hereunto more than <u>21_ECC_02_25</u> # For who can eat, or who else can hasten [hereunto], more than I?

hereunto were ye <u>60_1PE_02_21</u> # For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps:

Nereus and his <u>45_ROM_16_15</u># Salute Philologus, and Julia, Nereus, and his sister, and Olympas, and all the saints which are with them.

Reu lived after <u>01_GEN_11_21</u># And Reu lived after he begat Serug two hundred and seven years, and begat sons and daughters.

Reu lived two <u>01_GEN_11_20</u># And Reu lived two and thirty years, and begat Serug:

Reu two hundred <u>01_GEN_11_19</u># And Peleg lived after he begat Reu two hundred and nine years, and begat sons and daughters.

Reu <u>13_1CH_01_25</u> # Eber, Peleg, Reu,

Reu <u>01_GEN_11_18</u># And Peleg lived thirty years, and begat Reu:

Reuben according to <u>04_NUM_02_10</u> # On the south side [shall be] the standard of the camp of Reuben according to their armies: and the captain of the children of Reuben [shall be] Elizur the son of Shedeur.

Reuben according to <u>04_NUM_34_14</u> # For the tribe of the children of Reuben according to the house of their fathers, and the tribe of the children of Gad according to the house of their fathers, have received [their inheritance]; and half the tribe of Manasseh have received their inheritance:

Reuben after their <u>06_JOS_13_23</u># And the border of the children of Reuben was Jordan, and the border [thereof]. This [was] the inheritance of the children of Reuben after their families, the cities and the villages thereof.

Reuben and children <u>06_JOS_22_25</u> # For the LORD hath made Jordan a border between us and you, ye children of Reuben and children of Gad; ye have no part in the LORD: so shall your children make our children cease from fearing the LORD.

Reuben and from <u>06_JOS_22_32</u># And Phinehas the son of Eleazar the priest, and the princes, returned from the children of Reuben, and from the children of Gad, out of the land of Gilead, unto the land of Canaan, to the children of Israel, and brought them word again.

Reuben and Gad <u>06_JOS_22_33</u> # And the thing pleased the children of Israel; and the children of Israel blessed God, and did not intend to go up against them in battle, to destroy the land wherein the children of Reuben and Gad dwelt.

Reuben and half <u>06_JOS_18_07</u> # But the Levites have no part among you; for the priesthood of the LORD [is] their inheritance: and Gad, and Reuben, and half the tribe of Manasseh, have received their inheritance beyond Jordan on the east, which Moses the servant of the LORD gave them.

Reuben and out <u>13_1CH_06_63</u># Unto the sons of Merari [were given] by lot, throughout their families,

out of the tribe of Reuben, and out of the tribe of Gad, and out of the tribe of Zebulun, twelve cities.

Reuben and out <u>06_JOS_21_07</u> # The children of Merari by their families [had] out of the tribe of Reuben, and out of the tribe of Gad, and out of the tribe of Zebulun, twelve cities.

Reuben and Ramoth <u>06_JOS_20_08</u> # And on the other side Jordan by Jericho eastward, they assigned Bezer in the wilderness upon the plain out of the tribe of Reuben, and Ramoth in Gilead out of the tribe of Gad, and Golan in Bashan out of the tribe of Manasseh.

Reuben and Simeon <u>01_GEN_48_05</u> # And now thy two sons, Ephraim and Manasseh, which were born unto thee in the land of Egypt before I came unto thee into Egypt, [are] mine; as Reuben and Simeon, they shall be mine.

Reuben and the <u>13_1CH_05_18</u> # The sons of Reuben, and the Gadites, and half the tribe of Manasseh, of valiant men, men able to bear buckler and sword, and to shoot with bow, and skilful in war, [were] four and forty thousand seven hundred and threescore, that went out to the war.

Reuben and the <u>06_JOS_04_12</u># And the children of Reuben, and the children of Gad, and half the tribe of Manasseh, passed over armed before the children of Israel, as Moses spake unto them:

Reuben and the <u>06_JOS_22_09</u> # And the children of Reuben and the children of Gad and the half tribe of Manasseh returned, and departed from the children of Israel out of Shiloh, which [is] in the land of Canaan, to go unto the country of Gilead, to the land of their possession, whereof they were possessed, according to the word of the LORD by the hand of Moses.

