

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

displeased against the <u>35\_HAB\_03\_08</u># Was the LORD displeased against the rivers? [was] thine anger against the rivers? [was] thy wrath against the sea, that thou didst ride upon thine horses [and] thy chariots of salvation?

displeased and came 11\_1KI\_20\_43# And the king of Israel went to his house heavy and displeased, and came to Samaria.

displeased and said <u>41\_MAR\_10\_14</u> # But when Jesus saw [it], he was much displeased, and said unto them, Suffer the little children to come unto me, and forbid them not: for of such is the kingdom of God.

displeased and they <u>38\_ZEC\_01\_15</u> # And I am very sore displeased with the heathen [that are] at ease: for I was but a little displeased, and they helped forward the affliction.

displeased because of 11 1KI 21 04 And Ahab came into his house heavy and displeased because of the word which Naboth the Jezreelite had spoken to him: for he had said, I will not give thee the inheritance of my fathers. And he laid him down upon his bed, and turned away his face, and would eat no bread.

displeased because the <u>13\_1CH\_13\_11</u># And David was displeased, because the LORD had made a breach upon Uzza: wherefore that place is called Perezuzza to this day.

displeased because the <u>10\_2SA\_06\_08</u># And David was displeased, because the LORD had made a breach upon Uzzah: and he called the name of the place Perezuzzah to this day.

displeased him and <u>09\_1SA\_18\_08</u># And Saul was very wroth, and the saying displeased him; and he said, They have ascribed unto David ten thousands, and to me they have ascribed [but] thousands: and [what] can he have more but the kingdom?

displeased him and <u>01\_GEN\_48\_17</u># And when Joseph saw that his father laid his right hand upon the head of Ephraim, it displeased him: and he held up his father's hand, to remove it from Ephraim's head unto Manasseh's head.

displeased him at 11\_1KI\_01\_06# And his father had not displeased him at any time in saying, Why hast thou done so? and he also [was a] very goodly [man]; and [his mother] bare him after Absalom.

displeased him that 23\_ISA\_59\_15 # Yea, truth faileth; and he [that] departeth from evil maketh himself a prey: and the LORD saw [it], and it displeased him that [there was] no judgment.

displeased Jonah exceedingly 32\_JON\_04\_01 # But it displeased Jonah exceedingly, and he was very angry.

displeased O turn 19\_PSA\_60\_01 # To the chief Musician upon Shushaneduth, Michtam of David, to teach; when he strove with Aramnaharaim and with Aramzobah, when Joab returned, and smote of Edom in the valley of salt twelve thousand. O God, thou hast cast us off, thou hast scattered us, thou hast been displeased; O turn thyself to us again.

displeased Samuel when <u>09\_1SA\_08\_06</u> # But the thing displeased Samuel, when they said, Give us a king to judge us. And Samuel prayed unto the LORD.

displeased the LORD 10\_2SA\_11\_27 # And when the mourning was past, David sent and fetched her to his

house, and she became his wife, and bare him a son. But the thing that David had done displeased the LORD.

displeased the LORD <u>01\_GEN\_38\_10</u># And the thing which he did displeased the LORD: wherefore he slew him also.

displeased the LORD <u>04\_NUM\_11\_01</u># And [when] the people complained, it displeased the LORD: and the LORD heard [it]; and his anger was kindled; and the fire of the LORD burnt among them, and consumed [them that were] in the uttermost parts of the camp.

displeased with himself <u>27\_DAN\_06\_14</u> # Then the king, when he heard [these] words, was sore displeased with himself, and set [his] heart on Daniel to deliver him: and he laboured till the going down of the sun to deliver him.

displeased with James <u>41\_MAR\_10\_41</u> # And when the ten heard [it], they began to be much displeased with James and John.

displeased with the <u>38\_ZEC\_01\_15</u> # And I am very sore displeased with the heathen [that are] at ease: for I was but a little displeased, and they helped forward the affliction.

displeased with them <u>44\_ACT\_12\_20</u># And Herod was highly displeased with them of Tyre and Sidon: but they came with one accord to him, and, having made Blastus the king's chamberlain their friend, desired peace; because their country was nourished by the king's [country].

displeased with this 13\_1CH\_21\_07 # And God was displeased with this thing; therefore he smote Israel.

displeased with your 38\_ZEC\_01\_02 # The LORD hath been sore displeased with your fathers.

displeased 40\_MAT\_21\_15# And when the chief priests and scribes saw the wonderful things that he did, and the children crying in the temple, and saying, Hosanna to the son of David; they were sore displeased,

displeased <u>04\_NUM\_11\_10</u># Then Moses heard the people weep throughout their families, every man in the door of his tent: and the anger of the LORD was kindled greatly; Moses also was displeased.

pleased Absalom well 10\_2SA\_17\_04 # And the saying pleased Absalom well, and all the elders of Israel.

pleased all the <u>10\_2SA\_03\_36</u> # And all the people took notice [of it], and it pleased them: as whatsoever the king did pleased all the people.

