already and have <u>47_2CO_12_21</u> # [And] lest, when I come again, my God will humble me among you, and [that] I shall bewail many which have sinned already, and have not repented of the uncleanness and fornication and lasciviousness which they have committed.

already and it <u>21_ECC_06_10</u># That which hath been is named already, and it is known that it [is] man: neither may he contend with him that is mightier than he.

already and overthrow <u>55_2TI_02_18</u># Who concerning the truth have erred, saying that the resurrection is past already; and overthrow the faith of some.

already and they 40_MAT_17_12# But I say unto you, That Elias is come already, and they knew him not, but have done unto him whatsoever they listed. Likewise shall also the Son of man suffer of them.

already and ye 43_JOH_09_27_# He answered them, I have told you already, and ye did not hear: wherefore would ye hear [it] again? will ye also be his disciples?

already as though 46_1CO_05_03 # For I verily, as absent in body, but present in spirit, have judged already, as though I were present, [concerning] him that hath so done this deed,

already attained either <u>50_PHP_03_12</u> # Not as though I had already attained, either were already perfect: but I follow after, if that I may apprehend that for which also I am apprehended of Christ Jesus.

already attained let <u>50_PHP_03_16</u> # Nevertheless, whereto we have already attained, let us walk by the same rule, let us mind the same thing.

already because he <u>43_JOH_03_18</u> # He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

already because ye <u>39_MAL_02_02</u># If ye will not hear, and if ye will not lay [it] to heart, to give glory unto my name, saith the LORD of hosts, I will even send a curse upon you, and I will curse your blessings: yea, I have cursed them already, because ye do not lay [it] to heart.

already been and <u>21_ECC_03_15</u># That which hath been is now; and that which is to be hath already been; and God requireth that which is past.

already come unto <u>44_ACT_11_11</u># And, behold, immediately there were three men already come unto the house where I was, sent from Caesarea unto me.

already dead and <u>41_MAR_15_44</u> # And Pilate marvelled if he were already dead: and calling [unto him] the centurion, he asked him whether he had been any while dead.

already dead more 21_ECC_04_02 # Wherefore I praised the dead which are already dead more than the living which are yet alive.

already done <u>21_ECC_02_12</u> # And I turned myself to behold wisdom, and madness, and folly: for what [can] the man [do] that cometh after the king? [even] that which hath been already done.

already hold fast 66_REV_02_25 # But that which ye have [already] hold fast till I come.

already in his <u>40_MAT_05_28</u># But I say unto you, That whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart.

already is it <u>62_1JO_04_03</u> # And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that [spirit] of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.

already kindled <u>42_LUK_12_49</u># I am come to send fire on the earth; and what will I, if it be already kindled?

already neither is <u>16_NEH_05_05</u># Yet now our flesh [is] as the flesh of our brethren, our children as their children: and, lo, we bring into bondage our sons and our daughters to be servants, and [some] of our daughters are brought unto bondage [already]: neither [is it] in our power [to redeem them]; for other men have our lands and vineyards.

already of old <u>21_ECC_01_10</u># Is there [any] thing whereof it may be said, See, this [is] new? it hath been already of old time, which was before us.

already past Paul <u>44_ACT_27_09</u> # Now when much time was spent, and when sailing was now dangerous, because the fast was now already past, Paul admonished [them],

already perfect but 50_PHP_03_12 # Not as though I had already attained, either were already perfect: but I follow after, if that I may apprehend that for which also I am apprehended of Christ Jesus.

already that if <u>43_JOH_09_22</u> # These [words] spake his parents, because they feared the Jews: for the Jews had agreed already, that if any man did confess that he was Christ, he should be put out of the synagogue.

already they brake <u>43_JOH_19_33</u># But when they came to Jesus, and saw that he was dead already, they brake not his legs:

already to harvest 43_JOH_04_35_# Say not ye, There are yet four months, and [then] cometh harvest? behold, I say unto you, Lift up your eyes, and look on the fields; for they are white already to harvest.

already turned aside 54_1TI_05_15 # For some are already turned aside after Satan.

already work only <u>53_2TH_02_07</u> # For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth [will let], until he be taken out of the way.

already ye intend <u>14_2CH_28_13</u> # And said unto them, Ye shall not bring in the captives hither: for whereas we have offended against the LORD [already], ye intend to add [more] to our sins and to our trespass: for our trespass is great, and [there is] fierce wrath against Israel.

already <u>02_EXO_01_05</u># And all the souls that came out of the loins of Jacob were seventy souls: for Joseph was in Egypt [already].

already 43_JOH_11_17 # Then when Jesus came, he found that he had [lain] in the grave four days already.

bread according to <u>01_GEN_47_12</u> # And Joseph nourished his father, and his brethren, and all his father's household, with bread, according to [their] families.

bread after that <u>43_JOH_06_23</u> # [Howbeit there came other boats from Tiberias nigh unto the place where they did eat bread, after that the Lord had given thanks:]

bread again by <u>03 LEV_26_26</u> # [And] when I have broken the staff of your bread, ten women shall bake your bread in one oven, and they shall deliver [you] your bread again by weight: and ye shall eat, and not be satisfied.

bread all the <u>09_1SA_28_20</u># Then Saul fell straightway all along on the earth, and was sore afraid, because of the words of Samuel: and there was no strength in him; for he had eaten no bread all the day, nor all the night.

bread alone but <u>42 LUK 04 04 # And Jesus answered him, saying, It is written, That man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God.</u>

bread alone but 40_MAT_04_04 # But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.

bread also can <u>19_PSA_78_20</u> # Behold, he smote the rock, that the waters gushed out, and the streams overflowed; can he give bread also? can he provide flesh for his people?

bread also out <u>19_PSA_109_10</u> # Let his children be continually vagabonds, and beg: let them seek [their bread] also out of their desolate places.

bread alway at <u>10_2SA_09_10</u> # Thou therefore, and thy sons, and thy servants, shall till the land for him, and thou shalt bring in [the fruits], that thy master's son may have food to eat: but Mephibosheth thy master's son shall eat bread alway at my table. Now Ziba had fifteen sons and twenty servants.

bread among the <u>26_EZE_04_13</u> # And the LORD said, Even thus shall the children of Israel eat their defiled bread among the Gentiles, whither I will drive them.

bread among their 12_2KI_23_09 # Nevertheless the priests of the high places came not up to the altar of the LORD in Jerusalem, but they did eat of the unleavened bread among their brethren.

bread and a <u>13_1CH_16_03</u> # And he dealt to every one of Israel, both man and woman, to every one a loaf of bread, and a good piece of flesh, and a flagon [of wine].

