cypress and the <u>23\_ISA\_44\_14</u> # He heweth him down cedars, and taketh the cypress and the oak, which he strengtheneth for himself among the trees of the forest: he planteth an ash, and the rain doth nourish [it].

express image of <u>58\_HEB\_01\_03</u> # Who being the brightness of [his] glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;

expressed by name 13\_1CH\_12\_31 # And of the half tribe of Manasseh eighteen thousand, which were expressed by name, to come and make David king.

expressed by name 13\_1CH\_16\_41 # And with them Heman and Jeduthun, and the rest that were chosen, who were expressed by name, to give thanks to the LORD, because his mercy [endureth] for ever;

expressed by name 14\_2CH\_28\_15 # And the men which were expressed by name rose up, and took the captives, and with the spoil clothed all that were naked among them, and arrayed them, and shod them, and gave them to eat and to drink, and anointed them, and carried all the feeble of them upon asses, and brought them to Jericho, the city of palm trees, to their brethren: then they returned to Samaria.

expressed by name <u>15\_EZR\_08\_20</u> # Also of the Nethinims, whom David and the princes had appointed for the service of the Levites, two hundred and twenty Nethinims: all of them were expressed by name.

oppress a man <u>33\_MIC\_02\_02</u># And they covet fields, and take [them] by violence; and houses, and take [them] away: so they oppress a man and his house, even a man and his heritage.

oppress a stranger <u>02\_EXO\_23\_09</u> # Also thou shalt not oppress a stranger: for ye know the heart of a stranger, seeing ye were strangers in the land of Egypt.

oppress an hired <u>05\_DEU\_24\_14</u> # Thou shalt not oppress an hired servant [that is] poor and needy, [whether he be] of thy brethren, or of thy strangers that [are] in thy land within thy gates:

oppress him for <u>02\_EXO\_22\_21</u># Thou shalt neither vex a stranger, nor oppress him: for ye were strangers in the land of Egypt.

oppress him <u>05\_DEU\_23\_16</u># He shall dwell with thee, [even] among you, in that place which he shall choose in one of thy gates, where it liketh him best: thou shalt not oppress him.

oppress me from 19\_PSA\_17\_09 # From the wicked that oppress me, [from] my deadly enemies, [who] compass me about.

oppress me 19\_PSA\_119\_122 # Be surety for thy servant for good: let not the proud oppress me.

oppress my people <u>26\_EZE\_45\_08</u># In the land shall be his possession in Israel: and my princes shall no more oppress my people; and [the rest of] the land shall they give to the house of Israel according to their tribes.

oppress not the <u>24\_JER\_07\_06</u> # [If] ye oppress not the stranger, the fatherless, and the widow, and shed not innocent blood in this place, neither walk after other gods to your hurt:

oppress not the <u>38\_ZEC\_07\_10</u> # And oppress not the widow, nor the fatherless, the stranger, nor the poor; and let none of you imagine evil against his brother in your heart.

oppress one another <u>03\_LEV\_25\_14</u># And if thou sell ought unto thy neighbour, or buyest [ought] of thy neighbour's hand, ye shall not oppress one another:

oppressed and crushed <u>05\_DEU\_28\_33</u> # The fruit of thy land, and all thy labours, shall a nation which thou knowest not eat up; and thou shalt be only oppressed and crushed alway:

oppressed and hath <u>18\_JOB\_20\_19</u> # Because he hath oppressed [and] hath forsaken the poor; [because] he hath violently taken away an house which he builded not;

oppressed and he <u>23\_ISA\_53\_07</u># He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth.

oppressed judge the <u>23\_ISA\_01\_17</u># Learn to do well; seek judgment, relieve the oppressed, judge the fatherless, plead for the widow.

oppressed of the <u>44\_ACT\_10\_38</u># How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

oppressed or of <u>09\_1SA\_12\_03</u> # Behold, here I [am]: witness against me before the LORD, and before his anointed: whose ox have I taken? or whose ass have I taken? or whom have I defrauded? whom have I oppressed? or of whose hand have I received [any] bribe to blind mine eyes therewith? and I will restore it you.

oppressed return ashamed 19\_PSA\_74\_21 # O let not the oppressed return ashamed: let the poor and needy praise thy name.

oppressed some of 14\_2CH\_16\_10 # Then Asa was wroth with the seer, and put him in a prison house; for [he was] in a rage with him because of this [thing]. And Asa oppressed [some] of the people the same time.

oppressed spoiled his <u>26\_EZE\_18\_18</u> # [As for] his father, because he cruelly oppressed, spoiled his brother by violence, and did [that] which [is] not good among his people, lo, even he shall die in his iniquity.

oppressed that the <u>19\_PSA\_10\_18</u># To judge the fatherless and the oppressed, that the man of the earth may no more oppress.

