead, then they forsook their cities, and fled: and the Philistines came and dwelt in them.

Philistines came and <u>13\_1CH\_14\_09</u># And the Philistines came and spread themselves in the valley of Rephaim.

Philistines came and <u>09\_1SA\_31\_07</u> # And when the men of Israel that [were] on the other side of the valley, and [they] that [were] on the other side Jordan, saw that the men of Israel fled, and that Saul and his sons were dead, they forsook the cities, and fled; and the Philistines came and dwelt in them.

Philistines came to 13\_1CH\_10\_08 # And it came to pass on the morrow, when the Philistines came to strip the slain, that they found Saul and his sons fallen in mount Gilboa.

Philistines came to <u>09\_1SA\_31\_08</u># And it came to pass on the morrow, when the Philistines came to strip the slain, that they found Saul and his three sons fallen in mount Gilboa.

Philistines came up <u>10\_2SA\_05\_17</u># But when the Philistines heard that they had anointed David king over Israel, all the Philistines came up to seek David; and David heard [of it], and went down to the hold.

Philistines came up <u>10\_2SA\_05\_22</u> # And the Philistines came up yet again, and spread themselves in the valley of Rephaim.

Philistines came up <u>07\_JUD\_15\_06</u># Then the Philistines said, Who hath done this? And they answered, Samson, the son in law of the Timnite, because he had taken his wife, and given her to his companion. And the Philistines came up, and burnt her and her father with fire.

Philistines came up <u>07\_JUD\_16\_05</u># And the lords of the Philistines came up unto her, and said unto her, Entice him, and see wherein his great strength [lieth], and by what [means] we may prevail against him, that we may bind him to afflict him: and we will give thee every one of us eleven hundred [pieces] of silver.

Philistines came up <u>07\_JUD\_16\_18</u># And when Delilah saw that he had told her all his heart, she sent and called for the lords of the Philistines, saying, Come up this once, for he hath showed me all his heart. Then the lords of the Philistines came up unto her, and brought money in their hand.

Philistines drew near <u>09\_1SA\_07\_10</u># And as Samuel was offering up the burnt offering, the Philistines drew near to battle against Israel: but the LORD thundered with a great thunder on that day upon the Philistines, and discomfited them; and they were smitten before Israel.

Philistines encamped in <u>13\_1CH\_11\_15</u># Now three of the thirty captains went down to the rock to David, into the cave of Adullam; and the host of the Philistines encamped in the valley of Rephaim.

Philistines encamped in <u>09\_1SA\_13\_16</u> # And Saul, and Jonathan his son, and the people [that were] present with them, abode in Gibeah of Benjamin: but the Philistines encamped in Michmash.

Philistines envied him <u>01\_GEN\_26\_14</u># For he had possession of flocks, and possession of herds, and great store of servants: and the Philistines envied him.

Philistines even unto 12\_2KI\_18\_08 # He smote the Philistines, [even] unto Gaza, and the borders thereof, from the tower of the watchmen to the fenced city.

Philistines fell down <u>09\_1SA\_17\_52</u># And the men of Israel and of Judah arose, and shouted, and pursued the Philistines, until thou come to the valley, and to the gates of Ekron. And the wounded of the Philistines fell down by the way to Shaaraim, even unto Gath, and unto Ekron.

Philistines fight against <u>09\_1SA\_23\_01</u> # Then they told David, saying, Behold, the Philistines fight against Keilah, and they rob the threshingfloors.

Philistines fled even <u>09\_1SA\_14\_22</u> # Likewise all the men of Israel which had hid themselves in mount Ephraim, [when] they heard that the Philistines fled, even they also followed hard after them in the battle.

Philistines followed hard <u>13\_1CH\_10\_02</u> # And the Philistines followed hard after Saul, and after his sons; and the Philistines slew Jonathan, and Abinadab, and Malchishua, the sons of Saul.

Philistines followed hard <u>09\_1SA\_31\_02</u> # And the Philistines followed hard upon Saul and upon his sons; and the Philistines slew Jonathan, and Abinadab, and Melchishua, Saul's sons.