bread and a <u>09_1SA_16_20</u> # And Jesse took an ass [laden] with bread, and a bottle of wine, and a kid, and sent [them] by David his son unto Saul.

bread and a <u>09_1SA_22_13</u># And Saul said unto him, Why have ye conspired against me, thou and the son of Jesse, in that thou hast given him bread, and a sword, and hast inquired of God for him, that he should rise against me, to lie in wait, as at this day?

bread and a <u>10_2SA_06_19</u># And he dealt among all the people, [even] among the whole multitude of Israel, as well to the women as men, to every one a cake of bread, and a good piece [of flesh], and a flagon [of wine]. So all the people departed every one to his house.

bread and a <u>01_GEN_21_14</u># And Abraham rose up early in the morning, and took bread, and a bottle of water, and gave [it] unto Hagar, putting [it] on her shoulder, and the child, and sent her away: and she departed, and wandered in the wilderness of Beersheba.

bread and abundance <u>26_EZE_16_49</u> # Behold, this was the iniquity of thy sister Sodom, pride, fulness of bread, and abundance of idleness was in her and in her daughters, neither did she strengthen the hand of the poor and needy.

bread and after 11_1KI_13_23 # And it came to pass, after he had eaten bread, and after he had drunk, that he saddled for him the ass, [to wit], for the prophet whom he had brought back.

bread and afterward <u>07_JUD_19_05</u># And it came to pass on the fourth day, when they arose early in the morning, that he rose up to depart: and the damsel's father said unto his son in law, Comfort thine heart with a morsel of bread, and afterward go your way.

bread and blessed 41 MAR 14 22 # And as they did eat, Jesus took bread, and blessed, and brake [it], and gave to them, and said, Take, eat: this is my body.

bread and blessed 40 MAT 26 26 # And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and blessed [it], and brake [it], and gave [it] to the disciples, and said, Take, eat; this is my body.

bread and cakes <u>02_EXO_29_02</u># And unleavened bread, and cakes unleavened tempered with oil, and wafers unleavened anointed with oil: [of] wheaten flour shalt thou make them.

bread and call <u>19_PSA_14_04</u> # Have all the workers of iniquity no knowledge? who eat up my people [as] they eat bread, and call not upon the LORD.

bread and came <u>44_ACT_20_06</u> # And we sailed away from Philippi after the days of unleavened bread, and came unto them to Troas in five days; where we abode seven days.

bread and cast <u>40_MAT_15_26</u># But he answered and said, It is not meet to take the children's bread, and cast [it] to dogs.

bread and comfort <u>01_GEN_18_05</u> # And I will fetch a morsel of bread, and comfort ye your hearts; after that ye shall pass on: for therefore are ye come to your servant. And they said, So do, as thou hast said.

bread and dip <u>08_RUT_02_14</u> # And Boaz said unto her, At mealtime come thou hither, and eat of the bread, and dip thy morsel in the vinegar. And she sat beside the reapers: and he reached her parched [corn], and she did eat, and was sufficed, and left.

bread and drink <u>46_1CO_11_26</u># For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this cup, ye do show the Lord's death till he come.

bread and drink 46_1CO_11_27 # Wherefore whosoever shall eat this bread, and drink [this] cup of the Lord, unworthily, shall be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord.

bread and drink 46_1CO_11_28 # But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of [that] bread, and drink of [that] cup.

bread and drink <u>11_1KI_13_18</u># He said unto him, I [am] a prophet also as thou [art]; and an angel spake unto me by the word of the LORD, saying, Bring him back with thee into thine house, that he may eat bread and drink water. [But] he lied unto him.

bread and drink 11_1KI_13_22# But camest back, and hast eaten bread and drunk water in the place, of the which [the LORD] did say to thee, Eat no bread, and drink no water; thy carcase shall not come unto the sepulchre of thy fathers.

bread and drink 20_PRO_09_05 # Come, eat of my bread, and drink of the wine [which] I have mingled.

bread and drunk 11 1KI 13 22 # But camest back, and hast eaten bread and drunk water in the place, of the which [the LORD] did say to thee, Eat no bread, and drink no water; thy carcase shall not come unto the sepulchre of thy fathers.

bread and eaten 44_ACT_20_11# When he therefore was come up again, and had broken bread, and eaten, and talked a long while, even till break of day, so he departed.

bread and flesh <u>11_1KI_17_06</u># And the ravens brought him bread and flesh in the morning, and bread and flesh in the evening; and he drank of the brook.

bread and flesh <u>11_1KI_17_06</u># And the ravens brought him bread and flesh in the morning, and bread and flesh in the evening; and he drank of the brook.

bread and gave <u>44_ACT_27_35</u> # And when he had thus spoken, he took bread, and gave thanks to God in presence of them all: and when he had broken [it], he began to eat.

bread and gave <u>42_LUK_22_19</u> # And he took bread, and gave thanks, and brake [it], and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me.

bread and give <u>41_MAR_06_37</u> # He answered and said unto them, Give ye them to eat. And they say unto him, Shall we go and buy two hundred pennyworth of bread, and give them to eat?

bread and giveth 43_JOH_21_13 # Jesus then cometh, and taketh bread, and giveth them, and fish likewise.

bread and he <u>09_1SA_30_11</u># And they found an Egyptian in the field, and brought him to David, and gave him bread, and he did eat; and they made him drink water;

bread and his 18_JOB_33_20 # So that his life abhorreth bread, and his soul dainty meat.

bread and if <u>07_JUD_13_16</u># And the angel of the LORD said unto Manoah, Though thou detain me, I will not eat of thy bread: and if thou wilt offer a burnt offering, thou must offer it unto the LORD. For Manoah knew not that he [was] an angel of the LORD.

bread and in <u>14_2CH_08_13</u># Even after a certain rate every day, offering according to the commandment of Moses, on the sabbaths, and on the new moons, and on the solemn feasts, three times in the year, [even] in the feast of unleavened bread, and in the feast of weeks, and in the feast of tabernacles.

bread and in <u>44_ACT_02_42</u># And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers.

bread and in <u>05_DEU_16_16</u># Three times in a year shall all thy males appear before the LORD thy God in the place which he shall choose; in the feast of unleavened bread, and in the feast of weeks, and in the feast of tabernacles: and they shall not appear before the LORD empty:

bread and in <u>02_EXO_13_06</u> # Seven days thou shalt eat unleavened bread, and in the seventh day [shall be] a feast to the LORD.

bread and let 11_1KI_21_07 # And Jezebel his wife said unto him, Dost thou now govern the kingdom of