pleased Darius to <u>27\_DAN\_06\_01</u> # It pleased Darius to set over the kingdom an hundred and twenty princes, which should be over the whole kingdom;

pleased David well <u>09\_1SA\_18\_26</u> # And when his servants told David these words, it pleased David well to be the king's son in law: and the days were not expired.

pleased for his <u>23\_ISA\_42\_21</u> # The LORD is well pleased for his righteousness' sake; he will magnify the law, and make [it] honourable.

pleased for they <u>46\_1CO\_10\_05</u># But with many of them God was not well pleased: for they were overthrown in the wilderness.

pleased God by 46\_1CO\_01\_21 # For after that in the wisdom of God the world by wisdom knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe.

pleased God who 48\_GAL\_01\_15 # But when it pleased God, who separated me from my mother's womb,

and called [me] by his grace,

pleased God <u>58\_HEB\_11\_05</u># By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God.

pleased Haman and <u>17\_EST\_05\_14</u> # Then said Zeresh his wife and all his friends unto him, Let a gallows be made of fifty cubits high, and to morrow speak thou unto the king that Mordecai may be hanged thereon: then go thou in merrily with the king unto the banquet. And the thing pleased Haman; and he caused the gallows to be made.

pleased Hamor and 01\_GEN\_34\_18 # And their words pleased Hamor, and Shechem Hamor's son.

pleased hear ye <u>40\_MAT\_17\_05</u># While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him.

pleased Herod and <u>41\_MAR\_06\_22</u># And when the daughter of the said Herodias came in, and danced, and pleased Herod and them that sat with him, the king said unto the damsel, Ask of me whatsoever thou wilt, and I will give [it] thee.

pleased Herod <u>40\_MAT\_14\_06</u># But when Herod's birthday was kept, the daughter of Herodias danced before them, and pleased Herod.

pleased him and 46\_1CO\_15\_38 # But God giveth it a body as it hath pleased him, and to every seed his own body.

pleased him and <u>17\_EST\_02\_09</u> # And the maiden pleased him, and she obtained kindness of him; and he speedily gave her her things for purification, with such things as belonged to her, and seven maidens, [which were] meet to be given her, out of the king's house: and he preferred her and her maids unto the best [place] of the house of the women.

pleased him not 11 1KI 09 12 # And Hiram came out from Tyre to see the cities which Solomon had given him; and they pleased him not.

pleased him <u>46\_1CO\_12\_18</u># But now hath God set the members every one of them in the body, as it hath pleased him.

pleased him <u>09\_1SA\_18\_20</u> # And Michal Saul's daughter loved David: and they told Saul, and the thing pleased him.

pleased I will 40\_MAT\_12\_18# Behold my servant, whom I have chosen; my beloved, in whom my soul is well pleased: I will put my spirit upon him, and he shall show judgment to the Gentiles.

pleased it the <u>44\_ACT\_15\_22</u># Then pleased it the apostles and elders, with the whole church, to send chosen men of their own company to Antioch with Paul and Barnabas; [namely], Judas surnamed Barsabas, and Silas, chief men among the brethren:

pleased me well <u>05\_DEU\_01\_23</u># And the saying pleased me well: and I took twelve men of you, one of a tribe:

pleased men I <u>48\_GAL\_01\_10</u># For do I now persuade men, or God? or do I seek to please men? for if I yet pleased men, I should not be the servant of Christ.

pleased not himself 45\_ROM\_15\_03 # For even Christ pleased not himself; but, as it is written, The

reproaches of them that reproached thee fell on me.

pleased not Isaac <u>01\_GEN\_28\_08</u># And Esau seeing that the daughters of Canaan pleased not Isaac his father;

pleased O LORD 19\_PSA\_40\_13 # Be pleased, O LORD, to deliver me: O LORD, make haste to help me.

pleased Pharaoh well <u>01\_GEN\_45\_16</u># And the fame thereof was heard in Pharaoh's house, saying, Joseph's brethren are come: and it pleased Pharaoh well, and his servants.

pleased Samson well <u>07\_JUD\_14\_07</u> # And he went down, and talked with the woman; and she pleased Samson well.

pleased Silas to 44\_ACT\_15\_34 # Notwithstanding it pleased Silas to abide there still.

pleased that did 19\_PSA\_135\_06 # Whatsoever the LORD pleased, [that] did he in heaven, and in earth, in the seas, and all deep places.

pleased the children <u>06\_JOS\_22\_33</u># And the thing pleased the children of Israel; and the children of Israel blessed God, and did not intend to go up against them in battle, to destroy the land wherein the children of Reuben and Gad dwelt.

pleased the Father 51\_COL\_01\_19 # For it pleased [the Father] that in him should all fulness dwell;

pleased the Jews <u>44\_ACT\_12\_03</u> # And because he saw it pleased the Jews, he proceeded further to take Peter also. [Then were the days of unleavened bread.]

pleased the king 14\_2CH\_30\_04 # And the thing pleased the king and all the congregation.

