

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

provoke God are <u>18\_JOB\_12\_06</u># The tabernacles of robbers prosper, and they that provoke God are secure; into whose hand God bringeth [abundantly].

provoke him in 19\_PSA\_78\_40 # How oft did they provoke him in the wilderness, [and] grieve him in the desert!

provoke him not <u>02\_EXO\_23\_21</u># Beware of him, and obey his voice, provoke him not; for he will not pardon your transgressions: for my name [is] in him.

provoke him to 14\_2CH\_33\_06 # And he caused his children to pass through the fire in the valley of the son of Hinnom: also he observed times, and used enchantments, and used witchcraft, and dealt with a familiar spirit, and with wizards: he wrought much evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger.

provoke him to 12\_2KI\_17\_17 # And they caused their sons and their daughters to pass through the fire, and used divination and enchantments, and sold themselves to do evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger.

provoke him to 12\_2KI\_21\_06 # And he made his son pass through the fire, and observed times, and used enchantments, and dealt with familiar spirits and wizards: he wrought much wickedness in the sight of the LORD, to provoke [him] to anger.

provoke him to <u>05\_DEU\_04\_25</u># When thou shalt beget children, and children's children, and ye shall have remained long in the land, and shall corrupt [yourselves], and make a graven image, [or] the likeness of any [thing], and shall do evil in the sight of the LORD thy God, to provoke him to anger:

provoke him to <u>05\_DEU\_09\_18</u># And I fell down before the LORD, as at the first, forty days and forty nights: I did neither eat bread, nor drink water, because of all your sins which ye sinned, in doing wickedly in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger.

provoke him to <u>05\_DEU\_31\_29</u> # For I know that after my death ye will utterly corrupt [yourselves], and turn aside from the way which I have commanded you; and evil will befall you in the latter days; because ye will do evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger through the work of your hands.

provoke him to <u>42\_LUK\_11\_53</u># And as he said these things unto them, the scribes and the Pharisees began to urge [him] vehemently, and to provoke him to speak of many things:

provoke howbeit not <u>58\_HEB\_03\_16</u># For some, when they had heard, did provoke: howbeit not all that came out of Egypt by Moses.

provoke me and <u>05\_DEU\_31\_20</u># For when I shall have brought them into the land which I sware unto their fathers, that floweth with milk and honey; and they shall have eaten and filled themselves, and waxen fat; then will they turn unto other gods, and serve them, and provoke me, and break my covenant.

provoke me and <u>04\_NUM\_14\_11</u># And the LORD said unto Moses, How long will this people provoke me? and how long will it be ere they believe me, for all the signs which I have showed among them?

provoke me not 24\_JER\_25\_06 # And go not after other gods to serve them, and to worship them, and provoke me not to anger with the works of your hands; and I will do you no hurt.

provoke me to 11\_1KI\_14\_09 # But hast done evil above all that were before thee: for thou hast gone and made thee other gods, and molten images, to provoke me to anger, and hast cast me behind thy back:

provoke me to 11\_1KI\_16\_02 # Forasmuch as I exalted thee out of the dust, and made thee prince over my people Israel; and thou hast walked in the way of Jeroboam, and hast made my people Israel to sin, to provoke me to anger with their sins;

provoke me to 14\_2CH\_34\_25 # Because they have forsaken me, and have burned incense unto other gods, that they might provoke me to anger with all the works of their hands; therefore my wrath shall be poured out upon this place, and shall not be quenched.

provoke me to 12\_2KI\_22\_17 # Because they have forsaken me, and have burned incense unto other gods, that they might provoke me to anger with all the works of their hands; therefore my wrath shall be kindled against this place, and shall not be quenched.

provoke me to <u>26\_EZE\_08\_17</u> # Then he said unto me, Hast thou seen [this], O son of man? Is it a light thing to the house of Judah that they commit the abominations which they commit here? for they have filled the land with violence, and have returned to provoke me to anger: and, lo, they put the branch to their nose.

provoke me to <u>26\_EZE\_16\_26</u> # Thou hast also committed fornication with the Egyptians thy neighbours, great of flesh; and hast increased thy whoredoms, to provoke me to anger.

provoke me to <u>24\_JER\_07\_18</u># The children gather wood, and the fathers kindle the fire, and the women knead [their] dough, to make cakes to the queen of heaven, and to pour out drink offerings unto other gods, that they may provoke me to anger.

provoke me to <u>24\_JER\_07\_19</u> # Do they provoke me to anger? saith the LORD: [do they] not [provoke] themselves to the confusion of their own faces?

provoke me to <u>24\_JER\_11\_17</u># For the LORD of hosts, that planted thee, hath pronounced evil against thee, for the evil of the house of Israel and of the house of Judah, which they have done against themselves to provoke me to anger in offering incense unto Baal.

provoke me to <u>24\_JER\_25\_07</u># Yet ye have not hearkened unto me, saith the LORD; that ye might provoke me to anger with the works of your hands to your own hurt.

