copulation go out <u>03\_LEV\_15\_16</u># And if any man's seed of copulation go out from him, then he shall wash all his flesh in water, and be unclean until the even.

copulation shall be <u>03\_LEV\_15\_17</u># And every garment, and every skin, whereon is the seed of copulation, shall be washed with water, and be unclean until the even.

copulation they shall <u>03\_LEV\_15\_18</u># The woman also with whom man shall lie [with] seed of copulation, they shall [both] bathe [themselves] in water, and be unclean until the even.

populous No that <u>34\_NAH\_03\_08</u> # Art thou better than populous No, that was situate among the rivers, [that had] the waters round about it, whose rampart [was] the sea, [and] her wall [was] from the sea?

populous <u>05\_DEU\_26\_05</u># And thou shalt speak and say before the LORD thy God, A Syrian ready to perish [was] my father, and he went down into Egypt, and sojourned there with a few, and became there a nation, great, mighty, and populous:

Pul a thousand 12 2KI 15 19 # [And] Pul the king of Assyria came against the land: and Menahem gave Pul a thousand talents of silver, that his hand might be with him to confirm the kingdom in his hand.

Pul and Lud <u>23\_ISA\_66\_19</u> # And I will set a sign among them, and I will send those that escape of them unto the nations, [to] Tarshish, Pul, and Lud, that draw the bow, [to] Tubal, and Javan, [to] the isles afar off, that have not heard my fame, neither have seen my glory; and they shall declare my glory among the Gentiles.

Pul king of 13 1CH 05 26 # And the God of Israel stirred up the spirit of Pul king of Assyria, and the spirit of Tilgathpilneser king of Assyria, and he carried them away, even the Reubenites, and the Gadites, and the half tribe of Manasseh, and brought them unto Halah, and Habor, and Hara, and to the river Gozan, unto this day.

Pul the king 12\_2KI\_15\_19 # [And] Pul the king of Assyria came against the land: and Menahem gave Pul a thousand talents of silver, that his hand might be with him to confirm the kingdom in his hand.

pull down and <u>24\_JER\_01\_10</u># See, I have this day set thee over the nations and over the kingdoms, to root out, and to pull down, and to destroy, and to throw down, to build, and to plant.

pull down and <u>24\_JER\_18\_07</u> # [At what] instant I shall speak concerning a nation, and concerning a kingdom, to pluck up, and to pull down, and to destroy [it];

pull down my 42\_LUK\_12\_18 # And he said, This will I do: I will pull down my barns, and build greater; and there will I bestow all my fruits and my goods.

pull him out <u>42\_LUK\_14\_05</u># And answered them, saying, Which of you shall have an ass or an ox fallen into a pit, and will not straightway pull him out on the sabbath day?

pull it in <u>11\_1KI\_13\_04</u># And it came to pass, when king Jeroboam heard the saying of the man of God, which had cried against the altar in Bethel, that he put forth his hand from the altar, saying, Lay hold on him. And his hand, which he put forth against him, dried up, so that he could not pull it in again to him.

Pull me out 19\_PSA\_31\_04 # Pull me out of the net that they have laid privily for me: for thou [art] my strength.

pull off the <u>33\_MIC\_02\_08</u># Even of late my people is risen up as an enemy: ye pull off the robe with the garment from them that pass by securely as men averse from war.

pull out the <u>42\_LUK\_06\_42</u># Either how canst thou say to thy brother, Brother, let me pull out the mote that is in thine eye, when thou thyself beholdest not the beam that is in thine own eye? Thou hypocrite, cast out first the beam out of thine own eye, and then shalt thou see clearly to pull out the mote that is in thy brother's eye.

pull out the <u>42\_LUK\_06\_42</u># Either how canst thou say to thy brother, Brother, let me pull out the mote that is in thine eye, when thou thyself beholdest not the beam that is in thine own eye? Thou hypocrite, cast out first the beam out of thine own eye, and then shalt thou see clearly to pull out the mote that is in thy brother's eye.

pull out the <u>40\_MAT\_07\_04</u># Or how wilt thou say to thy brother, Let me pull out the mote out of thine eye; and, behold, a beam [is] in thine own eye?

pull thee down 23 ISA 22 19 # And I will drive thee from thy station, and from thy state shall he pull thee down.

