already and have [47\\_2CO\\_12\\_21](#) # [And] lest, when I come again, my God will humble me among you, and [that] I shall bewail many which have sinned already, and have not repented of the uncleanness and fornication and lasciviousness which they have committed.

already and it [21\\_ECC\\_06\\_10](#) # That which hath been is named already, and it is known that it [is] man: neither may he contend with him that is mightier than he.

already and overthrow [55\\_2TI\\_02\\_18](#) # Who concerning the truth have erred, saying that the resurrection is past already; and overthrow the faith of some.

already and they [40\\_MAT\\_17\\_12](#) # But I say unto you, That Elias is come already, and they knew him not, but have done unto him whatsoever they listed. Likewise shall also the Son of man suffer of them.

already and ye [43\\_JOH\\_09\\_27](#) # He answered them, I have told you already, and ye did not hear: wherefore would ye hear [it] again? will ye also be his disciples?

already as though [46\\_1CO\\_05\\_03](#) # For I verily, as absent in body, but present in spirit, have judged already, as though I were present, [concerning] him that hath so done this deed,

already attained either [50\\_PHP\\_03\\_12](#) # Not as though I had already attained, either were already perfect: but I follow after, if that I may apprehend that for which also I am apprehended of Christ Jesus.

already been and [21\\_ECC\\_03\\_15](#) # That which hath been is now; and that which is to be hath already been; and God requireth that which is past.

already come unto [44\\_ACT\\_11\\_11](#) # And, behold, immediately there were three men already come unto the house where I was, sent from Caesarea unto me.

already dead and [41\\_MAR\\_15\\_44](#) # And Pilate marvelled if he were already dead: and calling [unto him] the centurion, he asked him whether he had been any while dead.

already dead more [21\\_ECC\\_04\\_02](#) # Wherefore I praised the dead which are already dead more than the living which are yet alive.

already is it [62 1JO 04 03](#) # And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that [spirit] of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.

already kindled [42 LUK 12 49](#) # I am come to send fire on the earth; and what will I, if it be already kindled?

already neither is [16 NEH 05 05](#) # Yet now our flesh [is] as the flesh of our brethren, our children as their children: and, lo, we bring into bondage our sons and our daughters to be servants, and [some] of our daughters are brought unto bondage [already]: neither [is it] in our power [to redeem them]; for other men have our lands and vineyards.

already of old [21 ECC 01 10](#) # Is there [any] thing whereof it may be said, See, this [is] new? it hath been already of old time, which was before us.

already past Paul [44 ACT 27 09](#) # Now when much time was spent, and when sailing was now dangerous, because the fast was now already past, Paul admonished [them],

already perfect but [50 PHP 03 12](#) # Not as though I had already attained, either were already perfect: but I follow after, if that I may apprehend that for which also I am apprehended of Christ Jesus.

already that if [43 JOH 09 22](#) # These [words] spake his parents, because they feared the Jews: for the Jews had agreed already, that if any man did confess that he was Christ, he should be put out of the synagogue.

already they brake [43 JOH 19 33](#) # But when they came to Jesus, and saw that he was dead already, they brake not his legs:

already to harvest [43 JOH 04 35](#) # Say not ye, There are yet four months, and [then] cometh harvest? behold, I say unto you, Lift up your eyes, and look on the fields; for they are white already to harvest.

already turned aside [54 1TI 05 15](#) # For some are already turned aside after Satan.

already work only [53 2TH 02 07](#) # For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth [will let], until he be taken out of the way.

already ye intend [14 2CH 28 13](#) # And said unto them, Ye shall not bring in the captives hither: for whereas we have offended against the LORD [already], ye intend to add [more] to our sins and to our trespass: for our trespass is great, and [there is] fierce wrath against Israel.

already [02 EXO 01 05](#) # And all the souls that came out of the loins of Jacob were seventy souls: for Joseph was in Egypt [already].

already [43 JOH 11 17](#) # Then when Jesus came, he found that he had [lain] in the grave four days already.

bread according to [01 GEN 47 12](#) # And Joseph nourished his father, and his brethren, and all his father's household, with bread, according to [their] families.