Israel? arise, [and] eat bread, and let thine heart be merry: I will give thee the vineyard of Naboth the Jezreelite.

bread and meat <u>01_GEN_45_23</u> # And to his father he sent after this [manner]; ten asses laden with the good things of Egypt, and ten she asses laden with corn and bread and meat for his father by the way.

bread and mingled 19_PSA_102_09 # For I have eaten ashes like bread, and mingled my drink with weeping,

bread and my <u>09_1SA_25_11</u> # Shall I then take my bread, and my water, and my flesh that I have killed for my shearers, and give [it] unto men, whom I know not whence they [be]?

bread and my <u>28_HOS_02_05</u> # For their mother hath played the harlot: she that conceived them hath done shamefully: for she said, I will go after my lovers, that give [me] my bread and my water, my wool and my flax, mine oil and my drink.

bread and no <u>25_LAM_04_04</u> # The tongue of the sucking child cleaveth to the roof of his mouth for thirst: the young children ask bread, [and] no man breaketh [it] unto them.

bread and on <u>05_DEU_16_08</u> # Six days thou shalt eat unleavened bread: and on the seventh day [shall be] a solemn assembly to the LORD thy God: thou shalt do no work [therein].

bread and one 46_1CO_10_17 # For we [being] many are one bread, [and] one body: for we are all partakers of that one bread.

bread and one <u>02_EXO_29_23</u> # And one loaf of bread, and one cake of oiled bread, and one wafer out of the basket of the unleavened bread that [is] before the LORD:

bread and one <u>02_EXO_29_23</u> # And one loaf of bread, and one cake of oiled bread, and one wafer out of the basket of the unleavened bread that [is] before the LORD:

bread and one <u>03_LEV_08_26</u># And out of the basket of unleavened bread, that [was] before the LORD, he took one unleavened cake, and a cake of oiled bread, and one wafer, and put [them] on the fat, and upon the right shoulder:

bread and Pharaoh <u>01_GEN_41_55</u># And when all the land of Egypt was famished, the people cried to Pharaoh for bread: and Pharaoh said unto all the Egyptians, Go unto Joseph; what he saith to you, do.

bread and pottage <u>01_GEN_25_34</u> # Then Jacob gave Esau bread and pottage of lentiles; and he did eat and drink, and rose up, and went his way: thus Esau despised [his] birthright.

bread and prophesy <u>30_AMO_07_12</u> # Also Amaziah said unto Amos, O thou seer, go, flee thee away into the land of Judah, and there eat bread, and prophesy there:

bread and shall <u>09_1SA_02_36</u> # And it shall come to pass, [that] every one that is left in thine house shall come [and] crouch to him for a piece of silver and a morsel of bread, and shall say, Put me, I pray thee, into one of the priests' offices, that I may eat a piece of bread.

bread And so <u>12_2KI_04_08</u> # And it fell on a day, that Elisha passed to Shunem, where [was] a great woman; and she constrained him to eat bread. And [so] it was, [that] as oft as he passed by, he turned in thither to eat bread.

bread and summer <u>10_2SA_16_02</u># And the king said unto Ziba, What meanest thou by these? And Ziba said, The asses [be] for the king's household to ride on; and the bread and summer fruit for the young men to eat; and the wine, that such as be faint in the wilderness may drink.

bread and tarried <u>01_GEN_31_54</u># Then Jacob offered sacrifice upon the mount, and called his brethren to eat bread: and they did eat bread, and tarried all night in the mount.

bread and the <u>23_ISA_03_01</u># For, behold, the Lord, the LORD of hosts, doth take away from Jerusalem and from Judah the stay and the staff, the whole stay of bread, and the whole stay of water.

bread and the <u>41_MAR_14_01</u> # After two days was [the feast of] the passover, and of unleavened bread: and the chief priests and the scribes sought how they might take him by craft, and put [him] to death.

bread and the <u>20_PRO_06_26</u> # For by means of a whorish woman [a man is brought] to a piece of bread: and the adulteress will hunt for the precious life.

bread and there <u>24_JER_42_14</u># Saying, No; but we will go into the land of Egypt, where we shall see no war, nor hear the sound of the trumpet, nor have hunger of bread; and there will we dwell:

bread and they <u>09_1SA_02_05</u># [They that were] full have hired out themselves for bread; and [they that were] hungry ceased: so that the barren hath born seven; and she that hath many children is waxed feeble.

bread and they <u>01_GEN_19_03</u># And he pressed upon them greatly; and they turned in unto him, and entered into his house; and he made them a feast, and did bake unleavened bread, and they did eat.

bread and they <u>01_GEN_31_54</u># Then Jacob offered sacrifice upon the mount, and called his brethren to eat bread: and they did eat bread, and tarried all night in the mount.

bread and they <u>01_GEN_37_25</u># And they sat down to eat bread: and they lifted up their eyes and looked, and, behold, a company of Ishmeelites came from Gilead with their camels bearing spicery and balm and myrrh, going to carry [it] down to Egypt.

bread and thy <u>02_EXO_23_25</u> # And ye shall serve the LORD your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee.

bread and to <u>41_MAR_07_27</u># But Jesus said unto her, Let the children first be filled: for it is not meet to take the children's bread, and to cast [it] unto the dogs.

bread and under 18_JOB_28_05 # [As for] the earth, out of it cometh bread: and under it is turned up as it were fire.

bread and vineyards 12_2KI_18_32 # Until I come and take you away to a land like your own land, a land of corn and wine, a land of bread and vineyards, a land of oil olive and of honey, that ye may live, and not die: and hearken not unto Hezekiah, when he persuadeth you, saying, The LORD will deliver us.

bread and vineyards <u>23_ISA_36_17</u> # Until I come and take you away to a land like your own land, a land of corn and wine, a land of bread and vineyards.

bread and water 11_1KI_18_04# For it was [so], when Jezebel cut off the prophets of the LORD, that Obadiah took an hundred prophets, and hid them by fifty in a cave, and fed them with bread and water.]

bread and water <u>11_1KI_18_13</u># Was it not told my lord what I did when Jezebel slew the prophets of the LORD, how I hid an hundred men of the LORD's prophets by fifty in a cave, and fed them with bread and water?

bread and water 12_2KI_06_22 # And he answered, Thou shalt not smite [them]: wouldest thou smite those whom thou hast taken captive with thy sword and with thy bow? set bread and water before them, that they may eat and drink, and go to their master.

bread and water <u>26_EZE_04_17</u> # That they may want bread and water, and be astonied one with another, and consume away for their iniquity.