provoke me to 24\_JER\_32\_29 # And the Chaldeans, that fight against this city, shall come and set fire on this city, and burn it with the houses, upon whose roofs they have offered incense unto Baal, and poured out drink offerings unto other gods, to provoke me to anger.

provoke me to <u>24\_JER\_32\_32</u> # Because of all the evil of the children of Israel and of the children of Judah, which they have done to provoke me to anger, they, their kings, their princes, their priests, and their prophets, and the men of Judah, and the inhabitants of Jerusalem.

provoke me to <u>24\_JER\_44\_03</u> # Because of their wickedness which they have committed to provoke me to anger, in that they went to burn incense, [and] to serve other gods, whom they knew not, [neither] they, ye, nor your fathers.

provoke me unto 24\_JER\_44\_08 # In that ye provoke me unto wrath with the works of your hands, burning incense unto other gods in the land of Egypt, whither ye be gone to dwell, that ye might cut yourselves off, and that ye might be a curse and a reproach among all the nations of the earth?

provoke not your 51\_COL\_03\_21 # Fathers, provoke not your children [to anger], lest they be discouraged.

provoke not your <u>49\_EPH\_06\_04</u> # And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

provoke the eyes <u>23\_ISA\_03\_08</u> # For Jerusalem is ruined, and Judah is fallen: because their tongue and their doings [are] against the LORD, to provoke the eyes of his glory.

provoke the Lord 46\_1CO\_10\_22 # Do we provoke the Lord to jealousy? are we stronger than he?

provoke the LORD 11\_1KI\_16\_26# For he walked in all the way of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, and in his sin wherewith he made Israel to sin, to provoke the LORD God of Israel to anger with their vanities.

provoke the LORD <u>11\_1KI\_16\_33</u># And Ahab made a grove; and Ahab did more to provoke the LORD God of Israel to anger than all the kings of Israel that were before him.

provoke the LORD 12 2KI 17 11 # And there they burnt incense in all the high places, as [did] the heathen whom the LORD carried away before them; and wrought wicked things to provoke the LORD to anger:

provoke the LORD <u>12 2KI 23 19 # And all the houses also of the high places that [were] in the cities of Samaria, which the kings of Israel had made to provoke [the LORD] to anger, Josiah took away, and did to them according to all the acts that he had done in Bethel.</u>

provoke them to <u>05\_DEU\_32\_21</u> # They have moved me to jealousy with [that which is] not God; they have provoked me to anger with their vanities: and I will move them to jealousy with [those which are] not a people; I will provoke them to anger with a foolish nation.

provoke them to <u>45\_ROM\_11\_11</u># I say then, Have they stumbled that they should fall? God forbid: but [rather] through their fall salvation [is come] unto the Gentiles, for to provoke them to jealousy.

provoke themselves to <u>24\_JER\_07\_19</u> # Do they provoke me to anger? saith the LORD: [do they] not [provoke] themselves to the confusion of their own faces?

provoke to emulation <u>45\_ROM\_11\_14</u># If by any means I may provoke to emulation [them which are] my flesh, and might save some of them.

provoke unto love <u>58\_HEB\_10\_24</u># And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:

provoke you to <u>45\_ROM\_10\_19</u> # But I say, Did not Israel know? First Moses saith, I will provoke you to jealousy by [them that are] no people, [and] by a foolish nation I will anger you.

provoked David to <u>13\_1CH\_21\_01</u># And Satan stood up against Israel, and provoked David to number Israel.

provoked her sore <u>09\_1SA\_01\_06</u># And her adversary also provoked her sore, for to make her fret, because the LORD had shut up her womb.

provoked her therefore <u>09\_1SA\_01\_07</u> # And [as] he did so year by year, when she went up to the house of the LORD, so she provoked her; therefore she wept, and did not eat.

provoked him at <u>19\_PSA\_106\_07</u># Our fathers understood not thy wonders in Egypt; they remembered not the multitude of thy mercies; but provoked [him] at the sea, [even] at the Red sea.

provoked him to 11\_1KI\_14\_22 # And Judah did evil in the sight of the LORD, and they provoked him to jealousy with their sins which they had committed, above all that their fathers had done.

provoked him to <u>05\_DEU\_32\_16</u># They provoked him to jealousy with strange [gods], with abominations provoked they him to anger.

provoked him to <u>28\_HOS\_12\_14</u> # Ephraim provoked [him] to anger most bitterly: therefore shall he leave his blood upon him, and his reproach shall his Lord return unto him.

provoked him to 19\_PSA\_106\_29 # Thus they provoked [him] to anger with their inventions: and the plague brake in upon them.

provoked him to 19\_PSA\_78\_58 # For they provoked him to anger with their high places, and moved him to jealousy with their graven images.

provoked him with 19\_PSA\_106\_43 # Many times did he deliver them; but they provoked [him] with their counsel, and were brought low for their iniquity.

provoked him withal <u>12\_2KI\_23\_26</u># Notwithstanding the LORD turned not from the fierceness of his great wrath, wherewith his anger was kindled against Judah, because of all the provocations that Manasseh had provoked him withal.