bread and a [09 ISA 22 13](#) # And Saul said unto him, Why have ye conspired against me, thou and the son of Jesse, in that thou hast given him bread, and a sword, and hast inquired of God for him, that he should rise against me, to lie in wait, as at this day?

bread and a [10 2SA 06 19](#) # And he dealt among all the people, [even] among the whole multitude of Israel, as well to the women as men, to every one a cake of bread, and a good piece [of flesh], and a flagon [of wine]. So all the people departed every one to his house.

bread and cakes [02 EXO 29 02](#) # And unleavened bread, and cakes unleavened tempered with oil, and wafers unleavened anointed with oil: [of] wheaten flour shalt thou make them.

bread and call [19 PSA 14 04](#) # Have all the workers of iniquity no knowledge? who eat up my people [as] they eat bread, and call not upon the LORD.

bread and came [44 ACT 20 06](#) # And we sailed away from Philippi after the days of unleavened bread, and came unto them to Troas in five days; where we abode seven days.

bread and cast [40 MAT 15 26](#) # But he answered and said, It is not meet to take the children's bread, and cast [it] to dogs.

bread and comfort [01 GEN 18 05](#) # And I will fetch a morsel of bread, and comfort ye your hearts; after that ye shall pass on: for therefore are ye come to your servant. And they said, So do, as thou hast said.

bread and dip [08 RUT 02 14](#) # And Boaz said unto her, At mealtime come thou hither, and eat of the bread, and dip thy morsel in the vinegar. And she sat beside the reapers: and he reached her parched [corn], and she did eat, and was sufficed, and left.

bread and my [28 HOS 02 05](#) # For their mother hath played the harlot: she that conceived them hath done shamefully: for she said, I will go after my lovers, that give [me] my bread and my water, my wool and my flax, mine oil and my drink.

bread and no [25 LAM 04 04](#) # The tongue of the sucking child cleaveth to the roof of his mouth for thirst: the young children ask bread, [and] no man breaketh [it] unto them.

bread and on [05 DEU 16 08](#) # Six days thou shalt eat unleavened bread: and on the seventh day [shall be] a solemn assembly to the LORD thy God: thou shalt do no work [therein].

bread and one [46 1CO 10 17](#) # For we [being] many are one bread, [and] one body: for we are all partakers of that one bread.

bread and one [02 EXO 29 23](#) # And one loaf of bread, and one cake of oiled bread, and one wafer out of the basket of the unleavened bread that [is] before the LORD:

bread and pottage [01 GEN 25 34](#) # Then Jacob gave Esau bread and pottage of lentiles; and he did eat and drink, and rose up, and went his way: thus Esau despised [his] birthright.

bread and prophesy [30 AMO 07 12](#) # Also Amaziah said unto Amos, O thou seer, go, flee thee away into the land of Judah, and there eat bread, and prophesy there:

bread and shall [09 ISA 02 36](#) # And it shall come to pass, [that] every one that is left in thine house shall come [and] crouch to him for a piece of silver and a morsel of bread, and shall say, Put me, I pray thee, into one of the priests' offices, that I may eat a piece of bread.

bread And so [12 2KI 04 08](#) # And it fell on a day, that Elisha passed to Shunem, where [was] a great woman; and she constrained him to eat bread. And [so] it was, [that] as oft as he passed by, he turned in thither to eat bread.

bread and the [41 MAR 14 01](#) # After two days was [the feast of] the passover, and of unleavened bread: and the chief priests and the scribes sought how they might take him by craft, and put [him] to death.

bread and the [20 PRO 06 26](#) # For by means of a whorish woman [a man is brought] to a piece of bread: and the adulteress will hunt for the precious life.

bread and there [24 JER 42 14](#) # Saying, No; but we will go into the land of Egypt, where we shall see no war, nor hear the sound of the trumpet, nor have hunger of bread; and there will we dwell:

bread and they [01 GEN 31 54](#) # Then Jacob offered sacrifice upon the mount, and called his brethren to eat bread: and they did eat bread, and tarried all night in the mount.

bread and they [01 GEN 37 25](#) # And they sat down to eat bread: and they lifted up their eyes and looked, and, behold, a company of Ishmeelites came from Gilead with their camels bearing spicery and balm and myrrh, going to carry [it] down to Egypt.

