brawler not covetous <u>54\_1TI\_03\_03</u># Not given to wine, no striker, not greedy of filthy lucre; but patient, not a brawler, not covetous;

brawlers but gentle <u>56\_TIT\_03\_02</u># To speak evil of no man, to be no brawlers, [but] gentle, showing all meekness unto all men.

brawling woman and 20 PRO 25 24 # [It is] better to dwell in the corner of the housetop, than with a brawling woman and in a wide house.

brawling woman in 20\_PRO\_21\_09 # [It is] better to dwell in a corner of the housetop, than with a brawling woman in a wide house.

draw after him <u>18\_JOB\_21\_33</u> # The clods of the valley shall be sweet unto him, and every man shall draw after him, as [there are] innumerable before him.

draw all men 43\_JOH\_12\_32 # And I, if I be lifted up from the earth, will draw all [men] unto me.

draw away disciples <u>44\_ACT\_20\_30</u># Also of your own selves shall men arise, speaking perverse things, to draw away disciples after them.

draw back my <u>58\_HEB\_10\_38</u># Now the just shall live by faith: but if [any man] draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him.

draw back unto <u>58\_HEB\_10\_39</u> # But we are not of them who draw back unto perdition; but of them that believe to the saving of the soul.

draw for thy <u>01\_GEN\_24\_44</u> # And she say to me, Both drink thou, and I will also draw for thy camels: [let] the same [be] the woman whom the LORD hath appointed out for my master's son.

draw near and <u>26\_EZE\_22\_04</u># Thou art become guilty in thy blood that thou hast shed; and hast defiled thyself in thine idols which thou hast made; and thou hast caused thy days to draw near, and art come [even] unto thy years: therefore have I made thee a reproach unto the heathen, and a mocking to all countries.

draw their swords <u>26\_EZE\_30\_11</u># He and his people with him, the terrible of the nations, shall be brought to destroy the land: and they shall draw their swords against Egypt, and fill the land with the slain.

draweth near let <u>26\_EZE\_07\_12</u># The time is come, the day draweth near: let not the buyer rejoice, nor the seller mourn: for wrath [is] upon all the multitude thereof.

draweth near the <u>23\_ISA\_26\_17</u> # Like as a woman with child, [that] draweth near the time of her delivery, is in pain, [and] crieth out in her pangs; so have we been in thy sight, O LORD.

draweth near unto <u>18\_JOB\_33\_22</u> # Yea, his soul draweth near unto the grave, and his life to the destroyers.

draweth nigh unto 40\_MAT\_15\_08# This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, and honoureth me with [their] lips; but their heart is far from me.

draweth nigh unto 19\_PSA\_88\_03 # For my soul is full of troubles: and my life draweth nigh unto the grave.

draweth nigh <u>59\_JAM\_05\_08</u># Be ye also patient; stablish your hearts: for the coming of the Lord draweth nigh.

draweth nigh 42\_LUK\_21\_28 # And when these things begin to come to pass, then look up, and lift up your heads; for your redemption draweth nigh.

draweth toward evening <u>07\_JUD\_19\_09</u> # And when the man rose up to depart, he, and his concubine, and his servant, his father in law, the damsel's father, said unto him, Behold, now the day draweth toward evening, I pray you tarry all night: behold, the day groweth to an end, lodge here, that thine heart may be merry; and to morrow get you early on your way, that thou mayest go home.

drawing nigh unto 43\_JOH\_06\_19 # So when they had rowed about five and twenty or thirty furlongs, they see Jesus walking on the sea, and drawing nigh unto the ship: and they were afraid.

drawing water there <u>07\_JUD\_05\_11</u># [They that are delivered] from the noise of archers in the places of drawing water, there shall they rehearse the righteous acts of the LORD, [even] the righteous acts [toward the inhabitants] of his villages in Israel: then shall the people of the LORD go down to the gates.

drawn and cast <u>24\_JER\_22\_19</u># He shall be buried with the burial of an ass, drawn and cast forth beyond the gates of Jerusalem.

drawn from the <u>06\_JOS\_18\_17</u># And was drawn from the north, and went forth to Enshemesh, and went forth toward Geliloth, which [is] over against the going up of Adummim, and descended to the stone of Bohan the son of Reuben,

drawn out the 19\_PSA\_37\_14 # The wicked have drawn out the sword, and have bent their bow, to cast down the poor and needy, [and] to slay such as be of upright conversation.

drawn sword and <u>23\_ISA\_21\_15</u> # For they fled from the swords, from the drawn sword, and from the bent bow, and from the grievousness of war.

drawn them from <u>06\_JOS\_08\_06</u> # [For they will come out after us] till we have drawn them from the city; for they will say, They flee before us, as at the first: therefore we will flee before them.

drawn thence and <u>06\_JOS\_18\_14</u># And the border was drawn [thence], and compassed the corner of the sea southward, from the hill that [lieth] before Bethhoron southward; and the goings out thereof were at Kirjathbaal, which [is] Kirjathjearim, a city of the children of Judah: this [was] the west quarter.

drawn to Baalah <u>06\_JOS\_15\_09</u> # And the border was drawn from the top of the hill unto the fountain of the water of Nephtoah, and went out to the cities of mount Ephron; and the border was drawn to Baalah, which [is] Kirjathjearim:

drawn to Shicron <u>06\_JOS\_15\_11</u># And the border went out unto the side of Ekron northward: and the border was drawn to Shicron, and passed along to mount Baalah, and went out unto Jabneel; and the goings out of the border were at the sea.

drawn unto death <u>20\_PRO\_24\_11</u># If thou forbear to deliver [them that are] drawn unto death, and [those that are] ready to be slain;

drawn up again 44\_ACT\_11\_10 # And this was done three times: and all were drawn up again into heaven.

drawn <u>08 RUT 02 09 # [Let]</u> thine eyes [be] on the field that they do reap, and go thou after them: have I not charged the young men that they shall not touch thee? and when thou art athirst, go unto the vessels, and drink of [that] which the young men have drawn.

raw flesh and <u>03\_LEV\_13\_15</u> # And the priest shall see the raw flesh, and pronounce him to be unclean: [for] the raw flesh [is] unclean: it [is] a leprosy.

raw flesh appeareth 03\_LEV\_13\_14 # But when raw flesh appeareth in him, he shall be unclean.

raw flesh in <u>03\_LEV\_13\_10</u># And the priest shall see [him]: and, behold, [if] the rising [be] white in the skin, and it have turned the hair white, and [there be] quick raw flesh in the rising;

raw flesh is <u>03\_LEV\_13\_15</u># And the priest shall see the raw flesh, and pronounce him to be unclean: [for] the raw flesh [is] unclean: it [is] a leprosy.

raw flesh turn <u>03\_LEV\_13\_16</u># Or if the raw flesh turn again, and be changed unto white, he shall come unto the priest;

raw nor sodden <u>02\_EXO\_12\_09</u> # Eat not of it raw, nor sodden at all with water, but roast [with] fire; his head with his legs, and with the purtenance thereof.

raw 09\_1SA\_02\_15 # Also before they burnt the fat, the priest's servant came, and said to the man that

sacrificed, Give flesh to roast for the priest; for he will not have sodden flesh of thee, but raw.

straw and brass 18\_JOB\_41\_27 # He esteemeth iron as straw, [and] brass as rotten wood.

straw and provender <u>01\_GEN\_24\_25</u># She said moreover unto him, We have both straw and provender enough, and room to lodge in.