oppressed the children <u>07\_JUD\_04\_03</u> # And the children of Israel cried unto the LORD: for he had nine hundred chariots of iron; and twenty years he mightily oppressed the children of Israel.

oppresseth the poor <u>20\_PRO\_14\_31</u># He that oppresseth the poor reproacheth his Maker: but he that honoureth him hath mercy on the poor.

oppresseth the poor <u>20\_PRO\_22\_16</u> # He that oppresseth the poor to increase his [riches, and] he that giveth to the rich, [shall] surely [come] to want.

oppresseth the poor <u>20\_PRO\_28\_03</u> # A poor man that oppresseth the poor [is like] a sweeping rain which leaveth no food.

oppresseth you then <u>04\_NUM\_10\_09</u># And if ye go to war in your land against the enemy that oppresseth you, then ye shall blow an alarm with the trumpets; and ye shall be remembered before the LORD your God, and ye shall be saved from your enemies.

oppressing city 36\_ZEP\_03\_01 # Woe to her that is filthy and polluted, to the oppressing city!

oppression and for <u>24\_JER\_22\_17</u> # But thine eyes and thine heart [are] not but for thy covetousness, and for to shed innocent blood, and for oppression, and for violence, to do [it].

oppression and perverseness <u>23\_ISA\_30\_12</u> # Wherefore thus saith the Holy One of Israel, Because ye despise this word, and trust in oppression and perverseness, and stay thereon:

oppression and revolt <u>23\_ISA\_59\_13</u> # In transgressing and lying against the LORD, and departing away from our God, speaking oppression and revolt, conceiving and uttering from the heart words of falsehood.

oppression for righteousness <u>23\_ISA\_05\_07</u># For the vineyard of the LORD of hosts [is] the house of Israel, and the men of Judah his pleasant plant: and he looked for judgment, but behold oppression; for righteousness, but behold a cry.

oppression for thou <u>23\_ISA\_54\_14</u> # In righteousness shalt thou be established: thou shalt be far from oppression; for thou shalt not fear: and from terror; for it shall not come near thee.

oppression in the <u>24\_JER\_06\_06</u> # For thus hath the LORD of hosts said, Hew ye down trees, and cast a mount against Jerusalem: this [is] the city to be visited; she [is] wholly oppression in the midst of her.

oppression maketh a <u>21\_ECC\_07\_07</u># Surely oppression maketh a wise man mad; and a gift destroyeth the heart.

oppression of Israel 12 2KI 13 04 # And Jehoahaz besought the LORD, and the LORD hearkened unto him: for he saw the oppression of Israel, because the king of Syria oppressed them.

oppression of man 19\_PSA\_119\_134 # Deliver me from the oppression of man: so will I keep thy precepts.

oppression of the <u>21\_ECC\_05\_08</u># If thou seest the oppression of the poor, and violent perverting of judgment and justice in a province, marvel not at the matter: for [he that is] higher than the highest regardeth; and [there be] higher than they.

oppression of the <u>19\_PSA\_12\_05</u> # For the oppression of the poor, for the sighing of the needy, now will I arise, saith the LORD; I will set [him] in safety [from him that] puffeth at him.

press thee and <u>42\_LUK\_08\_45</u> # And Jesus said, Who touched me? When all denied, Peter and they that were with him said, Master, the multitude throng thee and press [thee], and sayest thou, Who touched me?

press there were 37\_HAG\_02\_16 # Since those [days] were, when [one] came to an heap of twenty [measures], there were [but] ten: when [one] came to the pressfat for to draw out fifty [vessels] out of the press, there were [but] twenty.

press they uncovered 41 MAR\_02\_04 # And when they could not come nigh unto him for the press, they uncovered the roof where he was: and when they had broken [it] up, they let down the bed wherein the sick of the palsy lay.

press toward the <u>50\_PHP\_03\_14</u># I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus.

press 42\_LUK\_08\_19 # Then came to him [his] mother and his brethren, and could not come at him for the press.

pressed and there <u>26\_EZE\_23\_03</u># And they committed whoredoms in Egypt; they committed whoredoms in their youth: there were their breasts pressed, and there they bruised the teats of their virginity.

pressed down and <u>42\_LUK\_06\_38</u># Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again.

pressed him daily <u>07\_JUD\_16\_16</u> # And it came to pass, when she pressed him daily with her words, and urged him, [so] that his soul was vexed unto death;

pressed him howbeit 10\_2SA\_13\_25 # And the king said to Absalom, Nay, my son, let us not all now go, lest we be chargeable unto thee. And he pressed him: howbeit he would not go, but blessed him.

pressed him that <u>10\_2SA\_13\_27</u># But Absalom pressed him, that he let Amnon and all the king's sons go with him.