Philistines for at <u>07\_JUD\_14\_04</u> # But his father and his mother knew not that it [was] of the LORD, that he sought an occasion against the Philistines: for at that time the Philistines had dominion over Israel.

Philistines for I <u>09\_1SA\_09\_16</u> # To morrow about this time I will send thee a man out of the land of Benjamin, and thou shalt anoint him [to be] captain over my people Israel, that he may save my people out of the hand of the Philistines: for I have looked upon my people, because their cry is come unto me.

Philistines for my <u>07\_JUD\_16\_28</u> # And Samson called unto the LORD, and said, O Lord GOD, remember me, I pray thee, and strengthen me, I pray thee, only this once, O God, that I may be at once avenged of the Philistines for my two eyes.

Philistines for Nadab <u>11\_1KI\_15\_27</u># And Baasha the son of Ahijah, of the house of Issachar, conspired against him; and Baasha smote him at Gibbethon, which [belonged] to the Philistines; for Nadab and all Israel laid siege to Gibbethon.

Philistines for one <u>09 1SA 06 04</u> # Then said they, What [shall be] the trespass offering which we shall return to him? They answered, Five golden emerods, and five golden mice, [according to] the number of the lords of the Philistines: for one plague [was] on you all, and on your lords.

Philistines forty years <u>07\_JUD\_13\_01</u># And the children of Israel did evil again in the sight of the LORD; and the LORD delivered them into the hand of the Philistines forty years.

Philistines fought against 13\_1CH\_10\_01 # Now the Philistines fought against Israel; and the men of Israel fled from before the Philistines, and fell down slain in mount Gilboa.

Philistines fought against <u>09\_1SA\_31\_01</u> # Now the Philistines fought against Israel: and the men of Israel fled from before the Philistines, and fell down slain in mount Gilboa.

Philistines fought and <u>09\_1SA\_04\_10</u># And the Philistines fought, and Israel was smitten, and they fled every man into his tent: and there was a very great slaughter; for there fell of Israel thirty thousand footmen.

Philistines from Caphtor <u>30\_AMO\_09\_07</u> # [Are] ye not as children of the Ethiopians unto me, O children of Israel? saith the LORD. Have not I brought up Israel out of the land of Egypt? and the Philistines from Caphtor, and the Syrians from Kir?

Philistines from Geba 10\_2SA\_05\_25 # And David did so, as the LORD had commanded him; and smote the Philistines from Geba until thou come to Gazer.

Philistines from Gibeon 13\_1CH\_14\_16 # David therefore did as God commanded him: and they smote the host of the Philistines from Gibeon even to Gazer.

Philistines garrison that <u>09\_1SA\_14\_01</u> # Now it came to pass upon a day, that Jonathan the son of Saul said unto the young man that bare his armour, Come, and let us go over to the Philistines' garrison, that [is] on the other side. But he told not his father.

Philistines garrison there <u>09\_1SA\_14\_04</u># And between the passages, by which Jonathan sought to go over unto the Philistines' garrison, [there was] a sharp rock on the one side, and a sharp rock on the other side: and the name of the one [was] Bozez, and the name of the other Seneh.

Philistines garrison was 13\_1CH\_11\_16# And David [was] then in the hold, and the Philistines' garrison [was] then at Bethlehem.

Philistines gathered their <u>09\_1SA\_28\_01</u># And it came to pass in those days, that the Philistines gathered their armies together for warfare, to fight with Israel. And Achish said unto David, Know thou assuredly, that thou shalt go out with me to battle, thou and thy men.

Philistines gathered them <u>07\_JUD\_16\_23</u># Then the lords of the Philistines gathered them together for to offer a great sacrifice unto Dagon their god, and to rejoice: for they said, Our god hath delivered Samson our enemy into our hand.

Philistines gathered themselves <u>09\_1SA\_13\_05</u> # And the Philistines gathered themselves together to fight with Israel, thirty thousand chariots, and six thousand horsemen, and people as the sand which [is] on the sea shore in multitude: and they came up, and pitched in Michmash, eastward from Bethaven.

Philistines had dominion <u>07\_JUD\_14\_04</u># But his father and his mother knew not that it [was] of the LORD, that he sought an occasion against the Philistines: for at that time the Philistines had dominion over Israel.

