despitefully use you <u>42\_LUK\_06\_28</u># Bless them that curse you, and pray for them which despitefully use you.

despitefully use you <u>40\_MAT\_05\_44</u># But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you;

hospitality a lover <u>56\_TIT\_01\_08</u># But a lover of hospitality, a lover of good men, sober, just, holy, temperate;

pit I have <u>18\_JOB\_33\_24</u> # Then he is gracious unto him, and saith, Deliver him from going down to the pit: I have found a ransom.

pit in a <u>13\_1CH\_11\_22</u># Benaiah the son of Jehoiada, the son of a valiant man of Kabzeel, who had done many acts; he slew two lionlike men of Moab: also he went down and slew a lion in a pit in a snowy day.

pit in darkness <u>19\_PSA\_88\_06</u> # Thou hast laid me in the lowest pit, in darkness, in the deeps.

pit in the <u>10\_2SA\_18\_17</u> # And they took Absalom, and cast him into a great pit in the wood, and laid a very great heap of stones upon him: and all Israel fled every one to his tent.

pit in time <u>10\_2SA\_23\_20</u> # And Benaiah the son of Jehoiada, the son of a valiant man, of Kabzeel, who had done many acts, he slew two lionlike men of Moab: he went down also and slew a lion in the midst of a pit in time of snow:

pit let no <u>20\_PRO\_28\_17</u> # A man that doeth violence to the blood of [any] person shall flee to the pit; let no man stay him.

pit Shall the <u>19\_PSA\_30\_09</u># What profit [is there] in my blood, when I go down to the pit? Shall the dust praise thee? shall it declare thy truth?

pit shut her <u>19\_PSA\_69\_15</u># Let not the waterflood overflow me, neither let the deep swallow me up, and let not the pit shut her mouth upon me.

pit that is <u>01\_GEN\_37\_22</u># And Reuben said unto them, Shed no blood, [but] cast him into this pit that [is] in the wilderness, and lay no hand upon him; that he might rid him out of their hands, to deliver him to his father again.

pit that they <u>19\_PSA\_09\_15</u># The heathen are sunk down in the pit [that] they made: in the net which they hid is their own foot taken.

pit that thou <u>26\_EZE\_26\_20</u> # When I shall bring thee down with them that descend into the pit, with the people of old time, and shall set thee in the low parts of the earth, in places desolate of old, with them that go down to the pit, that thou be not inhabited; and I shall set glory in the land of the living;

pit then ye <u>04\_NUM\_16\_30</u> # But if the LORD make a new thing, and the earth open her mouth, and swallow them up, with all that [appertain] unto them, and they go down quick into the pit; then ye shall understand that these men have provoked the LORD.

pit was empty <u>01\_GEN\_37\_24</u># And they took him, and cast him into a pit: and the pit [was] empty, [there was] no water in it.

pit when our <u>18\_JOB\_17\_16</u># They shall go down to the bars of the pit, when [our] rest together [is] in the dust.

pit whence ye <u>23\_ISA\_51\_01</u> # Hearken to me, ye that follow after righteousness, ye that seek the LORD: look unto the rock [whence] ye are hewn, and to the hole of the pit [whence] ye are digged.

pit wherein is <u>38\_ZEC\_09\_11</u># As for thee also, by the blood of thy covenant I have sent forth thy prisoners out of the pit wherein [is] no water.

pit wherein Ishmael 24\_JER\_41\_09 # Now the pit wherein Ishmael had cast all the dead bodies of the men, whom he had slain because of Gedaliah, [was] it which Asa the king had made for fear of Baasha king of Israel: [and] Ishmael the son of Nethaniah filled it with [them that were] slain.

pit wherein there <u>03\_LEV\_11\_36</u># Nevertheless a fountain or pit, [wherein there is] plenty of water, shall be clean: but that which toucheth their carcase shall be unclean.

pit which without <u>19\_PSA\_35\_07</u> # For without cause have they hid for me their net [in] a pit, [which] without cause they have digged for my soul.

