pitch and put <u>02_EXO_02_03</u># And when she could not longer hide him, she took for him an ark of bulrushes, and daubed it with slime and with pitch, and put the child therein; and she laid [it] in the flags by the river's brink.

pitch and the <u>23_ISA_34_09</u> # And the streams thereof shall be turned into pitch, and the dust thereof into brimstone, and the land thereof shall become burning pitch.

pitched before Medeba <u>13_1CH_19_07</u># So they hired thirty and two thousand chariots, and the king of Maachah and his people; who came and pitched before Medeba. And the children of Ammon gathered themselves together from their cities, and came to battle.

pitched before Migdol <u>04_NUM_33_07</u># And they removed from Etham, and turned again unto Pihahiroth, which [is] before Baalzephon: and they pitched before Migdol.

pitched before them <a><u>11_1KI_20_27</u># And the children of Israel were numbered, and were all present, and

went against them: and the children of Israel pitched before them like two little flocks of kids; but the Syrians filled the country.

pitched by the <u>09_1SA_17_02</u> # And Saul and the men of Israel were gathered together, and pitched by the valley of Elah, and set the battle in array against the Philistines.

pitched by their <u>04_NUM_02_34</u># And the children of Israel did according to all that the LORD commanded Moses: so they pitched by their standards, and so they set forward, every one after their families, according to the house of their fathers.

pitched for it <u>13_1CH_15_01</u># And [David] made him houses in the city of David, and prepared a place for the ark of God, and pitched for it a tent.

pitched for it <u>13_1CH_16_01</u> # So they brought the ark of God, and set it in the midst of the tent that David had pitched for it: and they offered burnt sacrifices and peace offerings before God.

pitched his tent <u>01_GEN_26_17</u># And Isaac departed thence, and pitched his tent in the valley of Gerar, and dwelt there.

pitched his tent <u>01_GEN_26_25</u># And he builded an altar there, and called upon the name of the LORD, and pitched his tent there: and there Isaac's servants digged a well.

pitched his tent <u>01_GEN_31_25</u># Then Laban overtook Jacob. Now Jacob had pitched his tent in the mount: and Laban with his brethren pitched in the mount of Gilead.

pitched his tent <u>01_GEN_33_18</u># And Jacob came to Shalem, a city of Shechem, which [is] in the land of Canaan, when he came from Padanaram; and pitched his tent before the city.

pitched his tent <u>07_JUD_04_11</u># Now Heber the Kenite, [which was] of the children of Hobab the father in law of Moses, had severed himself from the Kenites, and pitched his tent unto the plain of Zaanaim, which [is] by Kedesh.

pitched in Benejaakan <u>04_NUM_33_31</u># And they departed from Moseroth, and pitched in Benejaakan.

pitched in Dibongad <u>04_NUM_33_45</u> # And they departed from Iim, and pitched in Dibongad.

pitched in Etham <u>04_NUM_33_06</u># And they departed from Succoth, and pitched in Etham, which [is] in the edge of the wilderness.

pitched in Gilboa <u>09_1SA_28_04</u> # And the Philistines gathered themselves together, and came and pitched in Shunem: and Saul gathered all Israel together, and they pitched in Gilboa.

pitched in Hashmonah <u>04_NUM_33_29</u># And they went from Mithcah, and pitched in Hashmonah.

pitched in Ijeabarim <u>04_NUM_33_44</u> # And they departed from Oboth, and pitched in Ijeabarim, in the border of Moab.

pitched in Jahaz <u>07_JUD_11_20</u># But Sihon trusted not Israel to pass through his coast: but Sihon gathered all his people together, and pitched in Jahaz, and fought against Israel.

pitched in Jotbathah <u>04_NUM_33_33</u> # And they went from Horhagidgad, and pitched in Jotbathah.

pitched in Judah <u>07_JUD_15_09</u># Then the Philistines went up, and pitched in Judah, and spread themselves in Lehi.

pitched in Kehelathah <u>04_NUM_33_22</u># And they journeyed from Rissah, and pitched in Kehelathah.

pitched in Kirjathjearim <u>07_JUD_18_12</u># And they went up, and pitched in Kirjathjearim, in Judah: wherefore they called that place Mahanehdan unto this day: behold, [it is] behind Kirjathjearim.

pitched in Libnah <u>04_NUM_33_20</u> # And they departed from Rimmonparez, and pitched in Libnah.

pitched in Makheloth <u>04_NUM_33_25</u> # And they removed from Haradah, and pitched in Makheloth.

pitched in Marah <u>04_NUM_33_08</u># And they departed from before Pihahiroth, and passed through the midst of the sea into the wilderness, and went three days' journey in the wilderness of Etham, and pitched in Marah.

pitched in Michmash <u>09_1SA_13_05</u> # And the Philistines gathered themselves together to fight with Israel, thirty thousand chariots, and six thousand horsemen, and people as the sand which [is] on the sea shore in multitude: and they came up, and pitched in Michmash, eastward from Bethaven.

