plenty and be <u>29_JOE_02_26</u> # And ye shall eat in plenty, and be satisfied, and praise the name of the LORD your God, that hath dealt wondrously with you: and my people shall never be ashamed.

plenty and thy <u>20_PRO_03_10</u># So shall thy barns be filled with plenty, and thy presses shall burst out with new wine.

plenty for the 14_2CH_31_10 # And Azariah the chief priest of the house of Zadok answered him, and said, Since [the people] began to bring the offerings into the house of the LORD, we have had enough to eat, and have left plenty: for the LORD hath blessed his people; and that which is left [is] this great store.

plenty of almug 11_1KI_10_11# And the navy also of Hiram, that brought gold from Ophir, brought in from Ophir great plenty of almug trees, and precious stones.

plenty of bread <u>20_PRO_28_19</u> # He that tilleth his land shall have plenty of bread: but he that followeth after vain [persons] shall have poverty enough.

plenty of corn <u>01_GEN_27_28</u> # Therefore God give thee of the dew of heaven, and the fatness of the earth, and plenty of corn and wine:

plenty of justice 18_JOB_37_23 # [Touching] the Almighty, we cannot find him out: [he is] excellent in power, and in judgment, and in plenty of justice: he will not afflict.

plenty of silver 18_JOB_22_25 # Yea, the Almighty shall be thy defence, and thou shalt have plenty of silver.

plenty of victuals <u>24_JER_44_17</u> # But we will certainly do whatsoever thing goeth forth out of our own mouth, to burn incense unto the queen of heaven, and to pour out drink offerings unto her, as we have done, we, and our fathers, our kings, and our princes, in the cities of Judah, and in the streets of Jerusalem: for [then] had we plenty of victuals, and were well, and saw no evil.

plenty of water <u>03_LEV_11_36</u># Nevertheless a fountain or pit, [wherein there is] plenty of water, shall be clean: but that which toucheth their carcase shall be unclean.

plenty shall be <u>01_GEN_41_30</u> # And there shall arise after them seven years of famine; and all the plenty shall be forgotten in the land of Egypt; and the famine shall consume the land;

plenty shall not <u>01_GEN_41_31</u># And the plenty shall not be known in the land by reason of that famine following; for it [shall be] very grievous.

plenty throughout all <u>01_GEN_41_29</u># Behold, there come seven years of great plenty throughout all the land of Egypt:
