poor a strength <u>23_ISA_25_04</u> # For thou hast been a strength to the poor, a strength to the needy in his distress, a refuge from the storm, a shadow from the heat, when the blast of the terrible ones [is] as a storm [against] the wall.

poor also and <u>19_PSA_72_12</u># For he shall deliver the needy when he crieth; the poor also, and [him] that hath no helper.

poor always with <u>40_MAT_26_11</u># For ye have the poor always with you; but me ye have not always.

poor always ye <u>43_JOH_12_08</u> # For the poor always ye have with you; but me ye have not always.

poor among men <u>23_ISA_29_19</u> # The meek also shall increase [their] joy in the LORD, and the poor among men shall rejoice in the Holy One of Israel.

poor among you <u>05_DEU_15_04</u> # Save when there shall be no poor among you; for the LORD shall greatly bless thee in the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee [for] an inheritance to possess it:

poor Anathoth <u>23_ISA_10_30</u># Lift up thy voice, O daughter of Gallim: cause it to be heard unto Laish, O poor Anathoth.

poor and a <u>21_ECC_04_13</u># Better [is] a poor and a wise child than an old and foolish king, who will no more be admonished.

poor and be <u>03_LEV_25_39</u># And if thy brother [that dwelleth] by thee be waxen poor, and be sold unto thee; thou shalt not compel him to serve as a bondservant:

poor and blind <u>66_REV_03_17</u># Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked:

poor and cannot <u>03_LEV_14_21</u> # And if he [be] poor, and cannot get so much; then he shall take one lamb [for] a trespass offering to be waved, to make an atonement for him, and one tenth deal of fine flour mingled with oil for a meat offering, and a log of oil;

poor and despiseth <u>19_PSA_69_33</u> # For the LORD heareth the poor, and despiseth not his prisoners.

poor and fallen <u>03_LEV_25_35</u> # And if thy brother be waxen poor, and fallen in decay with thee; then thou shalt relieve him: [yea, though he be] a stranger, or a sojourner; that he may live with thee.

poor and fatherless <u>19_PSA_82_03</u> # Defend the poor and fatherless: do justice to the afflicted and needy.

poor and hath <u>03_LEV_25_25</u> # If thy brother be waxen poor, and hath sold away [some] of his possession, and if any of his kin come to redeem it, then shall he redeem that which his brother sold.

poor and his <u>18_JOB_20_10</u># His children shall seek to please the poor, and his hands shall restore their goods.

poor and if <u>42_LUK_19_08</u> # And Zacchaeus stood, and said unto the Lord; Behold, Lord, the half of my goods I give to the poor; and if I have taken any thing from any man by false accusation, I restore [him]

fourfold.

poor and let <u>38_ZEC_07_10</u> # And oppress not the widow, nor the fatherless, the stranger, nor the poor; and let none of you imagine evil against his brother in your heart.

poor and maketh <u>09_1SA_02_07</u># The LORD maketh poor, and maketh rich: he bringeth low, and lifteth up.

poor and needy <u>05_DEU_24_14</u> # Thou shalt not oppress an hired servant [that is] poor and needy, [whether he be] of thy brethren, or of thy strangers that [are] in thy land within thy gates:

poor and needy <u>26_EZE_16_49</u> # Behold, this was the iniquity of thy sister Sodom, pride, fulness of bread, and abundance of idleness was in her and in her daughters, neither did she strengthen the hand of the poor and needy.

poor and needy <u>26_EZE_18_12</u> # Hath oppressed the poor and needy, hath spoiled by violence, hath not restored the pledge, and hath lifted up his eyes to the idols, hath committed abomination,

poor and needy <u>26_EZE_22_29</u># The people of the land have used oppression, and exercised robbery, and have vexed the poor and needy: yea, they have oppressed the stranger wrongfully.

poor and needy <u>23_ISA_41_17</u> # [When] the poor and needy seek water, and [there is] none, [and] their tongue faileth for thirst, I the LORD will hear them, I the God of Israel will not forsake them.

poor and needy <u>24_JER_22_16</u># He judged the cause of the poor and needy; then [it was] well [with him: was] not this to know me? saith the LORD.