Philistines had done 13\_1CH\_10\_11# And when all Jabeshgilead heard all that the Philistines had done to Saul,

Philistines had done <u>09\_1SA\_31\_11</u># And when the inhabitants of Jabeshgilead heard of that which the Philistines had done to Saul;

Philistines had hanged <u>10\_2SA\_21\_12</u># And David went and took the bones of Saul and the bones of Jonathan his son from the men of Jabeshgilead, which had stolen them from the street of Bethshan, where the Philistines had hanged them, when the Philistines had slain Saul in Gilboa:

Philistines had put <u>09\_1SA\_17\_21</u> # For Israel and the Philistines had put the battle in array, army against army.

Philistines had seen <u>09\_1SA\_06\_16</u># And when the five lords of the Philistines had seen [it], they returned to Ekron the same day.

Philistines had slain 10\_2SA\_21\_12 # And David went and took the bones of Saul and the bones of Jonathan his son from the men of Jabeshgilead, which had stolen them from the street of Bethshan, where the Philistines had hanged them, when the Philistines had slain Saul in Gilboa:

Philistines had stopped <u>01\_GEN\_26\_15</u># For all the wells which his father's servants had digged in the days of Abraham his father, the Philistines had stopped them, and filled them with earth.

Philistines had stopped <u>01\_GEN\_26\_18</u># And Isaac digged again the wells of water, which they had digged in the days of Abraham his father; for the Philistines had stopped them after the death of Abraham: and he called their names after the names by which his father had called them.

Philistines had taken <u>09\_1SA\_07\_14</u> # And the cities which the Philistines had taken from Israel were restored to Israel, from Ekron even unto Gath; and the coasts thereof did Israel deliver out of the hands of the Philistines. And there was peace between Israel and the Amorites.

Philistines he was <u>09\_1SA\_28\_05</u> # And when Saul saw the host of the Philistines, he was afraid, and his heart greatly trembled.

Philistines heard of <u>09\_1SA\_13\_03</u># And Jonathan smote the garrison of the Philistines that [was] in Geba, and the Philistines heard [of it]. And Saul blew the trumpet throughout all the land, saying, Let the Hebrews hear.

Philistines heard that 13\_1CH\_14\_08 # And when the Philistines heard that David was anointed king over all Israel, all the Philistines went up to seek David. And David heard [of it], and went out against them.

Philistines heard that <u>09\_1SA\_07\_07</u> # And when the Philistines heard that the children of Israel were gathered together to Mizpeh, the lords of the Philistines went up against Israel. And when the children of Israel heard [it], they were afraid of the Philistines.

Philistines heard that <u>10\_2SA\_05\_17</u># But when the Philistines heard that they had anointed David king over Israel, all the Philistines came up to seek David; and David heard [of it], and went down to the hold.

Philistines heard the <u>09\_1SA\_04\_06</u># And when the Philistines heard the noise of the shout, they said, What [meaneth] the noise of this great shout in the camp of the Hebrews? And they understood that the ark of the LORD was come into the camp.

Philistines I will <u>36\_ZEP\_02\_05</u># Woe unto the inhabitants of the sea coast, the nation of the Cherethites! the word of the LORD [is] against you; O Canaan, the land of the Philistines, I will even destroy thee, that there shall be no inhabitant.

Philistines in three <u>09\_1SA\_13\_17</u> # And the spoilers came out of the camp of the Philistines in three companies: one company turned unto the way [that leadeth to] Ophrah, unto the land of Shual:

Philistines into thine <u>09\_1SA\_23\_04</u># Then David inquired of the LORD yet again. And the LORD answered him and said, Arise, go down to Keilah: for I will deliver the Philistines into thine hand.

Philistines into thine <u>10\_2SA\_05\_19</u> # And David inquired of the LORD, saying, Shall I go up to the Philistines? wilt thou deliver them into mine hand? And the LORD said unto David, Go up: for I will doubtless deliver the Philistines into thine hand.

