osprey <u>05\_DEU\_14\_12</u> # But these [are they] of which ye shall not eat: the eagle, and the ossifrage, and the osprey,

osprey <u>03\_LEV\_11\_13</u># And these [are they which] ye shall have in abomination among the fowls; they shall not be eaten, they [are] an abomination: the eagle, and the ossifrage, and the osprey,

prey and a <u>12\_2KI\_21\_14</u> # And I will forsake the remnant of mine inheritance, and deliver them into the hand of their enemies; and they shall become a prey and a spoil to all their enemies;

prey and as <u>19\_PSA\_17\_12</u># Like as a lion [that] is greedy of his prey, and as it were a young lion lurking in secret places.

prey and at <u>01\_GEN\_49\_27</u># Benjamin shall ravin [as] a wolf: in the morning he shall devour the prey, and at night he shall divide the spoil.

prey unto themselves <u>06\_JOS\_08\_27</u> # Only the cattle and the spoil of that city Israel took for a prey unto themselves, according unto the word of the LORD which he commanded Joshua.