bread and thy [02 EXO 23 25](#) # And ye shall serve the LORD your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee.

bread and to [41 MAR 07 27](#) # But Jesus said unto her, Let the children first be filled: for it is not meet to take the children's bread, and to cast [it] unto the dogs.

bread and under [18 JOB 28 05](#) # [As for] the earth, out of it cometh bread: and under it is turned up as it were fire.

bread and vineyards [12 2KI 18 32](#) # Until I come and take you away to a land like your own land, a land of corn and wine, a land of bread and vineyards, a land of oil olive and of honey, that ye may live, and not die: and hearken not unto Hezekiah, when he persuadeth you, saying, The LORD will deliver us.

bread and vineyards [23 ISA 36 17](#) # Until I come and take you away to a land like your own land, a land of corn and wine, a land of bread and vineyards.

bread and water [11 1KI 18 04](#) # For it was [so], when Jezebel cut off the prophets of the LORD, that Obadiah took an hundred prophets, and hid them by fifty in a cave, and fed them with bread and water.]

bread and water [11 1KI 18 13](#) # Was it not told my lord what I did when Jezebel slew the prophets of the LORD, how I hid an hundred men of the LORD's prophets by fifty in a cave, and fed them with bread and water?

bread and water [12 2KI 06 22](#) # And he answered, Thou shalt not smite [them]: wouldest thou smite those whom thou hast taken captive with thy sword and with thy bow? set bread and water before them, that they may eat and drink, and go to their master.

bread and water [26 EZE 04 17](#) # That they may want bread and water, and be astonished one with another, and consume away for their iniquity.

bread and we [01 GEN 47 19](#) # Wherefore shall we die before thine eyes, both we and our land? buy us and our land for bread, and we and our land will be servants unto Pharaoh: and give [us] seed, that we may live, and not die, that the land be not desolate.

bread and wear [23 ISA 04 01](#) # And in that day seven women shall take hold of one man, saying, We will eat our own bread, and wear our own apparel: only let us be called by thy name, to take away our reproach.

bread and wine [01 GEN 14 18](#) # And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and he [was] the priest of the most high God.

bread and wine [07 JUD 19 19](#) # Yet there is both straw and provender for our asses; and there is bread and wine also for me, and for thy handmaid, and for the young man [which is] with thy servants: [there is] no want of any thing.

bread and wine [16 NEH 05 15](#) # But the former governors that [had been] before me were chargeable unto the people, and had taken of them bread and wine, beside forty shekels of silver; yea, even their servants bare rule over the people: but so did not I, because of the fear of God.

bread and with [05 DEU 23 04](#) # Because they met you not with bread and with water in the way, when ye came forth out of Egypt; and because they hired against thee Balaam the son of Beor of Pethor of Mesopotamia, to curse thee.

bread and with [16 NEH 13 02](#) # Because they met not the children of Israel with bread and with water, but hired Balaam against them, that he should curse them: howbeit our God turned the curse into a blessing.

bread and ye [02 EXO 16 12](#) # I have heard the murmurings of the children of Israel: speak unto them, saying, At even ye shall eat flesh, and in the morning ye shall be filled with bread; and ye shall know that I [am] the LORD your God.

bread and your [23 ISA 55 02](#) # Wherefore do ye spend money for [that which is] not bread? and your labour for [that which] satisfieth not? hearken diligently unto me, and eat ye [that which is] good, and let your soul delight itself in fatness.

bread anointed with [04 NUM 06 15](#) # And a basket of unleavened bread, cakes of fine flour mingled with oil, and wafers of unleavened bread anointed with oil, and their meat offering, and their drink offerings.

bread as I [02 EXO 34 18](#) # The feast of unleavened bread shalt thou keep. Seven days thou shalt eat unleavened bread, as I commanded thee, in the time of the month Abib: for in the month Abib thou camest out from Egypt.

bread at my [10 2SA 09 07](#) # And David said unto him, Fear not: for I will surely show thee kindness for Jonathan thy father's sake, and will restore thee all the land of Saul thy father; and thou shalt eat bread at my table continually.

bread be eaten [02 EXO 13 03](#) # And Moses said unto the people, Remember this day, in which ye came out from Egypt, out of the house of bondage; for by strength of hand the LORD brought you out from this



