

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

perceive and eyes <u>05\_DEU\_29\_04</u># Yet the LORD hath not given you an heart to perceive, and eyes to see, and ears to hear, unto this day.

perceive and hearing <u>41\_MAR\_04\_12</u> # That seeing they may see, and not perceive; and hearing they may hear, and not understand; lest at any time they should be converted, and [their] sins should be forgiven them.

perceive and see <u>09\_1SA\_12\_17</u> # [Is it] not wheat harvest to day? I will call unto the LORD, and he shall send thunder and rain; that ye may perceive and see that your wickedness [is] great, which ye have done in the sight of the LORD, in asking you a king.

perceive him not <u>18\_JOB\_09\_11</u># Lo, he goeth by me, and I see [him] not: he passeth on also, but I perceive him not.

perceive him <u>18\_JOB\_23\_08</u># Behold, I go forward, but he [is] not [there]; and backward, but I cannot perceive him:

perceive not 23 ISA 06 09 # And he said, Go, and tell this people, Hear ye indeed, but understand not; and see ye indeed, but perceive not.

perceive of a <u>23\_ISA\_33\_19</u> # Thou shalt not see a fierce people, a people of a deeper speech than thou canst perceive; of a stammering tongue, [that thou canst] not understand.

perceive that God <u>44\_ACT\_10\_34</u># Then Peter opened [his] mouth, and said, Of a truth I perceive that God is no respecter of persons:

perceive that if <u>10\_2SA\_19\_06</u># In that thou lovest thine enemies, and hatest thy friends. For thou hast declared this day, that thou regardest neither princes nor servants: for this day I perceive, that if Absalom had lived, and all we had died this day, then it had pleased thee well.

perceive that in 44\_ACT\_17\_22 # Then Paul stood in the midst of Mars' hill, and said, [Ye] men of Athens, I perceive that in all things ye are too superstitious.

perceive that the <u>47\_2CO\_07\_08</u># For though I made you sorry with a letter, I do not repent, though I did repent: for I perceive that the same epistle hath made you sorry, though [it were] but for a season.

perceive that the <u>06\_JOS\_22\_31</u># And Phinehas the son of Eleazar the priest said unto the children of Reuben, and to the children of Gad, and to the children of Manasseh, This day we perceive that the LORD [is] among us, because ye have not committed this trespass against the LORD: now ye have delivered the children of Israel out of the hand of the LORD.

perceive that there <u>21\_ECC\_03\_22</u> # Wherefore I perceive that [there is] nothing better, than that a man should rejoice in his own works; for that [is] his portion: for who shall bring him to see what shall be after him?

perceive that this 12\_2KI\_04\_09 # And she said unto her husband, Behold now, I perceive that this [is] an holy man of God, which passeth by us continually.

perceive that this <u>44\_ACT\_27\_10</u> # And said unto them, Sirs, I perceive that this voyage will be with hurt and much damage, not only of the lading and ship, but also of our lives.

perceive that thou <u>44\_ACT\_08\_23</u># For I perceive that thou art in the gall of bitterness, and [in] the bond of iniquity.

perceive that thou 43\_JOH\_04\_19 # The woman saith unto him, Sir, I perceive that thou art a prophet.

perceive that virtue <u>42\_LUK\_08\_46</u> # And Jesus said, Somebody hath touched me: for I perceive that virtue is gone out of me.

perceive that whatsoever 41\_MAR\_07\_18 # And he saith unto them, Are ye so without understanding also? Do ye not perceive, that whatsoever thing from without entereth into the man, [it] cannot defile him;

perceive the words <u>20\_PRO\_01\_02</u> # To know wisdom and instruction; to perceive the words of understanding;

perceive we the <u>62\_1JO\_03\_16</u> # Hereby perceive we the love [of God], because he laid down his life for us: and we ought to lay down [our] lives for the brethren.

