pray about the <u>44_ACT_10_09</u> # On the morrow, as they went on their journey, and drew nigh unto the city, Peter went up upon the housetop to pray about the sixth hour:

pray always for <u>53_2TH_01_11</u># Wherefore also we pray always for you, that our God would count you worthy of [this] calling, and fulfil all the good pleasure of [his] goodness, and the work of faith with power:

pray always that <u>42_LUK_21_36</u># Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man.

pray and continued <u>42_LUK_06_12</u> # And it came to pass in those days, that he went out into a mountain to pray, and continued all night in prayer to God.

pray and cry <u>19_PSA_55_17</u># Evening, and morning, and at noon, will I pray, and cry aloud: and he shall hear my voice.

pray and make <u>11_1KI_08_33</u># When thy people Israel be smitten down before the enemy, because they have sinned against thee, and shall turn again to thee, and confess thy name, and pray, and make supplication unto thee in this house:

pray and make <u>14_2CH_06_24</u># And if thy people Israel be put to the worse before the enemy, because they have sinned against thee; and shall return and confess thy name, and pray and make supplication before thee in this house;

pray and not <u>42_LUK_18_01</u> # And he spake a parable unto them [to this end], that men ought always to pray, and not to faint;

pray and seek <u>14_2CH_07_14</u># If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

pray and the <u>40_MAT_19_13</u># Then were there brought unto him little children, that he should put [his] hands on them, and pray: and the disciples rebuked them.

pray and when <u>40_MAT_14_23</u># And when he had sent the multitudes away, he went up into a mountain apart to pray: and when the evening was come, he was there alone.

pray as John <u>42_LUK_11_01</u># And it came to pass, that, as he was praying in a certain place, when he ceased, one of his disciples said unto him, Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples.

pray before the <u>38_ZEC_07_02</u> # When they had sent unto the house of God Sherezer and Regemmelech, and their men, to pray before the LORD,

pray before the <u>38_ZEC_08_21</u> # And the inhabitants of one [city] shall go to another, saying, Let us go speedily to pray before the LORD, and to seek the LORD of hosts: I will go also.

pray before the <u>38_ZEC_08_22</u> # Yea, many people and strong nations shall come to seek the LORD of hosts in Jerusalem, and to pray before the LORD.

pray before thee <u>13_1CH_17_25</u> # For thou, O my God, hast told thy servant that thou wilt build him an house: therefore thy servant hath found [in his heart] to pray before thee.

pray before thee <u>16_NEH_01_06</u> # Let thine ear now be attentive, and thine eyes open, that thou mayest hear the prayer of thy servant, which I pray before thee now, day and night, for the children of Israel thy servants, and confess the sins of the children of Israel, which we have sinned against thee: both I and my father's house have sinned.

pray believe that <u>41_MAR_11_24</u># Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive [them], and ye shall have [them].

pray but he <u>23_ISA_16_12</u> # And it shall come to pass, when it is seen that Moab is weary on the high place, that he shall come to his sanctuary to pray; but he shall not prevail.

pray every where <u>54_1TI_02_08</u># I will therefore that men pray every where, lifting up holy hands, without wrath and doubting.

pray for as <u>45_ROM_08_26</u># Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

pray for it <u>62_1JO_05_16</u># If any man see his brother sin a sin [which is] not unto death, he shall ask, and he shall give him life for them that sin not unto death. There is a sin unto death: I do not say that he shall pray for it.

pray for me <u>11_1KI_13_06</u># And the king answered and said unto the man of God, Entreat now the face of the LORD thy God, and pray for me, that my hand may be restored me again. And the man of God besought the LORD, and the king's hand was restored him again, and became as [it was] before.

pray for the <u>15_EZR_06_10</u># That they may offer sacrifices of sweet savours unto the God of heaven, and pray for the life of the king, and of his sons.

