play before the 10 2SA 06 21 # And David said unto Michal, [It was] before the LORD, which chose me before thy father, and before all his house, to appoint me ruler over the people of the LORD, over Israel: therefore will I play before the LORD.

play before us <u>10\_2SA\_02\_14</u># And Abner said to Joab, Let the young men now arise, and play before us. And Joab said, Let them arise.

play on the <u>23\_ISA\_11\_08</u># And the sucking child shall play on the hole of the asp, and the weaned child shall put his hand on the cockatrice' den.

play skilfully with 19\_PSA\_33\_03 # Sing unto him a new song; play skilfully with a loud noise.

play the harlot <u>28\_HOS\_03\_03</u> # And I said unto her, Thou shalt abide for me many days; thou shalt not play the harlot, and thou shalt not be for [another] man: so [will] I also [be] for thee.

play the harlot <u>28\_HOS\_04\_15</u># Though thou, Israel, play the harlot, [yet] let not Judah offend; and come not ye unto Gilgal, neither go ye up to Bethaven, nor swear, The LORD liveth.

play the mad <u>09\_1SA\_21\_15</u># Have I need of mad men, that ye have brought this [fellow] to play the mad man in my presence? shall this [fellow] come into my house?

play the men <u>10\_2SA\_10\_12</u># Be of good courage, and let us play the men for our people, and for the cities of our God: and the LORD do that which seemeth him good.
