pleasant also our [22 SON 01 16](#) # Behold, thou [art] fair, my beloved, yea, pleasant: also our bed [is] green.

pleasant and bowed [01 GEN 49 15](#) # And he saw that rest [was] good, and the land that [it was] pleasant; and bowed his shoulder to bear, and became a servant unto tribute.

pleasant and praise [19 PSA 147 01](#) # Praise ye the LORD: for [it is] good to sing praises unto our God; for [it is] pleasant; [and] praise is comely.

pleasant art thou [22 SON 07 06](#) # How fair and how pleasant art thou, O love, for delights!

pleasant as my [12 2KI 02 19](#) # And the men of the city said unto Elisha, Behold, I pray thee, the situation of this city [is] pleasant, as my lord seeth: but the water [is] nought, and the ground barren.

pleasant bread neither [27 DAN 10 03](#) # I ate no pleasant bread, neither came flesh nor wine in my mouth, neither did I anoint myself at all, till three whole weeks were fulfilled.

pleasant child for [24 JER 31 20](#) # [Is] Ephraim my dear son? [is he] a pleasant child? for since I spake against him, I do earnestly remember him still: therefore my bowels are troubled for him; I will surely have mercy upon him, saith the LORD.

pleasant fields for [23 ISA 32 12](#) # They shall lament for the teats, for the pleasant fields, for the fruitful vine.

pleasant fruits camphire [22 SON 04 13](#) # Thy plants [are] an orchard of pomegranates, with pleasant fruits; camphire, with spikenard,

pleasant fruits new [22 SON 07 13](#) # The mandrakes give a smell, and at our gates [are] all manner of pleasant [fruits], new and old, [which] I have laid up for thee, O my beloved.

pleasant fruits [22 SON 04 16](#) # Awake, O north wind; and come, thou south; blow upon my garden, [that] the spices thereof may flow out. Let my beloved come into his garden, and eat his pleasant fruits.

pleasant furniture [34 NAH 02 09](#) # Take ye the spoil of silver, take the spoil of gold: for [there is] none end of the store [and] glory out of all the pleasant furniture.

pleasant harp with [19 PSA 81 02](#) # Take a psalm, and bring hither the timbrel, the pleasant harp with the psaltery.

pleasant hast thou [10 2SA 01 26](#) # I am distressed for thee, my brother Jonathan: very pleasant hast thou been unto me: thy love to me was wonderful, passing the love of women.

pleasant houses and [26 EZE 26 12](#) # And they shall make a spoil of thy riches, and make a prey of thy merchandise: and they shall break down thy walls, and destroy thy pleasant houses: and they shall lay thy stones and thy timber and thy dust in the midst of the water.

pleasant houses from [33 MIC 02 09](#) # The women of my people have ye cast out from their pleasant houses; from their children have ye taken away my glory for ever.

pleasant in their [10 2SA 01 23](#) # Saul and Jonathan [were] lovely and pleasant in their lives, and in their death they were not divided: they were swifter than eagles, they were stronger than lions.

pleasant in thine [11 1KI 20 06](#) # Yet I will send my servants unto thee to morrow about this time, and they shall search thine house, and the houses of thy servants; and it shall be, [that] whatsoever is pleasant in thine eyes, they shall put [it] in their hand, and take [it] away.

pleasant it is [19 PSA 133 01](#) # A Song of degrees of David. Behold, how good and how pleasant [it is] for brethren to dwell together in unity!

pleasant jewels [14 2CH 32 27](#) # And Hezekiah had exceeding much riches and honour: and he made himself treasuries for silver, and for gold, and for precious stones, and for spices, and for shields, and for all manner of pleasant jewels;

pleasant land a [24 JER 03 19](#) # But I said, How shall I put thee among the children, and give thee a pleasant land, a goodly heritage of the hosts of nations? and I said, Thou shalt call me, My father; and shalt not turn away from me.

pleasant land desolate [38 ZEC 07 14](#) # But I scattered them with a whirlwind among all the nations whom they knew not. Thus the land was desolate after them, that no man passed through nor returned: for they laid the pleasant land desolate.

pleasant land they [19 PSA 106 24](#) # Yea, they despised the pleasant land, they believed not his word:

pleasant riches [20 PRO 24 04](#) # And by knowledge shall the chambers be filled with all precious and pleasant riches.

pleasant roe let [20 PRO 05 19](#) # [Let her be as] the loving hind and pleasant roe; let her breasts satisfy thee at all times; and be thou ravished always with her love.

pleasant stones [23 ISA 54 12](#) # And I will make thy windows of agates, and thy gates of carbuncles, and all thy borders of pleasant stones.

pleasant thing if [20 PRO 22 18](#) # For [it is] a pleasant thing if thou keep them within thee; they shall withal be fitted in thy lips.

pleasant thing it [21 ECC 11 07](#) # Truly the light [is] sweet, and a pleasant [thing it is] for the eyes to behold the sun:

pleasant things are [23 ISA 64 11](#) # Our holy and our beautiful house, where our fathers praised thee, is burned up with fire: and all our pleasant things are laid waste.

pleasant things [29 JOE 03 05](#) # Because ye have taken my silver and my gold, and have carried into your temples my goodly pleasant things:

pleasant to the [01 GEN 02 09](#) # And out of the ground made the LORD God to grow every tree that is pleasant to the sight, and good for food; the tree of life also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of knowledge of good and evil.