pull them down 24\_JER\_24\_06 # For I will set mine eyes upon them for good, and I will bring them again to this land: and I will build them, and not pull [them] down; and I will plant them, and not pluck [them] up.

pull them out <u>24\_JER\_12\_03</u> # But thou, O LORD, knowest me: thou hast seen me, and tried mine heart toward thee: pull them out like sheep for the slaughter, and prepare them for the day of slaughter.

pull up the <u>26\_EZE\_17\_09</u># Say thou, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Shall it prosper? shall he not pull up the roots thereof, and cut off the fruit thereof, that it wither? it shall wither in all the leaves of her spring, even without great power or many people to pluck it up by the roots thereof.

pull you down 24\_JER\_42\_10 # If ye will still abide in this land, then will I build you, and not pull [you] down, and I will plant you, and not pluck [you] up: for I repent me of the evil that I have done unto you.

pulled away the <u>38\_ZEC\_07\_11</u># But they refused to hearken, and pulled away the shoulder, and stopped their ears, that they should not hear.

pulled down from <u>15\_EZR\_06\_11</u># Also I have made a decree, that whosoever shall alter this word, let timber be pulled down from his house, and being set up, let him be hanged thereon; and let his house be made a dunghill for this.

pulled her in <u>01\_GEN\_08\_09</u># But the dove found no rest for the sole of her foot, and she returned unto him into the ark, for the waters [were] on the face of the whole earth: then he put forth his hand, and took her, and pulled her in unto him into the ark.

pulled in pieces 44\_ACT\_23\_10 # And when there arose a great dissension, the chief captain, fearing lest Paul should have been pulled in pieces of them, commanded the soldiers to go down, and to take him by force from among them, and to bring [him] into the castle.

pulled Lot into <u>01\_GEN\_19\_10</u># But the men put forth their hand, and pulled Lot into the house to them, and shut to the door.

pulled me in 25\_LAM\_03\_11 # He hath turned aside my ways, and pulled me in pieces: he hath made me

desolate.

pulled up out 30\_AMO\_09\_15 # And I will plant them upon their land, and they shall no more be pulled up out of their land which I have given them, saith the LORD thy God.

pulling down of <u>47\_2CO\_10\_04</u> # [For the weapons of our warfare [are] not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;]

pulling them out 65\_JDE\_01\_23 # And others save with fear, pulling [them] out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh.

pulpit of wood <u>16\_NEH\_08\_04</u># And Ezra the scribe stood upon a pulpit of wood, which they had made for the purpose; and beside him stood Mattithiah, and Shema, and Anaiah, and Urijah, and Hilkiah, and Maaseiah, on his right hand; and on his left hand, Pedaiah, and Mishael, and Malchiah, and Hashum, and Hashbadana, Zechariah, [and] Meshullam.

pulse to eat <u>27\_DAN\_01\_12</u> # Prove thy servants, I beseech thee, ten days; and let them give us pulse to eat, and water to drink.

pulse <u>10\_2SA\_17\_28</u> # Brought beds, and basins, and earthen vessels, and wheat, and barley, and flour, and parched [corn], and beans, and lentiles, and parched [pulse],

pulse <u>27\_DAN\_01\_16</u> # Thus Melzar took away the portion of their meat, and the wine that they should drink; and gave them pulse.

sepulchre and departed <u>40\_MAT\_27\_60</u># And laid it in his own new tomb, which he had hewn out in the rock: and he rolled a great stone to the door of the sepulchre, and departed.

sepulchre and found <u>42\_LUK\_24\_24</u> # And certain of them which were with us went to the sepulchre, and found [it] even so as the women had said: but him they saw not.

sepulchre and he <u>43\_JOH\_20\_08</u> # Then went in also that other disciple, which came first to the sepulchre, and he saw, and believed.

sepulchre and how <u>42\_LUK\_23\_55</u># And the women also, which came with him from Galilee, followed after, and beheld the sepulchre, and how his body was laid.

sepulchre and seeth <u>43\_JOH\_20\_01</u> # The first [day] of the week cometh Mary Magdalene early, when it was yet dark, unto the sepulchre, and seeth the stone taken away from the sepulchre.

sepulchre and seeth <u>43\_JOH\_20\_06</u> # Then cometh Simon Peter following him, and went into the sepulchre, and seeth the linen clothes lie,

sepulchre and stooping <u>42\_LUK\_24\_12</u> # Then arose Peter, and ran unto the sepulchre; and stooping down, he beheld the linen clothes laid by themselves, and departed, wondering in himself at that which was come to pass.

