persuaded and a <u>20 PRO 25 15</u> # By long forbearing is a prince persuaded, and a soft tongue breaketh the bone.

persuaded and turned 44 ACT 19 26 # Moreover ye see and hear, that not alone at Ephesus, but almost throughout all Asia, this Paul hath persuaded and turned away much people, saying that they be no gods, which are made with hands:

persuaded better things 58 HEB 06 09 # But, beloved, we are persuaded better things of you, and things that accompany salvation, though we thus speak.

persuaded by the 45 ROM 14 14 # I know, and am persuaded by the Lord Jesus, that [there is] nothing unclean of itself: but to him that esteemeth any thing to be unclean, to him [it is] unclean.

persuaded him to 14 2CH 18 02 # And after [certain] years he went down to Ahab to Samaria. And Ahab killed sheep and oxen for him in abundance, and for the people that [he had] with him, and persuaded him to go up [with him] to Ramothgilead.

persuaded in his 45 ROM 14 05 # One man esteemeth one day above another: another esteemeth every day [alike]. Let every man be fully persuaded in his own mind.

persuaded of them 58 HEB 11 13# These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of [them], and embraced [them], and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth.

persuaded of you 45 ROM 15 14 # And I myself also am persuaded of you, my brethren, that ye also are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge, able also to admonish one another.

persuaded that he 55 2TI 01 12 # For the which cause I also suffer these things: nevertheless I am not ashamed: for I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day.

persuaded that in 55 2TI 01 05 # When I call to remembrance the unfeigned faith that is in thee, which dwelt first in thy grandmother Lois, and thy mother Eunice; and I am persuaded that in thee also.

persuaded that John 42 LUK 20.06 # But and if we say, Of men; all the people will stone us: for they be persuaded that John was a prophet.

persuaded that neither 45 ROM 08 38 # For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come,

persuaded that none 44 ACT 26 26 # For the king knoweth of these things, before whom also I speak freely: for I am persuaded that none of these things are hidden from him; for this thing was not done in a corner.

persuaded that what 45 ROM 04 21# And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform.

persuaded the Jews 44 ACT 18 04 # And he reasoned in the synagogue every sabbath, and persuaded the Jews and the Greeks.

persuaded the multitude 40 MAT 27 20 # But the chief priests and elders persuaded the multitude that they should ask Barabbas, and destroy Jesus.

persuaded the people 44 ACT 14 19 # And there came thither [certain] Jews from Antioch and Iconium, who persuaded the people, and, having stoned Paul, drew [him] out of the city, supposing he had been dead.

persuaded them to <u>44 ACT 13 43</u> # Now when the congregation was broken up, many of the Jews and religious proselytes followed Paul and Barnabas: who, speaking to them, persuaded them to continue in the grace of God.

persuaded though one 42 LUK 16 31 # And he said unto him, If they hear not Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded, though one rose from the dead.

persuaded we ceased 44 ACT 21 14# And when he would not be persuaded, we ceased, saying, The will of the Lord be done.
