

KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

pigeons and bring <u>03_LEV_15_29</u> # And on the eighth day she shall take unto her two turtles, or two young pigeons, and bring them unto the priest, to the door of the tabernacle of the congregation.

pigeons and come <u>03_LEV_15_14</u># And on the eighth day he shall take to him two turtledoves, or two young pigeons, and come before the LORD unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, and give them unto the priest:

pigeons such as <u>03_LEV_14_22</u># And two turtledoves, or two young pigeons, such as he is able to get; and the one shall be a sin offering, and the other a burnt offering.

pigeons such as <u>03_LEV_14_30</u># And he shall offer the one of the turtledoves, or of the young pigeons, such as he can get;

pigeons the one <u>03_LEV_12_08</u># And if she be not able to bring a lamb, then she shall bring two turtles, or two young pigeons; the one for the burnt offering, and the other for a sin offering: and the priest shall make an atonement for her, and she shall be clean.

pigeons then he <u>03_LEV_05_11</u># But if he be not able to bring two turtledoves, or two young pigeons, then he that sinned shall bring for his offering the tenth part of an ephah of fine flour for a sin offering; he shall put no oil upon it, neither shall he put [any] frankincense thereon: for it [is] a sin offering.

pigeons to the <u>04_NUM_06_10</u># And on the eighth day he shall bring two turtles, or two young pigeons, to the priest, to the door of the tabernacle of the congregation:

pigeons unto the <u>03_LEV_05_07</u># And if he be not able to bring a lamb, then he shall bring for his trespass, which he hath committed, two turtledoves, or two young pigeons, unto the LORD; one for a sin offering, and the other for a burnt offering.

pigeons <u>03_LEV_01_14</u> # And if the burnt sacrifice for his offering to the LORD [be] of fowls, then he shall bring his offering of turtledoves, or of young pigeons.

pigeons <u>42_LUK_02_24</u> # And to offer a sacrifice according to that which is said in the law of the Lord, A pair of turtledoves, or two young pigeons.