poor and needy <u>18_JOB_24_14</u># The murderer rising with the light killeth the poor and needy, and in the night is as a thief.

poor and needy <u>20_PRO_31_09</u> # Open thy mouth, judge righteously, and plead the cause of the poor and needy.

poor and needy <u>19_PSA_109_16</u># Because that he remembered not to show mercy, but persecuted the poor and needy man, that he might even slay the broken in heart.

poor and needy <u>19_PSA_109_22</u> # For I [am] poor and needy, and my heart is wounded within me.

poor and needy <u>19_PSA_37_14</u> # The wicked have drawn out the sword, and have bent their bow, to cast down the poor and needy, [and] to slay such as be of upright conversation.

poor and needy <u>19_PSA_40_17</u> # But I [am] poor and needy; [yet] the Lord thinketh upon me: thou [art] my help and my deliverer; make no tarrying, O my God.

poor and needy <u>19_PSA_70_05</u> # But I [am] poor and needy: make haste unto me, O God: thou [art] my help and my deliverer; O LORD, make no tarrying.

poor and needy <u>19_PSA_72_13</u># He shall spare the poor and needy, and shall save the souls of the needy.

poor and needy <u>19_PSA_74_21</u># O let not the oppressed return ashamed: let the poor and needy praise thy name.

poor and needy <u>19_PSA_82_04</u> # Deliver the poor and needy: rid [them] out of the hand of the wicked.

poor and needy <u>19_PSA_86_01</u># A Prayer of David. Bow down thine ear, O LORD, hear me: for I [am]

poor and needy.

poor and of <u>23_ISA_66_02</u> # For all those [things] hath mine hand made, and all those [things] have been, saith the LORD: but to this [man] will I look, [even] to [him that is] poor and of a contrite spirit, and trembleth at my word.

poor and reprove <u>23_ISA_11_04</u># But with righteousness shall he judge the poor, and reprove with equity for the meek of the earth: and he shall smite the earth with the rod of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips shall he slay the wicked.

poor and sell <u>03_LEV_25_47</u> # And if a sojourner or stranger wax rich by thee, and thy brother [that dwelleth] by him wax poor, and sell himself unto the stranger [or] sojourner by thee, or to the stock of the stranger's family:

poor and setteth <u>05_DEU_24_15</u> # At his day thou shalt give [him] his hire, neither shall the sun go down upon it; for he [is] poor, and setteth his heart upon it: lest he cry against thee unto the LORD, and it be sin unto thee.

poor and sorrowful <u>19_PSA_69_29</u># But I [am] poor and sorrowful: let thy salvation, O God, set me up on high.

poor and steal <u>20_PRO_30_09</u># Lest I be full, and deny [thee], and say, Who [is] the LORD? or lest I be poor, and steal, and take the name of my God [in vain].

poor and stranger <u>03 LEV 19 10</u> # And thou shalt not glean thy vineyard, neither shalt thou gather [every] grape of thy vineyard; thou shalt leave them for the poor and stranger: I [am] the LORD your God.

poor and the <u>23_ISA_26_06</u># The foot shall tread it down, [even] the feet of the poor, [and] the steps of the needy.

poor and the <u>18_JOB_29_16</u># I [was] a father to the poor: and the cause [which] I knew not I searched out.

poor and the <u>42_LUK_14_21</u> # So that servant came, and showed his lord these things. Then the master of the house being angry said to his servant, Go out quickly into the streets and lanes of the city, and bring in hither the poor, and the maimed, and the halt, and the blind.

poor and the <u>20_PRO_22_07</u># The rich ruleth over the poor, and the borrower [is] servant to the lender.

poor and the <u>20_PRO_29_13</u># The poor and the deceitful man meet together: the LORD lighteneth both their eyes.

poor and the <u>19_PSA_35_10</u> # All my bones shall say, LORD, who [is] like unto thee, which deliverest the poor from him that is too strong for him, yea, the poor and the needy from him that spoileth him?

poor And they <u>41_MAR_14_05</u> # For it might have been sold for more than three hundred pence, and have been given to the poor. And they murmured against her.

poor and thou <u>42_LUK_18_22</u> # Now when Jesus heard these things, he said unto him, Yet lackest thou one thing: sell all that thou hast, and distribute unto the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, follow me.