bread and we <u>01_GEN_47_19</u># Wherefore shall we die before thine eyes, both we and our land? buy us and our land for bread, and we and our land will be servants unto Pharaoh: and give [us] seed, that we may live, and not die, that the land be not desolate.

bread and wear <u>23_ISA_04_01</u> # And in that day seven women shall take hold of one man, saying, We will eat our own bread, and wear our own apparel: only let us be called by thy name, to take away our reproach.

bread and wine <u>01_GEN_14_18</u># And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and he [was] the priest of the most high God.

bread and wine <u>07_JUD_19_19</u> # Yet there is both straw and provender for our asses; and there is bread and wine also for me, and for thy handmaid, and for the young man [which is] with thy servants: [there is] no want of any thing.

bread and wine <u>16_NEH_05_15</u># But the former governors that [had been] before me were chargeable unto the people, and had taken of them bread and wine, beside forty shekels of silver; yea, even their servants bare rule over the people: but so did not I, because of the fear of God.

bread and with <u>05_DEU_23_04</u># Because they met you not with bread and with water in the way, when ye came forth out of Egypt; and because they hired against thee Balaam the son of Beor of Pethor of Mesopotamia, to curse thee.

bread and with <u>02_EXO_12_08</u># And they shall eat the flesh in that night, roast with fire, and unleavened bread; [and] with bitter [herbs] they shall eat it.

bread and with <u>16_NEH_13_02</u> # Because they met not the children of Israel with bread and with water, but hired Balaam against them, that he should curse them: howbeit our God turned the curse into a blessing.

bread and ye <u>02_EXO_16_12</u> # I have heard the murmurings of the children of Israel: speak unto them, saying, At even ye shall eat flesh, and in the morning ye shall be filled with bread; and ye shall know that I [am] the LORD your God.

bread and your <u>23_ISA_55_02</u> # Wherefore do ye spend money for [that which is] not bread? and your labour for [that which] satisfieth not? hearken diligently unto me, and eat ye [that which is] good, and let your soul delight itself in fatness.

bread anointed with <u>04_NUM_06_15</u># And a basket of unleavened bread, cakes of fine flour mingled with oil, and wafers of unleavened bread anointed with oil, and their meat offering, and their drink offerings.

bread as I <u>02_EXO_34_18</u> # The feast of unleavened bread shalt thou keep. Seven days thou shalt eat unleavened bread, as I commanded thee, in the time of the month Abib: for in the month Abib thou camest out from Egypt.

bread at my <u>10_2SA_09_07</u> # And David said unto him, Fear not: for I will surely show thee kindness for Jonathan thy father's sake, and will restore thee all the land of Saul thy father; and thou shalt eat bread at my table continually.

bread be eaten <u>02_EXO_13_03</u># And Moses said unto the people, Remember this day, in which ye came out from Egypt, out of the house of bondage; for by strength of hand the LORD brought you out from this

[place]: there shall no leavened bread be eaten.

bread be eaten <u>04_NUM_28_17</u> # And in the fifteenth day of this month [is] the feast: seven days shall unleavened bread be eaten.

bread be seen <u>02_EXO_13_07</u> # Unleavened bread shall be eaten seven days; and there shall no leavened bread be seen with thee, neither shall there be leaven seen with thee in all thy quarters.

bread before him <u>10_2SA_12_20</u># Then David arose from the earth, and washed, and anointed [himself], and changed his apparel, and came into the house of the LORD, and worshipped: then he came to his own house; and when he required, they set bread before him, and he did eat.

bread before him <u>24_JER_52_33</u> # And changed his prison garments: and he did continually eat bread before him all the days of his life.

bread before the <u>26_EZE_44_03</u> # [It is] for the prince; the prince, he shall sit in it to eat bread before the LORD; he shall enter by the way of the porch of [that] gate, and shall go out by the way of the same.

bread they have 19 PSA 53 04 # Have the workers of iniquity no knowledge? who eat up my people [as] they eat bread: they have not called upon God.

bread thou shalt <u>02_EXO_23_15</u> # Thou shalt keep the feast of unleavened bread: [thou shalt eat unleavened bread seven days, as I commanded thee, in the time appointed of the month Abib; for in it thou camest out from Egypt: and none shall appear before me empty:]

read it in 24_JER_36_21_# So the king sent Jehudi to fetch the roll: and he took it out of Elishama the scribe's chamber. And Jehudi read it in the ears of the king, and in the ears of all the princes which stood beside the king.

read it 12_2KI_22_08 # And Hilkiah the high priest said unto Shaphan the scribe, I have found the book of the law in the house of the LORD. And Hilkiah gave the book to Shaphan, and he read it.

read many of 43_JOH_19_20 # This title then read many of the Jews: for the place where Jesus was crucified was night o the city: and it was written in Hebrew, [and] Greek, [and] Latin.

read no one 23 ISA 34 16 # Seek ye out of the book of the LORD, and read: no one of these shall fail, none shall want her mate: for my mouth it hath commanded, and his spirit it hath gathered them.

read not before <u>06_JOS_08_35</u># There was not a word of all that Moses commanded, which Joshua read not before all the congregation of Israel, with the women, and the little ones, and the strangers that were conversant among them.

read of all 47_2CO_03_02 # Ye are our epistle written in our hearts, known and read of all men:

read or acknowledge <u>47_2CO_01_13</u> # For we write none other things unto you, than what ye read or acknowledge; and I trust ye shall acknowledge even to the end;

read Out of 40_MAT_21_16# And said unto him, Hearest thou what these say? And Jesus saith unto them, Yea; have ye never read, Out of the mouth of babes and sucklings thou hast perfected praise?

read so much <u>42_LUK_06_03</u> # And Jesus answering them said, Have ye not read so much as this, what David did, when himself was an hungered, and they which were with him;

read that he <u>40_MAT_19_04</u># And he answered and said unto them, Have ye not read, that he which made [them] at the beginning made them male and female,

read that which 40 MAT 22 31 # But as touching the resurrection of the dead, have ye not read that which was spoken unto you by God, saying,

read the book <u>24_JER_36_13</u># Then Michaiah declared unto them all the words that he had heard, when Baruch read the book in the ears of the people.

read the book <u>66_REV_05_04</u># And I wept much, because no man was found worthy to open and to read the book, neither to look thereon.

read the epistle <u>51_COL_04_16</u> # And when this epistle is read among you, cause that it be read also in the church of the Laodiceans; and that ye likewise read the [epistle] from Laodicea.

