

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

profane and cause 26\_EZE\_44\_23 # And they shall teach my people [the difference] between the holy and profane, and cause them to discern between the unclean and the clean.

profane and old <u>54\_1TI\_04\_07</u># But refuse profane and old wives' fables, and exercise thyself [rather] unto godliness.

profane and vain <u>54\_1TI\_06\_20</u> # O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane [and] vain babblings, and oppositions of science falsely so called:

profane and vain <u>55\_2TI\_02\_16</u> # But shun profane [and] vain babblings: for they will increase unto more ungodliness.

profane for murderers <u>54\_1TI\_01\_09</u> # Knowing this, that the law is not made for a righteous man, but for the lawless and disobedient, for the ungodly and for sinners, for unholy and profane, for murderers of fathers and murderers of mothers, for manslayers,

profane herself by <u>03\_LEV\_21\_09</u># And the daughter of any priest, if she profane herself by playing the whore, she profaneth her father: she shall be burnt with fire.

profane himself <u>03\_LEV\_21\_04</u> # [But] he shall not defile himself, [being] a chief man among his people, to profane himself.

profane his seed <u>03\_LEV\_21\_15</u># Neither shall he profane his seed among his people: for I the LORD do sanctify him.

profane it and <u>26\_EZE\_23\_39</u> # For when they had slain their children to their idols, then they came the same day into my sanctuary to profane it; and, lo, thus have they done in the midst of mine house.

profane it I <u>03\_LEV\_22\_09</u> # They shall therefore keep mine ordinance, lest they bear sin for it, and die therefore, if they profane it: I the LORD do sanctify them.

profane my holy <u>30\_AMO\_02\_07</u> # That pant after the dust of the earth on the head of the poor, and turn aside the way of the meek: and a man and his father will go in unto the [same] maid, to profane my holy name:

profane my holy <u>03\_LEV\_20\_03</u> # And I will set my face against that man, and will cut him off from among his people; because he hath given of his seed unto Molech, to defile my sanctuary, and to profane my holy name.

profane my holy <u>03\_LEV\_22\_32</u> # Neither shall ye profane my holy name; but I will be hallowed among the children of Israel: I [am] the LORD which hallow you,

profane my sanctuary <u>26\_EZE\_24\_21</u> # Speak unto the house of Israel, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I will profane my sanctuary, the excellency of your strength, the desire of your eyes, and that which your soul pitieth; and your sons and your daughters whom ye have left shall fall by the sword.

profane neither have <u>26\_EZE\_22\_26</u># Her priests have violated my law, and have profaned mine holy things: they have put no difference between the holy and profane, neither have they showed [difference]

between the unclean and the clean, and have hid their eyes from my sabbaths, and I am profaned among them.

profane neither shall <u>03\_LEV\_21\_07</u># They shall not take a wife [that is] a whore, or profane; neither shall they take a woman put away from her husband: for he [is] holy unto his God.

profane not my <u>03\_LEV\_21\_23</u> # Only he shall not go in unto the veil, nor come nigh unto the altar, because he hath a blemish; that he profane not my sanctuaries: for I the LORD do sanctify them.

profane not my <u>03\_LEV\_22\_02</u> # Speak unto Aaron and to his sons, that they separate themselves from the holy things of the children of Israel, and that they profane not my holy name [in those things] which they hallow unto me: I [am] the LORD.

profane or an <u>03\_LEV\_21\_14</u> # A widow, or a divorced woman, or profane, [or] an harlot, these shall he not take: but he shall take a virgin of his own people to wife.

profane out of <u>26\_EZE\_28\_16</u># By the multitude of thy merchandise they have filled the midst of thee with violence, and thou hast sinned: therefore I will cast thee as profane out of the mountain of God: and I will destroy thee, O covering cherub, from the midst of the stones of fire.

profane person as <u>58\_HEB\_12\_16</u> # Lest there [be] any fornicator, or profane person, as Esau, who for one morsel of meat sold his birthright.

profane place for <u>26\_EZE\_48\_15</u># And the five thousand, that are left in the breadth over against the five and twenty thousand, shall be a profane [place] for the city, for dwelling, and for suburbs: and the city shall be in the midst thereof.

profane place <u>26\_EZE\_42\_20</u># He measured it by the four sides: it had a wall round about, five hundred [reeds] long, and five hundred broad, to make a separation between the sanctuary and the profane place.

profane the holy <u>03\_LEV\_22\_15</u> # And they shall not profane the holy things of the children of Israel, which they offer unto the LORD;

profane the name <u>03\_LEV\_18\_21</u> # And thou shalt not let any of thy seed pass through [the fire] to Molech, neither shalt thou profane the name of thy God: I [am] the LORD.

profane the name <u>03\_LEV\_19\_12</u># And ye shall not swear by my name falsely, neither shalt thou profane the name of thy God: I [am] the LORD.