poor and thou <u>41_MAR_10_21</u> # Then Jesus beholding him loved him, and said unto him, One thing thou lackest: go thy way, sell whatsoever thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, take up the cross, and follow me.

poor and thou <u>40_MAT_19_21</u># Jesus said unto him, If thou wilt be perfect, go [and] sell that thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come [and] follow me.

poor and though <u>46_1CO_13_03</u> # And though I bestow all my goods to feed [the poor], and though I give my body to be burned, and have not charity, it profiteth me nothing.

poor and to <u>05_DEU_15_11</u># For the poor shall never cease out of the land: therefore I command thee, saying, Thou shalt open thine hand wide unto thy brother, to thy poor, and to thy needy, in thy land.

poor and to <u>03_LEV_23_22</u> # And when ye reap the harvest of your land, thou shalt not make clean riddance of the corners of thy field when thou reapest, neither shalt thou gather any gleaning of thy harvest: thou shalt leave them unto the poor, and to the stranger: I [am] the LORD your God.

poor and turn <u>30_AMO_02_07</u># That pant after the dust of the earth on the head of the poor, and turn aside the way of the meek: and a man and his father will go in unto the [same] maid, to profane my holy name:

poor and very <u>01_GEN_41_19</u> # And, behold, seven other kine came up after them, poor and very ill favoured and leanfleshed, such as I never saw in all the land of Egypt for badness:

poor and violent <u>21_ECC_05_08</u># If thou seest the oppression of the poor, and violent perverting of judgment and justice in a province, marvel not at the matter: for [he that is] higher than the highest regardeth; and [there be] higher than they.

poor and ye <u>30_AMO_05_11</u># Forasmuch therefore as your treading [is] upon the poor, and ye take from him burdens of wheat: ye have built houses of hewn stone, but ye shall not dwell in them; ye have planted pleasant vineyards, but ye shall not drink wine of them.

poor because he <u>18_JOB_20_19</u># Because he hath oppressed [and] hath forsaken the poor; [because] he hath violently taken away an house which he builded not;

poor because he <u>20_PRO_22_22</u> # Rob not the poor, because he [is] poor: neither oppress the afflicted in the gate:

poor because the <u>19_PSA_14_06</u># Ye have shamed the counsel of the poor, because the LORD [is] his refuge.

poor brother and <u>05_DEU_15_09</u> # Beware that there be not a thought in thy wicked heart, saying, The seventh year, the year of release, is at hand; and thine eye be evil against thy poor brother, and thou givest him nought; and he cry unto the LORD against thee, and it be sin unto thee.

poor brother <u>05_DEU_15_07</u> # If there be among you a poor man of one of thy brethren within any of thy gates in thy land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not harden thine heart, nor shut thine hand from thy poor brother:

poor but because <u>43_JOH_12_06</u> # This he said, not that he cared for the poor; but because he was a thief, and had the bag, and bare what was put therein.

poor but the <u>20_PRO_29_07</u># The righteous considereth the cause of the poor: [but] the wicked regardeth not to know [it].

poor but there <u>20_PRO_13_23</u># Much food [is in] the tillage of the poor: but there is [that is] destroyed for want of judgment.

poor by thee <u>02_EXO_22_25</u># If thou lend money to [any of] my people [that is] poor by thee, thou shalt

not be to him as an usurer, neither shalt thou lay upon him usury.

poor committeth himself <u>19_PSA_10_14</u># Thou hast seen [it]: for thou beholdest mischief and spite, to requite [it] with thy hand: the poor committeth himself unto thee; thou art the helper of the fatherless.

poor do hate <u>20_PRO_19_07</u># All the brethren of the poor do hate him: how much more do his friends go far from him? he pursueth [them with] words, [yet] they [are] wanting [to him].

poor Do not <u>59_JAM_02_06</u># But ye have despised the poor. Do not rich men oppress you, and draw you before the judgment seats?

poor for a <u>30_AMO_02_06</u># Thus saith the LORD; For three transgressions of Israel, and for four, I will not turn away [the punishment] thereof; because they sold the righteous for silver, and the poor for a pair of shoes;

poor for ever <u>19_PSA_74_19</u> # O deliver not the soul of thy turtledove unto the multitude [of the wicked]: forget not the congregation of thy poor for ever.

