Psalm of David <u>19_PSA_28_01</u> # [A Psalm] of David. Unto thee will I cry, O LORD my rock; be not silent to me: lest, [if] thou be silent to me, I become like them that go down into the pit.

Psalm of David <u>19_PSA_29_01</u> # A Psalm of David. Give unto the LORD, O ye mighty, give unto the LORD glory and strength.

Psalm of David <u>19_PSA_31_01</u># To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. In thee, O LORD, do I put my trust; let me never be ashamed: deliver me in thy righteousness.

Psalm of David <u>19_PSA_32_01</u> # [A Psalm] of David, Maschil. Blessed [is he whose] transgression [is] forgiven, [whose] sin [is] covered.

Psalm of David <u>19_PSA_34_01</u># [A Psalm] of David, when he changed his behaviour before Abimelech; who drove him away, and he departed. I will bless the LORD at all times: his praise [shall] continually [be] in my mouth.

Psalm of David <u>19_PSA_35_01</u> # [A Psalm] of David. Plead [my cause], O LORD, with them that strive with me: fight against them that fight against me.

Psalm of David <u>19_PSA_36_01</u># To the chief Musician, [A Psalm] of David the servant of the LORD. The transgression of the wicked saith within my heart, [that there is] no fear of God before his eyes.

Psalm of David <u>19_PSA_37_01</u># [A Psalm] of David. Fret not thyself because of evildoers, neither be thou envious against the workers of iniquity.

Psalm of David <u>19_PSA_38_01</u> # A Psalm of David, to bring to remembrance. O LORD, rebuke me not in thy wrath: neither chasten me in thy hot displeasure.

Psalm of David <u>19_PSA_39_01</u> # To the chief Musician, [even] to Jeduthun, A Psalm of David. I said, I will take heed to my ways, that I sin not with my tongue: I will keep my mouth with a bridle, while the wicked is before me.

Psalm of David <u>19_PSA_40_01</u> # To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. I waited patiently for the LORD; and he inclined unto me, and heard my cry.

Psalm of David <u>19_PSA_41_01</u> # To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. Blessed [is] he that considereth the poor: the LORD will deliver him in time of trouble.

Psalm of David <u>19_PSA_51_01</u># To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David, when Nathan the prophet came unto him, after he had gone in to Bathsheba. Have mercy upon me, O God, according to thy lovingkindness: according unto the multitude of thy tender mercies blot outmy transgressions.

Psalm of David <u>19_PSA_52_01</u> # To the chief Musician, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David, when Doeg the Edomite came and told Saul, and said unto him, David is come to the house of Ahimelech. Why boastest thou thyself in mischief, O mighty man? the goodness of God [endureth] continually.

Psalm of David <u>19_PSA_53_01</u> # To the chief Musician upon Mahalath, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David. The fool hath said in his heart, [There is] no God. Corrupt are they, and have done abominable iniquity: [there is] none that doeth good.

Psalm of David <u>19_PSA_54_01</u> # To the chief Musician on Neginoth, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David, when the Ziphims came and said to Saul, Doth not David hide himself with us? Save me, O God, by thy name, and judge me by thy strength.

Psalm of David <u>19_PSA_55_01</u> # To the chief Musician on Neginoth, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David. Give ear to my prayer, O God; and hide not thyself from my supplication.

Psalm of David <u>19_PSA_61_01</u># To the chief Musician upon Neginah, [A Psalm] of David. Hear my cry, O God; attend unto my prayer.

Psalm of David <u>19_PSA_62_01</u># To the chief Musician, to Jeduthun, A Psalm of David. Truly my soul waiteth upon God: from him [cometh] my salvation.

Psalm of David <u>19_PSA_64_01</u> # To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. Hear my voice, O God, in my prayer: preserve my life from fear of the enemy.

Psalm of David <u>19_PSA_69_01</u># To the chief Musician upon Shoshannim, [A Psalm] of David. Save me, O God; for the waters are come in unto [my] soul.

Psalm of David <u>19_PSA_70_01</u> # To the chief Musician, [A Psalm] of David, to bring to remembrance. [Make haste], O God, to deliver me; make haste to help me, O LORD.

Psalm of praise <u>19_PSA_100_01</u> # A Psalm of praise. Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all ye lands.

Psalm of praise <u>19_PSA_145_01</u># David's [Psalm] of praise. I will extol thee, my God, O king; and I will bless thy name for ever and ever.

Psalm or Song <u>19_PSA_67_01</u> # To the chief Musician on Neginoth, A Psalm [or] Song. God be merciful unto us, and bless us; [and] cause his face to shine upon us; Selah.

Psalm or Song <u>19_PSA_68_01</u># To the chief Musician, A Psalm [or] Song of David. Let God arise, let his enemies be scattered: let them also that hate him flee before him.

Psalm or Song <u>19_PSA_75_01</u> # To the chief Musician, Altaschith, A Psalm [or] Song of Asaph. Unto thee, O God, do we give thanks, [unto thee] do we give thanks: for [that] thy name is near thy wondrous works declare.

Psalm or Song <u>19_PSA_76_01</u> # To the chief Musician on Neginoth, A Psalm [or] Song of Asaph. In Judah [is] God known: his name [is] great in Israel.

Psalm or Song <u>19_PSA_92_01</u> # A Psalm [or] Song for the sabbath day. [It is a] good [thing] to give thanks unto the LORD, and to sing praises unto thy name, O most High:

psalmist of Israel <u>10_2SA_23_01</u> # Now these [be] the last words of David. David the son of Jesse said, and the man [who was] raised up on high, the anointed of the God of Jacob, and the sweet psalmist of Israel, said,

psalms and hymns <u>51_COL_03_16</u># Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.