Reuben and to <u>06_JOS_22_13</u> # And the children of Israel sent unto the children of Reuben, and to the children of Gad, and to the half tribe of Manasseh, into the land of Gilead, Phinehas the son of Eleazar the priest,

Reuben and unto <u>04_NUM_32_33</u> # And Moses gave unto them, [even] to the children of Gad, and to the children of Reuben, and unto half the tribe of Manasseh the son of Joseph, the kingdom of Sihon king of the Amorites, and the kingdom of Og king of Bashan, the land, with the cities thereof in the coasts, [even] the cities of the country round about.

Reuben answered saying <u>04_NUM_32_31</u> # And the children of Gad and the children of Reuben answered, saying, As the LORD hath said unto thy servants, so will we do.

Reuben answered them <u>01_GEN_42_22</u> # And Reuben answered them, saying, Spake I not unto you, saying, Do not sin against the child; and ye would not hear? therefore, behold, also his blood is required.

Reuben Bezer in <u>13_1CH_06_78</u> # And on the other side Jordan by Jericho, on the east side of Jordan, [were given them] out of the tribe of Reuben, Bezer in the wilderness with her suburbs, and Jahzah with her suburbs,

Reuben Bezer with <u>06_JOS_21_36</u># And out of the tribe of Reuben, Bezer with her suburbs, and Jahazah with her suburbs,

Reuben built Heshbon <u>04_NUM_32_37</u> # And the children of Reuben built Heshbon, and Elealeh, and Kirjathaim,

Reuben came and <u>04_NUM_32_02</u># The children of Gad and the children of Reuben came and spake unto Moses, and to Eleazar the priest, and unto the princes of the congregation, saying,

Reuben did offer <u>04_NUM_07_30</u> # On the fourth day Elizur the son of Shedeur, prince of the children of Reuben, [did offer]:

Reuben Elizur the <u>04_NUM_01_05</u> # And these [are] the names of the men that shall stand with you: of [the tribe of] Reuben; Elizur the son of Shedeur.

Reuben for she <u>01_GEN_29_32</u> # And Leah conceived, and bare a son, and she called his name Reuben: for she said, Surely the LORD hath looked upon my affliction; now therefore my husband will love me.

Reuben from the <u>26_EZE_48_07</u># And by the border of Reuben, from the east side unto the west side, a [portion for] Judah.

Reuben Gad and <u>05_DEU_27_13</u># And these shall stand upon mount Ebal to curse; Reuben, Gad, and Asher, and Zebulun, Dan, and Naphtali.

Reuben Hanoch and <u>01_GEN_46_09</u># And the sons of Reuben; Hanoch, and Phallu, and Hezron, and Carmi.

Reuben Hanoch of <u>04_NUM_26_05</u> # Reuben, the eldest son of Israel: the children of Reuben; Hanoch, [of whom cometh] the family of the Hanochites: of Pallu, the family of the Palluites:

Reuben heard it <u>01_GEN_37_21</u># And Reuben heard [it], and he delivered him out of their hands; and said, Let us not kill him.

Reuben how the <u>05_DEU_11_06</u># And what he did unto Dathan and Abiram, the sons of Eliab, the son of Reuben: how the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed them up, and their households, and their tents, and all the substance that [was] in their possession, in the midst of all Israel:

Reuben inheritance according <u>06_JOS_13_15</u># And Moses gave unto the tribe of the children of Reuben [inheritance] according to their families.

Reuben Israel's eldest <u>04_NUM_01_20</u> # And the children of Reuben, Israel's eldest son, by their generations, after their families, by the house of their fathers, according to the number of the names, by their polls, every male from twenty years old and upward, all that were able to go forth to war;

Reuben Jacob's firstborn <u>01_GEN_35_23</u># The sons of Leah; Reuben, Jacob's firstborn, and Simeon, and Levi, and Judah, and Issachar, and Zebulun:

Reuben Jacob's firstborn <u>01_GEN_46_08</u> # And these [are] the names of the children of Israel, which came into Egypt, Jacob and his sons: Reuben, Jacob's firstborn.

Reuben live and <u>05_DEU_33_06</u> # Let Reuben live, and not die; and let [not] his men be few.

Reuben one gate <u>26_EZE_48_31</u> # And the gates of the city [shall be] after the names of the tribes of Israel: three gates northward; one gate of Reuben, one gate of Judah, one gate of Levi.

