pledge abroad unto [05 DEU 24 11](#) # Thou shalt stand abroad, and the man to whom thou dost lend shall bring out the pledge abroad unto thee.

pledge again when [05 DEU 24 13](#) # In any case thou shalt deliver him the pledge again when the sun goeth down, that he may sleep in his own raiment, and bless thee: and it shall be righteousness unto thee before the LORD thy God.

pledge and hath [26 EZE 18 12](#) # Hath oppressed the poor and needy, hath spoiled by violence, hath not restored the pledge, and hath lifted up his eyes to the idols, hath committed abomination,

pledge by every [30 AMO 02 08](#) # And they lay [themselves] down upon clothes laid to pledge by every altar, and they drink the wine of the condemned [in] the house of their god.

pledge give again [26 EZE 33 15](#) # [If] the wicked restore the pledge, give again that he had robbed, walk in the statutes of life, without committing iniquity; he shall surely live, he shall not die.

pledge hath spoiled [26 EZE 18 07](#) # And hath not oppressed any, [but] hath restored to the debtor his pledge, hath spoiled none by violence, hath given his bread to the hungry, and hath covered the naked with a garment;
