porters Akkub Talmon <u>16 NEH_11_19</u># Moreover the porters, Akkub, Talmon, and their brethren that kept the gates, [were] an hundred seventy and two.

porters also by 14 2CH 08 14 # And he appointed, according to the order of David his father, the courses of the priests to their service, and the Levites to their charges, to praise and minister before the priests, as the duty of every day required: the porters also by their courses at every gate: for so had David the man of God commanded.

porters among the <u>13_1CH_26_19</u> # These [are] the divisions of the porters among the sons of Kore, and among the sons of Merari.

porters and four <u>13_1CH_23_05</u> # Moreover four thousand [were] porters; and four thousand praised the LORD with the instruments which I made, [said David], to praise [therewith].

porters and the <u>15_EZR_02_70</u># So the priests, and the Levites, and [some] of the people, and the singers, and the porters, and the Nethinims, dwelt in their cities, and all Israel in their cities.

porters and the <u>15_EZR_07_07</u># And there went up [some] of the children of Israel, and of the priests, and the Levites, and the singers, and the porters, and the Nethinims, unto Jerusalem, in the seventh year of Artaxerxes the king.

porters and the <u>16_NEH_07_01</u># Now it came to pass, when the wall was built, and I had set up the doors, and the porters and the singers and the Levites were appointed,

porters and the <u>16_NEH_07_73</u># So the priests, and the Levites, and the porters, and the singers, and [some] of the people, and the Nethinims, and all Israel, dwelt in their cities; and when the seventh month came, the children of Israel [were] in their cities.

porters and the <u>16_NEH_10_39</u># For the children of Israel and the children of Levi shall bring the offering of the corn, of the new wine, and the oil, unto the chambers, where [are] the vessels of the sanctuary, and the priests that minister, and the porters, and the singers: and we will not forsake the house of our God.

porters and the <u>16_NEH_13_05</u># And he had prepared for him a great chamber, where aforetime they laid the meat offerings, the frankincense, and the vessels, and the tithes of the corn, the new wine, and the oil, which was commanded [to be given] to the Levites, and the singers, and the porters; and the offerings of the priests.

porters and they 12_2KI_07_11 # And he called the porters; and they told [it] to the king's house within.

porters at the <u>14_2CH_23_19</u># And he set the porters at the gates of the house of the LORD, that none [which was] unclean in any thing should enter in.

porters even among <u>13_1CH_26_12</u> # Among these [were] the divisions of the porters, [even] among the chief men, [having] wards one against another, to minister in the house of the LORD.

porters every day <u>16_NEH_12_47</u># And all Israel in the days of Zerubbabel, and in the days of Nehemiah, gave the portions of the singers and the porters, every day his portion: and they sanctified [holy things] unto the Levites; and the Levites sanctified [them] unto the children of Aaron.

porters in the <u>13_1CH_09_18</u># Who hitherto [waited] in the king's gate eastward: they [were] porters in the companies of the children of Levi.

porters in the <u>13_1CH_09_22</u># All these [which were] chosen to be porters in the gates [were] two hundred and twelve. These were reckoned by their genealogy in their villages, whom David and Samuel the seer did ordain in their set office.

porters keeping the <u>16_NEH_12_25</u># Mattaniah, and Bakbukiah, Obadiah, Meshullam, Talmon, Akkub, [were] porters keeping the ward at the thresholds of the gates.

porters kept the <u>16_NEH_12_45</u># And both the singers and the porters kept the ward of their God, and the ward of the purification, according to the commandment of David, [and] of Solomon his son.

porters Nethinims or <u>15_EZR_07_24</u># Also we certify you, that touching any of the priests and Levites, singers, porters, Nethinims, or ministers of this house of God, it shall not be lawful to impose toll, tribute, or custom, upon them.

porters Of the <u>13_1CH_26_01</u> # Concerning the divisions of the porters: Of the Korhites [was] Meshelemiah the son of Kore, of the sons of Asaph.

porters of the <u>14_2CH_23_04</u> # This [is] the thing that ye shall do; A third part of you entering on the sabbath, of the priests and of the Levites, [shall be] porters of the doors;

porters Shallum and <u>15_EZR_10_24</u># Of the singers also; Eliashib: and of the porters; Shallum, and Telem, and Uri.

porters the children <u>15_EZR_02_42</u># The children of the porters: the children of Shallum, the children of Ater, the children of Talmon, the children of Akkub, the children of Hatita, the children of Shobai, [in] all an hundred thirty and nine.

porters the children <u>16_NEH_07_45</u># The porters: the children of Shallum, the children of Ater, the children of Talmon, the children of Akkub, the children of Hatita, the children of Shobai, an hundred thirty and eight.

porters the singers <u>16_NEH_10_28</u># And the rest of the people, the priests, the Levites, the porters, the singers, the Nethinims, and all they that had separated themselves from the people of the lands unto the law of God, their wives, their sons, and their daughters, every one having knowledge, and having understanding;

porters toward the <u>13_1CH_09_24</u># In four quarters were the porters, toward the east, west, north, and south.

porters waited at <u>14_2CH_35_15</u># And the singers the sons of Asaph [were] in their place, according to the commandment of David, and Asaph, and Heman, and Jeduthun the king's seer; and the porters [waited] at every gate; they might not depart from their service; for their brethren the Levites prepared for them.

porters were in <u>13_1CH_09_26</u> # For these Levites, the four chief porters, were in [their] set office, and were over the chambers and treasuries of the house of God.

porters were Shallum <u>13_1CH_09_17</u># And the porters [were], Shallum, and Akkub, and Talmon, and Ahiman, and their brethren: Shallum [was] the chief;

porters <u>13_1CH_15_18</u># And with them their brethren of the second [degree], Zechariah, Ben, and Jaaziel, and Shemiramoth, and Jehiel, and Unni, Eliab, and Benaiah, and Maaseiah, and Mattithiah, and Elipheleh,

and Mikneiah, and Obededom, and Jeiel, the porters.

porters <u>13_1CH_16_38</u># And Obededom with their brethren, threescore and eight; Obededom also the son of Jeduthun and Hosah [to be] porters:

porters <u>13_1CH_16_42</u># And with them Heman and Jeduthun with trumpets and cymbals for those that should make a sound, and with musical instruments of God. And the sons of Jeduthun [were] porters.

porters <u>14_2CH_34_13</u> # Also [they were] over the bearers of burdens, and [were] overseers of all that wrought the work in any manner of service: and of the Levites [there were] scribes, and officers, and porters.