Reuben returned unto <u>01_GEN_37_29</u># And Reuben returned unto the pit; and, behold, Joseph [was] not in the pit; and he rent his clothes.

Reuben said unto <u>01_GEN_37_22</u># And Reuben said unto them, Shed no blood, [but] cast him into this pit that [is] in the wilderness, and lay no hand upon him; that he might rid him out of their hands, to deliver him to his father again.

Reuben set forward <u>04_NUM_10_18</u> # And the standard of the camp of Reuben set forward according to their armies: and over his host [was] Elizur the son of Shedeur.

Reuben shall be <u>04_NUM_02_10</u> # On the south side [shall be] the standard of the camp of Reuben according to their armies: and the captain of the children of Reuben [shall be] Elizur the son of Shedeur.

Reuben Shall your <u>04_NUM_32_06</u># And Moses said unto the children of Gad and to the children of Reuben, Shall your brethren go to war, and shall ye sit here?

Reuben Shammua the <u>04_NUM_13_04</u> # And these [were] their names: of the tribe of Reuben, Shammua the son of Zaccur.

Reuben Simeon Levi <u>13_1CH_02_01</u># These [are] the sons of Israel; Reuben, Simeon, Levi, and Judah, Issachar, and Zebulun,

Reuben Simeon Levi <u>02_EXO_01_02</u> # Reuben, Simeon, Levi, and Judah,

Reuben spake unto <u>01_GEN_42_37</u> # And Reuben spake unto his father, saying, Slay my two sons, if I bring him not to thee: deliver him into my hand, and I will bring him to thee again.

Reuben spake unto 04_NUM_32_25 # And the children of Gad and the children of Reuben spake unto Moses, saying, Thy servants will do as my lord commandeth.

Reuben the eldest <u>04_NUM_26_05</u> # Reuben, the eldest son of Israel: the children of Reuben; Hanoch, [of whom cometh] the family of the Hanochites: of Pallu, the family of the Palluites:

Reuben the firstborn <u>13_1CH_05_01</u> # Now the sons of Reuben the firstborn of Israel, [for he [was] the firstborn; but, forasmuch as he defiled his father's bed, his birthright was given unto the sons of Joseph the son of Israel: and the genealogy is not to be reckoned after the birthright.

Reuben the firstborn <u>13_1CH_05_03</u># The sons, [I say], of Reuben the firstborn of Israel [were], Hanoch, and Pallu, Hezron, and Carmi.

Reuben the firstborn <u>02_EXO_06_14</u> # These [be] the heads of their fathers' houses: The sons of Reuben the firstborn of Israel; Hanoch, and Pallu, Hezron, and Carmi: these [be] the families of Reuben.

Reuben there were <u>07_JUD_05_15</u># And the princes of Issachar [were] with Deborah; even Issachar, and also Barak: he was sent on foot into the valley. For the divisions of Reuben [there were] great thoughts of heart.

Reuben there were <u>07_JUD_05_16</u> # Why abodest thou among the sheepfolds, to hear the bleatings of the flocks? For the divisions of Reuben [there were] great searchings of heart.

Reuben thou art <u>01_GEN_49_03</u># Reuben, thou [art] my firstborn, my might, and the beginning of my strength, the excellency of dignity, and the excellency of power:

Reuben took men <u>04_NUM_16_01</u> # Now Korah, the son of Izhar, the son of Kohath, the son of Levi, and Dathan and Abiram, the sons of Eliab, and On, the son of Peleth, sons of Reuben, took [men]:

Reuben was Jordan <u>06_JOS_13_23</u># And the border of the children of Reuben was Jordan, and the border [thereof]. This [was] the inheritance of the children of Reuben after their families, the cities and the villages thereof.

Reuben went and <u>01_GEN_35_22</u> # And it came to pass, when Israel dwelt in that land, that Reuben went and lay with Bilhah his father's concubine: and Israel heard [it]. Now the sons of Jacob were twelve:

Reuben went in <u>01_GEN_30_14</u># And Reuben went in the days of wheat harvest, and found mandrakes in the field, and brought them unto his mother Leah. Then Rachel said to Leah, Give me, I pray thee, of thy son's mandrakes.

Reuben were an <u>04_NUM_02_16</u> # All that were numbered in the camp of Reuben [were] an hundred thousand and fifty and one thousand and four hundred and fifty, throughout their armies. And they shall set forth in the second rank.

