disquiet the inhabitants <u>24_JER_50_34</u># Their Redeemer [is] strong; the LORD of hosts [is] his name: he shall thoroughly plead their cause, that he may give rest to the land, and disquiet the inhabitants of Babylon.

disquieted and for <u>20_PRO_30_21</u># For three [things] the earth is disquieted, and for four [which] it cannot bear:

disquieted in me <u>19_PSA_42_05</u> # Why art thou cast down, O my soul? and [why] art thou disquieted in me? hope thou in God: for I shall yet praise him [for] the help of his countenance.

disquieted in vain <u>19_PSA_39_06</u># Surely every man walketh in a vain show: surely they are disquieted in vain: he heapeth up [riches], and knoweth not who shall gather them.

disquieted me to <u>09_1SA_28_15</u> # And Samuel said to Saul, Why hast thou disquieted me, to bring me up? And Saul answered, I am sore distressed; for the Philistines make war against me, and God is departed from me, and answereth me no more, neither by prophets, nor by dreams: therefore I have called thee, that thou mayest make known unto me what I shall do.

disquieted within me <u>19_PSA_42_11</u># Why art thou cast down, O my soul? and why art thou disquieted within me? hope thou in God: for I shall yet praise him, [who is] the health of my countenance, and my God.

disquieted within me <u>19_PSA_43_05</u> # Why art thou cast down, O my soul? and why art thou disquieted within me? hope in God: for I shall yet praise him, [who is] the health of my countenance, and my God.

disquietness of my <u>19_PSA_38_08</u># I am feeble and sore broken: I have roared by reason of the disquietness of my heart.

quiet after that <u>14_2CH_23_21</u> # And all the people of the land rejoiced: and the city was quiet, after that they had slain Athaliah with the sword.

quiet all the <u>07_JUD_16_02</u> # [And it was told] the Gazites, saying, Samson is come hither. And they compassed [him] in, and laid wait for him all night in the gate of the city, and were quiet all the night, saying, In the morning, when it is day, we shall kill him.

quiet and likewise <u>34_NAH_01_12</u> # Thus saith the LORD; Though [they be] quiet, and likewise many, yet thus shall they be cut down, when he shall pass through. Though I have afflicted thee, I will afflict thee no more.

quiet and none 24_JER_30_10 # Therefore fear thou not, O my servant Jacob, saith the LORD; neither be dismayed, O Israel: for, lo, I will save thee from afar, and thy seed from the land of their captivity; and Jacob shall return, and shall be in rest, and be quiet, and none shall make [him] afraid.

quiet and peaceable <u>13_1CH_04_40</u> # And they found fat pasture and good, and the land [was] wide, and quiet, and peaceable; for [they] of Ham had dwelt there of old.

quiet and peaceable <u>54_1TI_02_02</u># For kings, and [for] all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.

quiet and secure <u>07_JUD_18_07</u># Then the five men departed, and came to Laish, and saw the people that [were] therein, how they dwelt careless, after the manner of the Zidonians, quiet and secure; and [there was] no magistrate in the land, that might put [them] to shame in [any] thing; and they [were] far from the Zidonians, and had no business with [any] man.

quiet and secure <u>07_JUD_18_27</u> # And they took [the things] which Micah had made, and the priest which he had, and came unto Laish, unto a people [that were] at quiet and secure: and they smote them with the edge of the sword, and burnt the city with fire.

quiet and they <u>12_2KI_11_20</u># And all the people of the land rejoiced, and the city was in quiet: and they slew Athaliah with the sword [beside] the king's house.

quiet and to <u>52_1TH_04_11</u># And that ye study to be quiet, and to do your own business, and to work with your own hands, as we commanded you;

quiet and to <u>44_ACT_19_36</u> # Seeing then that these things cannot be spoken against, ye ought to be quiet, and to do nothing rashly.

quiet and will <u>26_EZE_16_42</u> # So will I make my fury toward thee to rest, and my jealousy shall depart from thee, and I will be quiet, and will be no more angry.

quiet before him <u>14_2CH_14_05</u> # Also he took away out of all the cities of Judah the high places and the images: and the kingdom was quiet before him.

quiet fear not 23_ISA_07_04 # And say unto him, Take heed, and be quiet; fear not, neither be fainthearted for the two tails of these smoking firebrands, for the fierce anger of Rezin with Syria, and of the son of Remaliah.

quiet for his <u>14_2CH_20_30</u># So the realm of Jehoshaphat was quiet: for his God gave him rest round about.