read the letter 12_2KI_05_07# And it came to pass, when the king of Israel had read the letter, that he rent his clothes, and said, [Am] I God, to kill and to make alive, that this man doth send unto me to recover a man of his leprosy? wherefore consider, I pray you, and see how he seeketh a quarrel against me.

read the letter <u>44_ACT_23_34</u># And when the governor had read [the letter], he asked of what province he was. And when he understood that [he was] of Cilicia;

read the prophet <u>44_ACT_08_30</u> # And Philip ran thither to [him], and heard him read the prophet Esaias, and said, Understandest thou what thou readest?

read the writing <u>27_DAN_05_16</u># And I have heard of thee, that thou canst make interpretations, and dissolve doubts: now if thou canst read the writing, and make known to me the interpretation thereof, thou shalt be clothed with scarlet, and [have] a chain of gold about thy neck, and shalt be the third ruler in the kingdom.

read the writing 27_DAN_05_17 # Then Daniel answered and said before the king, Let thy gifts be to

thyself, and give thy rewards to another; yet I will read the writing unto the king, and make known to him the interpretation.

read them in <u>24_JER_36_06</u># Therefore go thou, and read in the roll, which thou hast written from my mouth, the words of the LORD in the ears of the people in the LORD'S house upon the fasting day: and also thou shalt read them in the ears of all Judah that come out of their cities.

read therein all <u>05_DEU_17_19</u> # And it shall be with him, and he shall read therein all the days of his life: that he may learn to fear the LORD his God, to keep all the words of this law and these statutes, to do them:

read therein before <u>16_NEH_08_03</u># And he read therein before the street that [was] before the water gate from the morning until midday, before the men and the women, and those that could understand; and the ears of all the people [were attentive] unto the book of the law.

read they rejoiced 44_ACT_15_31 # [Which] when they had read, they rejoiced for the consolation.

Read this I <u>23 ISA 29 11</u> # And the vision of all is become unto you as the words of a book that is sealed, which [men] deliver to one that is learned, saying, Read this, I pray thee: and he saith, I cannot; for it [is] sealed:

Read this I <u>23_ISA_29_12</u># And the book is delivered to him that is not learned, saying, Read this, I pray thee: and he saith, I am not learned.

read this law <u>05_DEU_31_11</u># When all Israel is come to appear before the LORD thy God in the place which he shall choose, thou shalt read this law before all Israel in their hearing.

read this letter 24_JER_29_29 # And Zephaniah the priest read this letter in the ears of Jeremiah the prophet.

read this scripture <u>41_MAR_12_10</u> # And have ye not read this scripture; The stone which the builders rejected is become the head of the corner:

read this writing <u>27_DAN_05_07</u> # The king cried aloud to bring in the astrologers, the Chaldeans, and the soothsayers. [And] the king spake, and said to the wise [men] of Babylon, Whosoever shall read this writing, and show me the interpretation thereof, shall be clothed with scarlet, and [have] a chain of gold about his neck, and shall be the third ruler in the kingdom.

read this writing <u>27_DAN_05_15</u> # And now the wise [men], the astrologers, have been brought in before me, that they should read this writing, and make known unto me the interpretation thereof: but they could not show the interpretation of the thing:

read what David 40_MAT_12_03 # But he said unto them, Have ye not read what David did, when he was

an hungred, and they that were with him;

read ye may <u>49_EPH_03_04</u># Whereby, when ye read, ye may understand my knowledge in the mystery of Christ]

read <u>12_2KI_22_16</u># Thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will bring evil upon this place, and upon the inhabitants thereof, [even] all the words of the book which the king of Judah hath read:

read <u>42_LUK_04_16</u># And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up: and, as his custom was, he went into the synagogue on the sabbath day, and stood up for to read.

readiness of mind <u>44_ACT_17_11</u> # These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so.

readiness to revenge <u>47_2CO_10_06</u># And having in a readiness to revenge all disobedience, when your obedience is fulfilled.

readiness to will <u>47_2CO_08_11</u> # Now therefore perform the doing [of it]; that as [there was] a readiness to will, so [there may be] a performance also out of that which ye have.

reading in the 24_JER_36_08 # And Baruch the son of Neriah did according to all that Jeremiah the prophet commanded him, reading in the book the words of the LORD in the LORD'S house.

reading of the <u>47_2CO_03_14</u># But their minds were blinded: for until this day remaineth the same veil untaken away in the reading of the old testament; which [veil] is done away in Christ.

reading of the <u>44_ACT_13_15</u># And after the reading of the law and the prophets the rulers of the synagogue sent unto them, saying, [Ye] men [and] brethren, if ye have any word of exhortation for the people, say on.

reading this book <u>24_JER_51_63</u> # And it shall be, when thou hast made an end of reading this book, [that] thou shalt bind a stone to it, and cast it into the midst of Euphrates:

reading to exhortation 54_1TI_04_13 # Till I come, give attendance to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine.

ready And his 12 2KI 09 21 # And Joram said, Make ready. And his chariot was made ready. And Joram king of Israel and Ahaziah king of Judah went out, each in his chariot, and they went out against Jehu, and met him in the portion of Naboth the Jezreelite.

ready armed to 13_1CH_12_23 # And these [are] the numbers of the bands [that were] ready armed to the war, [and] came to David to Hebron, to turn the kingdom of Saul to him, according to the word of the LORD.

ready armed to <u>13_1CH_12_24</u># The children of Judah that bare shield and spear [were] six thousand and eight hundred, ready armed to the war.

ready as a <u>47_2CO_09_05</u># Therefore I thought it necessary to exhort the brethren, that they would go before unto you, and make up before hand your bounty, whereof ye had notice before, that the same might

ready for in 40_MAT_24_44# Therefore be ye also ready: for in such an hour as ye think not the Son of man cometh.

ready for me 18_JOB_17_01 # My breath is corrupt, my days are extinct, the graves [are ready] for me.

ready for the 13_1CH_28_02 # Then David the king stood up upon his feet, and said, Hear me, my brethren, and my people: [As for me], I [had] in mine heart to build an house of rest for the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and for the footstool of our God, and had made ready for the building:

ready their heart <u>28_HOS_07_06</u># For they have made ready their heart like an oven, whiles they lie in wait: their baker sleepeth all the night; in the morning it burneth as a flaming fire.

ready thine arrows 19_PSA_21_12 # Therefore shalt thou make them turn their back, [when] thou shalt make ready [thine arrows] upon thy strings against the face of them.

ready to be <u>60_1PE_01_05</u># Who are kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

ready to be 55_2TI_04_06 # For I am now ready to be offered, and the time of my departure is at hand.