Pray for the <u>19_PSA_122_06</u> # Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: they shall prosper that love thee.

pray for thee <u>01_GEN_20_07</u> # Now therefore restore the man [his] wife; for he [is] a prophet, and he shall pray for thee, and thou shalt live: and if thou restore [her] not, know thou that thou shalt surely die, thou, and all that [are] thine.

pray for them <u>43_JOH_17_09</u># I pray for them: I pray not for the world, but for them which thou hast given me; for they are thine.

pray for them <u>42_LUK_06_28</u> # Bless them that curse you, and pray for them which despitefully use you.

pray for them <u>40_MAT_05_44</u># But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you;

Pray for thy <u>09_1SA_12_19</u># And all the people said unto Samuel, Pray for thy servants unto the LORD thy God, that we die not: for we have added unto all our sins [this] evil, to ask us a king.

pray for us <u>52_1TH_05_25</u> # Brethren, pray for us.

pray for us <u>53_2TH_03_01</u> # Finally, brethren, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may have [free] course, and be glorified, even as [it is] with you:

Pray for us <u>58_HEB_13_18</u> # Pray for us: for we trust we have a good conscience, in all things willing to

live honestly.

pray for us 24_JER_42_02 # And said unto Jeremiah the prophet, Let, we beseech thee, our supplication be accepted before thee, and pray for us unto the LORD thy God, [even] for all this remnant; [for we are left [but] a few of many, as thine eyes do behold us:]

Pray for us <u>24_JER_42_20</u># For ye dissembled in your hearts, when ye sent me unto the LORD your God, saying, Pray for us unto the LORD our God; and according unto all that the LORD our God shall say, so declare unto us, and we will do [it].

pray for ye <u>41_MAR_13_33</u># Take ye heed, watch and pray: for ye know not when the time is.

pray for you <u>09_18A_07_05</u># And Samuel said, Gather all Israel to Mizpeh, and I will pray for you unto the LORD.

pray for you <u>09_1SA_12_23</u># Moreover as for me, God forbid that I should sin against the LORD in ceasing to pray for you: but I will teach you the good and the right way:

pray for you <u>51_COL_01_09</u># For this cause we also, since the day we heard [it], do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding;

pray for you <u>18_JOB_42_08</u> # Therefore take unto you now seven bullocks and seven rams, and go to my servant Job, and offer up for yourselves a burnt offering; and my servant Job shall pray for you: for him will I accept: lest I deal with you [after your] folly, in that ye have not spoken of me [the thing which is] right, like my servant Job.

pray God if <u>44_ACT_08_22</u> # Repent therefore of this thy wickedness, and pray God, if perhaps the thought of thine heart may be forgiven thee.

pray God that <u>55_2TI_04_16</u># At my first answer no man stood with me, but all [men] forsook me: [I pray God] that it may not be laid to their charge.

pray God your <u>52_1TH_05_23</u># And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and [I pray God] your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

pray him to <u>41_MAR_05_17</u> # And they began to pray him to depart out of their coasts.

pray I for <u>43_JOH_17_20</u># Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word;

pray in an <u>46_1CO_14_14</u># For if I pray in an [unknown] tongue, my spirit prayeth, but my understanding is unfruitful.

pray in this <u>14_2CH_06_32</u> # Moreover concerning the stranger, which is not of thy people Israel, but is come from a far country for thy great name's sake, and thy mighty hand, and thy stretched out arm; if they come and pray in this house;

pray Is any <u>59_JAM_05_13</u> # Is any among you afflicted? let him pray. Is any merry? let him sing psalms.

pray lest ye <u>42_LUK_22_46</u># And said unto them, Why sleep ye? rise and pray, lest ye enter into temptation.

pray lest ye <u>41_MAR_14_38</u> # Watch ye and pray, lest ye enter into temptation. The spirit truly [is] ready, but the flesh [is] weak.

Pray not for 24_JER_14_11 # Then said the LORD unto me, Pray not for this people for [their] good.

pray not for <u>43_JOH_17_09</u># I pray for them: I pray not for the world, but for them which thou hast given me; for they are thine.

pray not that <u>43_JOH_17_15</u> # I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil.

pray not thou <u>24_JER_07_16</u># Therefore pray not thou for this people, neither lift up cry nor prayer for them, neither make intercession to me: for I will not hear thee.

pray not thou <u>24_JER_11_14</u># Therefore pray not thou for this people, neither lift up a cry or prayer for them: for I will not hear [them] in the time that they cry unto me for their trouble.

pray now and <u>07_JUD_09_38</u># Then said Zebul unto him, Where [is] now thy mouth, wherewith thou saidst, Who [is] Abimelech, that we should serve him? [is] not this the people that thou hast despised? go out, I pray now, and fight with them.