quiet from fear <u>20_PRO_01_33</u># But whoso hearkeneth unto me shall dwell safely, and shall be quiet from fear of evil.

quiet habitation a <u>23_ISA_33_20</u> # Look upon Zion, the city of our solemnities: thine eyes shall see Jerusalem a quiet habitation, a tabernacle [that] shall not be taken down; not one of the stakes thereof shall ever be removed, neither shall any of the cords thereof be broken.

quiet I should <u>18_JOB_03_13</u># For now should I have lain still and been quiet, I should have slept: then had I been at rest,

quiet in the <u>19_PSA_35_20</u># For they speak not peace: but they devise deceitful matters against [them that are] quiet in the land.

quiet more than <u>21_ECC_09_17</u># The words of wise [men are] heard in quiet more than the cry of him that ruleth among fools.

quiet prince <u>24_JER_51_59</u># The word which Jeremiah the prophet commanded Seraiah the son of Neriah, the son of Maaseiah, when he went with Zedekiah the king of Judah into Babylon in the fourth year of his reign. And [this] Seraiah [was] a quiet prince.

quiet put up <u>24_JER_47_06</u># O thou sword of the LORD, how long [will it be] ere thou be quiet? put up thyself into thy scabbard, rest, and be still.

quiet resting places <u>23 ISA 32 18</u> # And my people shall dwell in a peaceable habitation, and in sure dwellings, and in quiet resting places;

quiet seeing the <u>24_JER_47_07</u># How can it be quiet, seeing the LORD hath given it a charge against Ashkelon, and against the sea shore? there hath he appointed it.

quiet so he <u>19_PSA_107_30</u># Then are they glad because they be quiet; so he bringeth them unto their desired haven.

quiet spirit which <u>60_1PE_03_04</u> # But [let it be] the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, [even the ornament] of a meek and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of God of great price.

quiet ten years <u>14_2CH_14_01</u> # So Abijah slept with his fathers, and they buried him in the city of David: and Asa his son reigned in his stead. In his days the land was quiet ten years.

quiet they break 23_ISA_14_07 # The whole earth is at rest, [and] is quiet: they break forth into singing.

quiet yet trouble <u>18_JOB_03_26</u># I was not in safety, neither had I rest, neither was I quiet; yet trouble came.

quiet <u>24_JER_49_23</u> # Concerning Damascus. Hamath is confounded, and Arpad: for they have heard evil tidings: they are fainthearted; [there is] sorrow on the sea; it cannot be quiet.

quiet <u>18_JOB_21_23</u> # One dieth in his full strength, being wholly at ease and quiet.

quieted my spirit <u>38_ZEC_06_08</u># Then cried he upon me, and spake unto me, saying, Behold, these that go toward the north country have quieted my spirit in the north country.

quieted myself as <u>19_PSA_131_02</u># Surely I have behaved and quieted myself, as a child that is weaned of his mother: my soul [is] even as a weaned child.

quieteth the earth <u>18_JOB_37_17</u> # How thy garments [are] warm, when he quieteth the earth by the south [wind]?

quietly and smote <u>10_28A_03_27</u> # And when Abner was returned to Hebron, Joab took him aside in the gate to speak with him quietly, and smote him there under the fifth [rib], that he died, for the blood of Asahel his brother.

quietly wait for <u>25_LAM_03_26</u># [It is] good that [a man] should both hope and quietly wait for the salvation of the LORD.

quietness and assurance <u>23_ISA_32_17</u> # And the work of righteousness shall be peace; and the effect of righteousness quietness and assurance for ever.

quietness and in <u>23_ISA_30_15</u> # For thus saith the Lord GOD, the Holy One of Israel; In returning and rest shall ye be saved; in quietness and in confidence shall be your strength: and ye would not.

quietness and that <u>44_ACT_24_02</u> # And when he was called forth, Tertullus began to accuse [him], saying, Seeing that by thee we enjoy great quietness, and that very worthy deeds are done unto this nation by thy providence,

quietness forty years <u>07_JUD_08_28</u># Thus was Midian subdued before the children of Israel, so that they lifted up their heads no more. And the country was in quietness forty years in the days of Gideon.

quietness in his <u>18_JOB_20_20</u> # Surely he shall not feel quietness in his belly, he shall not save of that

quietness who then <u>18_JOB_34_29</u> # When he giveth quietness, who then can make trouble? and when he hideth [his] face, who then can behold him? whether [it be done] against a nation, or against a man only:
