

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

pronounce him clean <u>03\_LEV\_13\_06</u># And the priest shall look on him again the seventh day: and, behold, [if] the plague [be] somewhat dark, [and] the plague spread not in the skin, the priest shall pronounce him clean: it [is but] a scab: and he shall wash his clothes, and be clean.

pronounce him clean <u>03\_LEV\_13\_13</u># Then the priest shall consider: and, behold, [if] the leprosy have covered all his flesh, he shall pronounce [him] clean [that hath] the plague: it is all turned white: he [is] clean.

pronounce him clean <u>03\_LEV\_13\_17</u># And the priest shall see him: and, behold, [if] the plague be turned into white; then the priest shall pronounce [him] clean [that hath] the plague: he [is] clean.

pronounce him clean <u>03\_LEV\_13\_23</u># But if the bright spot stay in his place, [and] spread not, it [is] a burning boil; and the priest shall pronounce him clean.

pronounce him clean <u>03\_LEV\_13\_28</u># And if the bright spot stay in his place, [and] spread not in the skin, but it [be] somewhat dark; it [is] a rising of the burning, and the priest shall pronounce him clean: for it [is] an inflammation of the burning.

pronounce him clean <u>03 LEV 13 34</u> # And in the seventh day the priest shall look on the scall: and, behold, [if] the scall be not spread in the skin, nor [be] in sight deeper than the skin; then the priest shall pronounce him clean: and he shall wash his clothes, and be clean.

pronounce him clean <u>03\_LEV\_13\_37</u># But if the scall be in his sight at a stay, and [that] there is black hair grown up therein; the scall is healed, he [is] clean: and the priest shall pronounce him clean.

pronounce him clean <u>03\_LEV\_14\_07</u> # And he shall sprinkle upon him that is to be cleansed from the leprosy seven times, and shall pronounce him clean, and shall let the living bird loose into the open field.

pronounce him to <u>03\_LEV\_13\_15</u> # And the priest shall see the raw flesh, and pronounce him to be unclean: [for] the raw flesh [is] unclean: it [is] a leprosy.

pronounce him unclean <u>03\_LEV\_13\_03</u> # And the priest shall look on the plague in the skin of the flesh: and [when] the hair in the plague is turned white, and the plague in sight [be] deeper than the skin of his flesh, it [is] a plague of leprosy: and the priest shall look on him, and pronounce him unclean.

pronounce him unclean <u>03\_LEV\_13\_08</u> # And [if] the priest see that, behold, the scab spreadeth in the skin, then the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it [is] a leprosy.

pronounce him unclean <u>03\_LEV\_13\_11</u># It [is] an old leprosy in the skin of his flesh, and the priest shall pronounce him unclean, and shall not shut him up: for he [is] unclean.

pronounce him unclean <u>03\_LEV\_13\_20</u> # And if, when the priest seeth it, behold, it [be] in sight lower than the skin, and the hair thereof be turned white; the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it [is] a plague of leprosy broken out of the boil.

pronounce him unclean <u>03\_LEV\_13\_22</u> # And if it spread much abroad in the skin, then the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it [is] a plague.

pronounce him unclean <u>03\_LEV\_13\_25</u># Then the priest shall look upon it: and, behold, [if] the hair in the bright spot be turned white, and it [be in] sight deeper than the skin; it [is] a leprosy broken out of the burning: wherefore the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it [is] the plague of leprosy.

pronounce him unclean <u>03\_LEV\_13\_27</u># And the priest shall look upon him the seventh day: [and] if it be spread much abroad in the skin, then the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it [is] the plague of leprosy.

pronounce him unclean <u>03\_LEV\_13\_30</u> # Then the priest shall see the plague: and, behold, if it [be] in sight deeper than the skin; [and there be] in it a yellow thin hair; then the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it [is] a dry scall, [even] a leprosy upon the head or beard.

pronounce him utterly <u>03\_LEV\_13\_44</u> # He is a leprous man, he [is] unclean: the priest shall pronounce him utterly unclean; his plague [is] in his head.

pronounce it clean <u>03\_LEV\_13\_59</u># This [is] the law of the plague of leprosy in a garment of woollen or linen, either in the warp, or woof, or any thing of skins, to pronounce it clean, or to pronounce it unclean.