pitched in Mithcah <u>04_NUM_33_28</u> # And they removed from Tarah, and pitched in Mithcah.

pitched in mount <u>04_NUM_33_23</u> # And they went from Kehelathah, and pitched in mount Shapher.

pitched in Punon <u>04_NUM_33_42</u># And they departed from Zalmonah, and pitched in Punon.

pitched in Rephidim <u>02_EXO_17_01</u> # And all the congregation of the children of Israel journeyed from the wilderness of Sin, after their journeys, according to the commandment of the LORD, and pitched in Rephidim: and [there was] no water for the people to drink.

pitched in Rithmah <u>04_NUM_33_18</u> # And they departed from Hazeroth, and pitched in Rithmah.

pitched in Shunem <u>09_1SA_28_04</u> # And the Philistines gathered themselves together, and came and pitched in Shunem: and Saul gathered all Israel together, and they pitched in Gilboa.

pitched in Succoth <u>04_NUM_33_05</u># And the children of Israel removed from Rameses, and pitched in Succoth.

pitched in the <u>09_18A_26_03</u># And Saul pitched in the hill of Hachilah, which [is] before Jeshimon, by the way. But David abode in the wilderness, and he saw that Saul came after him into the wilderness.

pitched in the <u>10_2SA_17_26</u> # So Israel and Absalom pitched in the land of Gilead.

pitched in the <u>10_28A_23_13</u># And three of the thirty chief went down, and came to David in the harvest time unto the cave of Adullam: and the troop of the Philistines pitched in the valley of Rephaim.

pitched in the <u>02_EXO_19_02</u># For they were departed from Rephidim, and were come [to] the desert of Sinai, and had pitched in the wilderness; and there Israel camped before the mount.

pitched in the <u>01_GEN_31_25</u># Then Laban overtook Jacob. Now Jacob had pitched his tent in the mount: and Laban with his brethren pitched in the mount of Gilead.

pitched in the <u>07_JUD_06_33</u> # Then all the Midianites and the Amalekites and the children of the east were gathered together, and went over, and pitched in the valley of Jezreel.

pitched in the <u>04_NUM_12_16</u># And afterward the people removed from Hazeroth, and pitched in the wilderness of Paran.

pitched in the <u>04_NUM_21_12</u># From thence they removed, and pitched in the valley of Zared.

pitched in the <u>04_NUM_22_01</u># And the children of Israel set forward, and pitched in the plains of Moab on this side Jordan [by] Jericho.

pitched in the <u>04_NUM_33_15</u> # And they departed from Rephidim, and pitched in the wilderness of Sinai.

pitched in the <u>04_NUM_33_36</u># And they removed from Eziongaber, and pitched in the wilderness of Zin, which [is] Kadesh.

pitched in the <u>04_NUM_33_47</u> # And they removed from Almondiblathaim, and pitched in the mountains of Abarim, before Nebo.

pitched in the <u>04_NUM_33_48</u> # And they departed from the mountains of Abarim, and pitched in the

plains of Moab by Jordan [near] Jericho.

pitched in Zalmonah 04_NUM_33_41 # And they departed from mount Hor, and pitched in Zalmonah.

pitched it without <u>02_EXO_33_07</u> # And Moses took the tabernacle, and pitched it without the camp, afar off from the camp, and called it the Tabernacle of the congregation. And it came to pass, [that] every one which sought the LORD went out unto the tabernacle of the congregation, which [was] without the camp.

pitched on the <u>06_JOS_08_11</u># And all the people, [even the people] of war that [were] with him, went up, and drew nigh, and came before the city, and pitched on the north side of Ai: now [there was] a valley between them and Ai.

pitched on the <u>07_JUD_11_18</u># Then they went along through the wilderness, and compassed the land of Edom, and the land of Moab, and came by the east side of the land of Moab, and pitched on the other side of Arnon, but came not within the border of Moab: for Arnon [was] the border of Moab.

pitched together at <u>06_JOS_11_05</u># And when all these kings were met together, they came and pitched together at the waters of Merom, to fight against Israel.

pitcher and came <u>01_GEN_24_16</u># And the damsel [was] very fair to look upon, a virgin, neither had any man known her: and she went down to the well, and filled her pitcher, and came up.

pitcher be broken <u>21_ECC_12_06</u># Or ever the silver cord be loosed, or the golden bowl be broken, or the pitcher be broken at the fountain, or the wheel broken at the cistern.

pitcher from her <u>01_GEN_24_46</u># And she made haste, and let down her pitcher from her [shoulder], and said, Drink, and I will give thy camels drink also: so I drank, and she made the camels drink also.

pitcher I pray <u>01_GEN_24_14</u> # And let it come to pass, that the damsel to whom I shall say, Let down thy pitcher, I pray thee, that I may drink; and she shall say, Drink, and I will give thy camels drink also: [let the same be] she [that] thou hast appointed for thy servant Isaac; and thereby shall I know that thou hast showed kindness unto my master.