Reuben were forty <u>04_NUM_01_21</u># Those that were numbered of them, [even] of the tribe of Reuben, [were] forty and six thousand and five hundred.

Reuben were sealed <u>66_REV_07_05</u># Of the tribe of Juda [were] sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Reuben [were] sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Gad [were] sealed twelve thousand.

Reuben will pass <u>04_NUM_32_29</u> # And Moses said unto them, If the children of Gad and the children of Reuben will pass with you over Jordan, every man armed to battle, before the LORD, and the land shall be subdued before you; then ye shall give them the land of Gilead for a possession:

Reuben <u>02_EXO_06_14</u># These [be] the heads of their fathers' houses: The sons of Reuben the firstborn of Israel; Hanoch, and Pallu, Hezron, and Carmi: these [be] the families of Reuben.

Reuben <u>26_EZE_48_06</u> # And by the border of Ephraim, from the east side even unto the west side, a [portion for] Reuben.

Reuben <u>06_JOS_15_06</u># And the border went up to Bethhogla, and passed along by the north of Betharabah; and the border went up to the stone of Bohan the son of Reuben:

Reuben <u>06_JOS_18_17</u># And was drawn from the north, and went forth to Enshemesh, and went forth

toward Geliloth, which [is] over against the going up of Adummim, and descended to the stone of Bohan the son of Reuben,

Reubenite a captain <u>13_1CH_11_42</u># Adina the son of Shiza the Reubenite, a captain of the Reubenites, and thirty with him,

Reubenites and Ramoth <u>05_DEU_04_43</u> # [Namely], Bezer in the wilderness, in the plain country, of the Reubenites; and Ramoth in Gilead, of the Gadites; and Golan in Bashan, of the Manassites.

Reubenites and the <u>13_1CH_05_26</u> # And the God of Israel stirred up the spirit of Pul king of Assyria, and the spirit of Tilgathpilneser king of Assyria, and he carried them away, even the Reubenites, and the Gadites, and the half tribe of Manasseh, and brought them unto Halah, and Habor, and Hara, and to the river Gozan, unto this day.

Reubenites and the <u>13_1CH_12_37</u> # And on the other side of Jordan, of the Reubenites, and the Gadites, and of the half tribe of Manasseh, with all manner of instruments of war for the battle, an hundred and twenty thousand.

Reubenites and the <u>12_2KI_10_33</u># From Jordan eastward, all the land of Gilead, the Gadites, and the Reubenites, and the Manassites, from Aroer, which [is] by the river Arnon, even Gilead and Bashan.

Reubenites and the <u>06_JOS_12_06</u> # Them did Moses the servant of the LORD and the children of Israel smite: and Moses the servant of the LORD gave it [for] a possession unto the Reubenites, and the Gadites, and the half tribe of Manasseh.

Reubenites and the <u>06_JOS_13_08</u># With whom the Reubenites and the Gadites have received their inheritance, which Moses gave them, beyond Jordan eastward, [even] as Moses the servant of the LORD gave them;

Reubenites and the <u>06_JOS_22_01</u># Then Joshua called the Reubenites, and the Gadites, and the half tribe of Manasseh,

Reubenites and they <u>04_NUM_26_07</u> # These [are] the families of the Reubenites: and they that were numbered of them were forty and three thousand and seven hundred and thirty.

Reubenites and thirty <u>13_1CH_11_42</u># Adina the son of Shiza the Reubenite, a captain of the Reubenites, and thirty with him,

Reubenites and to <u>05_DEU_03_12</u># And this land, [which] we possessed at that time, from Aroer, which [is] by the river Arnon, and half mount Gilead, and the cities thereof, gave I unto the Reubenites and to the Gadites.

Reubenites and to <u>05_DEU_29_08</u># And we took their land, and gave it for an inheritance unto the Reubenites, and to the Gadites, and to the half tribe of Manasseh.

Reubenites and to <u>06_JOS_01_12</u># And to the Reubenites, and to the Gadites, and to half the tribe of Manasseh, spake Joshua, saying,

Reubenites and unto <u>05_DEU_03_16</u># And unto the Reubenites and unto the Gadites I gave from Gilead even unto the river Arnon half the valley, and the border even unto the river Jabbok, [which is] the border of the children of Ammon;

Reubenites the Gadites <u>13_1CH_26_32</u> # And his brethren, men of valour, [were] two thousand and seven hundred chief fathers, whom king David made rulers over the Reubenites, the Gadites, and the half tribe of Manasseh, for every matter pertaining to God, and affairs of the king.

