plow all day [23 ISA 28 24](#) # Doth the plowman plow all day to sow? doth he open and break the clods of his ground?

plow and Jacob [28 HOS 10 11](#) # And Ephraim [is as] an heifer [that is] taught, [and] loveth to tread out [the corn]; but I passed over upon her fair neck: I will make Ephraim to ride; Judah shall plow, [and] Jacob shall break his clods.

plow and looking [42 LUK 09 62](#) # And Jesus said unto him, No man, having put his hand to the plow, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God.

plow by reason [20 PRO 20 04](#) # The sluggard will not plow by reason of the cold; [therefore] shall he beg in harvest, and [have] nothing.

plow in hope [46 ICO 09 10](#) # Or saith he [it] altogether for our sakes? For our sakes, no doubt, [this] is written: that he that ploweth should plow in hope; and that he that thresheth in hope should be partaker of his hope.

plow iniquity and [18 JOB 04 08](#) # Even as I have seen, they that plow iniquity, and sow wickedness, reap the same.

plow there with [30 AMO 06 12](#) # Shall horses run upon the rock? will [one] plow [there] with oxen? for ye have turned judgment into gall, and the fruit of righteousness into hemlock:

plow with an [05 DEU 22 10](#) # Thou shalt not plow with an ox and an ass together.

plow [09 ISA 14 14](#) # And that first slaughter, which Jonathan and his armourbearer made, was about twenty men, within as it were an half acre of land, [which] a yoke [of oxen might plow].

plowed as a [33 MIC 03 12](#) # Therefore shall Zion for your sake be plowed [as] a field, and Jerusalem shall become heaps, and the mountain of the house as the high places of the forest.

plowed like a [24 JER 26 18](#) # Micah the Morasthite prophesied in the days of Hezekiah king of Judah, and spake to all the people of Judah, saying, Thus saith the LORD of hosts; Zion shall be plowed [like] a field, and Jerusalem shall become heaps, and the mountain of the house as the high places of a forest.

plowed upon my [19 PSA 129 03](#) # The plowers plowed upon my back: they made long their furrows.

plowed wickedness ye [28 HOS 10 13](#) # Ye have plowed wickedness, ye have reaped iniquity; ye have eaten the fruit of lies: because thou didst trust in thy way, in the multitude of thy mighty men.

plowed with my [07 JUD 14 18](#) # And the men of the city said unto him on the seventh day before the sun went down, What [is] sweeter than honey? and what [is] stronger than a lion? And he said unto them, If ye had not plowed with my heifer, ye had not found out my riddle.

plowers plowed upon [19 PSA 129 03](#) # The plowers plowed upon my back: they made long their furrows.

plowing with twelve [11 1KI 19 19](#) # So he departed thence, and found Elisha the son of Shaphat, who [was] plowing [with] twelve yoke [of oxen] before him, and he with the twelfth; and Elijah passed by him, and cast his mantle upon him.

plowman shall overtake [30 AMO 09 13](#) # Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that the plowman shall overtake the reaper, and the treader of grapes him that soweth seed; and the mountains shall drop sweet wine, and all the hills shall melt.

plowmen and your [23 ISA 61 05](#) # And strangers shall stand and feed your flocks, and the sons of the alien [shall be] your plowmen and your vinedressers.

plowmen were ashamed [24 JER 14 04](#) # Because the ground is chapt, for there was no rain in the earth, the plowmen were ashamed, they covered their heads.

plowshares and their [23 ISA 02 04](#) # And he shall judge among the nations, and shall rebuke many people: and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks: nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more.

plowshares and their [33 MIC 04 03](#) # And he shall judge among many people, and rebuke strong nations afar off; and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks: nation shall not lift up a sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more.

plowshares into swords [29 JOE 03 10](#) # Beat your plowshares into swords, and your pruninghooks into spears: let the weak say, I [am] strong.