sepulchre And the <u>12\_2KI\_23\_30</u># And his servants carried him in a chariot dead from Megiddo, and brought him to Jerusalem, and buried him in his own sepulchre. And the people of the land took Jehoahaz the son of Josiah, and anointed him, and made him king in his father's stead.

sepulchre and told <u>42\_LUK\_24\_09</u># And returned from the sepulchre, and told all these things unto the eleven, and to all the rest.

sepulchre and we 43\_JOH\_20\_02 # Then she runneth, and cometh to Simon Peter, and to the other disciple,

whom Jesus loved, and saith unto them, They have taken away the Lord out of the sepulchre, and we know not where they have laid him.

sepulchre at the <u>41\_MAR\_16\_02</u> # And very early in the morning the first [day] of the week, they came unto the sepulchre at the rising of the sun.

sepulchre be made <u>40\_MAT\_27\_64</u># Command therefore that the sepulchre be made sure until the third day, lest his disciples come by night, and steal him away, and say unto the people, He is risen from the dead: so the last error shall be worse than the first.

sepulchre bringing the <u>42\_LUK\_24\_01</u> # Now upon the first [day] of the week, very early in the morning, they came unto the sepulchre, bringing the spices which they had prepared, and certain [others] with them.

sepulchre but that <u>01\_GEN\_23\_06</u># Hear us, my lord: thou [art] a mighty prince among us: in the choice of our sepulchres bury thy dead; none of us shall withhold from thee his sepulchre, but that thou mayest bury thy dead.

sepulchre for they <u>41\_MAR\_16\_08</u># And they went out quickly, and fled from the sepulchre; for they trembled and were amazed: neither said they any thing to any [man]; for they were afraid.

sepulchre here as <u>23\_ISA\_22\_16</u> # What hast thou here? and whom hast thou here, that thou hast hewed thee out a sepulchre here, [as] he that heweth him out a sepulchre on high, [and] that graveth an habitation for himself in a rock?

sepulchre in the <u>09\_1SA\_10\_02</u># When thou art departed from me to day, then thou shalt find two men by Rachel's sepulchre in the border of Benjamin at Zelzah; and they will say unto thee, The asses which thou wentest to seek are found: and, lo, thy father hath left the care of the asses, and sorroweth for you, saying, What shall I do for my son?

sepulchre in the 12\_2KI\_21\_26# And he was buried in his sepulchre in the garden of Uzza: and Josiah his son reigned in his stead.

sepulchre is with <u>44\_ACT\_02\_29</u># Men [and] brethren, let me freely speak unto you of the patriarch David, that he is both dead and buried, and his sepulchre is with us unto this day.

sepulchre of Abner 10\_2SA\_04\_12 # And David commanded his young men, and they slew them, and cut off their hands and their feet, and hanged [them] up over the pool in Hebron. But they took the head of Ishbosheth, and buried [it] in the sepulchre of Abner in Hebron.

sepulchre of Elisha 12 2KI 13 21 # And it came to pass, as they were burying a man, that, behold, they spied a band [of men]; and they cast the man into the sepulchre of Elisha: and when the man was let down, and touched the bones of Elisha, he revived, and stood up on his feet.

sepulchre of his 10\_2SA\_02\_32 # And they took up Asahel, and buried him in the sepulchre of his father, which [was in] Bethlehem. And Joab and his men went all night, and they came to Hebron at break of day.

sepulchre of his <u>10\_2SA\_17\_23</u># And when Ahithophel saw that his counsel was not followed, he saddled [his] ass, and arose, and gat him home to his house, to his city, and put his household in order, and hanged himself, and died, and was buried in the sepulchre of his father.

sepulchre of Joash <u>07\_JUD\_08\_32</u># And Gideon the son of Joash died in a good old age, and was buried in the sepulchre of Joash his father, in Ophrah of the Abiezrites.

sepulchre of Kish 10\_2SA\_21\_14 # And the bones of Saul and Jonathan his son buried they in the country of Benjamin in Zelah, in the sepulchre of Kish his father: and they performed all that the king commanded.

