Barachel the Buzite 18_JOB_32_02 # Then was kindled the wrath of Elihu the son of Barachel the Buzite, of the kindred of Ram: against Job was his wrath kindled, because he justified himself rather than God.

Barachel the Buzite 18_JOB_32_06 # And Elihu the son of Barachel the Buzite answered and said, I [am] young, and ye [are] very old; wherefore I was afraid, and durst not show you mine opinion.

Rachel and God <u>01_GEN_30_22</u> # And God remembered Rachel, and God hearkened to her, and opened her womb.

Rachel and he <u>01_GEN_29_30</u># And he went in also unto Rachel, and he loved also Rachel more than Leah, and served with him yet seven other years.

Rachel and he <u>01_GEN_30_02</u> # And Jacob's anger was kindled against Rachel: and he said, [Am] I in God's stead, who hath withheld from thee the fruit of the womb?

Rachel and Joseph <u>01_GEN_33_02</u> # And he put the handmaids and their children foremost, and Leah and her children after, and Rachel and Joseph hindermost.

Rachel and Leah 01_GEN_31_04 # And Jacob sent and called Rachel and Leah to the field unto his flock,

Rachel and Leah <u>01_GEN_31_14</u># And Rachel and Leah answered and said unto him, [Is there] yet any portion or inheritance for us in our father's house?

Rachel and lifted 01_GEN_29_11 # And Jacob kissed Rachel, and lifted up his voice, and wept.

Rachel and like <u>08_RUT_04_11</u># And all the people that [were] in the gate, and the elders, said, [We are] witnesses. The LORD make the woman that is come into thine house like Rachel and like Leah, which two did build the house of Israel: and do thou worthily in Ephratah, and be famous in Bethlehem:

Rachel and said <u>01_GEN_29_18</u># And Jacob loved Rachel; and said, I will serve thee seven years for Rachel thy younger daughter.

Rachel and they <u>01_GEN_29_20</u># And Jacob served seven years for Rachel; and they seemed unto him [but] a few days, for the love he had to her.

Rachel and they <u>01_GEN_33_07</u> # And Leah also with her children came near, and bowed themselves: and after came Joseph near and Rachel, and they bowed themselves.

Rachel and unto <u>01_GEN_33_01</u># And Jacob lifted up his eyes, and looked, and, behold, Esau came, and with him four hundred men. And he divided the children unto Leah, and unto Rachel, and unto the two handmaids.

Rachel came with <u>01_GEN_29_09</u># And while he yet spake with them, Rachel came with her father's sheep: for she kept them.

Rachel died and <u>01_GEN_35_19</u># And Rachel died, and was buried in the way to Ephrath, which [is] Bethlehem.

Rachel died by <u>01_GEN_48_07</u># And as for me, when I came from Padan, Rachel died by me in the land of Canaan in the way, when yet [there was] but a little way to come unto Ephrath: and I buried her there in the way of Ephrath; the same [is] Bethlehem.

Rachel envied her <u>01_GEN_30_01</u># And when Rachel saw that she bare Jacob no children, Rachel envied her sister; and said unto Jacob, Give me children, or else I die.

Rachel had born <u>01_GEN_30_25</u># And it came to pass, when Rachel had born Joseph, that Jacob said unto Laban, Send me away, that I may go unto mine own place, and to my country.

Rachel had stolen <u>01_GEN_31_19</u># And Laban went to shear his sheep: and Rachel had stolen the images that [were] her father's.

Rachel had stolen <u>01_GEN_31_32</u># With whomsoever thou findest thy gods, let him not live: before our brethren discern thou what [is] thine with me, and take [it] to thee. For Jacob knew not that Rachel had stolen them.

Rachel had taken <u>01_GEN_31_34</u># Now Rachel had taken the images, and put them in the camel's furniture, and sat upon them. And Laban searched all the tent, but found [them] not.

Rachel his daughter <u>01_GEN_29_06</u> # And he said unto them, [Is] he well? And they said, [He is] well: and, behold, Rachel his daughter cometh with the sheep.

Rachel his daughter <u>01_GEN_29_28</u> # And Jacob did so, and fulfilled her week: and he gave him Rachel his daughter to wife also.

Rachel his daughter <u>01_GEN_29_29</u># And Laban gave to Rachel his daughter Bilhah his handmaid to be her maid.