poor for silver <u>30_AMO_08_06</u> # That we may buy the poor for silver, and the needy for a pair of shoes; [yea], and sell the refuse of the wheat?

poor for the <u>19_PSA_12_05</u># For the oppression of the poor, for the sighing of the needy, now will I arise, saith the LORD; I will set [him] in safety [from him that] puffeth at him.

poor for they <u>18_JOB_34_19</u># [How much less to him] that accepteth not the persons of princes, nor regardeth the rich more than the poor? for they all [are] the work of his hands.

poor for yours <u>42_LUK_06_20</u> # And he lifted up his eyes on his disciples, and said, Blessed [be ye] poor: for yours is the kingdom of God.

poor free and <u>66_REV_13_16</u># And he causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads:

poor from him <u>19_PSA_35_10</u> # All my bones shall say, LORD, who [is] like unto thee, which deliverest the poor from him that is too strong for him, yea, the poor and the needy from him that spoileth him?

poor from off <u>20_PRO_30_14</u> # [There is] a generation, whose teeth [are as] swords, and their jaw teeth [as] knives, to devour the poor from off the earth, and the needy from [among] men.

poor from the <u>24_JER_20_13</u># Sing unto the LORD, praise ye the LORD: for he hath delivered the soul of the poor from the hand of evildoers.

poor from the <u>18_JOB_05_15</u># But he saveth the poor from the sword, from their mouth, and from the hand of the mighty.

poor from their <u>18_JOB_31_16</u># If I have withheld the poor from [their] desire, or have caused the eyes of the widow to fail;

poor happy is <u>20_PRO_14_21</u># He that despiseth his neighbour sinneth: but he that hath mercy on the poor, happy [is] he.

poor hath hope <u>18_JOB_05_16</u> # So the poor hath hope, and iniquity stoppeth her mouth.

poor have the <u>40_MAT_11_05</u># The blind receive their sight, and the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, and the deaf hear, the dead are raised up, and the poor have the gospel preached to them.

poor he also <u>20_PRO_21_13</u># Whoso stoppeth his ears at the cry of the poor, he also shall cry himself, but shall not be heard.

poor he doth <u>19_PSA_10_09</u> # He lieth in wait secretly as a lion in his den: he lieth in wait to catch the poor: he doth catch the poor, when he draweth him into his net.

poor he hath <u>42_LUK_04_18</u> # The Spirit of the Lord [is] upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,

poor heareth not <u>20_PRO_13_08</u># The ransom of a man's life [are] his riches: but the poor heareth not rebuke.

poor his righteousness <u>47_2CO_09_09</u> # [As it is written, He hath dispersed abroad; he hath given to the poor: his righteousness remaineth for ever.

poor his righteousness <u>19_PSA_112_09</u># He hath dispersed, he hath given to the poor; his righteousness endureth for ever; his horn shall be exalted with honour.

poor his throne <u>20_PRO_29_14</u># The king that faithfully judgeth the poor, his throne shall be established for ever.

poor if it <u>27_DAN_04_27</u> # Wherefore, O king, let my counsel be acceptable unto thee, and break off thy sins by righteousness, and thine iniquities by showing mercy to the poor; if it may be a lengthening of thy tranquillity.

poor in his <u>02_EXO_23_06</u># Thou shalt not wrest the judgment of thy poor in his cause.

poor in his <u>18_JOB_36_15</u> # He delivereth the poor in his affliction, and openeth their ears in oppression.

poor in Manasseh <u>07_JUD_06_15</u> # And he said unto him, Oh my Lord, wherewith shall I save Israel? behold, my family [is] poor in Manasseh, and I [am] the least in my father's house.

poor in spirit <u>40_MAT_05_03</u># Blessed [are] the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

poor in the <u>30_AMO_05_12</u> # For I know your manifold transgressions, and your mighty sins: they afflict the just, they take a bribe, and they turn aside the poor in the gate [from their right].

poor innocents I <u>24_JER_02_34</u> # Also in thy skirts is found the blood of the souls of the poor innocents: I have not found it by secret search, but upon all these.