pleased the king 17\_EST\_01\_21 # And the saying pleased the king and the princes; and the king did according to the word of Memucan:

pleased the king <u>17\_EST\_02\_04</u># And let the maiden which pleaseth the king be queen instead of Vashti. And the thing pleased the king; and he did so.

pleased the king <u>16\_NEH\_02\_06</u># And the king said unto me, [the queen also sitting by him,] For how long shall thy journey be? and when wilt thou return? So it pleased the king to send me; and I set him a time.

pleased the Lord 11\_1KI\_03\_10 # And the speech pleased the Lord, that Solomon had asked this thing.

pleased the LORD <u>09\_1SA\_12\_22</u># For the LORD will not forsake his people for his great name's sake: because it hath pleased the LORD to make you his people.

pleased the LORD <u>23\_ISA\_53\_10</u># Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put [him] to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see [his] seed, he shall prolong [his] days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.

pleased the LORD <u>04\_NUM\_24\_01</u> # And when Balaam saw that it pleased the LORD to bless Israel, he went not, as at other times, to seek for enchantments, but he set his face toward the wilderness.

pleased the whole <u>44\_ACT\_06\_05</u># And the saying pleased the whole multitude: and they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Ghost, and Philip, and Prochorus, and Nicanor, and Timon, and Parmenas, and Nicolas a proselyte of Antioch:

pleased thee well 10\_2SA\_19\_06 # In that thou lovest thine enemies, and hatest thy friends. For thou hast

declared this day, that thou regardest neither princes nor servants: for this day I perceive, that if Absalom had lived, and all we had died this day, then it had pleased thee well.

pleased thee <u>32\_JON\_01\_14</u># Wherefore they cried unto the LORD, and said, We beseech thee, O LORD, we beseech thee, let us not perish for this man's life, and lay not upon us innocent blood: for thou, O LORD, hast done as it pleased thee.

pleased them as <u>10\_2SA\_03\_36</u> # And all the people took notice [of it], and it pleased them: as whatsoever the king did pleased all the people.

pleased them of <u>45\_ROM\_15\_26</u> # For it hath pleased them of Macedonia and Achaia to make a certain contribution for the poor saints which are at Jerusalem.

pleased them verily <u>45\_ROM\_15\_27</u> # It hath pleased them verily; and their debtors they are. For if the Gentiles have been made partakers of their spiritual things, their duty is also to minister unto them in carnal things.

pleased them <u>06\_JOS\_22\_30</u># And when Phinehas the priest, and the princes of the congregation and heads of the thousands of Israel which [were] with him, heard the words that the children of Reuben and the children of Gad and the children of Manasseh spake, it pleased them.

pleased to do 11\_1KI\_09\_01# And it came to pass, when Solomon had finished the building of the house of the LORD, and the king's house, and all Solomon's desire which he was pleased to do,

pleased to dwell 46\_1CO\_07\_12 # But to the rest speak I, not the Lord: If any brother hath a wife that believeth not, and she be pleased to dwell with him, let him not put her away.

pleased to dwell <u>46\_1CO\_07\_13</u> # And the woman which hath an husband that believeth not, and if he be pleased to dwell with her, let her not leave him.

pleased to kill <u>07\_JUD\_13\_23</u># But his wife said unto him, If the LORD were pleased to kill us, he would not have received a burnt offering and a meat offering at our hands, neither would he have showed us all these [things], nor would as at this time have told us [such things] as these.

pleased with me <u>01\_GEN\_33\_10</u> # And Jacob said, Nay, I pray thee, if now I have found grace in thy sight, then receive my present at my hand: for therefore I have seen thy face, as though I had seen the face of God, and thou wast pleased with me.

pleased with the 19 PSA 51 19 # Then shalt thou be pleased with the sacrifices of righteousness, with burnt offering and whole burnt offering: then shall they offer bullocks upon thine altar.

pleased with thee <u>39\_MAL\_01\_08</u> # And if ye offer the blind for sacrifice, [is it] not evil? and if ye offer the lame and sick, [is it] not evil? offer it now unto thy governor; will he be pleased with thee, or accept thy person? saith the LORD of hosts.

pleased with thousands <u>33\_MIC\_06\_07</u> # Will the LORD be pleased with thousands of rams, [or] with ten thousands of rivers of oil? shall I give my firstborn [for] my transgression, the fruit of my body [for] the sin of my soul?

pleased <u>61\_2PE\_01\_17</u># For he received from God the Father honour and glory, when there came such a voice to him from the excellent glory, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

pleased <u>58\_HEB\_13\_16</u># But to do good and to communicate forget not: for with such sacrifices God is well pleased.

pleased <u>42\_LUK\_03\_22</u># And the Holy Ghost descended in a bodily shape like a dove upon him, and a voice came from heaven, which said, Thou art my beloved Son; in thee I am well pleased.

pleased  $41\_MAR\_01\_11$  # And there came a voice from heaven, [saying], Thou art my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

pleased <u>40\_MAT\_03\_17</u># And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

pleased 19\_PSA\_115\_03# But our God [is] in the heavens: he hath done whatsoever he hath pleased.