ready to be 20_PRO_24_11# If thou forbear to deliver [them that are] drawn unto death, and [those that are] ready to be slain;

ready to be <u>66_REV_12_04</u># And his tail drew the third part of the stars of heaven, and did cast them to the earth: and the dragon stood before the woman which was ready to be delivered, for to devour her child as soon as it was born.

ready to become <u>18_JOB_15_28</u># And he dwelleth in desolate cities, [and] in houses which no man inhabiteth, which are ready to become heaps.

ready to burst 18_JOB_32_19 # Behold, my belly [is] as wine [which] hath no vent; it is ready to burst like new bottles.

ready to come <u>47_2CO_12_14</u># Behold, the third time I am ready to come to you; and I will not be burdensome to you: for I seek not yours, but you: for the children ought not to lay up for the parents, but the parents for the children.

ready to die 19_PSA_88_15 # I [am] afflicted and ready to die from [my] youth up: [while] I suffer thy terrors I am distracted.

ready <u>47_2CO_09_03</u> # Yet have I sent the brethren, lest our boasting of you should be in vain in this behalf; that, as I said, ye may be ready:

ready 43_JOH_07_06 # Then Jesus said unto them, My time is not yet come: but your time is alway ready.

ready <u>06_JOS_08_04</u> # And he commanded them, saying, Behold, ye shall lie in wait against the city, [even] behind the city: go not very far from the city, but be ye all ready:

ready <u>42_LUK_14_17</u> # And sent his servant at supper time to say to them that were bidden, Come; for all things are now ready.

ready 42 LUK 22 12 # And he shall show you a large upper room furnished: there make ready.

ready 19 PSA 07 12 # If he turn not, he will whet his sword; he hath bent his bow, and made it ready.

ready <u>66_REV_19_07</u> # Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife hath made herself ready.

showbread also set <u>14_2CH_13_11</u># And they burn unto the LORD every morning and every evening burnt sacrifices and sweet incense: the showbread also [set they in order] upon the pure table; and the candlestick of gold with the lamps thereof, to burn every evening: for we keep the charge of the LORD our

God; but ye have forsaken him.

showbread and for 13 1CH 23 29 # Both for the showbread, and for the fine flour for meat offering, and for the unleavened cakes, and for [that which is baked in] the pan, and for that which is fried, and for all manner of measure and size;

showbread and for 14_2CH_02_04 # Behold, I build an house to the name of the LORD my God, to dedicate [it] to him, [and] to burn before him sweet incense, and for the continual showbread, and for the burnt offerings morning and evening, on the sabbaths, and on the new moons, and on the solemn feasts of the LORD our God. This [is an ordinance] for ever to Israel.

showbread and for <u>16_NEH_10_33</u># For the showbread, and for the continual meat offering, and for the continual burnt offering, of the sabbaths, of the new moons, for the set feasts, and for the holy [things], and for the sin offerings to make an atonement for Israel, and [for] all the work of the house of our God.

showbread that was <u>09_1SA_21_06</u># So the priest gave him hallowed [bread]: for there was no bread there but the showbread, that was taken from before the LORD, to put hot bread in the day when it was taken away.

showbread was set 14_2CH_04_19 # And Solomon made all the vessels that [were for] the house of God, the golden altar also, and the tables whereon the showbread [was set];

showbread was 11_1KI_07_48# And Solomon made all the vessels that [pertained] unto the house of the LORD: the altar of gold, and the table of gold, whereupon the showbread [was],

showbread which is <u>58_HEB_09_02</u> # For there was a tabernacle made; the first, wherein [was] the candlestick, and the table, and the showbread; which is called the sanctuary.

showbread which is <u>41_MAR_02_26</u># How he went into the house of God in the days of Abiathar the high priest, and did eat the showbread, which is not lawful to eat but for the priests, and gave also to them which were with him?

showbread which was 40_MAT_12_04# How he entered into the house of God, and did eat the showbread, which was not lawful for him to eat, neither for them which were with him, but only for the priests?

showbread 02_EXO_35_13 # The table, and his staves, and all his vessels, and the showbread,

showbread 02_EXO_39_36 # The table, [and] all the vessels thereof, and the showbread,

spread a cloth <u>04_NUM_04_07</u># And upon the table of showbread they shall spread a cloth of blue, and put thereon the dishes, and the spoons, and the bowls, and covers to cover withal: and the continual bread shall be thereon:

spread a cloth <u>04_NUM_04_11</u># And upon the golden altar they shall spread a cloth of blue, and cover it with a covering of badgers' skins, and shall put to the staves thereof:

spread a cloud 19_PSA_105_39 # He spread a cloud for a covering; and fire to give light in the night.

spread a covering <u>10_2SA_17_19</u># And the woman took and spread a covering over the well's mouth, and spread ground corn thereon; and the thing was not known.

spread a garment <u>07_JUD_08_25</u> # And they answered, We will willingly give [them]. And they spread a garment, and did cast therein every man the earrings of his prey.

spread in the 20_PRO_01_17 # Surely in vain the net is spread in the sight of any bird.

spread into plates <u>24_JER_10_09</u> # Silver spread into plates is brought from Tarshish, and gold from Uphaz, the work of the workman, and of the hands of the founder: blue and purple [is] their clothing: they [are] all the work of cunning [men].

spread it before 12 2KI 19 14 # And Hezekiah received the letter of the hand of the messengers, and read it: and Hezekiah went up into the house of the LORD, and spread it before the LORD.

spread it before <u>26_EZE_02_10</u> # And he spread it before me; and it [was] written within and without: and [there was] written therein lamentations, and mourning, and woe.

spread it before 23_ISA_37_14 # And Hezekiah received the letter from the hand of the messengers, and read it: and Hezekiah went up unto the house of the LORD, and spread it before the LORD.

spreadeth abroad the <u>23_ISA_44_24</u> # Thus saith the LORD, thy redeemer, and he that formed thee from the womb, I [am] the LORD that maketh all [things]; that stretcheth forth the heavens alone; that spreadeth abroad the earth by myself;

spreadeth forth her <u>25_LAM_01_17</u># Zion spreadeth forth her hands, [and there is] none to comfort her: the LORD hath commanded concerning Jacob, [that] his adversaries [should be] round about him: Jerusalem is as a menstruous woman among them.

spreadeth forth his <u>23_ISA_25_11</u># And he shall spread forth his hands in the midst of them, as he that swimmeth spreadeth forth [his hands] to swim: and he shall bring down their pride together with the spoils

of their hands.