[place]: there shall no leavened bread be eaten.

bread be eaten [04 NUM 28 17](#) # And in the fifteenth day of this month [is] the feast: seven days shall unleavened bread be eaten.

bread be seen [02 EXO 13 07](#) # Unleavened bread shall be eaten seven days; and there shall no leavened bread be seen with thee, neither shall there be leaven seen with thee in all thy quarters.

bread before him [10 2SA 12 20](#) # Then David arose from the earth, and washed, and anointed [himself], and changed his apparel, and came into the house of the LORD, and worshipped: then he came to his own house; and when he required, they set bread before him, and he did eat.

bread before him [24 JER 52 33](#) # And changed his prison garments: and he did continually eat bread before him all the days of his life.

bread shall it [03 LEV 06 16](#) # And the remainder thereof shall Aaron and his sons eat: with unleavened bread shall it be eaten in the holy place; in the court of the tabernacle of the congregation they shall eat it.

bread shall live [43 JOH 06 58](#) # This is that bread which came down from heaven: not as your fathers did eat manna, and are dead: he that eateth of this bread shall live for ever.

bread shall ye [03 LEV 08 32](#) # And that which remaineth of the flesh and of the bread shall ye burn with fire.

bread shalt thou [02 EXO 34 18](#) # The feast of unleavened bread shalt thou keep. Seven days thou shalt eat unleavened bread, as I commanded thee, in the time of the month Abib: for in the month Abib thou camest out from Egypt.

bread should fail [23 ISA 51 14](#) # The captive exile hasteneth that he may be loosed, and that he should not die in the pit, nor that his bread should fail.

bread ten women [03 LEV 26 26](#) # [And] when I have broken the staff of your bread, ten women shall bake your bread in one oven, and they shall deliver [you] your bread again by weight: and ye shall eat, and not be satisfied.

bread that I [43 JOH 06 51](#) # I am the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live for ever: and the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world.

bread that is [02 EXO 29 23](#) # And one loaf of bread, and one cake of oiled bread, and one wafer out of the basket of the unleavened bread that [is] before the LORD:

bread they have [19 PSA 53 04](#) # Have the workers of iniquity no knowledge? who eat up my people [as] they eat bread: they have not called upon God.

bread thou shalt [02 EXO 23 15](#) # Thou shalt keep the feast of unleavened bread: [thou shalt eat unleavened bread seven days, as I commanded thee, in the time appointed of the month Abib; for in it thou camest out from Egypt: and none shall appear before me empty:]

ready [10 2SA 18 22](#) # Then said Ahimaaz the son of Zadok yet again to Joab, But howsoever, let me, I pray thee, also run after Cush. And Joab said, Wherefore wilt thou run, my son, seeing that thou hast no tidings ready?

ready [43 JOH 07 06](#) # Then Jesus said unto them, My time is not yet come: but your time is always ready.

ready [06 JOS 08 04](#) # And he commanded them, saying, Behold, ye shall lie in wait against the city, [even] behind the city: go not very far from the city, but be ye all ready:

ready [42 LUK 14 17](#) # And sent his servant at supper time to say to them that were bidden, Come; for all things are now ready.

ready [42 LUK 22 12](#) # And he shall show you a large upper room furnished: there make ready.

showbread [02 EXO 35 13](#) # The table, and his staves, and all his vessels, and the showbread,

showbread [02\\_EXO\\_39\\_36](#) # The table, [and] all the vessels thereof, and the showbread,

spread a cloth [04\\_NUM\\_04\\_07](#) # And upon the table of showbread they shall spread a cloth of blue, and put thereon the dishes, and the spoons, and the bowls, and covers to cover withal: and the continual bread shall be thereon:

spread a cloth [04\\_NUM\\_04\\_11](#) # And upon the golden altar they shall spread a cloth of blue, and cover it with a covering of badgers' skins, and shall put to the staves thereof:

spread a cloud [19\\_PSA\\_105\\_39](#) # He spread a cloud for a covering; and fire to give light in the night.