provoked his spirit 19\_PSA\_106\_33 # Because they provoked his spirit, so that he spake unadvisedly with his lips.

provoked me see <u>04\_NUM\_14\_23</u> # Surely they shall not see the land which I sware unto their fathers, neither shall any of them that provoked me see it:

provoked me to 11\_1KI\_21\_22 # And will make thine house like the house of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, and like the house of Baasha the son of Ahijah, for the provocation wherewith thou hast provoked [me] to anger, and made Israel to sin.

provoked me to 12\_2KI\_21\_15 # Because they have done [that which was] evil in my sight, and have provoked me to anger, since the day their fathers came forth out of Egypt, even unto this day.

provoked me to <u>05\_DEU\_32\_21</u> # They have moved me to jealousy with [that which is] not God; they have provoked me to anger with their vanities: and I will move them to jealousy with [those which are] not a people; I will provoke them to anger with a foolish nation.

provoked me to <u>24\_JER\_08\_19</u> # Behold the voice of the cry of the daughter of my people because of them that dwell in a far country: [Is] not the LORD in Zion? [is] not her king in her? Why have they provoked me to anger with their graven images, [and] with strange vanities?

provoked me to <u>24\_JER\_32\_30</u># For the children of Israel and the children of Judah have only done evil before me from their youth: for the children of Israel have only provoked me to anger with the work of their hands, saith the LORD.

provoked me to <u>38\_ZEC\_08\_14</u> # For thus saith the LORD of hosts; As I thought to punish you, when your fathers provoked me to wrath, saith the LORD of hosts, and I repented not:

provoked the God <u>15\_EZR\_05\_12</u> # But after that our fathers had provoked the God of heaven unto wrath, he gave them into the hand of Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, the Chaldean, who destroyed this house, and carried the people away into Babylon.

provoked the Holy <u>23\_ISA\_01\_04</u># Ah sinful nation, a people laden with iniquity, a seed of evildoers, children that are corrupters: they have forsaken the LORD, they have provoked the Holy One of Israel unto anger, they are gone away backward.

provoked the LORD <u>11\_1KI\_15\_30</u># Because of the sins of Jeroboam which he sinned, and which he made Israel sin, by his provocation wherewith he provoked the LORD God of Israel to anger.

provoked the LORD <u>05\_DEU\_09\_08</u># Also in Horeb ye provoked the LORD to wrath, so that the LORD was angry with you to have destroyed you.

provoked the LORD <u>05\_DEU\_09\_22</u># And at Taberah, and at Massah, and at Kibrothhattaavah, ye provoked the LORD to wrath.

provoked the LORD <u>07\_JUD\_02\_12</u> # And they forsook the LORD God of their fathers, which brought them out of the land of Egypt, and followed other gods, of the gods of the people that [were] round about them, and bowed themselves unto them, and provoked the LORD to anger.

provoked the LORD <u>04\_NUM\_16\_30</u> # But if the LORD make a new thing, and the earth open her mouth, and swallow them up, with all that [appertain] unto them, and they go down quick into the pit; then ye shall understand that these men have provoked the LORD.

provoked the most <u>19\_PSA\_78\_56</u># Yet they tempted and provoked the most high God, and kept not his testimonies:

provoked thee to <u>16\_NEH\_04\_05</u># And cover not their iniquity, and let not their sin be blotted out from before thee: for they have provoked [thee] to anger before the builders.

provoked they him <u>05\_DEU\_32\_16</u> # They provoked him to jealousy with strange [gods], with abominations provoked they him to anger.

provoked thinketh no <u>46\_1CO\_13\_05</u> # Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil;

provoked to anger 11\_1KI\_22\_53 # For he served Baal, and worshipped him, and provoked to anger the LORD God of Israel, according to all that his father had done.

provoked to anger 14\_2CH\_28\_25 # And in every several city of Judah he made high places to burn incense unto other gods, and provoked to anger the LORD God of his fathers.

provoked very many <u>47\_2CO\_09\_02</u> # For I know the forwardness of your mind, for which I boast of you to them of Macedonia, that Achaia was ready a year ago; and your zeal hath provoked very many.

provokedst the LORD <u>05\_DEU\_09\_07</u> # Remember, [and] forget not, how thou provokedst the LORD thy God to wrath in the wilderness: from the day that thou didst depart out of the land of Egypt, until ye came unto this place, ye have been rebellious against the LORD.

provoketh him to <u>20\_PRO\_20\_02</u> # The fear of a king [is] as the roaring of a lion: [whoso] provoketh him to anger sinneth [against] his own soul.

provoketh me to <u>23\_ISA\_65\_03</u> # A people that provoketh me to anger continually to my face; that sacrificeth in gardens, and burneth incense upon altars of brick;

provoketh to jealousy <u>26\_EZE\_08\_03</u># And he put forth the form of an hand, and took me by a lock of mine head; and the spirit lifted me up between the earth and the heaven, and brought me in the visions of God to Jerusalem, to the door of the inner gate that looketh toward the north; where [was] the seat of the image of jealousy, which provoketh to jealousy.