spreadeth her hands <u>24_JER_04_31</u># For I have heard a voice as of a woman in travail, [and] the anguish as of her that bringeth forth her first child, the voice of the daughter of Zion, [that] bewaileth herself, [that] spreadeth her hands, [saying], Woe [is] me now! for my soul is wearied because of murderers.

spreadeth his cloud <u>18_JOB_26_09</u># He holdeth back the face of his throne, [and] spreadeth his cloud upon it.

spreadeth his light <u>18_JOB_36_30</u># Behold, he spreadeth his light upon it, and covereth the bottom of the sea.

spreadeth in the <u>03_LEV_13_08</u># And [if] the priest see that, behold, the scab spreadeth in the skin, then the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it [is] a leprosy.

spreadeth it over <u>23_ISA_40_19</u> # The workman melteth a graven image, and the goldsmith spreadeth it over with gold, and casteth silver chains.

spreadeth out her <u>24_JER_17_08</u># For he shall be as a tree planted by the waters, and [that] spreadeth out her roots by the river, and shall not see when heat cometh, but her leaf shall be green; and shall not be careful in the year of drought, neither shall cease from yielding fruit.

spreadeth out the <u>18_JOB_09_08</u># Which alone spreadeth out the heavens, and treadeth upon the waves of the sea.

spreadeth sharp pointed <u>18_JOB_41_30</u># Sharp stones [are] under him: he spreadeth sharp pointed things upon the mire.

spreadeth them out <u>23_ISA_40_22</u> # [It is] he that sitteth upon the circle of the earth, and the inhabitants thereof [are] as grasshoppers; that stretcheth out the heavens as a curtain, and spreadeth them out as a tent to dwell in:

spreading himself like 19 PSA 37 35 # I have seen the wicked in great power, and spreading himself like a green bay tree.

spreading of nets <u>26_EZE_26_05</u># It shall be [a place for] the spreading of nets in the midst of the sea: for I have spoken [it], saith the Lord GOD: and it shall become a spoil to the nations.

spreading plague thou <u>03_LEV_13_57</u># And if it appear still in the garment, either in the warp, or in the woof, or in any thing of skin; it [is] a spreading [plague]: thou shalt burn that wherein the plague [is] with fire.

spreading vine of <u>26_EZE_17_06</u># And it grew, and became a spreading vine of low stature, whose branches turned toward him, and the roots thereof were under him: so it became a vine, and brought forth branches, and shot forth sprigs.

spreadings of the <u>18_JOB_36_29</u> # Also can [any] understand the spreadings of the clouds, [or] the noise of his tabernacle?

thread even to <u>01_GEN_14_23</u> # That I will not [take] from a thread even to a shoelatchet, and that I will not take any thing that [is] thine, lest thou shouldest say, I have made Abram rich:

thread in the <u>06_JOS_02_18</u># Behold, [when] we come into the land, thou shalt bind this line of scarlet thread in the window which thou didst let us down by: and thou shalt bring thy father, and thy mother, and thy brethren, and all thy father's household, home unto thee.

thread of scarlet <u>22_SON_04_03</u> # Thy lips [are] like a thread of scarlet, and thy speech [is] comely: thy temples [are] like a piece of a pomegranate within thy locks.

thread of tow <u>07_JUD_16_09</u> # Now [there were] men lying in wait, abiding with her in the chamber. And she said unto him, The Philistines [be] upon thee, Samson. And he brake the withs, as a thread of tow is broken when it toucheth the fire. So his strength was not known.

thread saying This <u>01_GEN_38_28</u># And it came to pass, when she travailed, that [the one] put out [his] hand: and the midwife took and bound upon his hand a scarlet thread, saying, This came out first.

thread upon his <u>01_GEN_38_30</u> # And afterward came out his brother, that had the scarlet thread upon his hand: and his name was called Zarah.

thread <u>07_JUD_16_12</u># Delilah therefore took new ropes, and bound him therewith, and said unto him, The Philistines [be] upon thee, Samson. And [there were] liers in wait abiding in the chamber. And he brake them from off his arms like a thread.

tread down all <u>26_EZE_26_11</u># With the hoofs of his horses shall he tread down all thy streets: he shall slay thy people by the sword, and thy strong garrisons shall go down to the ground.

tread down my 19_PSA_07_05 # Let the enemy persecute my soul, and take [it]; yea, let him tread down my life upon the earth, and lay mine honour in the dust. Selah.

tread down our <u>19_PSA_108_13</u> # Through God we shall do valiantly: for he [it is that] shall tread down our enemies.

tread down our <u>19_PSA_60_12</u># Through God we shall do valiantly: for he [it is that] shall tread down our enemies.

tread down the <u>23_ISA_63_06</u># And I will tread down the people in mine anger, and make them drunk in my fury, and I will bring down their strength to the earth.

tread down the <u>18_JOB_40_12</u># Look on every one [that is] proud, [and] bring him low; and tread down the wicked in their place.

tread down the <u>39_MAL_04_03</u> # And ye shall tread down the wicked; for they shall be ashes under the soles of your feet in the day that I shall do [this], saith the LORD of hosts.

tread down their <u>38_ZEC_10_05</u># And they shall be as mighty [men], which tread down [their enemies] in the mire of the streets in the battle: and they shall fight, because the LORD [is] with them, and the riders on horses shall be confounded.

tread down with <u>26_EZE_34_18</u># [Seemeth it] a small thing unto you to have eaten up the good pasture, but ye must tread down with your feet the residue of your pastures? and to have drunk of the deep waters, but ye must foul the residue with your feet?

tread him under 23_ISA_14_25 # That I will break the Assyrian in my land, and upon my mountains tread him under foot: then shall his yoke depart from off them, and his burden depart from off their shoulders.

tread in our <u>33_MIC_05_05</u># And this [man] shall be the peace, when the Assyrian shall come into our land: and when he shall tread in our palaces, then shall we raise against him seven shepherds, and eight principal men.

tread it down 27_DAN_07_23 # Thus he said, The fourth beast shall be the fourth kingdom upon earth,

which shall be diverse from all kingdoms, and shall devour the whole earth, and shall tread it down, and break it in pieces.

tread it down <u>23_ISA_26_06</u># The foot shall tread it down, [even] the feet of the poor, [and] the steps of the needy.

tread my courts 23 ISA 01 12 # When ye come to appear before me, who hath required this at your hand, to tread my courts?

tread on serpents <u>42_LUK_10_19</u> # Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

tread on the <u>09_1SA_05_05</u> # Therefore neither the priests of Dagon, nor any that come into Dagon's house, tread on the threshold of Dagon in Ashdod unto this day.