And after that God was entreated for the land.

sepulchre of the 12 2KI 23 17 # Then he said, What title [is] that that I see? And the men of the city told him, [It is] the sepulchre of the man of God, which came from Judah, and proclaimed these things that thou hast done against the altar of Bethel.

sepulchre of thy 11 1KI 13 22 # But camest back, and hast eaten bread and drunk water in the place, of the which [the LORD] did say to thee, Eat no bread, and drink no water; thy carcase shall not come unto the sepulchre of thy fathers.

sepulchre on high <u>23\_ISA\_22\_16</u># What hast thou here? and whom hast thou here, that thou hast hewed thee out a sepulchre here, [as] he that heweth him out a sepulchre on high, [and] that graveth an habitation for himself in a rock?

sepulchre sure sealing 40\_MAT\_27\_66# So they went, and made the sepulchre sure, sealing the stone, and setting a watch.

sepulchre that Abraham 44\_ACT\_07\_16 # And were carried over into Sychem, and laid in the sepulchre that Abraham bought for a sum of money of the sons of Emmor [the father] of Sychem.

sepulchre that was 42\_LUK\_23\_53 # And he took it down, and wrapped it in linen, and laid it in a sepulchre that was hewn in stone, wherein never man before was laid.

sepulchre they are 24\_JER\_05\_16 # Their quiver [is] as an open sepulchre, they [are] all mighty men.

sepulchre they flatter <u>19\_PSA\_05\_09</u> # For [there is] no faithfulness in their mouth; their inward part [is] very wickedness; their throat [is] an open sepulchre; they flatter with their tongue.

sepulchre they saw 41\_MAR\_16\_05 # And entering into the sepulchre, they saw a young man sitting on the right side, clothed in a long white garment; and they were affrighted.

sepulchre unto this <u>05\_DEU\_34\_06</u># And he buried him in a valley in the land of Moab, over against Bethpeor: but no man knoweth of his sepulchre unto this day.

sepulchre was nigh <u>43\_JOH\_19\_42</u> # There laid they Jesus therefore because of the Jews' preparation [day]; for the sepulchre was nigh at hand.

sepulchre weeping and <u>43\_JOH\_20\_11</u> # But Mary stood without at the sepulchre weeping: and as she wept, she stooped down, [and looked] into the sepulchre,

sepulchre wherein the <u>11\_1KI\_13\_31</u># And it came to pass, after he had buried him, that he spake to his sons, saying, When I am dead, then bury me in the sepulchre wherein the man of God [is] buried; lay my bones beside his bones:

sepulchre wherein was <u>43\_JOH\_19\_41</u> # Now in the place where he was crucified there was a garden; and in the garden a new sepulchre, wherein was never man yet laid.

sepulchre which was <u>41\_MAR\_15\_46</u># And he bought fine linen, and took him down, and wrapped him in the linen, and laid him in a sepulchre which was hewn out of a rock, and rolled a stone unto the door of the sepulchre.

sepulchre with fear 40\_MAT\_28\_08# And they departed quickly from the sepulchre with fear and great joy; and did run to bring his disciples word.

sepulchre with his 12\_2KI\_09\_28 # And his servants carried him in a chariot to Jerusalem, and buried him

in his sepulchre with his fathers in the city of David.

sepulchre with their <u>45\_ROM\_03\_13</u># Their throat [is] an open sepulchre; with their tongues they have used deceit; the poison of asps [is] under their lips:

sepulchre 44\_ACT\_13\_29 # And when they had fulfilled all that was written of him, they took [him] down from the tree, and laid [him] in a sepulchre.

sepulchre 43\_JOH\_20\_01 # The first [day] of the week cometh Mary Magdalene early, when it was yet dark, unto the sepulchre, and seeth the stone taken away from the sepulchre.

sepulchre 43\_JOH\_20\_03 # Peter therefore went forth, and that other disciple, and came to the sepulchre.

sepulchre <u>43\_JOH\_20\_04</u> # So they ran both together: and the other disciple did outrun Peter, and came first to the sepulchre.

sepulchre 43\_JOH\_20\_11 # But Mary stood without at the sepulchre weeping: and as she wept, she stooped down, [and looked] into the sepulchre,

sepulchre 42\_LUK\_24\_02 # And they found the stone rolled away from the sepulchre.

sepulchre <u>42\_LUK\_24\_22</u> # Yea, and certain women also of our company made us astonished, which were early at the sepulchre;

sepulchre 41\_MAR\_15\_46 # And he bought fine linen, and took him down, and wrapped him in the linen, and laid him in a sepulchre which was hewn out of a rock, and rolled a stone unto the door of the sepulchre.