Pray now unto 24_JER_37_03 # And Zedekiah the king sent Jehucal the son of Shelemiah and Zephaniah the son of Maaseiah the priest to the prophet Jeremiah, saying, Pray now unto the LORD our God for us.

pray one for <u>59_JAM_05_16</u> # Confess [your] faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.

pray over him <u>59_JAM_05_14</u> # Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:

pray say Our <u>42_LUK_11_02</u># And he said unto them, When ye pray, say, Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven, so in earth.

pray standing in <u>40_MAT_06_05</u># And when thou prayest, thou shalt not be as the hypocrites [are]: for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and in the corners of the streets, that they may be seen of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward.

pray that he <u>46_1CO_14_13</u># Wherefore let him that speaketh in an [unknown] tongue pray that he may interpret.

Pray that ye <u>42_LUK_22_40</u> # And when he was at the place, he said unto them, Pray that ye enter not into temptation.

pray that ye <u>40_MAT_26_41</u># Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed [is] willing, but the flesh [is] weak.

pray that your <u>50_PHP_01_09</u> # And this I pray, that your love may abound yet more and more in knowledge and [in] all judgment;

pray the Father <u>43_JOH_14_16</u> # And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;

pray the Father <u>43_JOH_16_26</u># At that day ye shall ask in my name: and I say not unto you, that I will pray the Father for you:

pray the one <u>42_LUK_18_10</u> # Two men went up into the temple to pray; the one a Pharisee, and the other a publican.

pray thee a <u>11_1KI_17_10</u># So he arose and went to Zarephath. And when he came to the gate of the city, behold, the widow woman [was] there gathering of sticks: and he called to her, and said, Fetch me, I pray thee, a little water in a vessel, that I may drink.

pray thee a <u>11_1KI_17_11</u># And as she was going to fetch [it], he called to her, and said, Bring me, I pray thee, a morsel of bread in thine hand.

pray thee a <u>12_2KI_05_22</u> # And he said, All [is] well. My master hath sent me, saying, Behold, even now there be come to me from mount Ephraim two young men of the sons of the prophets: give them, I pray thee, a talent of silver, and two changes of garments.

pray thee a <u>01_GEN_24_43</u> # Behold, I stand by the well of water; and it shall come to pass, that when the virgin cometh forth to draw [water], and I say to her, Give me, I pray thee, a little water of thy pitcher to drink;

pray thee a <u>07_JUD_04_19</u># And he said unto her, Give me, I pray thee, a little water to drink; for I am thirsty. And she opened a bottle of milk, and gave him drink, and covered him.

pray thee all <u>12_2KI_08_04</u> # And the king talked with Gehazi the servant of the man of God, saying, Tell me, I pray thee, all the great things that Elisha hath done.

pray thee also <u>10_2SA_18_22</u> # Then said Ahimaaz the son of Zadok yet again to Joab, But howsoever, let me, I pray thee, also run after Cushi. And Joab said, Wherefore wilt thou run, my son, seeing that thou hast no tidings ready?

pray thee and <u>11_1KI_14_02</u># And Jeroboam said to his wife, Arise, I pray thee, and disguise thyself, that thou be not known to be the wife of Jeroboam; and get thee to Shiloh: behold, there [is] Ahijah the prophet, which told me that [I should be] king over this people.

pray thee And <u>11_1KI_20_35</u># And a certain man of the sons of the prophets said unto his neighbour in the word of the LORD, Smite me, I pray thee. And the man refused to smite him.

pray thee And <u>11_1KI_20_37</u># Then he found another man, and said, Smite me, I pray thee. And the man smote him, so that in smiting he wounded [him].

pray thee and <u>09_1SA_20_29</u># And he said, Let me go, I pray thee; for our family hath a sacrifice in the city; and my brother, he hath commanded me [to be there]: and now, if I have found favour in thine eyes, let me get away, I pray thee, and see my brethren. Therefore he cometh not unto the king's table.

pray thee and <u>12_2KI_02_16</u># And they said unto him, Behold now, there be with thy servants fifty strong men; let them go, we pray thee, and seek thy master: lest peradventure the spirit of the LORD hath taken him up, and cast him upon some mountain, or into some valley. And he said, Ye shall not send.

pray thee and <u>12_2KI_06_03</u># And one said, Be content, I pray thee, and go with thy servants. And he answered, I will go.

pray thee and <u>10_2SA_16_09</u># Then said Abishai the son of Zeruiah unto the king, Why should this dead dog curse my lord the king? let me go over, I pray thee, and take off his head.

pray thee and <u>02_EXO_04_18</u># And Moses went and returned to Jethro his father in law, and said unto him, Let me go, I pray thee, and return unto my brethren which [are] in Egypt, and see whether they be yet alive. And Jethro said to Moses, Go in peace.