pit whose name <u>66\_REV\_09\_11</u># And they had a king over them, [which is] the angel of the bottomless pit,

whose name in the Hebrew tongue [is] Abaddon, but in the Greek tongue hath [his] name Apollyon.

pit with the <u>26\_EZE\_26\_20</u> # When I shall bring thee down with them that descend into the pit, with the people of old time, and shall set thee in the low parts of the earth, in places desolate of old, with them that go down to the pit, that thou be not inhabited; and I shall set glory in the land of the living;

pit <u>26\_EZE\_19\_08</u># Then the nations set against him on every side from the provinces, and spread their net over him: he was taken in their pit.

pit <u>26\_EZE\_31\_14</u> # To the end that none of all the trees by the waters exalt themselves for their height, neither shoot up their top among the thick boughs, neither their trees stand up in their height, all that drink water: for they are all delivered unto death, to the nether parts of the earth, in the midst of the children of men, with them that go down to the pit.

pit <u>26\_EZE\_32\_18</u> # Son of man, wail for the multitude of Egypt, and cast them down, [even] her, and the daughters of the famous nations, unto the nether parts of the earth, with them that go down into the pit.

pit <u>26\_EZE\_32\_30</u> # There [be] the princes of the north, all of them, and all the Zidonians, which are gone down with the slain; with their terror they are ashamed of their might; and they lie uncircumcised with [them that be] slain by the sword, and bear their shame with them that go down to the pit.

pit 23\_ISA\_14\_15 # Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit.

pitched before Medeba <u>13\_1CH\_19\_07</u> # So they hired thirty and two thousand chariots, and the king of Maachah and his people; who came and pitched before Medeba. And the children of Ammon gathered themselves together from their cities, and came to battle.

pitched before Migdol <u>04\_NUM\_33\_07</u># And they removed from Etham, and turned again unto Pihahiroth, which [is] before Baalzephon: and they pitched before Migdol.

pitched in Etham <u>04\_NUM\_33\_06</u># And they departed from Succoth, and pitched in Etham, which [is] in the edge of the wilderness.

pitched in Gilboa <u>09\_1SA\_28\_04</u> # And the Philistines gathered themselves together, and came and pitched in Shunem: and Saul gathered all Israel together, and they pitched in Gilboa.

pitched in Hashmonah <u>04\_NUM\_33\_29</u># And they went from Mithcah, and pitched in Hashmonah.

pitched in Ijeabarim <u>04\_NUM\_33\_44</u> # And they departed from Oboth, and pitched in Ijeabarim, in the border of Moab.

pitched in Jahaz <u>07\_JUD\_11\_20</u># But Sihon trusted not Israel to pass through his coast: but Sihon gathered all his people together, and pitched in Jahaz, and fought against Israel.

pitched in Jotbathah <u>04\_NUM\_33\_33</u> # And they went from Horhagidgad, and pitched in Jotbathah.

pitched in Judah <u>07\_JUD\_15\_09</u># Then the Philistines went up, and pitched in Judah, and spread themselves in Lehi.

pitched in Kehelathah <u>04\_NUM\_33\_22</u># And they journeyed from Rissah, and pitched in Kehelathah.

pitched in Kirjathjearim 07\_JUD\_18\_12 # And they went up, and pitched in Kirjathjearim, in Judah: wherefore they called that place Mahanehdan unto this day: behold, [it is] behind Kirjathjearim.

pitched in Libnah <u>04\_NUM\_33\_20</u> # And they departed from Rimmonparez, and pitched in Libnah.

pitched in Makheloth 04\_NUM\_33\_25 # And they removed from Haradah, and pitched in Makheloth.

pitched in Marah <u>04\_NUM\_33\_08</u># And they departed from before Pihahiroth, and passed through the midst of the sea into the wilderness, and went three days' journey in the wilderness of Etham, and pitched in Marah.

pitched in Michmash <u>09\_1SA\_13\_05</u> # And the Philistines gathered themselves together to fight with Israel, thirty thousand chariots, and six thousand horsemen, and people as the sand which [is] on the sea shore in multitude: and they came up, and pitched in Michmash, eastward from Bethaven.

