persuade Ahab that 11\_1KI\_22\_20# And the LORD said, Who shall persuade Ahab, that he may go up and fall at Ramothgilead? And one said on this manner, and another said on that manner.

persuade him and 11 1KI 22 22 # And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith? And he said, I will go forth, and I will be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And he said, Thou shalt persuade [him], and prevail also: go forth, and do so.

persuade him and 40 MAT 28 14 And if this come to the governor's ears, we will persuade him, and secure you.

persuade him 11\_1KI\_22\_21# And there came forth a spirit, and stood before the LORD, and said, I will persuade him.

persuade men but <u>47\_2CO\_05\_11</u># Knowing therefore the terror of the Lord, we persuade men; but we are made manifest unto God; and I trust also are made manifest in your consciences.

persuade men or <u>48\_GAL\_01\_10</u># For do I now persuade men, or God? or do I seek to please men? for if I yet pleased men, I should not be the servant of Christ.

persuade you on <u>14\_2CH\_32\_15</u># Now therefore let not Hezekiah deceive you, nor persuade you on this manner, neither yet believe him: for no god of any nation or kingdom was able to deliver his people out of mine hand, and out of the hand of my fathers: how much less shall your God deliver you out of mine hand?

persuade you saying <u>23\_ISA\_36\_18</u> # [Beware] lest Hezekiah persuade you, saying, The LORD will deliver us. Hath any of the gods of the nations delivered his land out of the hand of the king of Assyria?

persuade you to 14\_2CH\_32\_11# Doth not Hezekiah persuade you to give over yourselves to die by famine and by thirst, saying, The LORD our God shall deliver us out of the hand of the king of Assyria?

persuaded and a <u>20\_PRO\_25\_15</u> # By long forbearing is a prince persuaded, and a soft tongue breaketh the bone.

persuaded and turned <u>44\_ACT\_19\_26</u># Moreover ye see and hear, that not alone at Ephesus, but almost throughout all Asia, this Paul hath persuaded and turned away much people, saying that they be no gods, which are made with hands:

persuaded better things <u>58\_HEB\_06\_09</u># But, beloved, we are persuaded better things of you, and things that accompany salvation, though we thus speak.

persuaded by the <u>45\_ROM\_14\_14</u> # I know, and am persuaded by the Lord Jesus, that [there is] nothing unclean of itself: but to him that esteemeth any thing to be unclean, to him [it is] unclean.

persuaded him to 14\_2CH\_18\_02 # And after [certain] years he went down to Ahab to Samaria. And Ahab killed sheep and oxen for him in abundance, and for the people that [he had] with him, and persuaded him to go up [with him] to Ramothgilead.

persuaded in his <u>45\_ROM\_14\_05</u># One man esteemeth one day above another: another esteemeth every day [alike]. Let every man be fully persuaded in his own mind.

persuaded of them <u>58\_HEB\_11\_13</u># These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of [them], and embraced [them], and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth.

persuaded of you <u>45\_ROM\_15\_14</u> # And I myself also am persuaded of you, my brethren, that ye also are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge, able also to admonish one another.

persuaded that he <u>55\_2TI\_01\_12</u># For the which cause I also suffer these things: nevertheless I am not ashamed: for I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day.

persuaded that in <u>55\_2TI\_01\_05</u># When I call to remembrance the unfeigned faith that is in thee, which dwelt first in thy grandmother Lois, and thy mother Eunice; and I am persuaded that in thee also.

persuaded that John <u>42\_LUK\_20\_06</u># But and if we say, Of men; all the people will stone us: for they be persuaded that John was a prophet.

persuaded that neither <u>45\_ROM\_08\_38</u># For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come,

persuaded that none <u>44\_ACT\_26\_26</u># For the king knoweth of these things, before whom also I speak freely: for I am persuaded that none of these things are hidden from him; for this thing was not done in a corner.

persuaded that what <u>45\_ROM\_04\_21</u> # And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform.

persuaded the Jews <u>44\_ACT\_18\_04</u># And he reasoned in the synagogue every sabbath, and persuaded the Jews and the Greeks.

persuaded the multitude <u>40\_MAT\_27\_20</u># But the chief priests and elders persuaded the multitude that they should ask Barabbas, and destroy Jesus.

persuaded the people 44\_ACT\_14\_19 # And there came thither [certain] Jews from Antioch and Iconium, who persuaded the people, and, having stoned Paul, drew [him] out of the city, supposing he had been dead.

persuaded them to <u>44\_ACT\_13\_43</u># Now when the congregation was broken up, many of the Jews and religious proselytes followed Paul and Barnabas: who, speaking to them, persuaded them to continue in the grace of God.

persuaded though one 42\_LUK\_16\_31 # And he said unto him, If they hear not Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded, though one rose from the dead.

persuaded we ceased <u>44\_ACT\_21\_14</u># And when he would not be persuaded, we ceased, saying, The will of the Lord be done.

persuadest me to <u>44\_ACT\_26\_28</u># Then Agrippa said unto Paul, Almost thou persuadest me to be a Christian.

persuadeth men to <u>44\_ACT\_18\_13</u> # Saying, This [fellow] persuadeth men to worship God contrary to the law.

persuadeth you saying 12\_2KI\_18\_32 # Until I come and take you away to a land like your own land, a land of corn and wine, a land of bread and vineyards, a land of oil olive and of honey, that ye may live, and not