Philistines Is not <u>09\_1SA\_29\_03</u> # Then said the princes of the Philistines, What [do] these Hebrews [here]? Philistines land many 01\_GEN\_21\_34 # And Abraham sojourned in the Philistines' land many days.

Philistines Let us <u>09\_1SA\_04\_03</u> # And when the people were come into the camp, the elders of Israel said, Wherefore hath the LORD smitten us to day before the Philistines? Let us fetch the ark of the covenant of the LORD out of Shiloh unto us, that, when it cometh among us, it may save us out of the hand of our

enemies.

Philistines looked out <u>01\_GEN\_26\_08</u># And it came to pass, when he had been there a long time, that Abimelech king of the Philistines looked out at a window, and saw, and, behold, Isaac [was] sporting with Rebekah his wife.

Philistines make war <u>09\_1SA\_28\_15</u> # And Samuel said to Saul, Why hast thou disquieted me, to bring me up? And Saul answered, I am sore distressed; for the Philistines make war against me, and God is departed from me, and answereth me no more, neither by prophets, nor by dreams: therefore I have called thee, that thou mayest make known unto me what I shall do.

Philistines may be <u>09\_1SA\_18\_21</u># And Saul said, I will give him her, that she may be a snare to him, and that the hand of the Philistines may be against him. Wherefore Saul said to David, Thou shalt this day be my son in law in [the one of] the twain.

Philistines returned for <u>09\_1SA\_06\_17</u> # And these [are] the golden emerods which the Philistines returned [for] a trespass offering unto the LORD; for Ashdod one, for Gaza one, for Askelon one, for Gath one, for Ekron one;

Philistines round about 13\_1CH\_10\_09 # And when they had stripped him, they took his head, and his armour, and sent into the land of the Philistines round about, to carry tidings unto their idols, and to the people.

Philistines round about <u>09\_1SA\_31\_09</u># And they cut off his head, and stripped off his armour, and sent into the land of the Philistines round about, to publish [it in] the house of their idols, and among the people.

Philistines seven years 12 2KI 08 02 # And the woman arose, and did after the saying of the man of God: and she went with her household, and sojourned in the land of the Philistines seven years.

Philistines shall perish <u>30\_AMO\_01\_08</u> # And I will cut off the inhabitant from Ashdod, and him that holdeth the sceptre from Ashkelon, and I will turn mine hand against Ekron: and the remnant of the Philistines shall perish, saith the Lord GOD.

Philistines shouted against <u>07\_JUD\_15\_14</u> # [And] when he came unto Lehi, the Philistines shouted against him: and the spirit of the LORD came mightily upon him, and the cords that [were] upon his arms became as flax that was burnt with fire, and his bands loosed from off his hands.

Philistines six hundred <u>07\_JUD\_03\_31</u># And after him was Shamgar the son of Anath, which slew of the Philistines six hundred men with an ox goad: and he also delivered Israel.

Philistines slew Jonathan 13\_1CH\_10\_02 # And the Philistines followed hard after Saul, and after his sons; and the Philistines slew Jonathan, and Abinadab, and Malchishua, the sons of Saul.

Philistines slew Jonathan <u>09\_1SA\_31\_02</u> # And the Philistines followed hard upon Saul and upon his sons; and the Philistines slew Jonathan, and Abinadab, and Melchishua, Saul's sons.

Philistines stood on <u>09\_1SA\_17\_03</u># And the Philistines stood on a mountain on the one side, and Israel stood on a mountain on the other side: and [there was] a valley between them.

Philistines that day <u>09\_1SA\_14\_31</u># And they smote the Philistines that day from Michmash to Aijalon: and the people were very faint.

Philistines that it <u>09\_1SA\_24\_01</u># And it came to pass, when Saul was returned from following the Philistines, that it was told him, saying, Behold, David [is] in the wilderness of Engedi.

Philistines that was <u>09\_1SA\_13\_03</u># And Jonathan smote the garrison of the Philistines that [was] in Geba, and the Philistines heard [of it]. And Saul blew the trumpet throughout all the land, saying, Let the Hebrews hear.