profane the name <u>03\_LEV\_21\_06</u># They shall be holy unto their God, and not profane the name of their God: for the offerings of the LORD made by fire, [and] the bread of their God, they do offer: therefore they shall be holy.

profane the sabbath <u>40\_MAT\_12\_05</u># Or have ye not read in the law, how that on the sabbath days the priests in the temple profane the sabbath, and are blameless?

profane the sabbath <u>16\_NEH\_13\_17</u> # Then I contended with the nobles of Judah, and said unto them, What evil thing [is] this that ye do, and profane the sabbath day?

profane the sanctuary <u>03\_LEV\_21\_12</u> # Neither shall he go out of the sanctuary, nor profane the sanctuary of his God; for the crown of the anointing oil of his God [is] upon him: I [am] the LORD.

profane the temple <u>44\_ACT\_24\_06</u> # Who also hath gone about to profane the temple: whom we took, and would have judged according to our law.

profane wicked prince <u>26\_EZE\_21\_25</u> # And thou, profane wicked prince of Israel, whose day is come, when iniquity [shall have] an end,

profane yea in <u>24\_JER\_23\_11</u># For both prophet and priest are profane; yea, in my house have I found their wickedness, saith the LORD.

profaned among the <u>26\_EZE\_36\_21</u> # But I had pity for mine holy name, which the house of Israel had profaned among the heathen, whither they went.

profaned among the <u>26\_EZE\_36\_22</u> # Therefore say unto the house of Israel, Thus saith the Lord GOD; I do not [this] for your sakes, O house of Israel, but for mine holy name's sake, which ye have profaned among the heathen, whither ye went.

profaned among the <u>26\_EZE\_36\_23</u># And I will sanctify my great name, which was profaned among the heathen, which ye have profaned in the midst of them; and the heathen shall know that I [am] the LORD, saith the Lord GOD, when I shall be sanctified in you before their eyes.

profaned among them <u>26\_EZE\_22\_26</u># Her priests have violated my law, and have profaned mine holy things: they have put no difference between the holy and profane, neither have they showed [difference] between the unclean and the clean, and have hid their eyes from my sabbaths, and I am profaned among them.

profaned and against <u>26\_EZE\_25\_03</u># And say unto the Ammonites, Hear the word of the Lord GOD; Thus saith the Lord GOD; Because thou saidst, Aha, against my sanctuary, when it was profaned; and against the land of Israel, when it was desolate; and against the house of Judah, when they went into captivity;

profaned his crown 19\_PSA\_89\_39 # Thou hast made void the covenant of thy servant: thou hast profaned his crown [by casting it] to the ground.

profaned in the <u>26\_EZE\_36\_23</u> # And I will sanctify my great name, which was profaned among the heathen, which ye have profaned in the midst of them; and the heathen shall know that I [am] the LORD, saith the Lord GOD, when I shall be sanctified in you before their eyes.

profaned it in <u>39\_MAL\_01\_12</u> # But ye have profaned it, in that ye say, The table of the LORD [is] polluted; and the fruit thereof, [even] his meat, [is] contemptible.

profaned mine holy <u>26\_EZE\_22\_26</u># Her priests have violated my law, and have profaned mine holy things: they have put no difference between the holy and profane, neither have they showed [difference] between the unclean and the clean, and have hid their eyes from my sabbaths, and I am profaned among them.

profaned my holy <u>26\_EZE\_36\_20</u># And when they entered unto the heathen, whither they went, they profaned my holy name, when they said to them, These [are] the people of the LORD, and are gone forth out of his land.

profaned my sabbaths <u>26\_EZE\_22\_08</u># Thou hast despised mine holy things, and hast profaned my sabbaths.

profaned my sabbaths <u>26\_EZE\_23\_38</u> # Moreover this they have done unto me: they have defiled my sanctuary in the same day, and have profaned my sabbaths.

profaned the hallowed <u>03\_LEV\_19\_08</u> # Therefore [every one] that eateth it shall bear his iniquity, because he hath profaned the hallowed thing of the LORD: and that soul shall be cut off from among his people.

profaned the holiness <u>39\_MAL\_02\_11</u># Judah hath dealt treacherously, and an abomination is committed in Israel and in Jerusalem; for Judah hath profaned the holiness of the LORD which he loved, and hath married the daughter of a strange god.

profaned the princes <u>23\_ISA\_43\_28</u> # Therefore I have profaned the princes of the sanctuary, and have given Jacob to the curse, and Israel to reproaches.

profaneness gone forth <u>24\_JER\_23\_15</u> # Therefore thus saith the LORD of hosts concerning the prophets; Behold, I will feed them with wormwood, and make them drink the water of gall: for from the prophets of Jerusalem is profaneness gone forth into all the land.

profaneth her father <u>03\_LEV\_21\_09</u> # And the daughter of any priest, if she profane herself by playing the whore, she profaneth her father: she shall be burnt with fire.
