putteth a piece [42 LUK 05 36](#) # And he spake also a parable unto them; No man putteth a piece of a new garment upon an old; if otherwise, then both the new maketh a rent, and the piece that was [taken] out of the new agreeth not with the old.

putteth a piece [40 MAT 09 16](#) # No man putteth a piece of new cloth unto an old garment, for that which is put in to fill it up taketh from the garment, and the rent is made worse.

putteth any of [02 EXO 30 33](#) # Whosoever compoundeth [any] like it, or whosoever putteth [any] of it upon a stranger, shall even be cut off from his people.

putteth away his [42 LUK 16 18](#) # Whosoever putteth away his wife, and marrieth another, committeth adultery; and whosoever marrieth her that is put away from [her] husband committeth adultery.

putteth down one [19 PSA 75 07](#) # But God [is] the judge: he putteth down one, and setteth up another.

putteth forth her [05 DEU 25 11](#) # When men strive together one with another, and the wife of the one draweth near for to deliver her husband out of the hand of him that smiteth him, and putteth forth her hand, and taketh him by the secrets:

putteth forth her [22 SON 02 13](#) # The fig tree putteth forth her green figs, and the vines [with] the tender grape give a [good] smell. Arise, my love, my fair one, and come away.

putteth forth his [18 JOB 28 09](#) # He putteth forth his hand upon the rock; he overturneth the mountains by the roots.

putteth forth his [43 JOH 10 04](#) # And when he putteth forth his own sheep, he goeth before them, and the sheep follow him: for they know his voice.

putteth forth leaves [41 MAR 13 28](#) # Now learn a parable of the fig tree; When her branch is yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, ye know that summer is near:

putteth forth leaves [40 MAT 24 32](#) # Now learn a parable of the fig tree; When his branch is yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, ye know that summer [is] nigh:

putteth his mouth [25 LAM 03 29](#) # He putteth his mouth in the dust; if so be there may be hope.

putteth his trust [23 ISA 57 13](#) # When thou criest, let thy companies deliver thee; but the wind shall carry them all away; vanity shall take [them]: but he that putteth his trust in me shall possess the land, and shall inherit my holy mountain;

putteth his trust [20 PRO 28 25](#) # He that is of a proud heart stirreth up strife: but he that putteth his trust in the LORD shall be made fat.

putteth his trust [20 PRO 29 25](#) # The fear of man bringeth a snare: but whoso putteth his trust in the LORD shall be safe.

putteth in my [04 NUM 22 38](#) # And Balaam said unto Balak, Lo, I am come unto thee: have I now any power at all to say any thing? the word that God putteth in my mouth, that shall I speak.

putteth in the [41 MAR 04 29](#) # But when the fruit is brought forth, immediately he putteth in the sickle, because the harvest is come.

putteth it in [05 DEU 27 15](#) # Cursed [be] the man that maketh [any] graven or molten image, an abomination unto the LORD, the work of the hands of the craftsman, and putteth [it] in [a] secret [place]. And all the people shall answer and say, Amen.

putteth it in [42 LUK 11 33](#) # No man, when he hath lighted a candle, putteth [it] in a secret place, neither under a bushel, but on a candlestick, that they which come in may see the light.

putteth it off [11 1KI 20 11](#) # And the king of Israel answered and said, Tell [him], Let not him that girdeth on [his harness] boast himself as he that putteth it off.

putteth it under [42 LUK 08 16](#) # No man, when he hath lighted a candle, covereth it with a vessel, or putteth [it] under a bed; but setteth [it] on a candlestick, that they which enter in may see the light.

putteth my feet [18 JOB 33 11](#) # He putteth my feet in the stocks, he marketh all my paths.

putteth new wine [42 LUK 05 37](#) # And no man putteth new wine into old bottles; else the new wine will burst the bottles, and be spilled, and the bottles shall perish.

putteth new wine [41 MAR 02 22](#) # And no man putteth new wine into old bottles; else the new wine doth burst the bottles, and the wine is spilled, and the bottles will be marred: but new wine must be put into new bottles.

putteth no trust [18 JOB 15 15](#) # Behold, he putteth no trust in his saints; yea, the heavens are not clean in his sight.

putteth not into [33 MIC 03 05](#) # Thus saith the LORD concerning the prophets that make my people err, that bite with their teeth, and cry, Peace; and he that putteth not into their mouths, they even prepare war against him.

putteth not out [19 PSA 15 05](#) # [He that] putteth not out his money to usury, nor taketh reward against the innocent. He that doeth these [things] shall never be moved.

putteth on his [24 JER 43 12](#) # And I will kindle a fire in the houses of the gods of Egypt; and he shall burn them, and carry them away captives: and he shall array himself with the land of Egypt, as a shepherd putteth on his garment; and he shall go forth from thence in peace.

putteth the stumblingblock [26 EZE 14 04](#) # Therefore speak unto them, and say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Every man of the house of Israel that setteth up his idols in his heart, and putteth the stumblingblock of his iniquity before his face, and cometh to the prophet; I the LORD will answer him that cometh according to the multitude of his idols;