Reubenites was Eliezer <u>13_1CH_27_16</u># Furthermore over the tribes of Israel: the ruler of the Reubenites [was] Eliezer the son of Zichri: of the Simeonites, Shephatiah the son of Maachah:

Reubenites <u>**13**</u><u>**1CH**</u><u>**05**</u><u>**06**</u>*#* **Beerah his son, whom Tilgathpilneser king of Assyria carried away [captive]:** he [was] prince of the Reubenites.

Reuel and Jeush <u>13_1CH_01_35</u># The sons of Esau; Eliphaz, Reuel, and Jeush, and Jaalam, and Korah.

Reuel Esau's son <u>01_GEN_36_17</u># And these [are] the sons of Reuel Esau's son; duke Nahath, duke Zerah, duke Shammah, duke Mizzah: these [are] the dukes [that came] of Reuel in the land of Edom; these [are] the sons of Bashemath Esau's wife.

Reuel in the <u>01_GEN_36_17</u># And these [are] the sons of Reuel Esau's son; duke Nahath, duke Zerah, duke Shammah, duke Mizzah: these [are] the dukes [that came] of Reuel in the land of Edom; these [are] the sons of Bashemath Esau's wife.

Reuel Nahath Zerah <u>13_1CH_01_37</u># The sons of Reuel; Nahath, Zerah, Shammah, and Mizzah.

Reuel the son <u>13_1CH_09_08</u> # And Ibneiah the son of Jeroham, and Elah the son of Uzzi, the son of Michri, and Meshullam the son of Shephatiah, the son of Reuel, the son of Ibnijah;

Reuel the son <u>01_GEN_36_10</u># These [are] the names of Esau's sons; Eliphaz the son of Adah the wife of Esau, Reuel the son of Bashemath the wife of Esau.

Reuel their father <u>02_EXO_02_18</u># And when they came to Reuel their father, he said, How [is it that] ye are come so soon to day?

Reuel <u>01_GEN_36_04</u># And Adah bare to Esau Eliphaz; and Bashemath bare Reuel;

Reuel <u>04_NUM_02_14</u> # Then the tribe of Gad: and the captain of the sons of Gad [shall be] Eliasaph the son of Reuel.

Reumah she bare <u>01_GEN_22_24</u># And his concubine, whose name [was] Reumah, she bare also Tebah, and Gaham, and Thahash, and Maachah.

thereunto a border <u>02_EXO_37_12</u># Also he made thereunto a border of an handbreadth round about; and made a crown of gold for the border thereof round about.

thereunto a crown <u>02_EXO_37_11</u># And he overlaid it with pure gold, and made thereunto a crown of gold round about.

thereunto and said <u>02_EXO_32_08</u># They have turned aside quickly out of the way which I commanded them: they have made them a molten calf, and have worshipped it, and have sacrificed thereunto, and said, These [be] thy gods, O Israel, which have brought thee up out of the land of Egypt.

thereunto called that <u>60_1PE_03_09</u> # Not rendering evil for evil, or railing for railing: but contrariwise blessing; knowing that ye are thereunto called, that ye should inherit a blessing.

thereunto four pillars <u>02_EXO_36_36</u> # And he made thereunto four pillars [of] shittim [wood], and overlaid them with gold: their hooks [were of] gold; and he cast for them four sockets of silver.

thereunto in the <u>05_DEU_01_07</u> # Turn you, and take your journey, and go to the mount of the Amorites, and unto all [the places] nigh thereunto, in the plain, in the hills, and in the vale, and in the south, and by the sea side, to the land of the Canaanites, and unto Lebanon, unto the great river, the river Euphrates.

thereunto perfect <u>58_HEB_10_01</u> # For the law having a shadow of good things to come, [and] not the very image of the things, can never with those sacrifices which they offered year by year continually make the comers thereunto perfect.

thereunto with all <u>49_EPH_06_18</u> # Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

thereunto <u>52_1TH_03_03</u># That no man should be moved by these afflictions: for yourselves know that we are appointed thereunto.

thereupon and all <u>02_EXO_31_07</u># The tabernacle of the congregation, and the ark of the testimony, and the mercy seat that [is] thereupon, and all the furniture of the tabernacle,

thereupon he shall <u>46_1CO_03_14</u># If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward.

