pay a talent 11_1KI_20_39# And as the king passed by, he cried unto the king: and he said, Thy servant went out into the midst of the battle; and, behold, a man turned aside, and brought a man unto me, and said, Keep this man: if by any means he be missing, then shall thy life be for his life, or else thou shalt pay a talent of silver.

pay all that <u>40_MAT_18_34</u># And his lord was wroth, and delivered him to the tormentors, till he should pay all that was due unto him.

pay as the <u>02_EXO_21_22</u># If men strive, and hurt a woman with child, so that her fruit depart [from her], and yet no mischief follow: he shall be surely punished, according as the woman's husband will lay upon him; and he shall pay as the judges [determine].

pay double unto <u>02_EXO_22_09</u> # For all manner of trespass, [whether it be] for ox, for ass, for sheep, for raiment, [or] for any manner of lost thing, which [another] challengeth to be his, the cause of both parties shall come before the judges; [and] whom the judges shall condemn, he shall pay double unto his neighbour.

pay double <u>02_EXO_22_07</u># If a man shall deliver unto his neighbour money or stuff to keep, and it be stolen out of the man's house; if the thief be found, let him pay double.

pay for it <u>04_NUM_20_19</u> # And the children of Israel said unto him, We will go by the high way: and if I and my cattle drink of thy water, then I will pay for it: I will only, without [doing] any thing [else], go through on my feet.

pay for the <u>02_EXO_21_19</u># If he rise again, and walk abroad upon his staff, then shall he that smote [him] be quit: only he shall pay [for] the loss of his time, and shall cause [him] to be thoroughly healed.

pay he frankly <u>42_LUK_07_42</u> # And when they had nothing to pay, he frankly forgave them both. Tell me therefore, which of them will love him most?

pay him again 20_PRO_19_17_# He that hath pity upon the poor lendeth unto the LORD; and that which he hath given will he pay him again.

pay his lord 40 MAT_18_25# But forasmuch as he had not to pay, his lord commanded him to be sold, and his wife, and children, and all that he had, and payment to be made.

pay it for <u>05_DEU_23_21</u># When thou shalt vow a vow unto the LORD thy God, thou shalt not slack to pay it: for the LORD thy God will surely require it of thee; and it would be sin in thee.

pay it for <u>21_ECC_05_04</u> # When thou vowest a vow unto God, defer not to pay it; for [he hath] no pleasure in fools: pay that which thou hast vowed.

Pay me that <u>40 MAT_18_28</u># But the same servant went out, and found one of his fellowservants, which owed him an hundred pence: and he laid hands on him, and took [him] by the throat, saying, Pay me that thou owest.

pay money according <u>02_EXO_22_17</u># If her father utterly refuse to give her unto him, he shall pay money according to the dowry of virgins.

pay my vow 10_2SA_15_07 # And it came to pass after forty years, that Absalom said unto the king, I pray thee, let me go and pay my vow, which I have vowed unto the LORD, in Hebron.

pay my vows 19_PSA_116_14 # I will pay my vows unto the LORD now in the presence of all his people.

pay my vows 19_PSA_116_18 # I will pay my vows unto the LORD now in the presence of all his people,

pay my vows 19 PSA 22 25 # My praise [shall be] of thee in the great congregation: I will pay my vows before them that fear him.

pay ox for <u>02_EXO_21_36</u># Or if it be known that the ox hath used to push in time past, and his owner hath not kept him in; he shall surely pay ox for ox; and the dead shall be his own.

pay ten thousand <u>17_EST_03_09</u># If it please the king, let it be written that they may be destroyed: and I will pay ten thousand talents of silver to the hands of those that have the charge of the business, to bring [it] into the king's treasuries.

pay that that <u>32_JON_02_09</u> # But I will sacrifice unto thee with the voice of thanksgiving; I will pay [that] that I have vowed. Salvation [is] of the LORD.

pay that which <u>21_ECC_05_04</u># When thou vowest a vow unto God, defer not to pay it; for [he hath] no pleasure in fools: pay that which thou hast vowed.

pay the debt <u>40_MAT_18_30</u># And he would not: but went and cast him into prison, till he should pay the debt.

pay thee all <u>40_MAT_18_26</u># The servant therefore fell down, and worshipped him, saying, Lord, have patience with me, and I will pay thee all.