spreadeth abroad the [23 ISA 44 24](#) # Thus saith the LORD, thy redeemer, and he that formed thee from the womb, I [am] the LORD that maketh all [things]; that stretcheth forth the heavens alone; that spreadeth abroad the earth by myself;

spreadeth forth her [25 LAM 01 17](#) # Zion spreadeth forth her hands, [and there is] none to comfort her: the LORD hath commanded concerning Jacob, [that] his adversaries [should be] round about him: Jerusalem is as a menstruous woman among them.

spreadeth forth his [23 ISA 25 11](#) # And he shall spread forth his hands in the midst of them, as he that swimmeth spreadeth forth [his hands] to swim: and he shall bring down their pride together with the spoils

of their hands.

spreadeth her hands [24 JER 04 31](#) # For I have heard a voice as of a woman in travail, [and] the anguish as of her that bringeth forth her first child, the voice of the daughter of Zion, [that] bewaileth herself, [that] spreadeth her hands, [saying], Woe [is] me now! for my soul is wearied because of murderers.

spreadeth his cloud [18 JOB 26 09](#) # He holdeth back the face of his throne, [and] spreadeth his cloud upon it.

spreadeth his light [18 JOB 36 30](#) # Behold, he spreadeth his light upon it, and covereth the bottom of the sea.

spreadeth in the [03 LEV 13 08](#) # And [if] the priest see that, behold, the scab spreadeth in the skin, then the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it [is] a leprosy.

spreadeth it over [23 ISA 40 19](#) # The workman melteth a graven image, and the goldsmith spreadeth it over with gold, and casteth silver chains.

spreadeth out her [24 JER 17 08](#) # For he shall be as a tree planted by the waters, and [that] spreadeth out her roots by the river, and shall not see when heat cometh, but her leaf shall be green; and shall not be careful in the year of drought, neither shall cease from yielding fruit.

spreadeth out the [18 JOB 09 08](#) # Which alone spreadeth out the heavens, and treadeth upon the waves of the sea.

spreadeth sharp pointed [18 JOB 41 30](#) # Sharp stones [are] under him: he spreadeth sharp pointed things upon the mire.

spreadeth them out [23 ISA 40 22](#) # [It is] he that sitteth upon the circle of the earth, and the inhabitants thereof [are] as grasshoppers; that stretcheth out the heavens as a curtain, and spreadeth them out as a tent to dwell in:

spreading himself like [19 PSA 37 35](#) # I have seen the wicked in great power, and spreading himself like a green bay tree.

spreading of nets [26 EZE 26 05](#) # It shall be [a place for] the spreading of nets in the midst of the sea: for I have spoken [it], saith the Lord GOD: and it shall become a spoil to the nations.

spreading plague thou [03 LEV 13 57](#) # And if it appear still in the garment, either in the warp, or in the woof, or in any thing of skin; it [is] a spreading [plague]: thou shalt burn that wherein the plague [is] with fire.

spreading vine of [26 EZE 17 06](#) # And it grew, and became a spreading vine of low stature, whose branches turned toward him, and the roots thereof were under him: so it became a vine, and brought forth branches, and shot forth sprigs.

spreadings of the [18 JOB 36 29](#) # Also can [any] understand the spreadings of the clouds, [or] the noise of his tabernacle?

thread even to [01 GEN 14 23](#) # That I will not [take] from a thread even to a shoelatchet, and that I will not take any thing that [is] thine, lest thou shouldest say, I have made Abram rich:

thread in the [06 JOS 02 18](#) # Behold, [when] we come into the land, thou shalt bind this line of scarlet thread in the window which thou didst let us down by: and thou shalt bring thy father, and thy mother, and thy brethren, and all thy father's household, home unto thee.

thread of scarlet [22 SON 04 03](#) # Thy lips [are] like a thread of scarlet, and thy speech [is] comely: thy temples [are] like a piece of a pomegranate within thy locks.

thread of tow [07 JUD 16 09](#) # Now [there were] men lying in wait, abiding with her in the chamber. And she said unto him, The Philistines [be] upon thee, Samson. And he brake the withs, as a thread of tow is broken when it toucheth the fire. So his strength was not known.

thread saying This [01 GEN 38 28](#) # And it came to pass, when she travailed, that [the one] put out [his] hand: and the midwife took and bound upon his hand a scarlet thread, saying, This came out first.

