pleasant 19_PSA_135_03 # Praise the LORD; for the LORD [is] good: sing praises unto his name; for [it is] pleasant.

pleasantness and all 20_PRO_03_17 # Her ways [are] ways of pleasantness, and all her paths [are] peace.

please all men <u>46_1CO_10_33</u> # Even as I please all [men] in all [things], not seeking mine own profit, but the [profit] of many, that they may be saved.

please and it <u>23_ISA_55_11</u># So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper [in the thing] whereto I sent it.

please God so <u>52_1TH_04_01</u># Furthermore then we beseech you, brethren, and exhort [you] by the Lord Jesus, that as ye have received of us how ye ought to walk and to please God, [so] ye would abound more and more.

please God that <u>04_NUM_23_27</u># And Balak said unto Balaam, Come, I pray thee, I will bring thee unto another place; peradventure it will please God that thou mayest curse me them from thence.

please God to <u>18_JOB_06_09</u># Even that it would please God to destroy me; that he would let loose his hand, and cut me off!

please God 45_ROM_08_08 # So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.

please her husband <u>46_1CO_07_34</u> # There is difference [also] between a wife and a virgin. The unmarried woman careth for the things of the Lord, that she may be holy both in body and in spirit: but she that is married careth for the things of the world, how she may please [her] husband.

please him for 58_HEB_11_06 # But without faith [it is] impossible to please [him]: for he that cometh to

God must believe that he is, and [that] he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

please him who <u>55_2TI_02_04</u> # No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of [this] life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a soldier.

please him 43_JOH_08_29 # And he that sent me is with me: the Father hath not left me alone; for I do always those things that please him.

please his neighbour 45_ROM_15_02 # Let every one of us please [his] neighbour for [his] good to edification.

please his wife 46_1CO_07_33 # But he that is married careth for the things that are of the world, how he may please [his] wife.

please me and <u>23_ISA_56_04</u># For thus saith the LORD unto the eunuchs that keep my sabbaths, and choose [the things] that please me, and take hold of my covenant;

please ourselves <u>45_ROM_15_01</u># We then that are strong ought to bear the infirmities of the weak, and not to please ourselves.

please the king 17_EST_01_19 # If it please the king, let there go a royal commandment from him, and let it be written among the laws of the Persians and the Medes, that it be not altered, That Vashti come no more before king Ahasuerus; and let the king give her royal estate unto another that is better than she.

please the king <u>17_EST_03_09</u># If it please the king, let it be written that they may be destroyed: and I will pay ten thousand talents of silver to the hands of those that have the charge of the business, to bring [it] into the king's treasuries.

please the king <u>17_EST_05_08</u># If I have found favour in the sight of the king, and if it please the king to grant my petition, and to perform my request, let the king and Haman come to the banquet that I shall prepare for them, and I will do to morrow as the king hath said.

please the king <u>17_EST_07_03</u> # Then Esther the queen answered and said, If I have found favour in thy sight, O king, and if it please the king, let my life be given me at my petition, and my people at my request:

please the king <u>17_EST_08_05</u> # And said, If it please the king, and if I have found favour in his sight, and the thing [seem] right before the king, and I [be] pleasing in his eyes, let it be written to reverse the letters devised by Haman the son of Hammedatha the Agagite, which he wrote to destroy the Jews which [are] in all the king's provinces:

please the king 17_EST_09_13 # Then said Esther, If it please the king, let it be granted to the Jews which

[are] in Shushan to do to morrow also according unto this day's decree, and let Haman's ten sons be hanged upon the gallows.

please the king <u>16_NEH_02_05</u># And I said unto the king, If it please the king, and if thy servant have found favour in thy sight, that thou wouldest send me unto Judah, unto the city of my fathers' sepulchres, that I may build it.

please <u>22_SON_08_04</u> # I charge you, O daughters of Jerusalem, that ye stir not up, nor awake [my] love, until he please.

pleased Absalom well 10_2SA_17_04 # And the saying pleased Absalom well, and all the elders of Israel.

pleased all the 10_2SA_03_36 # And all the people took notice [of it], and it pleased them: as whatsoever the

king did pleased all the people.

pleased Darius to <u>27_DAN_06_01</u># It pleased Darius to set over the kingdom an hundred and twenty princes, which should be over the whole kingdom;

pleased David well <u>09_1SA_18_26</u> # And when his servants told David these words, it pleased David well to be the king's son in law: and the days were not expired.

pleased for his <u>23_ISA_42_21</u># The LORD is well pleased for his righteousness' sake; he will magnify the law, and make [it] honourable.

pleased for they <u>46_1CO_10_05</u># But with many of them God was not well pleased: for they were overthrown in the wilderness.

