province according to <u>17\_EST\_01\_22</u> # For he sent letters into all the king's provinces, into every province according to the writing thereof, and to every people after their language, that every man should bear rule in his own house, and that [it] should be published according to the language of every people.

province according to <u>17\_EST\_03\_12</u> # Then were the king's scribes called on the thirteenth day of the first month, and there was written according to all that Haman had commanded unto the king's lieutenants, and to the governors that [were] over every province, and to the rulers of every people of every province according to the writing thereof, and [to] every people after their language; in the name of king Ahasuerus was it written, and sealed with the king's ring.

province according to <u>17\_EST\_08\_09</u> # Then were the king's scribes called at that time in the third month, that [is], the month Sivan, on the three and twentieth [day] thereof; and it was written according to all that Mordecai commanded unto the Jews, and to the lieutenants, and the deputies and rulers of the provinces which [are] from India unto Ethiopia, an hundred twenty and seven provinces, unto every province according to the writing thereof, and unto every people after their language, and to the Jews according to their writing, and according to their language.

province after three <u>44\_ACT\_25\_01</u> # Now when Festus was come into the province, after three days he ascended from Caesarea to Jerusalem.

province and every <u>17\_EST\_09\_28</u># And [that] these days [should be] remembered and kept throughout every generation, every family, every province, and every city; and [that] these days of Purim should not fail from among the Jews, nor the memorial of them perish from their seed.

province and he <u>27\_DAN\_11\_24</u># He shall enter peaceably even upon the fattest places of the province; and he shall do [that] which his fathers have not done, nor his fathers' fathers; he shall scatter among them the prey, and spoil, and riches: [yea], and he shall forecast his devices against the strong holds, even for a time.

province and in <u>17\_EST\_08\_17</u> # And in every province, and in every city, whithersoever the king's commandment and his decree came, the Jews had joy and gladness, a feast and a good day. And many of the people of the land became Jews; for the fear of the Jews fell upon them.

province marvel not 21\_ECC\_05\_08 # If thou seest the oppression of the poor, and violent perverting of judgment and justice in a province, marvel not at the matter: for [he that is] higher than the highest regardeth; and [there be] higher than they.

province of Babylon <u>27 DAN 02 48</u> # Then the king made Daniel a great man, and gave him many great gifts, and made him ruler over the whole province of Babylon, and chief of the governors over all the wise [men] of Babylon.

province of Babylon <u>27\_DAN\_02\_49</u> # Then Daniel requested of the king, and he set Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, over the affairs of the province of Babylon: but Daniel [sat] in the gate of the king.

province of Babylon <u>27\_DAN\_03\_01</u> # Nebuchadnezzar the king made an image of gold, whose height [was] threescore cubits, [and] the breadth thereof six cubits: he set it up in the plain of Dura, in the province of Babylon.

province of Babylon <u>27\_DAN\_03\_12</u># There are certain Jews whom thou hast set over the affairs of the province of Babylon, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego; these men, O king, have not regarded thee: they serve not thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up.

province of Babylon <u>27\_DAN\_03\_30</u># Then the king promoted Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, in the province of Babylon.

province of Babylon <u>15\_EZR\_07\_16</u> # And all the silver and gold that thou canst find in all the province of Babylon, with the freewill offering of the people, and of the priests, offering willingly for the house of their God which [is] in Jerusalem:

province of Elam <u>27\_DAN\_08\_02</u> # And I saw in a vision; and it came to pass, when I saw, that I [was] at Shushan [in] the palace, which [is] in the province of Elam; and I saw in a vision, and I was by the river of Ulai.

province of Judea <u>15\_EZR\_05\_08</u> # Be it known unto the king, that we went into the province of Judea, to the house of the great God, which is builded with great stones, and timber is laid in the walls, and this work goeth fast on, and prospereth in their hands.

province that went <u>16\_NEH\_07\_06</u># These [are] the children of the province, that went up out of the captivity, of those that had been carried away, whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon had carried away, and came again to Jerusalem and to Judah, every one unto his city;

province that would <u>17\_EST\_08\_11</u> # Wherein the king granted the Jews which [were] in every city to gather themselves together, and to stand for their life, to destroy, to slay, and to cause to perish, all the power of the people and province that would assault them, [both] little ones and women, and [to take] the spoil of them for a prey,

province was published <u>17\_EST\_03\_14</u> # The copy of the writing for a commandment to be given in every province was published unto all people, that they should be ready against that day.

province was published <u>17\_EST\_08\_13</u># The copy of the writing for a commandment to be given in every

province [was] published unto all people, and that the Jews should be ready against that day to avenge themselves on their enemies.

province whithersoever the <u>17\_EST\_04\_03</u> # And in every province, whithersoever the king's commandment and his decree came, [there was] great mourning among the Jews, and fasting, and weeping, and wailing; and many lay in sackcloth and ashes.

provinces and gave <u>17\_EST\_02\_18</u># Then the king made a great feast unto all his princes and his servants, [even] Esther's feast; and he made a release to the provinces, and gave gifts, according to the state of the king.

provinces and spread <u>26 EZE 19 08</u> # Then the nations set against him on every side from the provinces, and spread their net over him: he was taken in their pit.

provinces and that <u>15\_EZR\_04\_15</u> # That search may be made in the book of the records of thy fathers: so shalt thou find in the book of the records, and know that this city [is] a rebellious city, and hurtful unto kings and provinces, and that they have moved sedition within the same of old time: for which cause was this city destroyed.

provinces and the <u>17\_EST\_09\_03</u> # And all the rulers of the provinces, and the lieutenants, and the deputies, and officers of the king, helped the Jews; because the fear of Mordecai fell upon them.

provinces how is <u>25\_LAM\_01\_01</u> # How doth the city sit solitary, [that was] full of people! [how] is she become as a widow! she [that was] great among the nations, [and] princess among the provinces, [how] is she become tributary!

provinces I gat <u>21\_ECC\_02\_08</u># I gathered me also silver and gold, and the peculiar treasure of kings and of the provinces: I gat me men singers and women singers, and the delights of the sons of men, [as] musical instruments, and that of all sorts.

provinces into every <u>17\_EST\_01\_22</u># For he sent letters into all the king's provinces, into every province according to the writing thereof, and to every people after their language, that every man should bear rule

provinces now what <u>17\_EST\_09\_12</u> # And the king said unto Esther the queen, The Jews have slain and destroyed five hundred men in Shushan the palace, and the ten sons of Haman; what have they done in the rest of the king's provinces? now what [is] thy petition? and it shall be granted thee: or what [is] thy request further? and it shall be done.

provinces of his <u>17\_EST\_02\_03</u> # And let the king appoint officers in all the provinces of his kingdom, that they may gather together all the fair young virgins unto Shushan the palace, to the house of the women, unto the custody of Hege the king's chamberlain, keeper of the women; and let their things for purification be given [them]:

provinces of king <u>17\_EST\_08\_12</u> # Upon one day in all the provinces of king Ahasuerus, [namely], upon the thirteenth [day] of the twelfth month, which [is] the month Adar.

provinces of the <u>17\_EST\_01\_16</u> # And Memucan answered before the king and the princes, Vashti the queen hath not done wrong to the king only, but also to all the princes, and to all the people that [are] in all the provinces of the king Ahasuerus.

provinces of the <u>17\_EST\_09\_02</u> # The Jews gathered themselves together in their cities throughout all the provinces of the king Ahasuerus, to lay hand on such as sought their hurt: and no man could withstand them; for the fear of them fell upon all people.