thread upon his [01 GEN 38 30](#) # And afterward came out his brother, that had the scarlet thread upon his hand: and his name was called Zarah.

thread [07 JUD 16 12](#) # Delilah therefore took new ropes, and bound him therewith, and said unto him, The Philistines [be] upon thee, Samson. And [there were] liers in wait abiding in the chamber. And he brake them from off his arms like a thread.

tread down all [26 EZE 26 11](#) # With the hoofs of his horses shall he tread down all thy streets: he shall slay thy people by the sword, and thy strong garrisons shall go down to the ground.

tread down my [19 PSA 07 05](#) # Let the enemy persecute my soul, and take [it]; yea, let him tread down my life upon the earth, and lay mine honour in the dust. Selah.

tread down our [19 PSA 108 13](#) # Through God we shall do valiantly: for he [it is that] shall tread down our enemies.

tread down our [19 PSA 60 12](#) # Through God we shall do valiantly: for he [it is that] shall tread down our enemies.

tread down the [23 ISA 63 06](#) # And I will tread down the people in mine anger, and make them drunk in my fury, and I will bring down their strength to the earth.

tread down the [18 JOB 40 12](#) # Look on every one [that is] proud, [and] bring him low; and tread down the wicked in their place.

tread down the [39 MAL 04 03](#) # And ye shall tread down the wicked; for they shall be ashes under the soles of your feet in the day that I shall do [this], saith the LORD of hosts.

tread down their [38 ZEC 10 05](#) # And they shall be as mighty [men], which tread down [their enemies] in the mire of the streets in the battle: and they shall fight, because the LORD [is] with them, and the riders on horses shall be confounded.

tread down with [26 EZE 34 18](#) # [Seemeth it] a small thing unto you to have eaten up the good pasture, but ye must tread down with your feet the residue of your pastures? and to have drunk of the deep waters, but ye must foul the residue with your feet?

tread him under [23 ISA 14 25](#) # That I will break the Assyrian in my land, and upon my mountains tread him under foot: then shall his yoke depart from off them, and his burden depart from off their shoulders.

tread in our [33 MIC 05 05](#) # And this [man] shall be the peace, when the Assyrian shall come into our land: and when he shall tread in our palaces, then shall we raise against him seven shepherds, and eight principal men.

tread it down [27 DAN 07 23](#) # Thus he said, The fourth beast shall be the fourth kingdom upon earth,

which shall be diverse from all kingdoms, and shall devour the whole earth, and shall tread it down, and break it in pieces.

tread on the [09 ISA 05 05](#) # Therefore neither the priests of Dagon, nor any that come into Dagon's house, tread on the threshold of Dagon in Ashdod unto this day.

tread out no [23 ISA 16 10](#) # And gladness is taken away, and joy out of the plentiful field; and in the vineyards there shall be no singing, neither shall there be shouting: the treaders shall tread out no wine in [their] presses; I have made [their vintage] shouting to cease.

tread out the [28 HOS 10 11](#) # And Ephraim [is as] an heifer [that is] taught, [and] loveth to tread out [the corn]; but I passed over upon her fair neck: I will make Ephraim to ride; Judah shall plow, [and] Jacob shall break his clods.

tread shall be [05 DEU 11 24](#) # Every place whereon the soles of your feet shall tread shall be yours: from the wilderness and Lebanon, from the river, the river Euphrates, even unto the uttermost sea shall your coast be.

tread the grapes [24 JER 25 30](#) # Therefore prophesy thou against them all these words, and say unto them, The LORD shall roar from on high, and utter his voice from his holy habitation; he shall mightily roar upon his habitation; he shall give a shout, as they that tread [the grapes], against all the inhabitants of the earth.

tread the mortar [34 NAH 03 14](#) # Draw thee waters for the siege, fortify thy strong holds: go into clay, and tread the mortar, make strong the brickkiln.

tread the olives [33 MIC 06 15](#) # Thou shalt sow, but thou shalt not reap; thou shalt tread the olives, but thou shalt not anoint thee with oil; and sweet wine, but shalt not drink wine.

tread their winepresses [18 JOB 24 11](#) # [Which] make oil within their walls, [and] tread [their] winepresses, and suffer thirst.