pronounce it right <u>07\_JUD\_12\_06</u># Then said they unto him, Say now Shibboleth: and he said Sibboleth: for he could not frame to pronounce [it] right. Then they took him, and slew him at the passages of Jordan: and there fell at that time of the Ephraimites forty and two thousand.

pronounce it unclean <u>03\_LEV\_13\_59</u> # This [is] the law of the plague of leprosy in a garment of woollen or linen, either in the warp, or woof, or any thing of skins, to pronounce it clean, or to pronounce it unclean.

pronounce the house <u>03\_LEV\_14\_48</u> # And if the priest shall come in, and look [upon it], and, behold, the plague hath not spread in the house, after the house was plastered: then the priest shall pronounce the house clean, because the plague is healed.

pronounce with an <u>03\_LEV\_05\_04</u> # Or if a soul swear, pronouncing with [his] lips to do evil, or to do good, whatsoever [it be] that a man shall pronounce with an oath, and it be hid from him; when he knoweth [of it], then he shall be guilty in one of these.

pronounced against it <u>24\_JER\_19\_15</u> # Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will bring upon this city and upon all her towns all the evil that I have pronounced against it, because they have hardened their necks, that they might not hear my words.

pronounced against it <u>24\_JER\_25\_13</u># And I will bring upon that land all my words which I have pronounced against it, [even] all that is written in this book, which Jeremiah hath prophesied against all the nations.

pronounced against them 24\_JER\_26\_19 # Did Hezekiah king of Judah and all Judah put him at all to death? did he not fear the LORD, and besought the LORD, and the LORD repented him of the evil which he had pronounced against them? Thus might we procure great evil against our souls.

pronounced against them <u>24\_JER\_35\_17</u> # Therefore thus saith the LORD God of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will bring upon Judah and upon all the inhabitants of Jerusalem all the evil that I have pronounced against them: because I have spoken unto them, but they have not heard; and I have called unto them, but they have not answered.

pronounced against them <u>24\_JER\_36\_31</u> # And I will punish him and his seed and his servants for their iniquity; and I will bring upon them, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and upon the men of Judah, all the evil that I have pronounced against them; but they hearkened not.

pronounced against this <u>24\_JER\_36\_07</u> # It may be they will present their supplication before the LORD, and will return every one from his evil way: for great [is] the anger and the fury that the LORD hath

pronounced against this people.

pronounced against you <u>24\_JER\_26\_13</u># Therefore now amend your ways and your doings, and obey the voice of the LORD your God; and the LORD will repent him of the evil that he hath pronounced against you.

pronounced all these <u>24\_JER\_36\_18</u> # Then Baruch answered them, He pronounced all these words unto me with his mouth, and I wrote [them] with ink in the book.

pronounced all this <u>24\_JER\_16\_10</u> # And it shall come to pass, when thou shalt show this people all these words, and they shall say unto thee, Wherefore hath the LORD pronounced all this great evil against us? or what [is] our iniquity? or what [is] our sin that we have committed against the LORD our God?

pronounced evil against <u>24\_JER\_11\_17</u># For the LORD of hosts, that planted thee, hath pronounced evil against thee, for the evil of the house of Israel and of the house of Judah, which they have done against themselves to provoke me to anger in offering incense unto Baal.

pronounced the word <u>24\_JER\_34\_05</u> # [But] thou shalt die in peace: and with the burnings of thy fathers, the former kings which were before thee, so shall they burn [odours] for thee; and they will lament thee, [saying], Ah lord! for I have pronounced the word, saith the LORD.

pronounced this evil <u>24\_JER\_40\_02</u># And the captain of the guard took Jeremiah, and said unto him, The LORD thy God hath pronounced this evil upon this place.

pronounced this prophecy <u>16\_NEH\_06\_12</u># And, lo, I perceived that God had not sent him; but that he pronounced this prophecy against me: for Tobiah and Sanballat had hired him.

pronounced turn from <u>24\_JER\_18\_08</u># If that nation, against whom I have pronounced, turn from their evil, I will repent of the evil that I thought to do unto them.