pleased God by 46_1CO_01_21 # For after that in the wisdom of God the world by wisdom knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe.

pleased it the <u>44_ACT_15_22</u># Then pleased it the apostles and elders, with the whole church, to send chosen men of their own company to Antioch with Paul and Barnabas; [namely], Judas surnamed Barsabas, and Silas, chief men among the brethren:

pleased me well <u>05_DEU_01_23</u># And the saying pleased me well: and I took twelve men of you, one of a tribe:

pleased men I <u>48_GAL_01_10</u> # For do I now persuade men, or God? or do I seek to please men? for if I yet pleased men, I should not be the servant of Christ.

pleased not himself <u>45_ROM_15_03</u> # For even Christ pleased not himself; but, as it is written, The reproaches of them that reproached thee fell on me.

pleased O LORD 19_PSA_40_13 # Be pleased, O LORD, to deliver me: O LORD, make haste to help me.

pleased Pharaoh well <u>01_GEN_45_16</u># And the fame thereof was heard in Pharaoh's house, saying, Joseph's brethren are come: and it pleased Pharaoh well, and his servants.

pleased Samson well <u>07_JUD_14_07</u> # And he went down, and talked with the woman; and she pleased Samson well.

pleased Silas to 44_ACT_15_34 # Notwithstanding it pleased Silas to abide there still.

pleased that did 19_PSA_135_06 # Whatsoever the LORD pleased, [that] did he in heaven, and in earth, in the seas, and all deep places.

pleased <u>58_HEB_13_16</u># But to do good and to communicate forget not: for with such sacrifices God is well pleased.

pleased <u>42_LUK_03_22</u># And the Holy Ghost descended in a bodily shape like a dove upon him, and a voice came from heaven, which said, Thou art my beloved Son; in thee I am well pleased.

pleasure in fools <u>21_ECC_05_04</u> # When thou vowest a vow unto God, defer not to pay it; for [he hath] no pleasure in fools: pay that which thou hast vowed.

pleasure in her 24 JER_02 24 # A wild ass used to the wilderness, [that] snuffeth up the wind at her pleasure; in her occasion who can turn her away? all they that seek her will not weary themselves; in her month they shall find her.

pleasure in her 19_PSA_102_14 # For thy servants take pleasure in her stones, and favour the dust thereof.

pleasure in him <u>58_HEB_10_38</u> # Now the just shall live by faith: but if [any man] draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him.

pleasure in his 19_PSA_149_04 # For the LORD taketh pleasure in his people: he will beautify the meek with salvation.

pleasure in infirmities <u>47_2CO_12_10</u> # Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in necessities, in persecutions, in distresses for Christ's sake: for when I am weak, then am I strong.

pleasure in it <u>37_HAG_01_08</u># Go up to the mountain, and bring wood, and build the house; and I will take pleasure in it, and I will be glorified, saith the LORD.

pleasure in you 39 MAL_01_10 # Who [is there] even among you that would shut the doors [for nought]? neither do ye kindle [fire] on mine altar for nought. I have no pleasure in you, saith the LORD of hosts, neither will I accept an offering at your hand.

pleasure is dead 54_1TI_05_06 # But she that liveth in pleasure is dead while she liveth.

pleasure left Paul 44_ACT_24_27 # But after two years Porcius Festus came into Felix' room: and Felix, willing to show the Jews a pleasure, left Paul bound.

pleasure my lord <u>01_GEN_18_12</u># Therefore Sarah laughed within herself, saying, After I am waxed old shall I have pleasure, my lord being old also?

pleasure nor speaking 23 ISA 58 13 # If thou turn away thy foot from the sabbath, [from] doing thy pleasure on my holy day; and call the sabbath a delight, the holy of the LORD, honourable; and shalt honour him, not doing thine own ways, nor finding thine own pleasure, nor speaking [thine own] words:

pleasure to the <u>18_JOB_22_03</u> # [Is it] any pleasure to the Almighty, that thou art righteous? or [is it] gain [to him], that thou makest thy ways perfect?

pleasure to us <u>15 EZR_05_17</u> # Now therefore, if [it seem] good to the king, let there be search made in the king's treasure house, which [is] there at Babylon, whether it be [so], that a decree was made of Cyrus the king to build this house of God at Jerusalem, and let the king send his pleasure to us concerning this matter.

pleasure which he <u>49_EPH_01_09</u> # Having made known unto us the mystery of his will, according to his good pleasure which he hath purposed in himself:

pleasure 17_EST_01_08 # And the drinking [was] according to the law; none did compel: for so the king had appointed to all the officers of his house, that they should do according to every man's pleasure.