thereupon in the <u>36_ZEP_02_07</u> # And the coast shall be for the remnant of the house of Judah; they shall feed thereupon: in the houses of Ashkelon shall they lie down in the evening: for the LORD their God shall visit them, and turn away their captivity.

thereupon the like <u>26_EZE_16_16</u># And of thy garments thou didst take, and deckedst thy high places with divers colours, and playedst the harlot thereupon: [the like things] shall not come, neither shall it be [so].

thereupon <u>46_1CO_03_10</u> # According to the grace of God which is given unto me, as a wise masterbuilder, I have laid the foundation, and another buildeth thereon. But let every man take heed how he buildeth thereupon.

whereunto also they <u>60_1PE_02_08</u> # And a stone of stumbling, and a rock of offence, [even to them] which stumble at the word, being disobedient: whereunto also they were appointed.

whereunto even baptism <u>60_1PE_03_21</u> # The like figure whereunto [even] baptism doth also now save us [not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,] by the resurrection of Jesus Christ:

Whereunto I am <u>54_1TI_02_07</u># Whereunto I am ordained a preacher, and an apostle, [I speak the truth in Christ, [and] lie not;] a teacher of the Gentiles in faith and verity.

Whereunto I am <u>55_2TI_01_11</u># Whereunto I am appointed a preacher, and an apostle, and a teacher of the Gentiles.

whereunto I have <u>44_ACT_13_02</u> # As they ministered to the Lord, and fasted, the Holy Ghost said, Separate me Barnabas and Saul for the work whereunto I have called them.

whereunto I may <u>19_PSA_71_03</u> # Be thou my strong habitation, whereunto I may continually resort: thou hast given commandment to save me; for thou [art] my rock and my fortress.

whereunto I will <u>26_EZE_05_09</u># And I will do in thee that which I have not done, and whereunto I will not do any more the like, because of all thine abominations.

whereunto shall I <u>42_LUK_13_18</u># Then said he, Unto what is the kingdom of God like? and whereunto shall I resemble it?

Whereunto shall I <u>42_LUK_13_20</u> # And again he said, Whereunto shall I liken the kingdom of God?

whereunto shall I <u>40_MAT_11_16</u># But whereunto shall I liken this generation? It is like unto children sitting in the markets, and calling unto their fellows,

Whereunto shall we <u>41_MAR_04_30</u> # And he said, Whereunto shall we liken the kingdom of God? or with what comparison shall we compare it?

whereunto the ark <u>14_2CH_08_11</u># And Solomon brought up the daughter of Pharaoh out of the city of David unto the house that he had built for her: for he said, My wife shall not dwell in the house of David king of Israel, because [the places are] holy, whereunto the ark of the LORD hath come.

whereunto the king <u>17_EST_10_02</u> # And all the acts of his power and of his might, and the declaration of the greatness of Mordecai, whereunto the king advanced him, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Media and Persia?

Whereunto then shall <u>42_LUK_07_31</u> # And the Lord said, Whereunto then shall I liken the men of this generation? and to what are they like?

whereunto they are <u>04_NUM_36_03</u> # And if they be married to any of the sons of the [other] tribes of the children of Israel, then shall their inheritance be taken from the inheritance of our fathers, and shall be put to the inheritance of the tribe whereunto they are received: so shall it be taken from the lot of our inheritance.

whereunto they are <u>04_NUM_36_04</u># And when the jubilee of the children of Israel shall be, then shall their inheritance be put unto the inheritance of the tribe whereunto they are received: so shall their inheritance be taken away from the inheritance of the tribe of our fathers.

whereunto they desire <u>24_JER_22_27</u> # But to the land whereunto they desire to return, thither shall they not return.

whereunto ye go <u>05_DEU_04_26</u> # I call heaven and earth to witness against you this day, that ye shall soon utterly perish from off the land whereunto ye go over Jordan to possess it; ye shall not prolong [your] days upon it, but shall utterly be destroyed.

Whereupon the king <u>11_1KI_12_28</u># Whereupon the king took counsel, and made two calves [of] gold, and said unto them, It is too much for you to go up to Jerusalem: behold thy gods, O Israel, which brought thee up out of the land of Egypt.

Whereupon the princes <u>14_2CH_12_06</u> # Whereupon the princes of Israel and the king humbled themselves; and they said, The LORD [is] righteous.