poor is hated <u>20_PRO_14_20</u># The poor is hated even of his own neighbour: but the rich [hath] many friends.

poor is in <u>23_ISA_03_14</u># The LORD will enter into judgment with the ancients of his people, and the princes thereof: for ye have eaten up the vineyard; the spoil of the poor [is] in your houses.

poor is like <u>20_PRO_28_03</u> # A poor man that oppresseth the poor [is like] a sweeping rain which leaveth no food.

poor is separated <u>20_PRO_19_04</u> # Wealth maketh many friends; but the poor is separated from his neighbour.

poor is their <u>20_PRO_10_15</u> # The rich man's wealth [is] his strong city: the destruction of the poor [is]

their poverty.

poor lendeth unto <u>20_PRO_19_17</u># He that hath pity upon the poor lendeth unto the LORD; and that which he hath given will he pay him again.

poor let them <u>19_PSA_10_02</u># The wicked in [his] pride doth persecute the poor: let them be taken in the devices that they have imagined.

poor man and <u>09_1SA_18_23</u> # And Saul's servants spake those words in the ears of David. And David said, Seemeth it to you [a] light [thing] to be a king's son in law, seeing that I [am] a poor man, and lightly esteemed?

poor man cried <u>19_PSA_34_06</u># This poor man cried, and the LORD heard [him], and saved him out of all his troubles.

poor man had <u>10_2SA_12_03</u> # But the poor [man] had nothing, save one little ewe lamb, which he had bought and nourished up: and it grew up together with him, and with his children; it did eat of his own meat, and drank of his own cup, and lay in his bosom, and was unto him as a daughter.

poor man he <u>20_PRO_21_17</u># He that loveth pleasure [shall be] a poor man: he that loveth wine and oil shall not be rich.

poor man in <u>02_EXO_23_03</u> # Neither shalt thou countenance a poor man in his cause.

poor man in <u>59_JAM_02_02</u> # For if there come unto your assembly a man with a gold ring, in goodly apparel, and there come in also a poor man in vile raiment;

poor man is **<u>20_PRO_19_22</u>**# The desire of a man [is] his kindness: and a poor man [is] better than a liar.

poor man of <u>05_DEU_15_07</u> # If there be among you a poor man of one of thy brethren within any of thy gates in thy land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not harden thine heart, nor shut thine hand from thy poor brother:

poor man that <u>20_PRO_28_03</u># A poor man that oppresseth the poor [is like] a sweeping rain which leaveth no food.

poor man <u>21_ECC_09_15</u> # Now there was found in it a poor wise man, and he by his wisdom delivered the city; yet no man remembered that same poor man.

poor man's lamb <u>10_2SA_12_04</u> # And there came a traveller unto the rich man, and he spared to take of his own flock and of his own herd, to dress for the wayfaring man that was come unto him; but took the poor man's lamb, and dressed it for the man that was come to him.

poor man's wisdom <u>21_ECC_09_16</u> # Then said I, Wisdom [is] better than strength: nevertheless the poor man's wisdom [is] despised, and his words are not heard.

poor may fall <u>19_PSA_10_10</u> # He croucheth, [and] humbleth himself, that the poor may fall by his strong ones.

poor meet together <u>20_PRO_22_02</u># The rich and poor meet together: the LORD [is] the maker of them all.

poor neither oppress <u>20_PRO_22_22</u> # Rob not the poor, because he [is] poor: neither oppress the afflicted in the gate:

poor nor honour <u>03_LEV_19_15</u> # Ye shall do no unrighteousness in judgment: thou shalt not respect the person of the poor, nor honour the person of the mighty: [but] in righteousness shalt thou judge thy neighbour.

poor of his <u>23_ISA_14_32</u> # What shall [one] then answer the messengers of the nation? That the LORD hath founded Zion, and the poor of his people shall trust in it.

poor of my <u>23_ISA_10_02</u> # To turn aside the needy from judgment, and to take away the right from the poor of my people, that widows may be their prey, and [that] they may rob the fatherless!

poor of the <u>12_2KI_25_12</u># But the captain of the guard left of the poor of the land [to be] vinedressers and husbandmen.