tread out no <u>23_ISA_16_10</u># And gladness is taken away, and joy out of the plentiful field; and in the vineyards there shall be no singing, neither shall there be shouting: the treaders shall tread out no wine in [their] presses; I have made [their vintage] shouting to cease.

tread out the <u>28_HOS_10_11</u># And Ephraim [is as] an heifer [that is] taught, [and] loveth to tread out [the corn]; but I passed over upon her fair neck: I will make Ephraim to ride; Judah shall plow, [and] Jacob shall break his clods.

tread shall be <u>05_DEU_11_24</u># Every place whereon the soles of your feet shall tread shall be yours: from the wilderness and Lebanon, from the river, the river Euphrates, even unto the uttermost sea shall your coast be.

tread the grapes 24_JER_25_30 # Therefore prophesy thou against them all these words, and say unto them, The LORD shall roar from on high, and utter his voice from his holy habitation; he shall mightily roar upon his habitation; he shall give a shout, as they that tread [the grapes], against all the inhabitants of the earth.

tread the mortar <u>34_NAH_03_14</u> # Draw thee waters for the siege, fortify thy strong holds: go into clay, and tread the mortar, make strong the brickkiln.

tread the olives <u>33_MIC_06_15</u> # Thou shalt sow, but thou shalt not reap; thou shalt tread the olives, but thou shalt not anoint thee with oil; and sweet wine, but shalt not drink wine.

tread their winepresses <u>18_JOB_24_11</u># [Which] make oil within their walls, [and] tread [their] winepresses, and suffer thirst.

tread them down <u>23_ISA_10_06</u># I will send him against an hypocritical nation, and against the people of my wrath will I give him a charge, to take the spoil, and to take the prey, and to tread them down like the mire of the streets.

tread them in <u>23_ISA_63_03</u># I have trodden the winepress alone; and of the people [there was] none with me: for I will tread them in mine anger, and trample them in my fury; and their blood shall be sprinkled upon my garments, and I will stain all my raiment.

tread them under 19_PSA_44_05 # Through thee will we push down our enemies: through thy name will we tread them under that rise up against us.

tread under foot <u>66_REV_11_02</u># But the court which is without the temple leave out, and measure it not; for it is given unto the Gentiles: and the holy city shall they tread under foot forty [and] two months.

tread upon as <u>05_DEU_11_25</u># There shall no man be able to stand before you: [for] the LORD your God shall lay the fear of you and the dread of you upon all the land that ye shall tread upon, as he hath said unto you.

tread upon that <u>06_JOS_01_03</u> # Every place that the sole of your foot shall tread upon, that have I given unto you, as I said unto Moses.

tread upon the <u>33_MIC_01_03</u> # For, behold, the LORD cometh forth out of his place, and will come down, and tread upon the high places of the earth.

tread upon the <u>19_PSA_91_13</u># Thou shalt tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon shalt thou trample under feet.

tread upon their <u>05_DEU_33_29</u> # Happy [art] thou, O Israel: who [is] like unto thee, O people saved by the LORD, the shield of thy help, and who [is] the sword of thy excellency! and thine enemies shall be found liars unto thee; and thou shalt tread upon their high places.

tread with shouting <u>24_JER_48_33</u># And joy and gladness is taken from the plentiful field, and from the land of Moab; and I have caused wine to fail from the winepresses: none shall tread with shouting; [their] shouting [shall be] no shouting.

treader of grapes 30_AMO_09_13 # Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that the plowman shall overtake the reaper, and the treader of grapes him that soweth seed; and the mountains shall drop sweet wine, and all the hills shall melt.

treaders shall tread <u>23_ISA_16_10</u># And gladness is taken away, and joy out of the plentiful field; and in the vineyards there shall be no singing, neither shall there be shouting: the treaders shall tread out no wine in [their] presses; I have made [their vintage] shouting to cease.

treadeth clay 23 ISA 41 25 # I have raised up [one] from the north, and he shall come: from the rising of the sun shall he call upon my name: and he shall come upon princes as [upon] mortar, and as the potter treadeth clay.

treadeth down and <u>33_MIC_05_08</u># And the remnant of Jacob shall be among the Gentiles in the midst of many people as a lion among the beasts of the forest, as a young lion among the flocks of sheep: who, if he go through, both treadeth down, and teareth in pieces, and none can deliver.

treadeth in the <u>23_ISA_63_02</u> # Wherefore [art thou] red in thine apparel, and thy garments like him that treadeth in the winefat?

treadeth out the <u>46_1CO_09_09</u> # For it is written in the law of Moses, Thou shalt not muzzle the mouth of the ox that treadeth out the corn. Doth God take care for oxen?

treadeth out the $\underline{54_1TI_05_18}$ # For the scripture saith, Thou shalt not muzzle the ox that treadeth out the corn. And, The labourer [is] worthy of his reward.

treadeth out the 05_DEU_25_04 # Thou shalt not muzzle the ox when he treadeth out [the corn].

treadeth the winepress 66_REV_19_15 # And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

treadeth upon the <u>30_AMO_04_13</u># For, lo, he that formeth the mountains, and createth the wind, and declareth unto man what [is] his thought, that maketh the morning darkness, and treadeth upon the high places of the earth, The LORD, The God of hosts, [is] his name.

treadeth upon the <u>18_JOB_09_08</u># Which alone spreadeth out the heavens, and treadeth upon the waves of the sea.

treadeth within our <u>33_MIC_05_06</u># And they shall waste the land of Assyria with the sword, and the land of Nimrod in the entrances thereof: thus shall he deliver [us] from the Assyrian, when he cometh into our land, and when he treadeth within our borders.

treading down and 23_ISA_22_05 # For [it is] a day of trouble, and of treading down, and of perplexity by the Lord GOD of hosts in the valley of vision, breaking down the walls, and of crying to the mountains.

treading is upon <u>30_AMO_05_11</u># Forasmuch therefore as your treading [is] upon the poor, and ye take from him burdens of wheat: ye have built houses of hewn stone, but ye shall not dwell in them; ye have planted pleasant vineyards, but ye shall not drink wine of them.

treading of lesser 23 ISA 07 25 # And [on] all hills that shall be digged with the mattock, there shall not come thither the fear of briers and thorns: but it shall be for the sending forth of oxen, and for the treading of lesser cattle.

treading wine presses 16_NEH_13_15 # In those days saw I in Judah [some] treading wine presses on the sabbath, and bringing in sheaves, and lading asses; as also wine, grapes, and figs, and all [manner of] burdens, which they brought into Jerusalem on the sabbath day: and I testified [against them] in the day wherein they sold victuals.