pressed in the <u>44\_ACT\_18\_05</u># And when Silas and Timotheus were come from Macedonia, Paul was pressed in the spirit, and testified to the Jews [that] Jesus [was] Christ.

pressed on by <u>17\_EST\_08\_14</u> # [So] the posts that rode upon mules [and] camels went out, being hastened and pressed on by the king's commandment. And the decree was given at Shushan the palace.

pressed out of <u>47\_2CO\_01\_08</u># For we would not, brethren, have you ignorant of our trouble which came to us in Asia, that we were pressed out of measure, above strength, insomuch that we despaired even of life:

pressed sore upon <u>01\_GEN\_19\_09</u># And they said, Stand back. And they said [again], This one [fellow] came in to sojourn, and he will needs be a judge: now will we deal worse with thee, than with them. And they pressed sore upon the man, [even] Lot, and came near to break the door.

pressed upon him <u>41\_MAR\_03\_10</u> # For he had healed many; insomuch that they pressed upon him for to touch him, as many as had plagues.

pressed upon them <u>01\_GEN\_19\_03</u># And he pressed upon them greatly; and they turned in unto him, and entered into his house; and he made them a feast, and did bake unleavened bread, and they did eat.

presses I have 23 ISA 16 10 # And gladness is taken away, and joy out of the plentiful field; and in the vineyards there shall be no singing, neither shall there be shouting: the treaders shall tread out no wine in [their] presses; I have made [their vintage] shouting to cease.

presses on the <u>16\_NEH\_13\_15</u> # In those days saw I in Judah [some] treading wine presses on the sabbath, and bringing in sheaves, and lading asses; as also wine, grapes, and figs, and all [manner of] burdens, which they brought into Jerusalem on the sabbath day: and I testified [against them] in the day wherein they sold victuals.

presses shall burst <u>20\_PRO\_03\_10</u> # So shall thy barns be filled with plenty, and thy presses shall burst out with new wine.

presseth into it <u>42\_LUK\_16\_16</u># The law and the prophets [were] until John: since that time the kingdom of God is preached, and every man presseth into it.

presseth me sore 19\_PSA\_38\_02 # For thine arrows stick fast in me, and thy hand presseth me sore.

pressfat for to <u>37\_HAG\_02\_16</u># Since those [days] were, when [one] came to an heap of twenty [measures], there were [but] ten: when [one] came to the pressfat for to draw out fifty [vessels] out of the press, there were [but] twenty.

winepress alone and <u>23\_ISA\_63\_03</u># I have trodden the winepress alone; and of the people [there was] none with me: for I will tread them in mine anger, and trample them in my fury; and their blood shall be sprinkled upon my garments, and I will stain all my raiment.

winepress even unto <u>66\_REV\_14\_20</u> # And the winepress was trodden without the city, and blood came out of the winepress, even unto the horse bridles, by the space of a thousand [and] six hundred furlongs.

winepress therein and 23 ISA 05 02 # And he fenced it, and gathered out the stones thereof, and planted it with the choicest vine, and built a tower in the midst of it, and also made a winepress therein: and he looked that it should bring forth grapes, and it brought forth wild grapes.

winepress to hide <u>07\_JUD\_06\_11</u># And there came an angel of the LORD, and sat under an oak which [was] in Ophrah, that [pertained] unto Joash the Abiezrite: and his son Gideon threshed wheat by the winepress, to hide [it] from the Midianites.

winepress 12 2KI 06 27 # And he said, If the LORD do not help thee, whence shall I help thee? out of the barnfloor, or out of the winepress?

winepress 25 LAM\_01\_15 # The Lord hath trodden under foot all my mighty [men] in the midst of me: he hath called an assembly against me to crush my young men: the Lord hath trodden the virgin, the daughter of Judah, [as] in a winepress.

winepress <u>04\_NUM\_18\_27</u> # And [this] your heave offering shall be reckoned unto you, as though [it were] the corn of the threshingfloor, and as the fulness of the winepress.

winepress <u>04\_NUM\_18\_30</u># Therefore thou shalt say unto them, When ye have heaved the best thereof from it, then it shall be counted unto the Levites as the increase of the threshingfloor, and as the increase of the winepress.

winepresses and suffer 18\_JOB\_24\_11 # [Which] make oil within their walls, [and] tread [their] winepresses, and suffer thirst.

winepresses none shall <u>24\_JER\_48\_33</u># And joy and gladness is taken from the plentiful field, and from the land of Moab; and I have caused wine to fail from the winepresses: none shall tread with shouting; [their] shouting [shall be] no shouting.

winepresses <u>38\_ZEC\_14\_10</u># All the land shall be turned as a plain from Geba to Rimmon south of Jerusalem: and it shall be lifted up, and inhabited in her place, from Benjamin's gate unto the place of the first gate, unto the corner gate, and [from] the tower of Hananeel unto the king's winepresses.