poor of the <u>30_AMO_08_04</u> # Hear this, O ye that swallow up the needy, even to make the poor of the land to fail,

poor of the <u>24_JER_39_10</u># But Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard left of the poor of the people, which had nothing, in the land of Judah, and gave them vineyards and fields at the same time.

poor of the <u>24_JER_40_07</u> # Now when all the captains of the forces which [were] in the fields, [even] they and their men, heard that the king of Babylon had made Gedaliah the son of Ahikam governor in the land, and had committed unto him men, and women, and children, and of the poor of the land, of them that were not carried away captive to Babylon;

poor of the <u>24_JER_52_15</u> # Then Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard carried away captive [certain] of the poor of the people, and the residue of the people that remained in the city, and those that fell away, that fell to the king of Babylon, and the rest of the multitude.

poor of the <u>24_JER_52_16</u># But Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard left [certain] of the poor of the land for vinedressers and for husbandmen.

poor of the <u>18_JOB_24_04</u> # They turn the needy out of the way: the poor of the earth hide themselves together.

poor of the <u>19_PSA_72_04</u># He shall judge the poor of the people, he shall save the children of the needy, and shall break in pieces the oppressor.

poor of the <u>38_ZEC_11_07</u># And I will feed the flock of slaughter, [even] you, O poor of the flock. And I took unto me two staves; the one I called Beauty, and the other I called Bands; and I fed the flock.

poor of the <u>38_ZEC_11_11</u># And it was broken in that day: and so the poor of the flock that waited upon me knew that it [was] the word of the LORD.

poor of this <u>59_JAM_02_05</u> # Hearken, my beloved brethren, Hath not God chosen the poor of this world rich in faith, and heirs of the kingdom which he hath promised to them that love him?

poor of thy <u>02_EXO_23_11</u># But the seventh [year] thou shalt let it rest and lie still; that the poor of thy people may eat: and what they leave the beasts of the field shall eat. In like manner thou shalt deal with thy vineyard, [and] with thy oliveyard.

poor on high <u>19_PSA_107_41</u># Yet setteth he the poor on high from affliction, and maketh [him] families like a flock.

poor or rich <u>08_RUT_03_10</u> # And he said, Blessed [be] thou of the LORD, my daughter: [for] thou hast showed more kindness in the latter end than at the beginning, inasmuch as thou followedst not young men,

whether poor or rich.

poor out of <u>09_1SA_02_08</u> # He raiseth up the poor out of the dust, [and] lifteth up the beggar from the dunghill, to set [them] among princes, and to make them inherit the throne of glory: for the pillars of the earth [are] the LORD's, and he hath set the world upon them.

poor out of <u>19_PSA_113_07</u># He raiseth up the poor out of the dust, [and] lifteth the needy out of the dunghill;

poor people and <u>36_ZEP_03_12</u># I will also leave in the midst of thee an afflicted and poor people, and they shall trust in the name of the LORD.

poor people <u>20_PRO_28_15</u> # [As] a roaring lion, and a ranging bear; [so is] a wicked ruler over the poor people.

poor reproacheth his <u>20_PRO_14_31</u> # He that oppresseth the poor reproacheth his Maker: but he that honoureth him hath mercy on the poor.

poor reproacheth his <u>20_PRO_17_05</u># Whoso mocketh the poor reproacheth his Maker: [and] he that is glad at calamities shall not be unpunished.

poor saints which <u>45_ROM_15_26</u># For it hath pleased them of Macedonia and Achaia to make a certain contribution for the poor saints which are at Jerusalem.

poor saith the <u>23_ISA_03_15</u> # What mean ye [that] ye beat my people to pieces, and grind the faces of the poor? saith the Lord GOD of hosts.

poor secretly <u>35_HAB_03_14</u> # Thou didst strike through with his staves the head of his villages: they came out as a whirlwind to scatter me: their rejoicing [was] as to devour the poor secretly.

poor shall feed <u>23_ISA_14_30</u> # And the firstborn of the poor shall feed, and the needy shall lie down in safety: and I will kill thy root with famine, and he shall slay thy remnant.

poor shall never <u>05_DEU_15_11</u># For the poor shall never cease out of the land: therefore I command thee, saying, Thou shalt open thine hand wide unto thy brother, to thy poor, and to thy needy, in thy land.