pay thee all <u>40_MAT_18_29</u># And his fellowservant fell down at his feet, and besought him, saying, Have patience with me, and I will pay thee all.

pay thee my 19_PSA_66_13 # I will go into thy house with burnt offerings: I will pay thee my vows,

pay thy debt 12_2KI_04_07 # Then she came and told the man of God. And he said, Go, sell the oil, and pay thy debt, and live thou and thy children of the rest.

pay thy vows <u>18_JOB_22_27</u> # Thou shalt make thy prayer unto him, and he shall hear thee, and thou shalt pay thy vows.

pay thy vows 19_PSA_50_14 # Offer unto God thanksgiving; and pay thy vows unto the most High:

pay tithe of 40_MAT_23_23# Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier [matters] of the law, judgment, mercy, and faith: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.

pay to the <u>17_EST_04_07</u># And Mordecai told him of all that had happened unto him, and of the sum of the money that Haman had promised to pay to the king's treasuries for the Jews, to destroy them.

pay toll tribute <u>15_EZR_04_13</u># Be it known now unto the king, that, if this city be builded, and the walls set up [again, then] will they not pay toll, tribute, and custom, and [so] thou shalt endamage the revenue of the kings.

pay tribute until 14_2CH_08_08 # [But] of their children, who were left after them in the land, whom the

children of Israel consumed not, them did Solomon make to pay tribute until this day.

pay tribute 40 MAT 17 24 # And when they were come to Capernaum, they that received tribute [money] came to Peter, and said, Doth not your master pay tribute?

pay unto him 14_2CH_27_05 # He fought also with the king of the Ammonites, and prevailed against them. And the children of Ammon gave him the same year an hundred talents of silver, and ten thousand measures of wheat, and ten thousand of barley. So much did the children of Ammon pay unto him, both the second year, and the third.

pay unto the 19_PSA_76_11 # Vow, and pay unto the LORD your God: let all that be round about him bring presents unto him that ought to be feared.

pay why should <u>20_PRO_22_27</u># If thou hast nothing to pay, why should he take away thy bed from under thee?

pay ye tribute <u>45_ROM_13_06</u> # For for this cause pay ye tribute also: for they are God's ministers, attending continually upon this very thing.

pay 21_ECC_05_05_# Better [is it] that thou shouldest not vow, than that thou shouldest vow and not pay.

payed my vows 20_PRO_07_14 # [I have] peace offerings with me; this day have I payed my vows.

payed tithes in <u>58_HEB_07_09</u> # And as I may so say, Levi also, who receiveth tithes, payed tithes in Abraham.

payeth not again <u>19_PSA_37_21</u> # The wicked borroweth, and payeth not again: but the righteous showeth mercy, and giveth.

payment to be <u>40_MAT_18_25</u># But forasmuch as he had not to pay, his lord commanded him to be sold, and his wife, and children, and all that he had, and payment to be made.

repay fury to <u>23_ISA_59_18</u># According to [their] deeds, accordingly he will repay, fury to his adversaries, recompense to his enemies; to the islands he will repay recompense.

repay him to <u>05_DEU_07_10</u># And repayeth them that hate him to their face, to destroy them: he will not be slack to him that hateth him, he will repay him to his face.

repay him what <u>18_JOB_21_31</u> # Who shall declare his way to his face? and who shall repay him [what] he hath done?

repay him whatsoever <u>18_JOB_41_11</u># Who hath prevented me, that I should repay [him? whatsoever is] under the whole heaven is mine.

repay it albeit <u>57_PHM_01_19</u># I Paul have written [it] with mine own hand, I will repay [it]: albeit I do not say to thee how thou owest unto me even thine own self besides.

repay recompense 23_ISA_59_18 # According to [their] deeds, accordingly he will repay, fury to his adversaries, recompense to his enemies; to the islands he will repay recompense.

repay saith the <u>45_ROM_12_19</u> # Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but [rather] give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance [is] mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.

repay thee <u>42_LUK_10_35</u># And on the morrow when he departed, he took out two pence, and gave [them] to the host, and said unto him, Take care of him; and whatsoever thou spendest more, when I come again, I

will repay thee.

repayed 20_PRO_13_21 # Evil pursueth sinners: but to the righteous good shall be repayed.

repayeth them that $\underline{05_DEU_07_10}$ # And repayeth them that hate him to their face, to destroy them: he will not be slack to him that hateth him, he will repay him to his face.