Perceive ye how 43\_JOH\_12\_19 # The Pharisees therefore said among themselves, Perceive ye how ye prevail nothing? behold, the world is gone after him.

perceive ye not 41\_MAR\_08\_17 # And when Jesus knew [it], he saith unto them, Why reason ye, because ye have no bread? perceive ye not yet, neither understand? have ye your heart yet hardened?

perceive <u>44\_ACT\_28\_26</u> # Saying, Go unto this people, and say, Hearing ye shall hear, and shall not understand; and seeing ye shall see, and not perceive:

perceive <u>40\_MAT\_13\_14</u># And in them is fulfilled the prophecy of Esaias, which saith, By hearing ye shall hear, and shall not understand; and seeing ye shall see, and shall not perceive:

perceived all that <u>17\_EST\_04\_01</u> # When Mordecai perceived all that was done, Mordecai rent his clothes, and put on sackcloth with ashes, and went out into the midst of the city, and cried with a loud and a bitter cry;

perceived also that <u>21\_ECC\_02\_14</u># The wise man's eyes [are] in his head; but the fool walketh in darkness: and I myself perceived also that one event happeneth to them all.

perceived and heard <u>24\_JER\_23\_18</u> # For who hath stood in the counsel of the LORD, and hath perceived and heard his word? who hath marked his word, and heard [it]?

perceived by the <u>23\_ISA\_64\_04</u># For since the beginning of the world [men] have not heard, nor perceived by the ear, neither hath the eye seen, O God, beside thee, [what] he hath prepared for him that waiteth for him.

perceived he said <u>40\_MAT\_16\_08</u># [Which] when Jesus perceived, he said unto them, O ye of little faith, why reason ye among yourselves, because ye have brought no bread?

perceived in his <u>41\_MAR\_02\_08</u> # And immediately when Jesus perceived in his spirit that they so reasoned within themselves, he said unto them, Why reason ye these things in your hearts?

perceived it not <u>42\_LUK\_09\_45</u># But they understood not this saying, and it was hid from them, that they perceived it not: and they feared to ask him of that saying.

perceived not when <u>01\_GEN\_19\_33</u># And they made their father drink wine that night: and the firstborn went in, and lay with her father; and he perceived not when she lay down, nor when she arose.

perceived not when <u>01\_GEN\_19\_35</u> # And they made their father drink wine that night also: and the younger arose, and lay with him; and he perceived not when she lay down, nor when she arose.

perceived that God <u>16\_NEH\_06\_12</u> # And, lo, I perceived that God had not sent him; but that he pronounced this prophecy against me: for Tobiah and Sanballat had hired him.

perceived that he <u>07\_JUD\_06\_22</u># And when Gideon perceived that he [was] an angel of the LORD, Gideon said, Alas, O Lord GOD! for because I have seen an angel of the LORD face to face.

perceived that he <u>42\_LUK\_01\_22</u># And when he came out, he could not speak unto them: and they perceived that he had seen a vision in the temple: for he beckoned unto them, and remained speechless.

perceived that he <u>42\_LUK\_20\_19</u> # And the chief priests and the scribes the same hour sought to lay hands on him; and they feared the people: for they perceived that he had spoken this parable against them.

perceived that he <u>40\_MAT\_21\_45</u># And when the chief priests and Pharisees had heard his parables, they perceived that he spake of them.

perceived that it 11\_1KI\_22\_33# And it came to pass, when the captains of the chariots perceived that it [was] not the king of Israel, that they turned back from pursuing him.

perceived that it <u>09\_1SA\_28\_14</u># And he said unto her, What form [is] he of? And she said, An old man cometh up; and he [is] covered with a mantle. And Saul perceived that it [was] Samuel, and he stooped with [his] face to the ground, and bowed himself.

perceived that it <u>14\_2CH\_18\_32</u> # For it came to pass, that, when the captains of the chariots perceived that it was not the king of Israel, they turned back again from pursuing him.