poor shall not <u>02_EXO_30_15</u># The rich shall not give more, and the poor shall not give less than half a shekel, when [they] give an offering unto the LORD, to make an atonement for your souls.

poor shall not <u>20_PRO_28_27</u># He that giveth unto the poor shall not lack: but he that hideth his eyes shall have many a curse.

poor shall not <u>19_PSA_09_18</u># For the needy shall not alway be forgotten: the expectation of the poor shall [not] perish for ever.

poor Stand thou <u>59_JAM_02_03</u> # And ye have respect to him that weareth the gay clothing, and say unto him, Sit thou here in a good place; and say to the poor, Stand thou there, or sit here under my footstool:

poor that are <u>23_ISA_58_07</u> # [Is it] not to deal thy bread to the hungry, and that thou bring the poor that are cast out to thy house? when thou seest the naked, that thou cover him; and that thou hide not thyself from thine own flesh?

poor that cried <u>18_JOB_29_12</u> # Because I delivered the poor that cried, and the fatherless, and [him that had] none to help him.

poor that dealeth <u>20_PRO_10_04</u> # He becometh poor that dealeth [with] a slack hand: but the hand of the diligent maketh rich.

poor that hath <u>26_EZE_18_17</u> # [That] hath taken off his hand from the poor, [that] hath not received usury nor increase, hath executed my judgments, hath walked in my statutes; he shall not die for the iniquity of his father, he shall surely live.

poor that hath <u>20_PRO_28_11</u># The rich man [is] wise in his own conceit; but the poor that hath understanding searcheth him out.

poor that knoweth <u>21_ECC_06_08</u># For what hath the wise more than the fool? what hath the poor, that knoweth to walk before the living?

poor that walketh <u>20_PRO_19_01</u># Better [is] the poor that walketh in his integrity, than [he that is] perverse in his lips, and is a fool.

poor that walketh <u>20_PRO_28_06</u># Better [is] the poor that walketh in his uprightness, than [he that is] perverse [in his] ways, though he [be] rich.

poor that ye <u>47_2CO_08_09</u> # For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich.

poor the gospel <u>42_LUK_07_22</u> # Then Jesus answering said unto them, Go your way, and tell John what things ye have seen and heard; how that the blind see, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, to the poor the gospel is preached.

poor the LORD <u>19_PSA_41_01</u> # To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. Blessed [is] he that considereth the poor: the LORD will deliver him in time of trouble.

poor the maimed <u>42_LUK_14_13</u> # But when thou makest a feast, call the poor, the maimed, the lame, the blind:

poor the same <u>48_GAL_02_10</u> # Only [they would] that we should remember the poor; the same which I also was forward to do.

poor they are <u>24_JER_05_04</u> # Therefore I said, Surely these [are] poor; they are foolish: for they know not the way of the LORD, [nor] the judgment of their God.

poor thou shalt <u>05_DEU_24_12</u> # And if the man [be] poor, thou shalt not sleep with his pledge:

poor to come <u>18_JOB_34_28</u># So that they cause the cry of the poor to come unto him, and he heareth the cry of the afflicted.

poor to increase <u>20_PRO_22_16</u># He that oppresseth the poor to increase his [riches, and] he that giveth to the rich, [shall] surely [come] to want.

poor to save <u>19_PSA_109_31</u> # For he shall stand at the right hand of the poor, to save [him] from those that condemn his soul.

poor together <u>19_PSA_49_02</u> # Both low and high, rich and poor, together.

poor useth entreaties <u>20_PRO_18_23</u> # The poor useth entreaties; but the rich answereth roughly.

poor when he <u>19_PSA_10_09</u> # He lieth in wait secretly as a lion in his den: he lieth in wait to catch the poor: he doth catch the poor, when he draweth him into his net.

poor which crush <u>30_AMO_04_01</u># Hear this word, ye kine of Bashan, that [are] in the mountain of Samaria, which oppress the poor, which crush the needy, which say to their masters, Bring, and let us drink.

poor widow and <u>41_MAR_12_42</u># And there came a certain poor widow, and she threw in two mites, which make a farthing.

