reckon one was 40_MAT_18_24# And when he had begun to reckon, one was brought unto him, which owed him ten thousand talents.

reckon that the <u>45_ROM_08_18</u># For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time [are] not worthy [to be compared] with the glory which shall be revealed in us.

reckon the instruments <u>04_NUM_04_32</u># And the pillars of the court round about, and their sockets, and their pins, and their cords, with all their instruments, and with all their service: and by name ye shall reckon the instruments of the charge of their burden.

reckon unto him 26_EZE_44_26 # And after he is cleansed, they shall reckon unto him seven days.

reckon unto him <u>03_LEV_27_18</u> # But if he sanctify his field after the jubilee, then the priest shall reckon unto him the money according to the years that remain, even unto the year of the jubilee, and it shall be abated from thy estimation.

reckon unto him <u>03_LEV_27_23</u># Then the priest shall reckon unto him the worth of thy estimation, [even] unto the year of the jubilee: and he shall give thine estimation in that day, [as] a holy thing unto the LORD.

reckon with him <u>03_LEV_25_50</u># And he shall reckon with him that bought him from the year that he was sold to him unto the year of jubilee: and the price of his sale shall be according unto the number of years, according to the time of an hired servant shall it be with him.

reckon ye also <u>45_ROM_06_11</u> # Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord.

reckoned after the <u>13_1CH_05_01</u> # Now the sons of Reuben the firstborn of Israel, [for he [was] the firstborn; but, forasmuch as he defiled his father's bed, his birthright was given unto the sons of Joseph the son of Israel: and the genealogy is not to be reckoned after the birthright.

reckoned among the <u>42_LUK_22_37</u># For I say unto you, that this that is written must yet be accomplished in me, And he was reckoned among the transgressors: for the things concerning me have an end.

reckoned among the <u>04_NUM_23_09</u># For from the top of the rocks I see him, and from the hills I behold him: lo, the people shall dwell alone, and shall not be reckoned among the nations.

reckoned by genealogies <u>13_1CH_05_17</u> # All these were reckoned by genealogies in the days of Jotham king of Judah, and in the days of Jeroboam king of Israel.

reckoned by genealogies <u>13_1CH_09_01</u> # So all Israel were reckoned by genealogies; and, behold, they [were] written in the book of the kings of Israel and Judah, [who] were carried away to Babylon for their transgression.

reckoned by genealogies <u>14_2CH_31_19</u># Also of the sons of Aaron the priests, [which were] in the fields of the suburbs of their cities, in every several city, the men that were expressed by name, to give portions to all the males among the priests, and to all that were reckoned by genealogies among the Levites.

reckoned by genealogy 15_EZR_02_62 # These sought their register [among] those that were reckoned by

genealogy, but they were not found: therefore were they, as polluted, put from the priesthood.

reckoned by genealogy <u>15_EZR_08_03</u> # Of the sons of Shechaniah, of the sons of Pharosh; Zechariah: and with him were reckoned by genealogy of the males an hundred and fifty.

reckoned by genealogy <u>16_NEH_07_05</u># And my God put into mine heart to gather together the nobles, and the rulers, and the people, that they might be reckoned by genealogy. And I found a register of the genealogy of them which came up at the first, and found written therein,

reckoned by genealogy <u>16_NEH_07_64</u> # These sought their register [among] those that were reckoned by genealogy, but it was not found: therefore were they, as polluted, put from the priesthood.

reckoned by their <u>13_1CH_07_07</u># And the sons of Bela; Ezbon, and Uzzi, and Uzziel, and Jerimoth, and Iri, five; heads of the house of [their] fathers, mighty men of valour; and were reckoned by their genealogies twenty and two thousand and thirty and four.

reckoned by their 13 1CH 09 22 # All these [which were] chosen to be porters in the gates [were] two hundred and twelve. These were reckoned by their genealogy in their villages, whom David and Samuel the seer did ordain in their set office.

reckoned in all <u>13_1CH_07_05</u> # And their brethren among all the families of Issachar [were] valiant men of might, reckoned in all by their genealogies fourscore and seven thousand.

reckoned not with 12 2KI 12 15 # Moreover they reckoned not with the men, into whose hand they delivered the money to be bestowed on workmen: for they dealt faithfully.

reckoned of grace <u>45_ROM_04_04</u> # Now to him that worketh is the reward not reckoned of grace, but of debt.

reckoned till morning 23_ISA_38_13_# I reckoned till morning, [that], as a lion, so will he break all my bones: from day [even] to night wilt thou make an end of me.

reckoned to Abraham 45 ROM 04 09 # [Cometh] this blessedness then upon the circumcision [only], or upon the uncircumcision also? for we say that faith was reckoned to Abraham for righteousness.

reckoned to Benjamin 10_2SA_04_02 # And Saul's son had two men [that were] captains of bands: the name of the one [was] Baanah, and the name of the other Rechab, the sons of Rimmon a Beerothite, of the children of Benjamin: [for Beeroth also was reckoned to Benjamin.

reckoned unto you <u>04_NUM_18_27</u> # And [this] your heave offering shall be reckoned unto you, as though [it were] the corn of the threshingfloor, and as the fulness of the winepress.

reckoned up in 19 PSA 40 05 # Many, O LORD my God, [are] thy wonderful works [which] thou hast done, and thy thoughts [which are] to us ward: they cannot be reckoned up in order unto thee: [if] I would declare and speak [of them], they are more than can be numbered.

reckoned were the <u>13_1CH_05_07</u> # And his brethren by their families, when the genealogy of their generations was reckoned, [were] the chief, Jeiel, and Zechariah,

reckoned when he <u>45_ROM_04_10</u> # How was it then reckoned? when he was in circumcision, or in uncircumcision? Not in circumcision, but in uncircumcision.

reckoneth with them <u>40_MAT_25_19</u># After a long time the lord of those servants cometh, and reckoneth with them.

reckoning according to 13_1CH_23_11# And Jahath was the chief, and Zizah the second: but Jeush and Beriah had not many sons; therefore they were in one reckoning, according to [their] father's house.

reckoning made with 12 2KI 22 07 # Howbeit there was no reckoning made with them of the money that was delivered into their hand, because they dealt faithfully.
