

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

pavilion from the <u>19\_PSA\_31\_20</u># Thou shalt hide them in the secret of thy presence from the pride of man: thou shalt keep them secretly in a pavilion from the strife of tongues.

pavilion in the 19\_PSA\_27\_05 # For in the time of trouble he shall hide me in his pavilion: in the secret of his tabernacle shall he hide me; he shall set me up upon a rock.

pavilion over them <u>24\_JER\_43\_10</u># And say unto them, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will send and take Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon, my servant, and will set his throne upon these stones that I have hid; and he shall spread his royal pavilion over them.

pavilion round about 19\_PSA\_18\_11# He made darkness his secret place; his pavilion round about him [were] dark waters [and] thick clouds of the skies.

pavilions he and <u>11\_1KI\_20\_16</u># And they went out at noon. But Benhadad [was] drinking himself drunk in the pavilions, he and the kings, the thirty and two kings that helped him.

pavilions round about 10\_2SA\_22\_12 # And he made darkness pavilions round about him, dark waters, [and] thick clouds of the skies.

pavilions that he <u>11\_1KI\_20\_12</u># And it came to pass, when [Benhadad] heard this message, as he [was] drinking, he and the kings in the pavilions, that he said unto his servants, Set [yourselves in array]. And they set [themselves in array] against the city.