tread them down [23 ISA 10 06](#) # I will send him against an hypocritical nation, and against the people of my wrath will I give him a charge, to take the spoil, and to take the prey, and to tread them down like the mire of the streets.

tread them in [23 ISA 63 03](#) # I have trodden the winepress alone; and of the people [there was] none with me: for I will tread them in mine anger, and trample them in my fury; and their blood shall be sprinkled upon my garments, and I will stain all my raiment.

tread them under [19 PSA 44 05](#) # Through thee will we push down our enemies: through thy name will we tread them under that rise up against us.

tread under foot [66 REV 11 02](#) # But the court which is without the temple leave out, and measure it not; for it is given unto the Gentiles: and the holy city shall they tread under foot forty [and] two months.

tread upon as [05 DEU 11 25](#) # There shall no man be able to stand before you: [for] the LORD your God shall lay the fear of you and the dread of you upon all the land that ye shall tread upon, as he hath said unto you.

tread upon that [06 JOS 01 03](#) # Every place that the sole of your foot shall tread upon, that have I given unto you, as I said unto Moses.

tread upon the [33 MIC 01 03](#) # For, behold, the LORD cometh forth out of his place, and will come down, and tread upon the high places of the earth.

tread upon the [19 PSA 91 13](#) # Thou shalt tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon shalt thou trample under feet.

tread upon their [05 DEU 33 29](#) # Happy [art] thou, O Israel: who [is] like unto thee, O people saved by the LORD, the shield of thy help, and who [is] the sword of thy excellency! and thine enemies shall be found liars unto thee; and thou shalt tread upon their high places.

tread with shouting [24 JER 48 33](#) # And joy and gladness is taken from the plentiful field, and from the land of Moab; and I have caused wine to fail from the winepresses: none shall tread with shouting; [their] shouting [shall be] no shouting.

treader of grapes [30 AMO 09 13](#) # Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that the plowman shall overtake the reaper, and the treader of grapes him that soweth seed; and the mountains shall drop sweet wine, and all the hills shall melt.

treaders shall tread [23 ISA 16 10](#) # And gladness is taken away, and joy out of the plentiful field; and in the vineyards there shall be no singing, neither shall there be shouting: the treaders shall tread out no wine in [their] presses; I have made [their vintage] shouting to cease.

treadeth clay [23 ISA 41 25](#) # I have raised up [one] from the north, and he shall come: from the rising of the sun shall he call upon my name: and he shall come upon princes as [upon] mortar, and as the potter treadeth clay.

treadeth down and [33 MIC 05 08](#) # And the remnant of Jacob shall be among the Gentiles in the midst of many people as a lion among the beasts of the forest, as a young lion among the flocks of sheep: who, if he go through, both treadeth down, and teareth in pieces, and none can deliver.

treadeth in the [23 ISA 63 02](#) # Wherefore [art thou] red in thine apparel, and thy garments like him that treadeth in the winefat?

treadeth out the [46 ICO 09 09](#) # For it is written in the law of Moses, Thou shalt not muzzle the mouth of the ox that treadeth out the corn. Doth God take care for oxen?

treadeth out the [54 ITI 05 18](#) # For the scripture saith, Thou shalt not muzzle the ox that treadeth out the corn. And, The labourer [is] worthy of his reward.

treadeth out the [05 DEU 25 04](#) # Thou shalt not muzzle the ox when he treadeth out [the corn].

treadeth the winepress [66 REV 19 15](#) # And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

treadeth upon the [30 AMO 04 13](#) # For, lo, he that formeth the mountains, and createth the wind, and declareth unto man what [is] his thought, that maketh the morning darkness, and treadeth upon the high places of the earth, The LORD, The God of hosts, [is] his name.

treadeth upon the [18 JOB 09 08](#) # Which alone spreadeth out the heavens, and treadeth upon the waves of the sea.

treadeth within our [33 MIC 05 06](#) # And they shall waste the land of Assyria with the sword, and the land of Nimrod in the entrances thereof: thus shall he deliver [us] from the Assyrian, when he cometh into our land, and when he treadeth within our borders.

treading down and [23 ISA 22 05](#) # For [it is] a day of trouble, and of treading down, and of perplexity by the Lord GOD of hosts in the valley of vision, breaking down the walls, and of crying to the mountains.
