

KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

push a manservant <u>02_EXO_21_32</u># If the ox shall push a manservant or a maidservant; he shall give unto their master thirty shekels of silver, and the ox shall be stoned.

push at him <u>27_DAN_11_40</u># And at the time of the end shall the king of the south push at him: and the king of the north shall come against him like a whirlwind, with chariots, and with horsemen, and with many ships; and he shall enter into the countries, and shall overflow and pass over.

push away my 18_JOB_30_12 # Upon [my] right [hand] rise the youth; they push away my feet, and they raise up against me the ways of their destruction.

push down our 19_PSA_44_05 # Through thee will we push down our enemies: through thy name will we tread them under that rise up against us.

push in time <u>02_EXO_21_36</u> # Or if it be known that the ox hath used to push in time past, and his owner hath not kept him in; he shall surely pay ox for ox; and the dead shall be his own.

push Syria until 14_2CH_18_10 # And Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah had made him horns of iron, and said, Thus saith the LORD, With these thou shalt push Syria until they be consumed.

push the people <u>05_DEU_33_17</u> # His glory [is like] the firstling of his bullock, and his horns [are like] the horns of unicorns: with them he shall push the people together to the ends of the earth: and they [are] the ten thousands of Ephraim, and they [are] the thousands of Manasseh.

push the Syrians <u>11_1KI_22_11</u># And Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah made him horns of iron: and he said, Thus saith the LORD, With these shalt thou push the Syrians, until thou have consumed them.

push with his <u>02_EXO_21_29</u> # But if the ox were wont to push with his horn in time past, and it hath been testified to his owner, and he hath not kept him in, but that he hath killed a man or a woman; the ox shall be stoned, and his owner also shall be put to death.

pushed all the <u>26_EZE_34_21</u># Because ye have thrust with side and with shoulder, and pushed all the diseased with your horns, till ye have scattered them abroad;

pushing westward and <u>27_DAN_08_04</u># I saw the ram pushing westward, and northward, and southward; so that no beasts might stand before him, neither [was there any] that could deliver out of his hand; but he did according to his will, and became great.
