proudly against the <u>23_ISA_03_05</u># And the people shall be oppressed, every one by another, and every one by his neighbour: the child shall behave himself proudly against the ancient, and the base against the honourable.

proudly against them <u>16_NEH_09_10</u># And showedst signs and wonders upon Pharaoh, and on all his servants, and on all the people of his land: for thou knewest that they dealt proudly against them. So didst thou get thee a name, as [it is] this day.

proudly and contemptuously 19_PSA_31_18 # Let the lying lips be put to silence; which speak grievous things proudly and contemptuously against the righteous.

proudly and hardened <u>16_NEH_09_16</u># But they and our fathers dealt proudly, and hardened their necks, and hearkened not to thy commandments,

proudly and hearkened <u>16_NEH_09_29</u> # And testifiedst against them, that thou mightest bring them again unto thy law: yet they dealt proudly, and hearkened not unto thy commandments, but sinned against thy judgments, [which if a man do, he shall live in them;] and withdrew the shoulder, and hardened their neck, and would not hear.

proudly he was <u>02_EXO_18_11</u># Now I know that the LORD [is] greater than all gods: for in the thing wherein they dealt proudly [he was] above them.

proudly in the <u>31_OBA_01_12</u># But thou shouldest not have looked on the day of thy brother in the day that he became a stranger; neither shouldest thou have rejoiced over the children of Judah in the day of their destruction; neither shouldest thou have spoken proudly in the day of distress.

proudly let not <u>09_1SA_02_03</u> # Talk no more so exceeding proudly; let [not] arrogancy come out of your mouth: for the LORD [is] a God of knowledge, and by him actions are weighed.

proudly 19 PSA 17 10 # They are enclosed in their own fat: with their mouth they speak proudly.
