apothecaries and they <u>16_NEH_03_08</u># Next unto him repaired Uzziel the son of Harhaiah, of the goldsmiths. Next unto him also repaired Hananiah the son of [one of] the apothecaries, and they fortified Jerusalem unto the broad wall.

apothecaries art and <u>14_2CH_16_14</u> # And they buried him in his own sepulchres, which he had made for himself in the city of David, and laid him in the bed which was filled with sweet odours and divers kinds [of spices] prepared by the apothecaries' art: and they made a very great burning for him.

apothecary it shall <u>02_EXO_30_25</u># And thou shalt make it an oil of holy ointment, an ointment compound after the art of the apothecary: it shall be an holy anointing oil.

impotent folk of <u>43_JOH_05_03</u># In these lay a great multitude of impotent folk, of blind, halt, withered, waiting for the moving of the water.

impotent in his <u>44_ACT_14_08</u> # And there sat a certain man at Lystra, impotent in his feet, being a cripple from his mother's womb, who never had walked:

pots and cups <u>41_MAR_07_08</u> # For laying aside the commandment of God, ye hold the tradition of men, [as] the washing of pots and cups: and many other such like things ye do.

waterpots with water <u>43_JOH_02_07</u> # Jesus saith unto them, Fill the waterpots with water. And they filled them up to the brim.