Philistines that were 10\_2SA\_23\_09 # And after him [was] Eleazar the son of Dodo the Ahohite, [one] of the

three mighty men with David, when they defied the Philistines [that] were there gathered together to battle, and the men of Israel were gone away:

Philistines that ye <u>09\_1SA\_04\_09</u># Be strong, and quit yourselves like men, O ye Philistines, that ye be not servants unto the Hebrews, as they have been to you: quit yourselves like men, and fight.

Philistines the Gazathites <u>06\_JOS\_13\_03</u># From Sihor, which [is] before Egypt, even unto the borders of Ekron northward, [which] is counted to the Canaanite: five lords of the Philistines; the Gazathites, and the Ashdothites, the Eshkalonites, the Gittites, and the Ekronites; also the Avites:

Philistines the remnant 24\_JER\_47\_04 # Because of the day that cometh to spoil all the Philistines, [and] to cut off from Tyrus and Zidon every helper that remaineth: for the LORD will spoil the Philistines, the remnant of the country of Caphtor.

Philistines therefore they <u>09\_1SA\_23\_28</u> # Wherefore Saul returned from pursuing after David, and went against the Philistines: therefore they called that place Selahammahlekoth.

Philistines went up <u>09\_1SA\_07\_07</u># And when the Philistines heard that the children of Israel were gathered together to Mizpeh, the lords of the Philistines went up against Israel. And when the children of Israel heard [it], they were afraid of the Philistines.

Philistines went up <u>09\_1SA\_29\_11</u># So David and his men rose up early to depart in the morning, to return into the land of the Philistines. And the Philistines went up to Jezreel.

Philistines went up <u>07\_JUD\_15\_09</u># Then the Philistines went up, and pitched in Judah, and spread themselves in Lehi.

Philistines were afraid <u>09\_1SA\_04\_07</u> # And the Philistines were afraid, for they said, God is come into the camp. And they said, Woe unto us! for there hath not been such a thing heretofore.

Philistines were gathered <u>13\_1CH\_11\_13</u># He was with David at Pasdammim, and there the Philistines were gathered together to battle, where was a parcel of ground full of barley; and the people fled from before the Philistines.

Philistines were gathered <u>10 2SA 23 11</u> # And after him [was] Shammah the son of Agee the Hararite. And the Philistines were gathered together into a troop, where was a piece of ground full of lentiles: and the people fled from the Philistines.

Philistines were subdued <u>09\_1SA\_07\_13</u> # So the Philistines were subdued, and they came no more into the coast of Israel: and the hand of the LORD was against the Philistines all the days of Samuel.

Philistines were there <u>07\_JUD\_16\_27</u> # Now the house was full of men and women; and all the lords of the Philistines [were] there; and [there were] upon the roof about three thousand men and women, that beheld while Samson made sport.

Philistines were wroth <u>09 1SA 29 04 # And the princes of the Philistines were wroth with him; and the princes of the Philistines said unto him, Make this fellow return, that he may go again to his place which thou hast appointed him, and let him not go down with us to battle, lest in the battle he be an adversary to us: for wherewith should he reconcile himself unto his master? [should it] not [be] with the heads of these men?</u>

Philistines What do <u>09\_1SA\_29\_03</u># Then said the princes of the Philistines, What [do] these Hebrews [here]? Philistines where Elhanan 10 2SA 21 19 # And there was again a battle in Gob with the Philistines, where Elhanan the son of Jaareoregim, a Bethlehemite, slew [the brother of] Goliath the Gittite, the staff of whose spear [was] like a weaver's beam.

Philistines which are <u>26\_EZE\_16\_27</u> # Behold, therefore I have stretched out my hand over thee, and have diminished thine ordinary [food], and delivered thee unto the will of them that hate thee, the daughters of the Philistines, which are ashamed of thy lewd way.

Philistines <u>11\_1KI\_16\_15</u># In the twenty and seventh year of Asa king of Judah did Zimri reign seven days in Tirzah. And the people [were] encamped against Gibbethon, which [belonged] to the Philistines.

Philistines <u>09\_1SA\_07\_03</u> # And Samuel spake unto all the house of Israel, saying, If ye do return unto the LORD with all your hearts, [then] put away the strange gods and Ashtaroth from among you, and prepare your hearts unto the LORD, and serve him only: and he will deliver you out of the hand of the Philistines.