sepulchre <u>41\_MAR\_16\_03</u># And they said among themselves, Who shall roll us away the stone from the door of the sepulchre?

sepulchre <u>40\_MAT\_27\_61</u># And there was Mary Magdalene, and the other Mary, sitting over against the sepulchre.

sepulchre <u>40\_MAT\_28\_01</u># In the end of the sabbath, as it began to dawn toward the first [day] of the week, came Mary Magdalene and the other Mary to see the sepulchre.

sepulchres and burned 12\_2KI\_23\_16# And as Josiah turned himself, he spied the sepulchres that [were] there in the mount, and sent, and took the bones out of the sepulchres, and burned [them] upon the altar, and polluted it, according to the word of the LORD which the man of God proclaimed, who proclaimed these words.

sepulchres bury thy <u>01\_GEN\_23\_06</u># Hear us, my lord: thou [art] a mighty prince among us: in the choice of our sepulchres bury thy dead; none of us shall withhold from thee his sepulchre, but that thou mayest bury thy dead.

sepulchres lieth waste <u>16\_NEH\_02\_03</u># And said unto the king, Let the king live for ever: why should not my countenance be sad, when the city, the place of my fathers' sepulchres, [lieth] waste, and the gates thereof are consumed with fire?

sepulchres of David <u>16\_NEH\_03\_16</u># After him repaired Nehemiah the son of Azbuk, the ruler of the half part of Bethzur, unto [the place] over against the sepulchres of David, and to the pool that was made, and unto the house of the mighty.

sepulchres of his 14\_2CH\_35\_24 # His servants therefore took him out of that chariot, and put him in the second chariot that he had; and they brought him to Jerusalem, and he died, and was buried in [one of] the

sepulchres of his fathers. And all Judah and Jerusalem mourned for Josiah.

sepulchres of the <u>14\_2CH\_21\_20</u> # Thirty and two years old was he when he began to reign, and he reigned in Jerusalem eight years, and departed without being desired. Howbeit they buried him in the city of David, but not in the sepulchres of the kings.

sepulchres of the 14\_2CH\_24\_25 # And when they were departed from him, [for they left him in great diseases,] his own servants conspired against him for the blood of the sons of Jehoiada the priest, and slew him on his bed, and he died: and they buried him in the city of David, but they buried him not in the sepulchres of the kings.

sepulchres of the <u>14\_2CH\_28\_27</u> # And Ahaz slept with his fathers, and they buried him in the city, [even] in Jerusalem: but they brought him not into the sepulchres of the kings of Israel: and Hezekiah his son reigned in his stead.

sepulchres of the <u>14\_2CH\_32\_33</u># And Hezekiah slept with his fathers, and they buried him in the chiefest of the sepulchres of the sons of David: and all Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem did him honour at his death. And Manasseh his son reigned in his stead.

sepulchres of the <u>42\_LUK\_11\_47</u># Woe unto you! for ye build the sepulchres of the prophets, and your fathers killed them.

sepulchres of the <u>40\_MAT\_23\_29</u># Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! because ye build the tombs of the prophets, and garnish the sepulchres of the righteous,

sepulchres that I <u>16\_NEH\_02\_05</u># And I said unto the king, If it please the king, and if thy servant have found favour in thy sight, that thou wouldest send me unto Judah, unto the city of my fathers' sepulchres, that I may build it.

sepulchres that were 12\_2KI\_23\_16 # And as Josiah turned himself, he spied the sepulchres that [were] there in the mount, and sent, and took the bones out of the sepulchres, and burned [them] upon the altar, and polluted it, according to the word of the LORD which the man of God proclaimed, who proclaimed these words.

sepulchres which he <a href="#">14\_2CH\_16\_14</a># And they buried him in his own sepulchres, which he had made for himself in the city of David, and laid him in the bed which was filled with sweet odours and divers kinds [of spices] prepared by the apothecaries' art: and they made a very great burning for him.

sepulchres which indeed <u>40\_MAT\_23\_27</u># Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye are like unto whited sepulchres, which indeed appear beautiful outward, but are within full of dead [men's] bones, and of all uncleanness.

sepulchres <u>42\_LUK\_11\_48</u># Truly ye bear witness that ye allow the deeds of your fathers: for they indeed killed them, and ye build their sepulchres.