perceived that the <u>13\_1CH\_14\_02</u> # And David perceived that the LORD had confirmed him king over Israel, for his kingdom was lifted up on high, because of his people Israel.

perceived that the <u>09\_1SA\_03\_08</u># And the LORD called Samuel again the third time. And he arose and went to Eli, and said, Here [am] I; for thou didst call me. And Eli perceived that the LORD had called the child.

perceived that the <u>10\_2SA\_05\_12</u> # And David perceived that the LORD had established him king over Israel, and that he had exalted his kingdom for his people Israel's sake.

perceived that the <u>10\_2SA\_12\_19</u> # But when David saw that his servants whispered, David perceived that the child was dead: therefore David said unto his servants, Is the child dead? And they said, He is dead.

perceived that the <u>10\_2SA\_14\_01</u># Now Joab the son of Zeruiah perceived that the king's heart [was] toward Absalom.

perceived that the <u>44\_ACT\_23\_06</u># But when Paul perceived that the one part were Sadducees, and the other Pharisees, he cried out in the council, Men [and] brethren, I am a Pharisee, the son of a Pharisee: of the hope and resurrection of the dead I am called in question.

perceived that the <u>16\_NEH\_13\_10</u># And I perceived that the portions of the Levites had not been given [them]: for the Levites and the singers, that did the work, were fled every one to his field.

perceived that they 44\_ACT\_04\_13 # Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived

that they were unlearned and ignorant men, they marvelled; and they took knowledge of them, that they had been with Jesus.

perceived that they <u>43\_JOH\_06\_15</u> # When Jesus therefore perceived that they would come and take him by force, to make him a king, he departed again into a mountain himself alone.

perceived that this <u>21\_ECC\_01\_17</u># And I gave my heart to know wisdom, and to know madness and folly: I perceived that this also is vexation of spirit.

perceived that this <u>16\_NEH\_06\_16</u># And it came to pass, that when all our enemies heard [thereof], and all the heathen that [were] about us saw [these things], they were much cast down in their own eyes: for they perceived that this work was wrought of our God.

perceived the breadth <u>18\_JOB\_38\_18</u># Hast thou perceived the breadth of the earth? declare if thou knowest it all.

perceived the grace <u>48\_GAL\_02\_09</u># And when James, Cephas, and John, who seemed to be pillars, perceived the grace that was given unto me, they gave to me and Barnabas the right hands of fellowship; that we [should go] unto the heathen, and they unto the circumcision.

perceived their craftiness <u>42\_LUK\_20\_23</u># But he perceived their craftiness, and said unto them, Why tempt ye me?

perceived their thoughts <u>42\_LUK\_05\_22</u> # But when Jesus perceived their thoughts, he answering said unto them, What reason ye in your hearts?

perceived their wickedness <u>40\_MAT\_22\_18</u># But Jesus perceived their wickedness, and said, Why tempt ye me, [ye] hypocrites?

perceived to be <u>44\_ACT\_23\_29</u># Whom I perceived to be accused of questions of their law, but to have nothing laid to his charge worthy of death or of bonds.

perceived <u>24\_JER\_38\_27</u> # Then came all the princes unto Jeremiah, and asked him: and he told them according to all these words that the king had commanded. So they left off speaking with him; for the matter was not perceived.

perceivest not in <u>20\_PRO\_14\_07</u> # Go from the presence of a foolish man, when thou perceivest not [in him] the lips of knowledge.

perceivest not the <u>42\_LUK\_06\_41</u> # And why beholdest thou the mote that is in thy brother's eye, but perceivest not the beam that is in thine own eye?

perceiveth it not <u>18\_JOB\_14\_21</u> # His sons come to honour, and he knoweth [it] not; and they are brought low, but he perceiveth [it] not of them.

perceiveth it not 18\_JOB\_33\_14 # For God speaketh once, yea twice, [yet man] perceiveth it not.

perceiveth that her 20\_PRO\_31\_18 # She perceiveth that her merchandise [is] good: her candle goeth not out by night.