poor widow casting <u>42_LUK_21_02</u> # And he saw also a certain poor widow casting in thither two mites.

poor widow hath <u>42_LUK_21_03</u># And he said, Of a truth I say unto you, that this poor widow hath cast in more than they all:

poor widow hath <u>41_MAR_12_43</u># And he called [unto him] his disciples, and saith unto them, Verily I say unto you, That this poor widow hath cast more in, than all they which have cast into the treasury:

poor wise man <u>21_ECC_09_15</u> # Now there was found in it a poor wise man, and he by his wisdom delivered the city; yet no man remembered that same poor man.

poor with bread <u>19_PSA_132_15</u># I will abundantly bless her provision: I will satisfy her poor with bread.

poor with judgment <u>19_PSA_72_02</u># He shall judge thy people with righteousness, and thy poor with judgment.

poor with lying <u>23_ISA_32_07</u># The instruments also of the churl [are] evil: he deviseth wicked devices to destroy the poor with lying words, even when the needy speaketh right.

poor with you <u>41_MAR_14_07</u> # For ye have the poor with you always, and whensoever ye will ye may do them good: but me ye have not always.

poor without covering <u>18_JOB_31_19</u># If I have seen any perish for want of clothing, or any poor without covering;

poor yea she <u>20_PRO_31_20</u># She stretcheth out her hand to the poor; yea, she reacheth forth her hands to the needy.

poor yet hath <u>20_PRO_13_07</u> # There is that maketh himself rich, yet [hath] nothing: [there is] that maketh himself poor, yet [hath] great riches.

poor yet making <u>47_2CO_06_10</u> # As sorrowful, yet alway rejoicing; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, and [yet] possessing all things.

poor <u>10_2SA_12_01</u> # And the LORD sent Nathan unto David. And he came unto him, and said unto him, There were two men in one city; the one rich, and the other poor.

poor <u>21_ECC_04_14</u># For out of prison he cometh to reign; whereas also [he that is] born in his kingdom becometh poor.

poor <u>17_EST_09_22</u> # As the days wherein the Jews rested from their enemies, and the month which was turned unto them from sorrow to joy, and from mourning into a good day: that they should make them days of feasting and joy, and of sending portions one to another, and gifts to the poor.

poor <u>18_JOB_24_09</u># They pluck the fatherless from the breast, and take a pledge of the poor.

poor <u>18_JOB_30_25</u> # Did not I weep for him that was in trouble? was [not] my soul grieved for the poor?

poor <u>18_JOB_36_06</u># He preserveth not the life of the wicked: but giveth right to the poor.

poor <u>43_JOH_12_05</u> # Why was not this ointment sold for three hundred pence, and given to the poor?

poor <u>43_JOH_13_29</u># For some [of them] thought, because Judas had the bag, that Jesus had said unto him, Buy [those things] that we have need of against the feast; or, that he should give something to the poor.

poor <u>40_MAT_26_09</u># For this ointment might have been sold for much, and given to the poor.

poor <u>20_PRO_14_31</u># He that oppresseth the poor reproacheth his Maker: but he that honoureth him hath mercy on the poor.

poor <u>20_PRO_22_09</u> # He that hath a bountiful eye shall be blessed; for he giveth of his bread to the poor.

poor <u>20_PRO_28_08</u># He that by usury and unjust gain increaseth his substance, he shall gather it for him that will pity the poor.

poor <u>19_PSA_10_08</u> # He sitteth in the lurking places of the villages: in the secret places doth he murder the innocent: his eyes are privily set against the poor.

poor <u>19_PSA_140_12</u> # I know that the LORD will maintain the cause of the afflicted, [and] the right of the poor.

poor <u>19_PSA_68_10</u> # Thy congregation hath dwelt therein: thou, O God, hast prepared of thy goodness for the poor.

poorer than thy <u>03_LEV_27_08</u> # But if he be poorer than thy estimation, then he shall present himself before the priest, and the priest shall value him; according to his ability that vowed shall the priest value him.

poorest sort of <u>12_2KI_24_14</u> # And he carried away all Jerusalem, and all the princes, and all the mighty men of valour, [even] ten thousand captives, and all the craftsmen and smiths: none remained, save the poorest sort of the people of the land.