pitched in Mithcah 04\_NUM\_33\_28 # And they removed from Tarah, and pitched in Mithcah.

pitched in mount 04\_NUM\_33\_23 # And they went from Kehelathah, and pitched in mount Shapher.

pitched in mount <u>04\_NUM\_33\_37</u> # And they removed from Kadesh, and pitched in mount Hor, in the edge of the land of Edom.

pitched in Oboth <u>04\_NUM\_21\_10</u> # And the children of Israel set forward, and pitched in Oboth.

pitched in Oboth <u>04\_NUM\_33\_43</u> # And they departed from Punon, and pitched in Oboth.

pitched in Punon <u>04\_NUM\_33\_42</u> # And they departed from Zalmonah, and pitched in Punon.

pitched in Rephidim <u>02\_EXO\_17\_01</u> # And all the congregation of the children of Israel journeyed from the wilderness of Sin, after their journeys, according to the commandment of the LORD, and pitched in Rephidim: and [there was] no water for the people to drink.

pitched in Rithmah <u>04\_NUM\_33\_18</u> # And they departed from Hazeroth, and pitched in Rithmah.

pitched in Shunem <u>09\_1SA\_28\_04</u> # And the Philistines gathered themselves together, and came and pitched in Shunem: and Saul gathered all Israel together, and they pitched in Gilboa.

pitched in Succoth <u>04\_NUM\_33\_05</u># And the children of Israel removed from Rameses, and pitched in Succoth.

pitched in the <u>09\_18A\_26\_03</u># And Saul pitched in the hill of Hachilah, which [is] before Jeshimon, by the way. But David abode in the wilderness, and he saw that Saul came after him into the wilderness.

pitched in the <u>10\_2SA\_17\_26</u> # So Israel and Absalom pitched in the land of Gilead.

pitched in the <u>10\_28A\_23\_13</u># And three of the thirty chief went down, and came to David in the harvest time unto the cave of Adullam: and the troop of the Philistines pitched in the valley of Rephaim.

pitiful women have <u>25\_LAM\_04\_10</u># The hands of the pitiful women have sodden their own children: they were their meat in the destruction of the daughter of my people.

pits and found <u>24\_JER\_14\_03</u> # And their nobles have sent their little ones to the waters: they came to the pits, [and] found no water; they returned with their vessels empty; they were ashamed and confounded, and covered their heads.

pits for me <u>19\_PSA\_119\_85</u># The proud have digged pits for me, which [are] not after thy law.

pits of whom <u>25 LAM\_04\_20</u> # The breath of our nostrils, the anointed of the LORD, was taken in their pits, of whom we said, Under his shadow we shall live among the heathen.

pits that they <u>19\_PSA\_140\_10</u># Let burning coals fall upon them: let them be cast into the fire; into deep pits, that they rise not up again.

pits through a 24\_JER\_02\_06 # Neither said they, Where [is] the LORD that brought us up out of the land of Egypt, that led us through the wilderness, through a land of deserts and of pits, through a land of drought, and of the shadow of death, through a land that no man passed through, and where no man dwelt?

pits <u>09\_1SA\_13\_06</u># When the men of Israel saw that they were in a strait, [for the people were distressed,] then the people did hide themselves in caves, and in thickets, and in rocks, and in high places, and in pits.

pity for mine <u>26\_EZE\_36\_21</u> # But I had pity for mine holy name, which the house of Israel had profaned among the heathen, whither they went.

pity he redeemed <u>23\_ISA\_63\_09</u># In all their affliction he was afflicted, and the angel of his presence saved them: in his love and in his pity he redeemed them; and he bare them, and carried them all the days of old.

pity her <u>05\_DEU\_25\_12</u># Then thou shalt cut off her hand, thine eye shall not pity [her].

pity him but <u>05\_DEU\_19\_13</u># Thine eye shall not pity him, but thou shalt put away [the guilt of] innocent blood from Israel, that it may go well with thee.