Rachel his daughter <u>01_GEN_46_25</u> # These [are] the sons of Bilhah, which Laban gave unto Rachel his daughter, and she bare these unto Jacob: all the souls [were] seven.

Rachel Jacob's wife <u>01_GEN_46_19</u> # The sons of Rachel Jacob's wife; Joseph, and Benjamin.

Rachel Joseph and 01_GEN_35_24 # The sons of Rachel; Joseph, and Benjamin:

Rachel more than <u>01_GEN_29_30</u> # And he went in also unto Rachel, and he loved also Rachel more than Leah, and served with him yet seven other years.

Rachel said God <u>01_GEN_30_06</u> # And Rachel said, God hath judged me, and hath also heard my voice, and hath given me a son: therefore called she his name Dan.

Rachel said Therefore <u>01_GEN_30_15</u># And she said unto her, [Is it] a small matter that thou hast taken my husband? and wouldest thou take away my son's mandrakes also? And Rachel said, Therefore he shall lie with thee to night for thy son's mandrakes.

Rachel said to <u>01_GEN_30_14</u># And Reuben went in the days of wheat harvest, and found mandrakes in the field, and brought them unto his mother Leah. Then Rachel said to Leah, Give me, I pray thee, of thy son's mandrakes.

Rachel said With <u>01_GEN_30_08</u># And Rachel said, With great wrestlings have I wrestled with my sister, and I have prevailed: and she called his name Naphtali.

Rachel saw that <u>01_GEN_30_01</u># And when Rachel saw that she bare Jacob no children, Rachel envied her sister; and said unto Jacob, Give me children, or else I die.

Rachel that he <u>01_GEN_29_12</u> # And Jacob told Rachel that he [was] her father's brother, and that he [was] Rebekah's son: and she ran and told her father.

Rachel the daughter <u>01_GEN_29_10</u> # And it came to pass, when Jacob saw Rachel the daughter of Laban his mother's brother, and the sheep of Laban his mother's brother, that Jacob went near, and rolled the stone from the well's mouth, and watered the flock of Laban his mother's brother.

Rachel thy younger <u>01_GEN_29_18</u> # And Jacob loved Rachel; and said, I will serve thee seven years for Rachel thy younger daughter.

Rachel travailed and <u>01_GEN_35_16</u># And they journeyed from Bethel; and there was but a little way to come to Ephrath: and Rachel travailed, and she had hard labour.

Rachel was barren <u>01_GEN_29_31</u># And when the LORD saw that Leah [was] hated, he opened her womb: but Rachel [was] barren.

Rachel was beautiful <u>01_GEN_29_17</u># Leah [was] tender eyed; but Rachel was beautiful and well favoured.

Rachel weeping for 40_MAT_02_18# In Rama was there a voice heard, lamentation, and weeping, and great mourning, Rachel weeping [for] her children, and would not be comforted, because they are not.

Rachel wherefore then <u>01_GEN_29_25</u># And it came to pass, that in the morning, behold, it [was] Leah: and he said to Laban, What [is] this thou hast done unto me? did not I serve with thee for Rachel? wherefore then hast thou beguiled me?

Rachel which were <u>01_GEN_46_22</u> # These [are] the sons of Rachel, which were born to Jacob: all the souls [were] fourteen.

Rachel <u>01_GEN_29_16</u># And Laban had two daughters: the name of the elder [was] Leah, and the name of the younger [was] Rachel.

Rachel's grave unto <u>01_GEN_35_20</u> # And Jacob set a pillar upon her grave: that [is] the pillar of Rachel's grave unto this day.

Rachel's handmaid Dan 01_GEN_35_25 # And the sons of Bilhah, Rachel's handmaid; Dan, and Naphtali:

Rachel's maid conceived <u>01_GEN_30_07</u> # And Bilhah Rachel's maid conceived again, and bare Jacob a second son.

Rachel's sepulchre in <u>09_1SA_10_02</u># When thou art departed from me to day, then thou shalt find two men by Rachel's sepulchre in the border of Benjamin at Zelzah; and they will say unto thee, The asses which thou wentest to seek are found: and, lo, thy father hath left the care of the asses, and sorroweth for you, saying, What shall I do for my son?

Rachel's tent <u>01_GEN_31_33</u># And Laban went into Jacob's tent, and into Leah's tent, and into the two maidservants' tents; but he found [them] not. Then went he out of Leah's tent, and entered into Rachel's tent.