pray thee and <u>01_GEN_50_05</u> # My father made me swear, saying, Lo, I die: in my grave which I have

digged for me in the land of Canaan, there shalt thou bury me. Now therefore let me go up, I pray thee, and bury my father, and I will come again.

pray thee and <u>23_ISA_29_11</u># And the vision of all is become unto you as the words of a book that is sealed, which [men] deliver to one that is learned, saying, Read this, I pray thee: and he saith, I cannot; for it [is] sealed:

pray thee and <u>23_ISA_29_12</u># And the book is delivered to him that is not learned, saying, Read this, I pray thee: and he saith, I am not learned.

pray thee and <u>24_JER_40_15</u> # Then Johanan the son of Kareah spake to Gedaliah in Mizpah secretly, saying, Let me go, I pray thee, and I will slay Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, and no man shall know [it]: wherefore should he slay thee, that all the Jews which are gathered unto thee should be scattered, and the remnant in Judah perish?

pray thee and <u>07_JUD_13_04</u> # Now therefore beware, I pray thee, and drink not wine nor strong drink, and eat not any unclean [thing]:

pray thee and <u>07_JUD_16_28</u> # And Samson called unto the LORD, and said, O Lord GOD, remember me, I pray thee, and strengthen me, I pray thee, only this once, O God, that I may be at once avenged of the Philistines for my two eyes.

pray thee and <u>07_JUD_19_06</u># And they sat down, and did eat and drink both of them together: for the damsel's father had said unto the man, Be content, I pray thee, and tarry all night, and let thine heart be merry.

pray thee And <u>07_JUD_19_08</u># And he arose early in the morning on the fifth day to depart: and the damsel's father said, Comfort thine heart, I pray thee. And they tarried until afternoon, and they did eat both of them.

pray thee and <u>07_JUD_19_11</u># [And] when they [were] by Jebus, the day was far spent; and the servant said unto his master, Come, I pray thee, and let us turn in into this city of the Jebusites, and lodge in it.

pray thee at <u>11_1KI_22_05</u># And Jehoshaphat said unto the king of Israel, Inquire, I pray thee, at the word of the LORD to day.

pray thee at <u>14_2CH_18_04</u> # And Jehoshaphat said unto the king of Israel, Inquire, I pray thee, at the word of the LORD to day.

pray thee be <u>11_1KI_08_26</u># And now, O God of Israel, let thy word, I pray thee, be verified, which thou spakest unto thy servant David my father.

pray thee be <u>11_1KI_22_13</u># And the messenger that was gone to call Micaiah spake unto him, saying, Behold now, the words of the prophets [declare] good unto the king with one mouth: let thy word, I pray thee, be like the word of one of them, and speak [that which is] good.

pray thee be <u>14_2CH_18_12</u> # And the messenger that went to call Micaiah spake to him, saying, Behold, the words of the prophets [declare] good to the king with one assent; let thy word therefore, I pray thee, be like one of theirs, and speak thou good.

pray thee be <u>12_2KI_05_17</u> # And Naaman said, Shall there not then, I pray thee, be given to thy servant two mules' burden of earth? for thy servant will henceforth offer neither burnt offering nor sacrifice unto other gods, but unto the LORD.

pray thee be <u>10_2SA_24_17</u> # And David spake unto the LORD when he saw the angel that smote the

people, and said, Lo, I have sinned, and I have done wickedly: but these sheep, what have they done? let thine hand, I pray thee, be against me, and against my father's house.

pray thee be <u>24_JER_37_20</u># Therefore hear now, I pray thee, O my lord the king: let my supplication, I pray thee, be accepted before thee; that thou cause me not to return to the house of Jonathan the scribe, lest I die there.

pray thee before <u>09_1SA_15_30</u> # Then he said, I have sinned: [yet] honour me now, I pray thee, before the elders of my people, and before Israel, and turn again with me, that I may worship the LORD thy God.

pray thee between <u>01_GEN_13_08</u># And Abram said unto Lot, Let there be no strife, I pray thee, between me and thee, and between my herdmen and thy herdmen; for we [be] brethren.

pray thee bring <u>09_1SA_30_07</u># And David said to Abiathar the priest, Ahimelech's son, I pray thee, bring me hither the ephod. And Abiathar brought thither the ephod to David.

pray thee but <u>07_JUD_06_39</u># And Gideon said unto God, Let not thine anger be hot against me, and I will speak but this once: let me prove, I pray thee, but this once with the fleece; let it now be dry only upon the fleece, and upon all the ground let there be dew.

pray thee by <u>02_EXO_04_13</u># And he said, O my Lord, send, I pray thee, by the hand [of him whom] thou wilt send.

pray thee come <u>09_1SA_22_03</u># And David went thence to Mizpeh of Moab: and he said unto the king of Moab, Let my father and my mother, I pray thee, come forth, [and be] with you, till I know what God will do for me.

pray thee come <u>41_MAR_05_23</u> # And besought him greatly, saying, My little daughter lieth at the point of death: [I pray thee], come and lay thy hands on her, that she may be healed; and she shall live.

pray thee curse <u>04_NUM_22_06</u># Come now therefore, I pray thee, curse me this people; for they [are] too mighty for me: peradventure I shall prevail, [that] we may smite them, and [that] I may drive them out of the land: for I wot that he whom thou blessest [is] blessed, and he whom thou cursest is cursed.

pray thee curse <u>04_NUM_22_17</u># For I will promote thee unto very great honour, and I will do whatsoever thou sayest unto me: come therefore, I pray thee, curse me this people.

pray thee divine <u>09_1SA_28_08</u> # And Saul disguised himself, and put on other raiment, and he went, and two men with him, and they came to the woman by night: and he said, I pray thee, divine unto me by the familiar spirit, and bring me [him] up, whom I shall name unto thee.

pray thee drink <u>01_GEN_24_17</u># And the servant ran to meet her, and said, Let me, I pray thee, drink a little water of thy pitcher.

pray thee feign <u>10_2SA_14_02</u> # And Joab sent to Tekoah, and fetched thence a wise woman, and said unto her, I pray thee, feign thyself to be a mourner, and put on now mourning apparel, and anoint not thyself with oil, but be as a woman that had a long time mourned for the dead:

pray thee five <u>12_2KI_07_13</u># And one of his servants answered and said, Let [some] take, I pray thee, five of the horses that remain, which are left in the city, [behold, they [are] as all the multitude of Israel that are left in it: behold, [I say], they [are] even as all the multitude of the Israelites that are consumed:] and let us send and see.

pray thee for <u>09_1SA_20_29</u> # And he said, Let me go, I pray thee; for our family hath a sacrifice in the city; and my brother, he hath commanded me [to be there]: and now, if I have found favour in thine eyes,

let me get away, I pray thee, and see my brethren. Therefore he cometh not unto the king's table.

pray thee for <u>12_2KI_02_02</u># And Elijah said unto Elisha, Tarry here, I pray thee; for the LORD hath sent me to Bethel. And Elisha said [unto him, As] the LORD liveth, and [as] thy soul liveth, I will not leave thee. So they went down to Bethel.

pray thee for <u>12_2KI_02_04</u># And Elijah said unto him, Elisha, tarry here, I pray thee; for the LORD hath sent me to Jericho. And he said, [As] the LORD liveth, and [as] thy soul liveth, I will not leave thee. So they came to Jericho.

pray thee for <u>32_JON_01_08</u># Then said they unto him, Tell us, we pray thee, for whose cause this evil [is] upon us; What [is] thine occupation? and whence comest thou? what [is] thy country? and of what people [art] thou?

pray thee forasmuch <u>04_NUM_10_31</u> # And he said, Leave us not, I pray thee; forasmuch as thou knowest how we are to encamp in the wilderness, and thou mayest be to us instead of eyes.

pray thee forgive <u>09_1SA_25_28</u> # I pray thee, forgive the trespass of thine handmaid: for the LORD will certainly make my lord a sure house; because my lord fighteth the battles of the LORD, and evil hath not been found in thee [all] thy days.

pray thee forgive <u>01_GEN_50_17</u> # So shall ye say unto Joseph, Forgive, I pray thee now, the trespass of thy brethren, and their sin; for they did unto thee evil: and now, we pray thee, forgive the trespass of the servants of the God of thy father. And Joseph wept when they spake unto him.

pray thee from <u>01_GEN_13_09</u># [Is] not the whole land before thee? separate thyself, I pray thee, from me: if [thou wilt take] the left hand, then I will go to the right; or if [thou depart] to the right hand, then I will go to the left.

pray thee from <u>01_GEN_18_03</u># And said, My Lord, if now I have found favour in thy sight, pass not away, I pray thee, from thy servant:

pray thee from <u>01_GEN_32_11</u># Deliver me, I pray thee, from the hand of my brother, from the hand of Esau: for I fear him, lest he will come and smite me, [and] the mother with the children.

pray thee give <u>11_1KI_01_12</u># Now therefore come, let me, I pray thee, give thee counsel, that thou mayest save thine own life, and the life of thy son Solomon.

pray thee give <u>12_2KI_18_23</u> # Now therefore, I pray thee, give pledges to my lord the king of Assyria, and I will deliver thee two thousand horses, if thou be able on thy part to set riders upon them.

pray thee glory <u>06_JOS_07_19</u> # And Joshua said unto Achan, My son, give, I pray thee, glory to the LORD God of Israel, and make confession unto him; and tell me now what thou hast done; hide [it] not from me.

pray thee go <u>02_EXO_34_09</u> # And he said, If now I have found grace in thy sight, O Lord, let my Lord, I pray thee, go among us; for it [is] a stiffnecked people; and pardon our iniquity and our sin, and take us for thine inheritance.

pray thee go <u>01_GEN_16_02</u> # And Sarai said unto Abram, Behold now, the LORD hath restrained me from bearing: I pray thee, go in unto my maid; it may be that I may obtain children by her. And Abram hearkened to the voice of Sarai.

pray thee have <u>42_LUK_14_18</u># And they all with one [consent] began to make excuse. The first said unto him, I have bought a piece of ground, and I must needs go and see it: I pray thee have me excused.

pray thee have <u>42_LUK_14_19</u># And another said, I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I go to prove them: I pray thee have me excused.

pray thee hear <u>01_GEN_23_13</u># And he spake unto Ephron in the audience of the people of the land, saying, But if thou [wilt give it], I pray thee, hear me: I will give thee money for the field; take [it] of me, and I will bury my dead there.

pray thee hear <u>18_JOB_33_01</u># Wherefore, Job, I pray thee, hear my speeches, and hearken to all my words.

pray thee hearken <u>09_1SA_28_22</u> # Now therefore, I pray thee, hearken thou also unto the voice of thine handmaid, and let me set a morsel of bread before thee; and eat, that thou mayest have strength, when thou goest on thy way.

pray thee here <u>12_2KI_02_06</u> # And Elijah said unto him, Tarry, I pray thee, here; for the LORD hath sent me to Jordan. And he said, [As] the LORD liveth, and [as] thy soul liveth, I will not leave thee. And they two went on.

pray thee hide <u>09_1SA_03_17</u> # And he said, What [is] the thing that [the LORD] hath said unto thee? I pray thee hide [it] not from me: God do so to thee, and more also, if thou hide [any] thing from me of all the things that he said unto thee.

pray thee if <u>01_GEN_30_27</u># And Laban said unto him, I pray thee, if I have found favour in thine eyes, [tarry: for] I have learned by experience that the LORD hath blessed me for thy sake.

pray thee if <u>01_GEN_33_10</u> # And Jacob said, Nay, I pray thee, if now I have found grace in thy sight, then receive my present at my hand: for therefore I have seen thy face, as though I had seen the face of God, and thou wast pleased with me.

pray thee of <u>07_JUD_18_05</u># And they said unto him, Ask counsel, we pray thee, of God, that we may know whether our way which we go shall be prosperous.

pray thee on <u>12_2KI_04_10</u> # Let us make a little chamber, I pray thee, on the wall; and let us set for him there a bed, and a table, and a stool, and a candlestick: and it shall be, when he cometh to us, that he shall turn in thither.

pray thee who <u>**18_JOB_04_07</u>**# Remember, I pray thee, who [ever] perished, being innocent? or where were the righteous cut off?</u>

pray thee whose <u>01_GEN_38_25</u> # When she [was] brought forth, she sent to her father in law, saying, By the man, whose these [are, am] I with child: and she said, Discern, I pray thee, whose [are] these, the signet, and bracelets, and staff.

prayed him that <u>41_MAR_05_18</u># And when he was come into the ship, he that had been possessed with the devil prayed him that he might be with him.

praying without at <u>42_LUK_01_10</u> # And the whole multitude of the people were praying without at the time of incense.

praying <u>44_ACT_12_12</u> # And when he had considered [the thing], he came to the house of Mary the mother of John, whose surname was Mark; where many were gathered together praying.