Philistines <u>09\_1SA\_07\_07</u> # And when the Philistines heard that the children of Israel were gathered together to Mizpeh, the lords of the Philistines went up against Israel. And when the children of Israel heard [it], they were afraid of the Philistines.

Philistines <u>09\_1SA\_07\_08</u> # And the children of Israel said to Samuel, Cease not to cry unto the LORD our God for us, that he will save us out of the hand of the Philistines.

Philistines <u>09\_1SA\_14\_30</u> # How much more, if haply the people had eaten freely to day of the spoil of their enemies which they found? for had there not been now a much greater slaughter among the Philistines?

Philistines <u>09\_1SA\_17\_02</u> # And Saul and the men of Israel were gathered together, and pitched by the valley of Elah, and set the battle in array against the Philistines.

Philistines <u>09\_1SA\_17\_19</u> # Now Saul, and they, and all the men of Israel, [were] in the valley of Elah, fighting with the Philistines.

Philistines <u>09\_1SA\_18\_25</u> # And Saul said, Thus shall ye say to David, The king desireth not any dowry, but an hundred foreskins of the Philistines, to be avenged of the king's enemies. But Saul thought to make David fall by the hand of the Philistines.

Philistines <u>09\_1SA\_23\_03</u> # And David's men said unto him, Behold, we be afraid here in Judah: how much more then if we come to Keilah against the armies of the Philistines?

Philistines <u>09\_1SA\_27\_11</u> # And David saved neither man nor woman alive, to bring [tidings] to Gath, saying, Lest they should tell on us, saying, So did David, and so [will be] his manner all the while he dwelleth in the country of the Philistines.

Philistines <u>09\_1SA\_28\_19</u> # Moreover the LORD will also deliver Israel with thee into the hand of the Philistines: and to morrow [shalt] thou and thy sons [be] with me: the LORD also shall deliver the host of Israel into the hand of the Philistines.

Philistines <u>09\_1SA\_29\_07</u># Wherefore now return, and go in peace, that thou displease not the lords of the Philistines.

Philistines <u>14\_2CH\_26\_06</u># And he went forth and warred against the Philistines, and brake down the wall of Gath, and the wall of Jabneh, and the wall of Ashdod, and built cities about Ashdod, and among the Philistines.

Philistines <u>10\_2SA\_03\_14</u> # And David sent messengers to Ishbosheth Saul's son, saying, Deliver [me] my wife Michal, which I espoused to me for an hundred foreskins of the Philistines.

Philistines <u>10\_2SA\_05\_24</u> # And let it be, when thou hearest the sound of a going in the tops of the mulberry trees, that then thou shalt bestir thyself: for then shall the LORD go out before thee, to smite the host of the Philistines.

Philistines <u>10\_2SA\_08\_01</u># And after this it came to pass, that David smote the Philistines, and subdued them: and David took Methegammah out of the hand of the Philistines.

Philistines <u>10\_2SA\_23\_11</u># And after him [was] Shammah the son of Agee the Hararite. And the Philistines were gathered together into a troop, where was a piece of ground full of lentiles: and the people fled from the Philistines.

Philistines <u>01\_GEN\_21\_32</u> # Thus they made a covenant at Beersheba: then Abimelech rose up, and Phichol the chief captain of his host, and they returned into the land of the Philistines.

Philistines <u>07\_JUD\_10\_11</u># And the LORD said unto the children of Israel, [Did] not [I deliver you] from the Egyptians, and from the Amorites, from the children of Ammon, and from the Philistines?

Philistines <u>07\_JUD\_13\_05</u> # For, lo, thou shalt conceive, and bear a son; and no razor shall come on his head: for the child shall be a Nazarite unto God from the womb: and he shall begin to deliver Israel out of the hand of the Philistines.

Philistines <u>07\_JUD\_14\_01</u> # And Samson went down to Timnath, and saw a woman in Timnath of the daughters of the Philistines.

Philistines 38\_ZEC\_09\_06 # And a bastard shall dwell in Ashdod, and I will cut off the pride of the Philistines.
